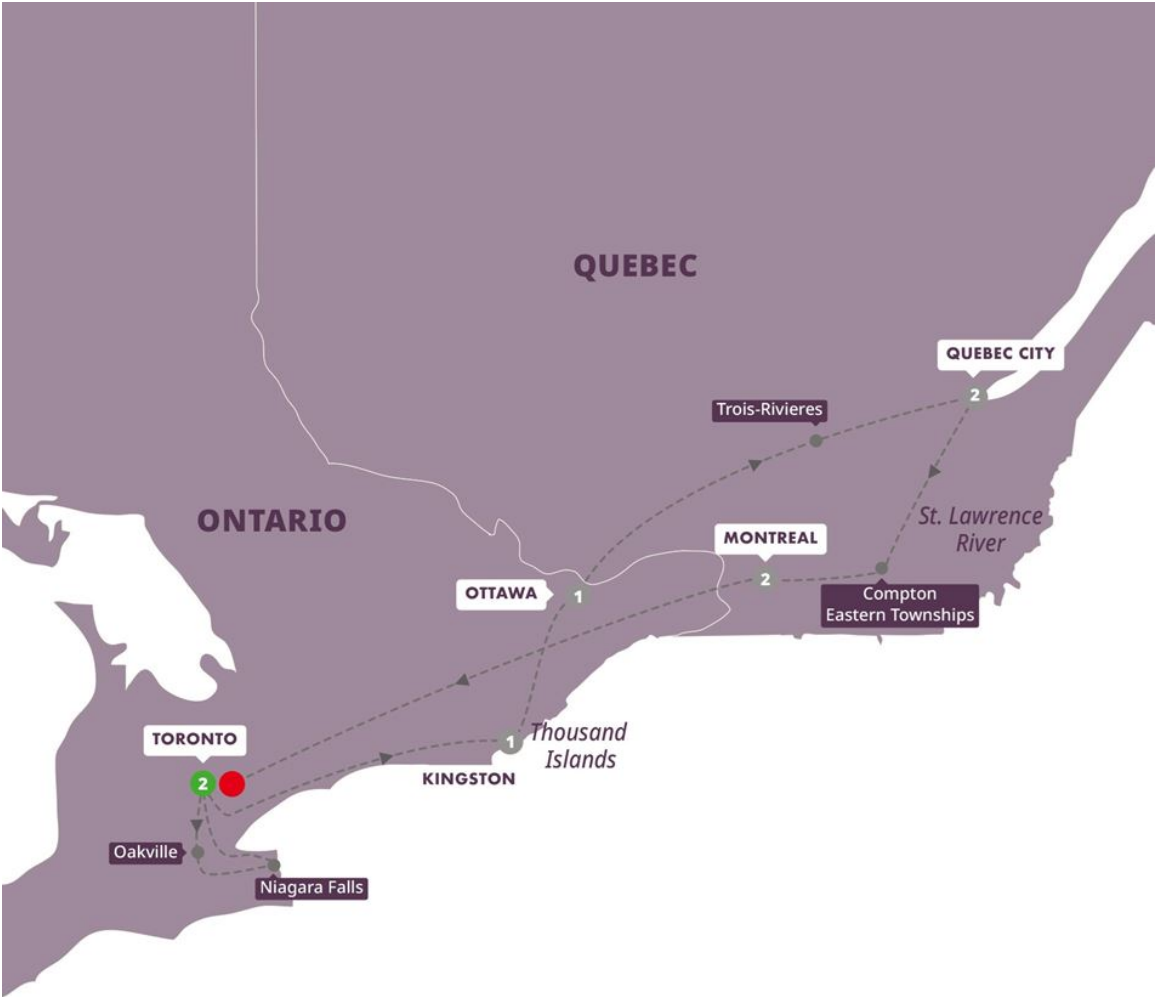

Day 1 | Welcome to Toronto
