DAY 1 : Kuala Lumpur ✈ Mauritius

Upon arrival Sir Seewoosagur Ramgoolam (SSR) International Airport, local representative will pick up and transfer to hotel check in, free at own leisure.

DAY 2 : Mauritius

Discover the South West of Mauritius with a private 8-hour Mauritius tour. The driver will pick you up from your hotel and drive you to the various sights and attractions below. You will get to explore at your own pace while the driver waits for you.

Enjoy the 360 degree views from the top of the **Trou aux Cerfs volcano** while taking a stroll around the crater. This dormant volcano stands at around 600 m above sea level, and on clear days offers a breathtaking panoramic view of the island.

Drive by the Mare-aux-Vacoas, Mauritius' largest reservoir, on the way to **Grand Bassin**, a tranquil and serene crater lake considered sacred by the Hindu population. Discover the Hindu culture by visiting the temples around the lake and enjoy the peace and quiet of the surroundings. You will also be amazed by the **tall statue of Shiva** and the view from the highest temple. Be sure to watch out for the monkeys and wildlife. Note: It may not be possible to make this stop in the month of February or March as the area is also a pilgrimage site during the festival of Mahashivaratree.

Nature lovers will enjoy the incredible views of the **Black River Gorges**, the largest national park in Mauritius. Covering an area of 6754 hectares, the park is home to numerous endemic flora and fauna and provides visitors with beautiful hikes, with varying levels of difficulty. During your drive through the park and Plaine des Champagnes, you will also get to stop and admire **Alexandra falls** and viewpoint, and if they're in season, like the locals, you'll want to pick a few goyaves de chine!

Visit the popular Chamarel, the coloured earth site, where in addition to the geological wonders of the seven coloured dunes, you can view the **Chamarel Falls**, the most famous waterfall in Mauritius! And, make sure you stop by the giant tortoise pens before leaving the park!

DAY 4 : Mauritius



Discover the south of Mauritius, including the **Blue Bay Marine Park**, on this unique 8-hour tour. Your private driver will pick you up at your hotel and take you to see the attractions listed below. You'll get to explore at your own pace while the driver waits for you.

Blue Bay Glass Bottom Boat & Snorkelling

Once you arrive at Blue Bay Beach, you will begin to understand where the name "Blue Bay" came from: the water is a multitude of shades of blue. From the beach, you'll embark on a glass bottom boat trip to the famous Blue Bay Marine Park. The marine park is arguably the best location for snorkelling in Mauritius. With snorkelling gear provided, you'll be able to discover the abundance of colourful tropical fish, including the trumpet fish, diverse coral formations and other marine creatures that call this park home.

While most of Mauritius is surrounded by coral reefs, giving us the calm lagoon the island is famous for, the southern part of the island is where there is a break in the reef. At **Gris Gris**, you will be able to admire the rugged scenery of big, powerful waves crashing on the stunning cliffs. A few metres away, you will see **La Roche qui Pleure**, a natural rock formation that resembles a person crying when the waves hit it.

Stroll through **La Vanille Réserve des Mascareignes** and its 3.5 hectares of lush greenery. Discover its beautiful palm and banana trees, giant bamboos, its impressive animals, including 2,000 Nile Crocodiles and 1,000 giant tortoises. You will also visit their insectarium which boasts one of the best private collections in the world with 23,000 species.

The St. Aubin Rhumerie uses both artisanal and traditional distillery techniques to make its award-winning rum. You'll have the opportunity to visit the factory and learn about the rum-making process and sample the delicious varieties of rum they offer. You can also visit the beautiful colonial house and the vanilla and anthurium flower plantations.
