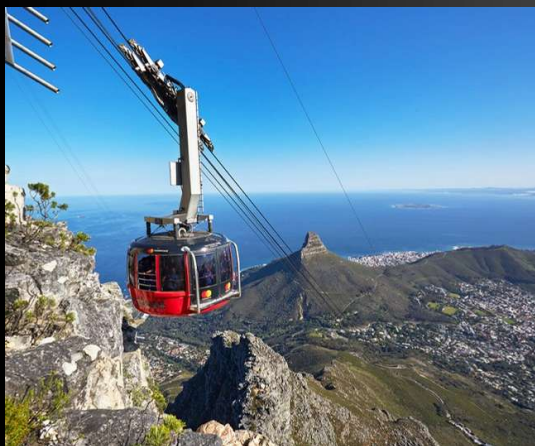
### DAY 4 : CAPE PENINSULA SCENIC TOUR

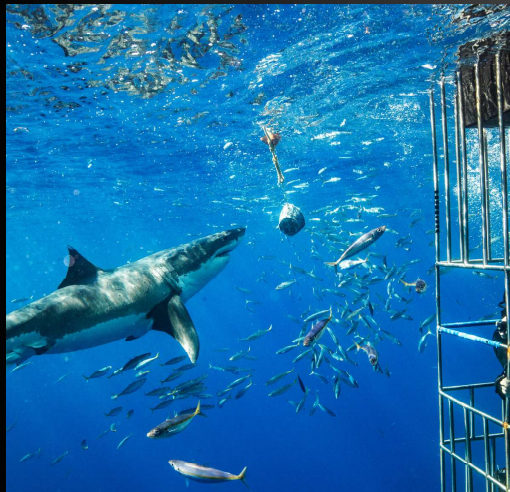

In the afternoon, cross into eSwatini, a small, independent kingdom with a strong cultural identity and beautiful highland scenery.

## DAY 8 : ESWATINI CULTURE & MATSAMO VILLAGE

Start your day with a visit to the **Ngwenya Glass Factory**, where talented artisans transform recycled glass into beautiful handcrafted pieces. Then, cross back into South Africa and stop at **Matsamo Cultural Village** for a vibrant display of traditional Swati life, including song, dance, and a delicious Swati-style lunch. Continue to **Hazyview**, a charming town on the edge of **Kruger National Park**.

## DAY 9 : FULL-DAY SAFARI IN KRUGER NATIONAL PARK

Today promises thrilling wildlife encounters as you embark on a full-day open-vehicle safari in **Kruger National Park**, one of Africa's premier game reserves. ## Is This Trip Right for You?

- **Uniqueness of Destination:**
- Some of the accommodations are built in the traditional local style and have no air conditioning. During heat waves, these hotels can become uncomfortable. Short power outages are a regular occurrence in South Africa. Hotels in major cities are equipped with back-up generators so there are no interruptions to normal services, however hotels outside of major cities may have supplemental generators that provide electricity to only essential services.
- **Things to Consider:** Expect several days with early mornings. Only "nature toilets" are available during game drives, which require the ability to squat. This tour includes cruising through open seas on a ferry.
- Game drives will be performed in small safari vehicles or boats that cannot be air-conditioned. Small boats, and safari vehicles, require agility to embark and disembark.
- This tour includes animal-related activities which carry inherent risks, as animal behavior can be unpredictable. You may choose not to participate.
- Visitors to Kruger National Park and Zimbabwe are encouraged to consult their health care providers regarding malaria prophylaxis.
- We suggest you check with your health care provider before signing up for this tour.
- **Transportation:** There are two days with over 5 hours of driving.
- **Pace:** Expect 3-4 hours of walking on included sightseeing days, as well as considerable time standing.
- **Terrain:** On this tour, you may need to walk on uneven and challenging terrain, navigate steep steps or slopes, and encounter cobblestone streets.
