### DAY 1 : CHECK IN /DEPART KLIA ✈️

### DAY 2 : ARRIVAL ZURICH

Welcome! Upon arrival, we'll provide a **transfer** to the hotel. You can enjoy free time until your tour starts next day

### DAY 3 : ZURICH



- Explore Zurich, known for its cultural and financial significance, take a scenic Lake Zurich cruise with stops at charming villages.
- Visit Rapperswil's medieval castle, and return to Zurich by local train to experience the Swiss railway system.

With our guide, we'll explore **Zurich**, the most populous city in **Switzerland**, and its financial and cultural heart. Known for its banks, Zurich has been twice recognized as the city with the best quality of life in the world. Afterwards, we'll embark on a scenic **cruise** of nearly two hours on **Lake Zurich**, with brief stops to enjoy the charming villages along the route. We'll disembark in **Rapperswil**, a picturesque village renowned for its medieval castle. We'll return to Zurich by **local train**, providing an opportunity to experience the efficiency and punctuality of the Swiss railway system.

**Note:** Depending on the number of travelers, transfers to and from the city center may be via public transport.

### DAY 4: ZURICH - LUCERNE - ZURICH



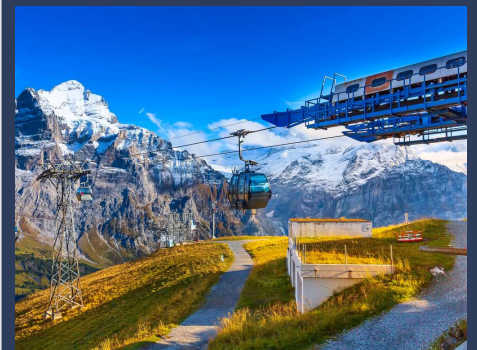
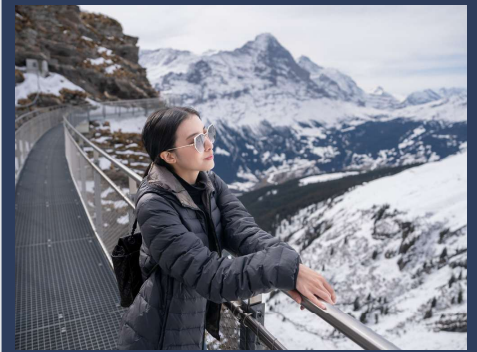
- Discover stunning mountain and lake scenery in the Interlaken region, with a stop in Grindelwald First Cliff for a cable car ride and a walk across a suspended bridge offering spectacular glacier views
- Explore the charming city of Lucerne before returning to Zurich.

Today's journey features stunning landscapes with tall mountains and pristine lakes. We'll enjoy breathtaking scenery in the **Interlaken** region.

Our first stop will be **Grindelwald**, where we'll have time for a coffee before taking the cable car up the mountain. Once there, we'll walk along a winding path leading to a suspended bridge. For those who are adventurous, crossing the bridge offers spectacular views of the surrounding glaciers.

We'll have **lunch on the mountain** (included) before heading back down.

Our next destination is **Lucerne**, one of Switzerland's most beautiful cities, where you'll have time to explore and enjoy the charming cityscape. We'll then return to **Zurich**.





## DAY 5 : ZURICH - BELLINZONA - COMO - MILAN

- Crossing the Beautiful Alps, some of the breathtaking scenery
- Visiting Bellinzona renowned for its three medieval castles
- Entering Italy by visiting charming town of COMO
- Exploring Milan's famed Piazza del Duomo (Outside view)

We'll leave **ZURICH** early in the morning, crossing the Alps to reach the Italian-speaking part of Switzerland. Our first stop will be **BELLINZONA**, renowned for its three medieval castles, which are UNESCO World Heritage Sites. Perched on the hills overlooking the city, these castles highlight Bellinzona's historical significance as a key alpine stronghold. Enjoy some free time to wander through the charming streets of the old town.

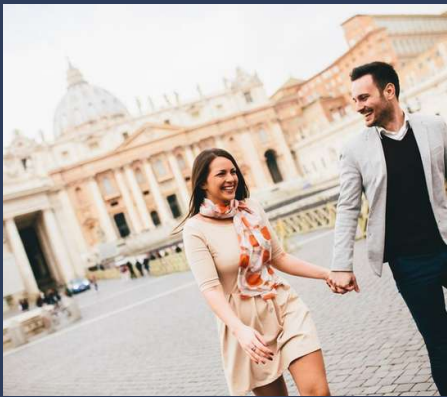


Next, we'll enter Italy and stop in the charming town of **COMO** for lunch. This town is considered the jewel of **LOMBARDY**, known for its beautiful gardens beside the lake and its spectacular cathedral. We'll continue to **MILAN**, where our guide will take us to the impressive Piazza del Duomo. You'll have some time to wander around before we transfer you to the hotel.

## DAY 6 : MILAN - PISA - ROME

- Riding a small tourist train in Pisa
- Visiting Piazza dei Miracoli (Outside view)
- Admiring the Leaning Tower of Pisa (Outside view)

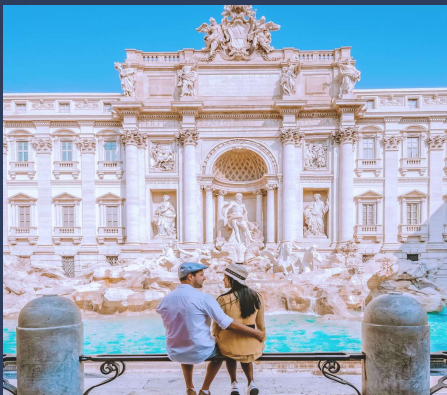


Today, the journey takes us to the charming city of **Pisa**, home to one of Italy's most iconic landmarks. Upon arrival, we'll hop onto a small **tourist train** that will take us to the Piazza dei Miracoli, also known as the Square of Miracles. This historic square is renowned for its stunning architectural ensemble.

You'll have time to admire one of the most captivating and beautiful art complexes in **Italy**, including the famous **Leaning Tower of Pisa**, a world-famous symbol of architectural ingenuity. Afterwards, we'll head to **Rome**, arriving later in the day.

## DAY 7: ROME

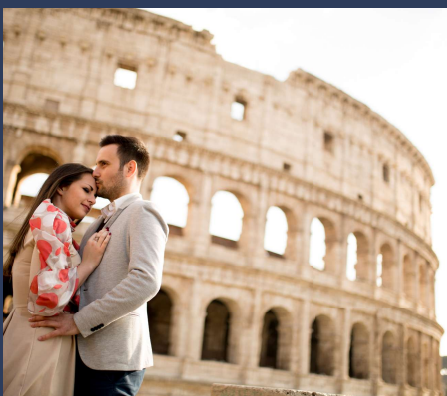

- Morning Panoramic tour of Rome (Drive pass)
- We will get down from bus and Photostop at Coliseum & Imperial Forum
- Tour ends at Vatican Square approx 11 am
- Exploring Saint Peter's Basilica (Outside view)
- Afternoon free time or join optional tour Entrance to Vatican & Sistine Chapel tour EUR70/pax
- Rome walking tour (optional) during afternoon free time
- Make your way to TRASTEVERE area to meet guide & transfer to hotel

In the morning, we'll take a **three-hour guided** tour of the Eternal City, combining a walking tour through Imperial Rome with a panoramic bus ride to admire one of the oldest and most influential cities in Western civilization.

During the tour, we'll see iconic landmarks (**outside views**) such as the Arch of Constantine, the exterior of the Colosseum and the Imperial Forums, the Circus Maximus, the Baths of Caracalla, the Basilica of Saint Mary Major, the Pyramid of Cestius, and Castel Sant'Angelo.



The tour will end at **Vatican City** around 11:00 a.m. Afterward, our guide will offer an optional visit to explore the Vatican Museums and the Sistine Chapel. At the end of the day, make your way **to the popular Trastevere neighborhood**, known for its cozy restaurants and lively atmosphere. Return to the hotel will be around 8:30 p.m.

## DAY 8: ROME - FLORENCE



- Enjoying beautiful landscapes from Rome to Florence
- Visiting Piazzale Michelangelo (outside view)
- Visiting landmarks during walking tour (outside view)
- Afternoon few hours free at leisure in Florence city center, back to hotel

Today, we'll leave ROME and head north, taking in the beautiful landscapes along the way. Upon reaching **Florence** we'll go directly to the stunning Piazzale Michelangelo for breathtaking views of the city. We will then walk toward the historic center where, after some time for lunch, we'll enjoy a **guided walking tour** with a local expert through the historic center, visiting landmarks (outside views) such as the Ponte Vecchio, the Duomo, and Piazza della Signoria. This city is like an open-air museum. Afterward, you'll have some free time to explore at your leisure. In the evening, you'll have plenty of options for dinner, as this district offers many restaurants with a variety of international cuisines.

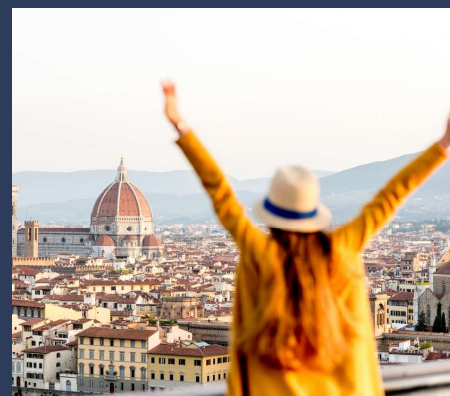


## DAY 9: FLORENCE - VENICE

- Free time to explore Venice (Gondola Optional Eur40/PAX) back to hotel

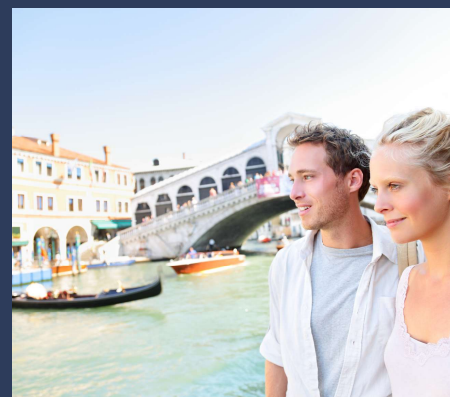
Today, we'll enjoy the stunning mountain landscapes as we cross the Apennines. Upon arriving in **VENICE**, we'll take a **boat across the Giudecca Canal** to the Island of Venice. With a local guide, we'll visit the marvelous ST. MARK'S SQUARE. Afterwards, we'll tour the Murano Glass Factory, where you'll see the fascinating techniques used to create this ancient glass. You'll have some free time to explore on your own. **Accommodation will be in the Mestre district.**



## DAY 10: VENICE ✈️ HOME DEPARTURE

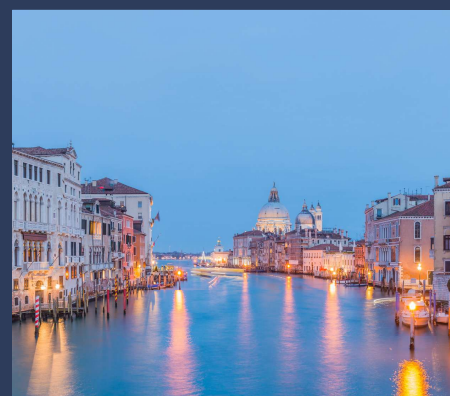


After breakfast, check-out as per hotel standard policy then free at own leisure till transfer to airport for flight back to Malaysia
