



8D5N Grand Tasmania (Hobart to Launceston)

DAY 1 : Depart KLIA-MEL/SYD

DAY 2 : Arrival Hobart VIA MEL/SYD

Arrive Hobart Airport shuttle transfer to hotel. Hotel check-in time 1400PM.

Free at own leisure to explore the waterfront, harbour, galleries, gardens and historic Battery Point. On Saturdays, explore Salamanca market. Hobart sprawls on either side of the expansive Derwent River with Historic sandstone buildings lining the city's old docks. Considering Hobart started as a penal colony, the city of just 215,000 residents has fared quite well (by the way; it's now quite cool to have convict ancestry). Hobart is also the gateway to the surroundings such as the Huon Valley, Derwent Valley and Tasman Peninsula which is all under 90 minutes away.

DAY 3 : Hobart - Full Day BRUNY ISLAND

(Breakfast/Lunch)

Enjoy a relaxing fully guided tour with all foods, attraction and entry fees included. Discover everything that makes Bruny Island amazing with this outstanding sightseeing, food, and lighthouse tour. Eat local fresh produce; everything from oysters to cider, chocolate, fudge, honey, and artisan cheeses. You'll get to spot wildlife in their habitat, walk the beaches, smell the rainforests, climb The Truganini Neck Lookout and tour the iconic Cape Bruny Lighthouse, perched above the wild Tasmanian coastlines. Meet the local producers and characters with local guides that make your trip to Bruny Island special.

With a Hotel pick-up, you'll enjoy a scenic country and coastal drive to Kettering, here you will board the ferry and enjoy the beautiful scenery as you head over to Bruny Island, watching the seals frolic in the sheltered waterways. First up climbing the Truganini Neck Lookout and visit Two Tree Point in Adventure Bay, where you will enjoy your rustic style picnic, with local cheese, freshly shucked oysters and wood oven bread. Then it's a scenic drive through rainforest and around Mount Mangana to Cape Bruny. For lunch, choose from an extensive menu of locally caught fresh fish, succulent local lamb, Tasmanian Salmon, seafood chowder or the popular seafood platter for two. A collaboration of fine food with the island producers and Tasmanian produce, overlooking Sunset Beach.

If that's not enough why don't you enjoy a unique [Bruny Island Cider tasting](#). You'll visit South Bruny Island National Park where you'll be astounded by the spectacular and rugged coastal views, expanses of coastal vegetation and the wildlife, white wallabies, eagles, echidnas and more that call this area their home. Go on a tour of the Iconic Bruny Island Lighthouse and learn about the history of this lovely building, taking in sea views from its balcony. Stories ooze from the convict-built lighthouse with tragic shipwrecks and lightkeeper trials and tribulations. Your afternoon will be full of [more local delights with Chocolate, Fudge and Honey tasting](#) with yummy samples of course and plenty of time to shop... With another visit to the Cheese Company giving you the opportunity to sample and purchase your favourite cheese to take home. We stop at many of the island's main attractions. The Neck Wildlife Reserve (Penguins sometimes seen in the burrows), Mount Mangana, Adventure Bay, South Bruny National Park, and Cape Bruny Lighthouse.

DAY 4 : Hobart - Port Arthur – Hobart

(Breakfast)

[Port Arthur & Tasmanian Devils](#) | Depart Hobart at 7.30am | Return 6.00pm

We take an early start from Hobart and head to the stunning [Tasman Peninsula](#), home to Australia's highest sea cliffs. Enjoy the panoramic views of the area from Pirates Bay Lookout, and along the short but spectacular [Waterfall Bay Clifftop Track](#). This is one of Tasmania's "Great Short Walks", around 45 minutes, concluding at the remarkable rock formations of Tasman Arch and Devil's Kitchen. Next stop is the [Tasmanian Devil Unzoo](#). We arrive here for the action of a Tasmanian Devil Feeding. Watch the snarling, fighting and bone crushing in a spectacle of devilish behaviour during the feeding. Hand feed the wallabies and walk amongst the local fauna and flora in the charming "Unzoo" setting.

Just a short drive down the road, we enter the Port Arthur Historic Site. Here you have around 2.5 hours to explore the site. Your entry includes a complimentary Harbour Cruise around the Isle of the Dead and a guided walking tour with Port Arthur's expert guides. Discover the grim and violent history of the early Australian Penal system and get a sense of the isolation experienced by the convicts in this "inescapable prison". On our return to Hobart, we make a stop at Federation Chocolate with a variety of chocolate flavours to sample. Further along we arrive in the late afternoon into historic Richmond Village. Meander the streets, stop for a coffee and walk across Australia's oldest bridge still in use – a convict built sand-stone bridge, reported to be haunted! Last but not least, before we re-enter Hobart we stop for a fabulous view across Hobart from a local lookout. A picturesque way to return to the city. We drop you back to your Hobart central city hotel/hostel around 6.00pm.



DAY 5 : Hobart - Wineglass Bay, Freycinet National Park- Launceston

(Breakfast/-/-)

Departs: Hobart 7.30am,

Returns: Launceston 6.30pm

[Wineglass Bay](#) has been voted many times amongst the top beaches of the world. A perfect crescent shape, stunning colours and dazzling white sand make this one of Tasmania's "not to be missed" locations.

Walk to the [Wineglass Bay lookout](#) to see one of the "World's Top 10 beaches!" Join us for a fun & action-packed day out as we discover the "Jewel in the Crown" of Tasmania's east coast. We enjoy a [variety of short walks, National Park coastal scenery & delicious local food opportunities](#) along the way (local oysters, berries, ice-creams and hand-made chocolates!)

We depart Hobart heading east then following the coastline north. We travel through the seaside towns of Orford and Swansea as we make our way to Freycinet National Park. Freycinet is one of [Tasmania's first National Parks, famous for its rich and stunning coastal landscapes](#). Pink Granite Mountains form the backdrop for secluded bays, pristine waters, white sandy beaches, local wildlife and amazing walking trails.

As we enter the Freycinet peninsula, we have a brief stop at the [Freycinet Marine Farm](#) for anyone interested

in the local oysters fresh from the surrounding waters. We walk as a group to the [Wineglass Bay Lookout](#), a moderate uphill walk of around 45 - 60 minutes. Here the views make the walk well worth the effort! For the keen walkers, you can continue along the track that takes you down to Wineglass beach (2.5 hr return walking time). Once on the beach you have time to take a swim, relax, eat your lunch or meander along the white sands.

If you prefer to select the shorter walking option, then we return from the Lookout with our Tour Guide and explore other areas of Freycinet National Park. Visit [Honeymoon Bay](#), [Sleepy Bay](#), [Cape Tourville Lighthouse](#) & [Great Short Walk](#).

We re-group ready for the return journey to Launceston. Still on the East Coast we will make a short stop along the way, for those looking for a sweet treat there will be tasty local ice-cream and desserts available, a well deserved reward after a full day out! We arrive in Launceston around 6.30pm.

DAY 6 : Launceston - Cradle Mountain World Heritage – Launceston (Breakfast)

Departs: Launceston 7.30am

Returns: Launceston 6.30pm

[Cradle Mountain National Park](#) is an area of iconic scenery with a huge variety of walking trails to choose from in this stunning world heritage listed area. With around 5 hours to spend in the National Park we leave our walking itinerary flexible to suit our guests and the weather conditions on the day.

After departing Launceston we enjoy a short stop in [Sheffield – The Town of Murals](#). Sheffield is a small and quirky village where the history of the Cradle Mountain region is depicted in artworks across the buildings throughout the town, this includes the opportunity to see the famous Eason's Mural.

We continue our journey into the mountains and arrive at Cradle Mountain and Dove Lake with around 5 hours of possible walking time before us. We begin with a series of short walks to [Rainforest City and](#)

[Pencil Pine Falls](#). From here we can choose from the gentle and [iconic Dove Lake Circuit](#) an easy 2 hour walk with amazing mountain views. For the more active, we offer the chance to climb to the loftier heights of Marion's Lookout. This walk is well rewarded with amazing 360 degree views of the surrounding World Heritage wilderness area. Enjoy lunch on own expenses by a quiet stream, watch the famous and friendly Cradle wombats in their natural habitat, or enjoy the many photographic opportunities that abound. Learn some of the local history as we visit Weindorfer's Chalet and see the ancient King Billy Pines on Weindorfer's Forest Walk. Cradle Mountain is the backdrop for a truly memorable and not to be missed Tasmanian experience. On our return to Launceston, we stop and sample some local tasty products at the award winning Ashgrove Cheese Factory. We return to Launceston around 6.30 – 7.00pm after a huge yet unforgettable Cradle Mountain day.



DAY 7 : Launceston – MEL/SYD - KUL

(Breakfast)

[Free at own Leisure](#). Hotel airport transfer. Hotel check-out time 1000AM.

Founded in 1806, Launceston has many delightful Victorian and Georgian heritage buildings to admire on a walking tour. The Queen Victoria Museum and Art Gallery is one of Australia's most respected regional museums. Cataract Gorge is one of the city's most visited sites and the chairlift is a must-do activity especially as it is the world's longest single span chairlift at 308m.
