### DAY 1 : Depart from KLIA

### DAY 2 : Sydney Arrival

Arrival at Sydney International Airport, meet by local driver and Transfer to hotel (checkin 3pm)

### Day 3: Blue Mountains with entrance to Scenic World

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Journey to the heart of the **Blue Mountains on this full-day tour from Sydney**, including hotel pick-up. Kick-off your adventure seeing a koala or a kangaroo at Wildlife Park, then enjoy a dramatic view of the Three Sisters rocks from Echo Point. After lunch (own expense), head to **Scenic World to ride the Cableway, Skyway and Railway (entrance fee included)** for unbeatable aerial views of the Jamison Valley and Katoomba Falls. Finish with a leisurely cruise along the Parramatta River to Sydney's Darling Harbour or Circular Quay.

- See iconic Australian wildlife including koalas, kangaroos, and native animals.
- Opportunity to take photos with a koala (Admission included)
- Visit the famous Three Sisters rock formation.
- Enjoy panoramic views over the Jamison Valley.
- Learn about the Aboriginal legend behind the Three Sisters.
- Experience the Scenic Railway (world's steepest incline railway)
- Ride the Scenic Cableway with spectacular valley views.
- Walk through the World Heritage rainforest boardwalk.
- View Katoomba Falls, Orphan Rock, Mt Solitary, and the Three Sisters
- Relax on a scenic ferry cruise (**AUD10/pax pay on spot excluded**) from Parramatta River to Darling Harbour or Circular Quay.
- Enjoy Sydney Harbour and waterfront views.
- Once reached **Sydney Central Business District** by ferry you have option to walk to hotel on own or take short uber driver (depending on hotel's location)

### Day 4: Hunter Valley Wine Tour

- Spend a full day in one of Australia's best loved wine regions on a relaxed Hunter Valley day tour that blends cellar doors, local produce and rolling vineyard views. ### Day 5 : Sydney - Panoramic Sydney half day city with Bondi Beach (B)

- Depart your hotel for an unforgettable **Panoramic Sydney half day city sights tour**. On tour you will visit the historic Rocks area and hear of early convict history. We continue through the financially focused Central Business District(CBD), and Macquarie Street. Marvel at 18th century sandstone architecture such as NSW Parliament House, Rum Hospital, Hyde Park Barracks and St Mary's Cathedral. We will continue to Mrs Macquaries Point, to enjoy magnificent views of the Sydney Opera House and Harbour Bridge.
- We then continue through Sydneys Eastern Suburbs, home to the rich and famous. Travelling along the coves and shores of one of the worlds most impressive harbours, we will take a few stops for photo opportunities, including a panoramic photo of Sydney skyline. You will pass through areas such as Kings Cross, Double Bay, Rose Bay before arriving at Watsons Bay, passengers will have the option a short coastal walk with views of the South Pacific Ocean and the entrance to Sydney harbour.
- Travel on to famous Bondi Beach for a 30 minute stop. Visit the beachfront promenade, put your toes in the sand, enjoy a coffee or cool drink (at own cost). Re-board your bus and continue on to Tamarama and Bronte beaches before returning to the city via Centennial Park and Paddington, a trendy district with its elegant terrace houses and boutique shops along Oxford street.
- Final stop of the day is Darling Harbour, passengers who are on lunch cruise may board their lunch cruises here. Passengers can join our optional harbour lunch cruises, bookings are essential and additional cost.
- Tour ends at Darling Harbour and Walk/Uber back to hotel on own cost depending on hotel's location.
