## Day 01 KL> ATHENS Meals on Board

 Assemble at Airport for your long-haul flight to Athens, Greece

## Day 02 ATHENS - SANTORINI

- · Transfer to Santorini Airport on domestic flight.
- Get introduced to the beauty and fame of Fira town and caldera by a walking tour around its narrow streets and its typical small white churches with blue domes, restaurants, and boutiques.

## Day 03 SANTORINI


#### **Breakfast**

- Drive to Kamari, the famous black beach, which unique color was created by the eruption of the volcano in the ancient times.
- Continue your tour to **Pyrgos** a village found at the highest point of Santorini, with panoramic views of the whole island all the way to the village of **Oia**, which will be your final point of destination. The village of Oia is the most photographed place in Greece, best known for its breast stop of the day is thatching sunsets. The village is approximately 150 meters above sea level. This distance is covered by walking up the traditional steps (250 steps) or by riding donkeys. Small white house's tier the hillside, interspersed by splashes of rich okra, deep fuchsia, cobalt blue, oyster pink and earthy red.

## Day 04 SANTORINI - MYKONOS

#### **Breakfast**

- · Domestic Ferry to the Island of Mykonos.
- Upon arrival, transfer and discover the cosmopolitan Mykonos town with its whitewashed cubic houses, windmills, and chapels. Discover the towns' beautiful narrow streets with traditional shops and restaurants, little Venice with the famous windmills and a number of small chapels around nearly every corner.



### Day 05 MYKONOS - DELOS - MYKONOS

#### **Breakfast**

- Embark one of the local ferries to **Delos**, an islet of the Aegean, nowadays uninhabited, one of the most important archaeological sites in the eastern Mediterranean Sea. Delos is the legendary birthplace of the twin gods, Apollo and Artemis. Remains of temples and residences on Delos are dating back from the Neolithic to the Roman periods.
- The tour includes amongst others, a visit of the remains of the Temple of Apollo, the Sanctuary of Artemis, the Old city and the Theatre and a walk down the celebrated Lion Street. Also, in the Museum of Delos, admire Archaic, Classical, Hellenistic and Roman sculptures, a collection of vessels from all periods as well as items of everyday use.

## Day 06 MYKONOS - ATHENS

#### **Breakfast**

- · Ferry back to Athens.
- Depart for your sightseeing tour of the capital of Greece, birthplace of democracy and philosophy.
- Your tour includes the Constitution Square (Syntagma), the House of Parliament, the Evzones in their picturesque uniform guarding the Memorial to the Unknown Soldier.
- Have a short stop at the Panathenaic Stadium, where the first Modern Olympic Games in 1896 were held.
- On your way to the Acropolis, you will see the Hadrian's Arch and your will enter the site of the Temple of Olympian Zeus Scone to the Acropolis hill where you visit the architectural masterpieces of the Golden Age of Athens: The Propylaea, the Temple of Athena Nike, the Erechtheion and finally, "the harmony between material and spirit", the monument that "puts order in the mind", the Parthenon. You will also see the ancient theatre of Dionysos and the Herodian theatre.
- Walk through Plaka the oldest historical neighbourhood of the city of Athens, located at the foot of the Acropolis. This district incorporates and combines buildings that feature neoclassical and traditional Cycladic architecture and the ruins of the Ancient Agora. It is an area full of shops, café, restaurants, and museums.

## Day 07 ATHENS - OLYMPIA

#### Breakfast | Dinner

- Depart for Olympia through Central Peloponnese, Tripoli, and Megalopolis.
- Upon arrival, visit Ancient Olympia, the birthplace of the idea and site of the Ancient Olympic Games. You will see the Sanctuary of Olympian Zeus and the Archaeological Museum of Olympia, which hosts important treasures such as the famous Hermes of Praxiteles Statue.

## Day 08 OLYMPIA - DELPHI - KALAMBAKA

#### Breakfast | Dinner

 Cross through Achaia region via Rio - Antirion bridge towards Delphi, passing through the picturesque towns of Nafpaktos and Itea. Located on the slopes of Mount Parnassus, Delphi, once believed as the "Naval" of the Earth, is the home of the Sanctuary of Apollo Pythios.


















 You will also visit the Treasury of the Athenians and the Delphi Museum, which hosts valuable pieces of art like the famous bronze charioteer.

Enjoy some free time for lunch on own and after departing via picturesque villages and towns of central Greece to Kalambaka.

## Day 09 KALAMBAKA - METEORA - ATHENS

#### Breakfast | Lunch | Dinner

- Visit two of the breathtaking monasteries of Meteora where you can see exquisite specimens of Byzantine art. Perched on huge granite rocks, the monasteries seem to suspend between earth and sky, providing a magnificent view. Each monastery contains priceless historical and religious treasures.
- Enjoy your lunch at local restaurant and after starting your return trip to Athens bypassing Trikala, Lamia, and Thermopylae where a stop will be made to visit the memorial of Leonidas and the brave 300 Spartians. Upon arrival in Athens continue to your Michelin star restaurant for dinner.

## Day 10 ATHENS > SINGAPORE

#### Breakfast

• Free at leisure time in Athens city centre till transport to the airport for flight back home.
