

7D5N WHITE HOKAIDDO WINTER FUN

ITINERARY

DAY 1: DEPART - JAPAN

Assemble at KLIA/KLIA2 for departure flight to Japan.

DAY 2: ARRIVE - CHITOSE - TOYA - NOBORIBETSU

Upon arrival at **New Chitose Airport**, your 1st day sightseeing attractions start with;

- **Noboribetsu Jigokudani** - a spectacular, named Valley just above the town of Nobotibetsu Onsen, with a diameter of about 450 meters, 3 thousands liters of spring water gushes out every minute from the crater. Along the valley, you can have a close up view of hot steam vents and sulfurous streams.
- **Mt. Showa Shinzan** - Literally means 'Showa New Mountain' as it was formed during the reign of Emperor Hirohito, known as Showa period.
- **Bear Ranch** - There are about 100 Ezo Brown Bears in the park. You can feed them with apples or cookies. The big brown bears will stand up and make 'give me' poses which attract many visitors.
- **Lake Toya** - Japan's 3rd largest volcanic caldera lake. This ice-free lake never freezes, even in winter when the temperature falls quite drastically.
- **Noboribetsu Hot Spring** - you will stay one night in the onsen resort and enjoy its hot spring that is most popular in Hokkaido.

DAY 3: NOBORIBETSU - HAKODATE

Today, you'll visit **Hakodate** - which is Hokkaido's third largest city, that is one of the first three ports in Japan to be opened for foreign trade in 1859,

- **Kanemori Red Brick Warehouse** - where you can stroll along the bay for outdoor spectacular views while enjoying the refreshing sea breeze, and have a tea break.
- **Goryokaku Park** - the site of Goryokaku Fort, designated as a national historic site, is a park blessed with nature. You will enjoy walking around through beautiful scenery in 4 seasons. **Cherry Blossoms** in spring, **Green Trees** in summer, **Autumn Leaves** in fall, and **Snow** in winter.





- **Mt. Hakodate (ropeway)** - the Mountain Base Station where cable car boarding & disembarking point for a modern tramway to the top of Mount Hakodate. In the night, you'll enjoy this Award Winning of a 3* view ranking as "Michelin Green Guide Japan". ****subject to weather condition..** The view from Mt Hokodate is described as one of the most stunning night view that 'worth to see' in the world.
- Enjoy and relax yourself while staying at the **Onsen Hotel** in Hokkaido

DAY 4: HAKODATE

This morning, let's explore Hokkaido's largest seafood market with fresh fruits and vegetables and eateries at the Hakodate Morning Market.

After that, you'll enjoy the most popular activities in the winter of Hokkaido.

- **Ski Fun** - Hokkaido's white, light and fluffy powder snow provides the best quality snow to ski for everyone. ****ski equipment and activities are at own expenses)**
- **Ski Resort** - tonight you'll stay at one of the best ski resorts in Hokkaido.

DAY 5: OTARU - SAPPORO

Today, you'll explore many other attraction sites of Hokkaido;

- **Otaru Canal** - which was once a transportation hub that was transformed to a tourists attraction and now a landmark of Otaru.
- **Otaru Handicraft Street** - renowned for its glass handicrafts, music box museum, art gallery, ice-cream & dessert shops. A perfect place to shop for souvenirs for your friends and your love one.
- **Hokkaido's Former Government Building** - an European building that built in 1888 with Baroque style which is listed as Japan's cultural relic.
- **Odori Park** - located in the heart of Sapporo, it is the popular venue for various festivals throughout the year. The 147.2 meters high **Sapporo TV Tower** is an attractive landmark of the park.
- **Tanukikoji Shopping Arcade** - approximately 1km long arcade you can enjoy shopping spree with more than 150 shops ranging from souvenirs, clothing, cafes and snacks. After that, drive pass **Susukino**, Sapporo's most famous nightlife and entertainment area.

DAY 6: SAPPORO - KITAHIROSHIMA

Today, you'll get a chance to witness the renowned Sapporo Winter Olympic ski-jump that was used in 1972;

- **Okurayama Olympic Ski Jump** - you can also view the entire city of Sapporo from the observation deck. ****subject to weather condition**
- **Hokkaido Shrine** - in 1869, the Meiji Emperor decided to enshrine 3 Shinto Deities; Sukunahikona, Ookunitama and Ookuninushi, they became the 3 deities in Hokkaido.
- **Mitsui Outlet Park** - other than Japanese products, here you can find most international brands, as well as value buy promotions!


DAY 7: KITAHIROSHIMA - CHITOSE - KUALA LUMPUR

After breakfast, proceed to airport for your flight back home with a sweet memory.
