### DAY 1 : CHECK IN / DEPART KLIA ✈️

### DAY 2 : K.L ✈️ PARIS - TOURS

Welcome to Rome! At around 05:30 p.m., we'll depart **Paris** for the **Loire Valley**. We'll arrive in **Tours**, the regional capital of the **Loire**, in the late afternoon. We recommend taking some time to explore the beautiful old town and enjoy a nice dinner.

### DAY 3 : TOURS - BORDEAUX - LOURDES

- Visit vineyards and Bordeaux (UNESCO World Heritage Site).
- Suggested stops: Port of the Moon, Cathedral of St. Andrew.
- Continue to Lourdes for a candlelight procession and worship.
- Dinner provided at the hotel.

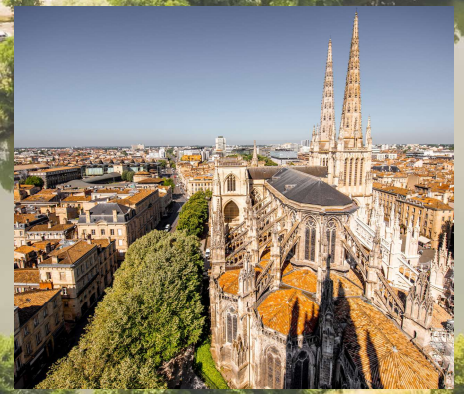
Today, we embark on an enchanting journey to the south of **France**, traversing picturesque vineyards and arriving in **Bordeaux**, a town center recognized as a UNESCO World Heritage Site. You'll have the opportunity to enjoy lunch and explore the area. We recommend visiting the Port of the Moon and the Cathedral of St. Andrew. Following this, we will proceed towards the Pyrenees, reaching **Lourdes** in the late afternoon. Here, you can participate in the candlelight procession (available from late March through the end of October) and explore various places of worship. **Dinner will be provided at the hotel for all our guests.**

### DAY 4 : LOURDES - CARCASSONNE - NARBONNE - MARSEILLE

 B

- Explore Carcassonne, known for its beautiful walls.
- Visit Narbonne, with time to discover its historic old town.
- Conclude in Marseille, enjoying the lively Vieux-Port area.

We will journey through the south of France, making a stop in **Carcassonne**, a city encircled by some of the most stunning walls in Europe. You'll have the opportunity to stroll and explore at your leisure. After lunch, we will proceed to **Narbonne**, where you can take your time to uncover the charm of this historic Occitan city and its picturesque old town. In the late afternoon, we will arrive in **Marseille**, the second-largest city in France. We suggest taking a leisurely walk through its lively Vieux-Port (Old Port), bustling with activity and featuring delightful small restaurants.





## DAY 5: MARSEILLE - ARLES - AVIGNON - LYON

🏠 B

- Explore Arles, a UNESCO city known for Roman sites and Van Gogh.
- Visit medieval Les Baux and the Carrières de Lumières art show.
- Enjoy lunch and a stroll in Avignon, home to the Palais des Papes.
- Walk through Lyon's old town, a World Heritage Site.
- Take a cable car to Notre-Dame de Fourvière for city views.
- If Carrières de Lumières is unavailable, visit the Pont du Gard aqueduct instead.

Explore stunning locations in **Provence**, including **Arles**, a UNESCO site with Roman and medieval heritage and Van Gogh's influence. Visit the medieval village of **Les Baux** and enjoy the **Carrières de Lumières** exhibition. Savor lunch and stroll in **Avignon**, home to the Palais des Papes. In **Lyon**, explore the old town and ride the **cable car** to Notre-Dame de Fourvière for breathtaking views. If Carrières de Lumières is unavailable, the Roman aqueduct at Pont du Gard will be visited instead.

## DAY 6: LYON - TOURNUS - SAVIGNY CASTLE - BEAUNE - DIJON

🏠 B

- Begin in Lyon, then visit Tournus for its stone gate and abbey.
- Explore Beaune, the wine capital, with a wine museum and historic hospice.
- Visit Savigny Castle, featuring museums for motorbikes, racing cars, and aircraft.
- End in Dijon, famous for its vibrant streets and medieval/Renaissance architecture, including the Palace of the Dukes.

We will depart from **Lyon** and make our way to the **Burgundy** region. Our first destination will be **Tournus**, a charming little town characterized by its impressive stone gate and a grand abbey. Following that, we'll head to **Beaune**, where we'll enjoy lunch and explore the wine capital of **Burgundy**. We suggest a visit to the wine museum or the historic hospice. Next, we'll proceed to **Savigny Castle**, nestled in the heart of this renowned winemaking area. Constructed in the 15th century, the castle boasts remarkable museums that showcase motorbikes, racing cars, planes, and helicopters. Our adventure will conclude in **Dijon**, the capital of **Burgundy**, celebrated for its vibrant streets and an array of medieval and Renaissance architecture, including the iconic **Palace of the Dukes**.

## DAY 7: DIJON - BESANCON - COLMAR - RIQUEWIHR - STRASBOURG

🏠 B

- Visit historic Besançon and its 17th-century citadel.
- Experience the French-German culture and dialect of Alsace.
- First stop: Colmar, famous for architecture, canals, and cuisine.
- Explore medieval Riquewihr, the inspiration for "Beauty and the Beast."

While still in the **Burgundy** region, we'll stop in **Besançon**, a city of Roman origin with a beautiful historic center and a 17th-century citadel that overlooks the town. We'll then continue our journey to **Alsace**, a French region that has been contested between France and Germany for centuries. Alsace retains its own German dialect, Alsatian, along with architecture and traditions deeply rooted in Germanic culture. Our first stop in Alsace will be **Colmar**, a city with unique architecture, colorful half-timbered houses and canals winding through the town. Colmar is also famous for its white wine and gastronomy. You'll have time for lunch and a leisurely walk. In the afternoon, we'll visit one of the most beautiful towns in Alsace: **Riquewihr**, a medieval town with cobblestone streets and colorful houses that look like they're straight out of a fairy tale—it even inspired scenes from Beauty and the Beast. We'll arrive in **Strasbourg** in the evening. We recommend taking a walk around the cathedral area and Petite France, both filled with charming spots and cozy restaurants.

## DAY 8: STRASBOURG - FRIBOURG - TRIBERG - GENGENBACH - BADEN BADEN



- Explore Strasbourg's historic center and Gothic cathedral.
- Take a boat trip through Petite France's canals.
- Visit Germany's Black Forest and have lunch in Freiburg's medieval center.
- Discover cuckoo clocks and waterfalls in Triberg, and enjoy Gengenbach's central square.

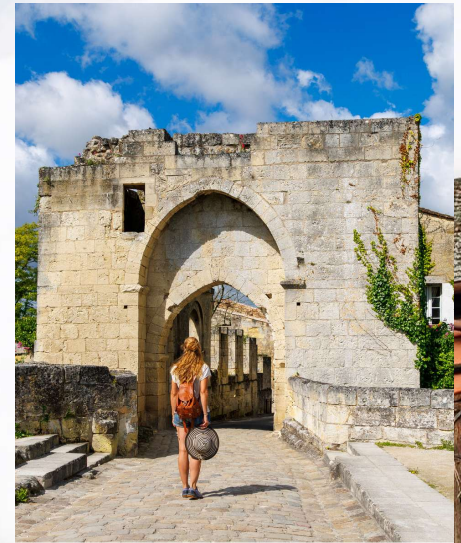
We'll start our day in **Strasbourg**, the capital of Alsace and home to the European Parliament. The city's historic center is a true gem, with its charming medieval streets, a stunning Gothic cathedral, and picturesque canals lined with flowers. We'll include a **boat trip through the canals** of Petite France to fully appreciate this beautiful area. Afterward, we'll cross into **Germany**, passing through the scenic mountain landscapes and towns of the **Black Forest**. In **Freiburg**, you'll have time for lunch and a walk through this lively university city, known for its medieval center and impressive cathedral. We'll then continue through the Black Forest to **Triberg**, one of the most picturesque towns in the region, famous for its cuckoo clocks. We'll include admission to the **Triberg Waterfalls**, Germany's highest waterfalls, which we'll reach via a lovely walking path. Next, we'll make a quick stop so you can take some pictures of **Gengenbach**, a charming town with a beautiful central square, before heading to **Baden-Baden** for the night. This spa town, once a favorite retreat for European nobility and the upper bourgeoisie, still exudes an air of elegance with its casinos, architecture, and parks.

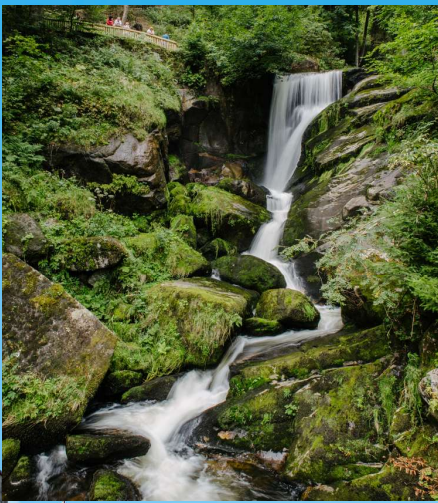
## DAY 9: BADEN BADEN - SPEYER - HEIDELBERG - FRANKFURT



- Explore Baden-Baden parks during free time.
- Visit Speyer's Romanesque cathedral and Alte Münze.
- Take a cable car to Heidelberg Castle, enjoying gardens and wineries.
- Have lunch and stroll through Heidelberg's old town, including Marktplatz.
- Arrive in Frankfurt, known for skyscrapers, historic sites, and nightlife.

We'll begin the day with some free time in **Baden-Baden** for a relaxing stroll through its lovely parks before we head to **Rhineland-Palatinate**. Our first stop will be **Speyer**, a historic city along the Rhine River. Here, you can explore the grand Romanesque cathedral, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, and wander through the old quarter, where Alte Münze stands out. We'll then make our way to **Heidelberg**, where a cable car will take us up to the impressive **castle**, offering breathtaking views over the city (tickets included). Your ticket includes access to the **castle's gardens, wineries, and the apothecary museum**. Afterward, you'll have time for lunch and a leisurely walk through the old town, including the Marktplatz. In the afternoon, we'll arrive in **Frankfurt**, a bustling financial center known for its modern skyscrapers, historic old town, scenic views of the Rhine River, and vibrant nightlife. . In a typical beer garden located in the historic heart of the city, Römerberg Square, we'll enjoy a tasting of a classic German specialty: **beer paired with Frankfurt sausage and sauerkraut**.





## DAY 10 : FRANKFURT - LUXEMBOURG - REIMS - PARIS

🏠 B

- Start in Luxembourg, blending history and modernity with German and French languages.
- Explore Old Town, Grand Ducal Palace, and Notre-Dame Cathedral.
- Proceed to Reims, France, known for its Gothic cathedral and Champagne region.

We'll journey to **France**, beginning with a visit to the **Grand Duchy of Luxembourg**, a small country where both German (Luxembourgish dialect) and French are spoken. We'll arrive in **Luxembourg**, a cosmopolitan city that seamlessly blends its rich history with the modernity of being a financial hub and a key location for European institutions. Some of its highlights include the old town, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, as well as the city's fortifications, the Grand Ducal Palace, and the Notre-Dame Cathedral. After lunch, we'll continue our journey into **France**. In the heart of the Champagne-producing region, we'll stop in **Reims**, where you can marvel at its stunning Gothic cathedral, the historic site of numerous French royal coronations. We'll arrive in **Paris** by the end of the day.
