TOURIST ATTRACTIONS:

TOKYO

- ◆ **Sensoji (Asakusa Kanon Temple)** - the temple is dedicated to the god of mercy, Kanon. And is famous for its Kaminari-mon or Thunder Gate. And you could walk along Nakamise Shopping Arcade, is bustling with people buying traditional Japanese snacks, which you could see many snack stalls demonstrate how they make it and then sell it still piping hot.
- ◆ **Shinjuku Kabuki-cho** - is one of the 23 wards of Tokyo, but the name commonly refers just to the large entertainment, business and shopping area around Shinjuku Station. Handling more than two million passengers each day.

HAKONE

- ◆ **Mount Fuji** - Mt. Fuji, rising above the clouds, is the symbol of Japan and has provided a spiritual basis for the Japanese since ancient times, with the height of 3776m high. Owakudani Valley - An area with active volcanic zone where sulphurous fumes, its "Black jewel eggs" cooked in the area's thermal heat sources, are a Hakone specialty.
- ◆ **Lake Ashi Pirate Ship** - was formed in the caldera of Mount Hakone after the volcano's last eruption 3000 years ago. And the boat ride could enjoy dreams and romance while gazing upon the delights of Mt. Fuji. Peace Park - The stupa, the symbol of the park, keeps the Buddha's ashes presented by late Indian Prime Minister Nehru. 4 golden images of Buddha are also housed.

HAMAMATSU

- ◆ **Lake Hamana** - is a brackish lagoon in Shizuoka Prefecture, Japan. Formerly a true lake, it is now connected to the Pacific Ocean by a channel. As an internal body of water, it is considered Japan's tenth-largest lake. It spans the boundaries of the cities of Hamamatsu and Kosai.

KYOTO

- ◆ **Kyoto Kiyomizu Temple** - the temple is renowned for its construction which uses no nails to support the elaborate wooden structure of the main hall. And with a quaint old lane lined with pottery shops lead up to this famous temple.
- ◆ **Kyoto Shijo Kawaramachi** - in central Kyoto is one of Kyoto city's busiest stations and shopping areas. Shijo Kawaramachi area include McDonalds, Starbucks, OPA and BAL as well as a number of traditional souvenir shops and convenience stores. The area is packed with places to eat and drink.

NARA

- ◆ **Nara Todai-ji** - is one of Japan's most famous temples and a landmark of Nara. Located in Nara Park, in central Nara, Todaiji was constructed in 752 as the head temple of all temples.

OSAKA

- ◆ **Osaka Castle (Photo Stop)** - it is one of Japan's most famous castles.
- ◆ **Sinsaibashi Shopping Arcade** - a covered shopping street, liveliest and it lines with an interesting shop.

观光景点：

东京

- ◆ **浅草雷门观音寺** - 建于7世纪的佛庙，其象征物是风雷神门，上面挂着写有“雷门”两个字的大红灯笼，这里每天都有前来参拜的观光客，终年熙熙攘攘。您也可在该寺前的热闹街道“仲见世”购物，此处满布出售纪念品的小店及当地小吃的日式店铺。
- ◆ **新宿购物区** - 东京都政府大楼、高楼大厦林立的事务所一条街。以购物、娱乐综合设施为中心的新宿，被誉为不夜城的歌舞伎町为中心的日本少有的娱乐区。

箱根

- ◆ **富士山** - 富士山海拔3776米，是日本第一高峰。它气势雄伟，为其它山峰所不及，呈圆锥形的山姿十分优美，常常被用来作为绘画和文学的创作题材，它作为日本的象征，名扬全世界。
- ◆ **箱根大涌谷** - 为300年前火山爆发的火山口，每当起风时，带着硫磺味的浓烟弥漫期间时，形成特殊景观。登上山顶，有用火山温泉煮熟的「黑鸡蛋」，据日本人说吃一个可长寿7年。
- ◆ **芦之湖海盗船** - 乘海盗船游览背倚着富士山的芦之湖，湖山相映，不同的季节有不同的景致和情趣。
- ◆ **平和公园** - 内有各种四季植物花卉和松树，也有一座大型释迦牟尼之塔。

滨松

- ◆ **滨名湖** - 为位于日本静冈县滨松市、湖西市的潟湖。南部与海相通，为日本第十大湖。

京都

- ◆ **清水寺** - 历史悠久的寺庙，整座建筑完全不用铁打钉锁。沿途坡道两旁是日式古老建筑及商店，摆满了各种各式的日本手工艺品，陶瓷，日本娃娃等，不胜枚举。
- ◆ **京都四条河原町** - 是指河原町大街与四条大街相交叉的十字路口，是四条大街的中心地带，也是京都的主要购物区。这里有阪急百货店、高岛屋百货店等各大百货商店、河原町OPA等各种时装店、珠宝首饰店、工艺美术礼品店等均集中在此。

奈良

- ◆ **奈良东大寺** - 是日本最有名和历史上最重要的寺庙之一，同时它也是奈良的地标建筑及世界上最大的木结构建筑。

大阪

- ◆ **大阪城堡** - 是大阪的象征，它包括十三处被日本政府立为重要文化遗产的建筑。
- ◆ **心斋桥商店街** - 大阪最大的购物区，也是日本最长的天缝式购物街，集中了许多精品屋和专卖店还有很多饮食店，既有日本菜，也可以品尝到中国、韩国、亚洲、美洲和欧洲等世界各个国家、各个地区不同的风味呢。
