## DAY 1 : CHECK IN / DEPART KLIA

## DAY 2 : ARRIVAL PARIS

- Pickup from airport and Transfer to the hotel

Welcome to your tour with Europamundo! We'll transfer you to the hotel and you'll have some free time. In the afternoon, you'll find information about the start of your tour on the boards located at the hotel reception.

## DAY 3 : PARIS



- Palace of Versailles (Photostop) for its stunning gardens.
- Visit Montmartre, renowned for its artists, painters, and cabarets.

We'll immerse ourselves in the rich history of **France** at the magnificent **Palace of Versailles** (admission not included), renowned for its stunning gardens. On our return to **Paris**, we'll visit **Montmartre**, a charming bohemian neighborhood famous for its artists, painters, and cabarets. To fully appreciate the grandeur of Paris, we'll embark on a **panoramic city tour** with a local guide, showcasing the city's impressive avenues and iconic monuments. Afterward, we'll return to the hotel. For those interested, there is an optional variety show in the evening.



## DAY 4: PARIS



- Day Trip to Paris: Eiffel Tower and Seine Cruise
- Visit the Eiffel Tower, including second floor (tickets included)
- Enjoy a relaxing boat cruise along the Seine
- Free afternoon for city exploration (back to hotel on own)

We'll start our day in central **Paris**, beginning with a visit to the iconic **Eiffel Tower**. You'll have the chance to go up to the second floor of this famous iron landmark (tickets included). Afterwards, we'll enjoy a relaxing **boat cruise along the Seine**, which will last approximately one hour and fifteen minutes. You'll have a free afternoon to explore the city at your own pace. Back to hotel on own expenses (take uber).

**Note:** If wait times at the **Eiffel Tower** are too long, we might reschedule the visit to a different time (or on Sunday) for your convenience.





## DAY 5 : PARIS - BURGUNDY - BEAUNE - LYON

 B

- Journey through the Bourgogne region, known for its vineyards and wines.
- Visit Beaune, a charming town in Burgundy known for its flower-filled streets, hospice, and wine museum.
- Continue to Lyon, the former capital of Roman Gaul, with its historic center as a UNESCO World Heritage site.
- Take a cable car to Notre-Dame de Fourvière for a stunning city view.

Today, we'll journey to the heart of **France**, passing through the **Bourgogne** region, renowned for its picturesque vineyards and world-class wines. Our first stop will be **Beaune**, a charming town in the center of **Burgundy** known for its flower-filled streets, hospice, and wine museum. After some free time for lunch and a walk, we'll continue to **Lyon**, the former capital of **Roman Gaul**, located on the banks of the **Rhône River**. Lyon's historic center is a UNESCO World Heritage site. We'll take a **cable car up to Notre-Dame de Fourvière**, where we can enjoy a stunning view of the city. You'll have some free time to explore at your leisure.

**Note:** In some cases, part of the group will stay in **Chambéry**, near Lyon. We'll travel there in the evening for an overnight stay, allowing time to visit the medieval capital of **Savoia**, known for its historic center and castle.

## DAY 6 : LYON - GENEVA - LAUSANNE - GRUYERES - FRIBOURG

 B

- Photo stop: Palace of Nations in Geneva, English Garden and the Jet d'Eau fountain.
- Explore Lake Geneva's shores, passing vineyards and snow-capped mountains.
- Visit The Olympic Park, a lakeside landmark.
- Visit Gruyeres, renowned for cheese and chocolate.
- Visit the Cailler Chocolate Factory, offering a tasting.
- Continue to Fribourg, a bilingual French-German city with a charming old town.

Today, we'll travel to **Switzerland**. In **Geneva**, we'll pass by the **Palace of Nations** (the European headquarters of the United Nations) and stop at the beautiful **English Garden** with its flower clock before admiring the **Jet d'Eau**. You'll then have free time to explore and enjoy lunch. We'll continue along the shores of **Lake Geneva**, passing vineyard-covered hills and snow-capped mountains, until we reach **Lausanne**. We'll stop at the **Olympic Park**, a lakeside landmark dedicated to sports and Olympic culture. Afterward, we'll head to the walled town of **Gruyeres**, world-renowned for its cheese. Nearby, we'll find some of Switzerland's top chocolate producers, including Nestlé. We'll visit the **Cailler Chocolate Factory**, with a **tasting included!** We'll then continue to **Fribourg**, a bilingual French-German city with a charming old town.

**Note:** Occasionally, accommodation may be arranged in a nearby city.

## DAY 7 : FRIBOURG - INTERLAKEN - AARE GORGE - LUGANO - CHIASSO

 B/L

- Photo stop at Schwarzenburg Castle or viewpoint of Lake Thun/Lake Brienz
- Continue to Interlaken, tourist town between two lakes
- Explore Aare Gorge's impressive ravines (tickets included)
- Journey to Susten Pass and stop for glacier scenery
- Travel through Gotthard Tunnel
- Stop in Gandria, charming lakeside village

This itinerary includes a scenic road through the **Bern canton**, stopping at **Schwarzenburg Castle** or **Lake Thun** or **Brienz**. The tour then continues to **Interlaken**, where we explore the **Aare Gorge**, where we'll explore its impressive **ravines** (tickets included), followed by an included lunch. We then head towards the Susten Pass, a spectacular mountain pass with snow and glaciers. We continue towards the Italian-speaking region of Switzerland, passing through the **Gotthard Tunnel** and stopping in **Gandria**, a charming lakeside village on **Lake Lugano**. We then board a boat to **Lugano**, known for its mild climate and beautiful lakeside promenade.

**Note:** -From late May to early October, the Susten Pass may be closed due to snow; in this case, we'll travel through the equally stunning Brünig Pass.

-Occasionally, accommodation will be in the **Como metropolitan area**.

## DAY 8 : CHIASSO - BELLINZONA - ALTDORF - LUCERNE



- Departure to Bellinzona, capital of Italian-speaking Switzerland.
- Visit to three UNESCO World Heritage Site medieval castles.
- Crossing Gotthard Pass for a photo opportunity.
- Visit to Altdorf, Uri canton capital.
- Lucerne, tourist capital of Switzerland, with attractions like Kapellbrücke, Lion Monument, cathedral, Jesuit Church, and old town.

After breakfast, we'll depart for **Bellinzona**, the capital of Italian-speaking Switzerland, renowned for its three medieval castles which are a UNESCO World Heritage Site. You'll have time to stroll through the picturesque streets of the city center. We'll then head back toward the German-speaking region of Switzerland, crossing the **Gotthard Pass**, where we'll stop for a photo at a stunning viewpoint. Our next stop will be **Altdorf**, the capital of the **Uri canton**, known as the birthplace of William Tell and one of the founding cantons of independent Switzerland. You'll have free time to enjoy lunch. Afterward, we'll head to **Lucerne**, where you can visit the famous **Kapellbrücke**, the **Lion Monument**, the iconic cathedral, the **Jesuit Church**, and the beautiful old town. Lucerne is considered the tourist capital of Switzerland.



## DAY 9 : LUCERNE - EINSIEDELN - VADUZ - FELDKIRCH



- Departing from Lake of the Four Cantons towards Einsiedeln
- Continuing east to Heididorf, a picturesque site with stunning landscapes.
- Entering Liechtenstein, with free time in Vaduz for strolling and lunch.
- Proceeding to Feldkirch, Austria, a charming walled city with a medieval quarter and castle.

We'll depart, skirting the shores of the **Lake of the Four Cantons** as we head toward **Einsiedeln**, renowned for its immense baroque abbey, the most important pilgrimage center in Switzerland. Continuing east, we'll visit **Heididorf**, where we'll see **Heidi's House** (admission not included), a picturesque site with stunning landscapes accessible via a pedestrian path. Next, we'll enter the small independent country of **Liechtenstein**, and in its capital, **Vaduz**, nestled beneath its castle, you'll have free time to stroll and enjoy lunch. Afterwards, we'll proceed to the neighboring city of **Feldkirch** in Austria, a charming walled city near the borders of **Switzerland**, **Liechtenstein**, and **Germany**, with a beautiful medieval quarter and castle. Free time.



## DAY 10 : FELDKIRCH - ST. GALLEN - CONSTANCE - STEIN AM RHEIN



### - RHINE FALLS - ZURICH

- Visit the UNESCO World Heritage Site-designated historic center of St. Gallen.
- Explore the abbey's library, a UNESCO World Heritage Site
- Continue along Lake Constance, Germany's border, to Constance, a medieval old town known for its cathedral and Market Square.
- Return to Switzerland to visit Stein am Rhein
- Visit the Rhine Falls, the most powerful waterfalls in Europe, with an optional boat ride.
- Arrival in Zurich in the evening.

We'll depart for **St. Gallen**, whose historic center has been declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site. We'll include admission to the library of its magnificent abbey, featuring a baroque hall that houses 170,000 volumes and the **Egyptian mummy of Schepense**. The library is also UNESCO World Heritage Site. Afterward, we'll continue our journey along the shores of **Lake Constance**, situated between Germany and Switzerland, until we reach **Constance**, a German city with a beautiful medieval old town known for its cathedral and the **Market Square**. You'll have time to stroll and enjoy lunch. We'll then return to Switzerland to visit **Stein am Rhein**, a charming village on the banks of the Rhine, famous for its beautifully painted houses. We'll also visit the **Rhine Falls** (tickets included), the most powerful waterfalls in Europe. We recommend an optional boat ride that will make you feel like you can almost touch the cascading waters. Arrival in **Zurich** will be in the evening.





## DAY 11 : ZURICH

🏠 B

- Enjoy a scenic cruise on Lake Zurich, stopping at charming villages.
- Disembark in Rapperswil, renowned for its medieval castle.
- Return to Zurich via train, showcasing Swiss railway system's efficiency and punctuality.

With our guide, we'll explore **Zurich**, the most populous city in **Switzerland**, and its financial and cultural heart. Known for its banks, Zurich has been twice recognized as the city with the best quality of life in the world. Afterwards, we'll embark on a **scenic cruise** of nearly two hours on **Lake Zurich**, with brief stops to enjoy the charming villages along the route. We'll disembark in **Rapperswil**, a picturesque village renowned for its medieval castle. We'll return to Zurich by train, providing an opportunity to experience the efficiency and punctuality of the Swiss railway system.

**Note:** Depending on the number of travelers, transfers to and from the city center may be via local transport.



## DAY 12 : ZURICH ✈️ KUALA LUMPUR
