

10D8N LONDON TO PRAGUE

(LONDON/AMSTERDAM/BERLIN/PRAGUE)

DAY 1 : KUALA LUMPUR 🛪 LONDON

Arrival London, pickup from airport and transfer to Hotel

Welcome to London Upon arriving at the airport, we will be waiting to transfer you to your hotel. Check the information boards in the hotel reception on next day details

DAY 2: LONDON

- London City Tour
- · Changing of the Guard, afternoon free time
- Evening transfer to Soho, tourist area

Get to know LONDON on a locally guided tour featuring style, culture and history. See the Houses of Parliament, the River Thames, the Tower of London and Buckingham Palace, where we will be able to watch the famous "Changing of the Guard" (depending on the season). Afternoon at leisure or join optional tour

In the evening, we will take a walk through Leicester Square, China Town and Soho, with a lively atmosphere, theatres and entertainment. There are several restaurants to chose where you can dine. Return to the hotel.

DAY 3 : LONDON - COLCHESTER - FERRY COLCHESTER VOLENDAM

- · British Museum (entrance included
- · Pleasant hill scenery travelling to Colchester
- Overnight Ferry (cruise type inside cabin with private washroom)

After breakfast we will go to the British Museum, one of the oldest museums in the world. At lunch time we transfer to Camden, a district famous for having one of the most varied and extravagant street markets in London where we can see relics from cultures all around the world. Enjoy some leisure time. At around 16.00 we will leave for COLCHESTER, known as the most ancient city in England. Time for a stroll. We will then board the ferry in Harwich, taking a night voyage to the Netherlands.

Note: Because the ferry used has a limited number of cabins, sometimes the stage may undergo modifications and it might go from London to Amsterdam either by a day ferry, sleeping in Antwerp, or by train or plane to Amsterdam.

DAY 4 : FERRY COLCHESTER VOLENDAM - VOLENDAM-AMSTERDAM 🔼 B

- · Picturesque typical village of Volendam
- · Visit to Amsterdam and visit famous Red Light area, diamond cutting

At around 08:00 in the morning we will reach the Netherlands (Hoek Van Holland), making a stop in VOLENDAM, a very picturesque fishing village. After this we travel to AMSTERDAM, where we will enjoy a panoramic visit of the city to see its narrow canals, its official buildings and parks. We will also see the technique of diamond cutting. Time for dinner in Rembrandtplein, an area with many restaurants from all corners of the world and near the red-light district with its liberal values.







DAY 5: AMSTERDAM - HAMELIN - BERLIN

 Visit to the Hamelin German village that became famous by the children' story "The Pied Piper of Hamelin"

We leave Amsterdam towards Germany. We make a stop in HAMELIN, a picturesque German town, many of its shops and streets remind us of the fairy tale of the Pied Piper of Hamelin by the Brothers Grimm. We continue towards Berlin passing through Marienborn, the old border that separated East and West Germany until 1990. Arrival in BERLIN in the evening.

DAY 6 : BERLIN

- · City tour of Berlin, Holocaust Memorial and the Berlin Wall Museum
- Enjoy an evening in the lively area of Kantstrasse

Ease your way into the local culture with a guided visit of Germany's incredible capital, Berlin. We shall visit the **historic center, Museum Island, the Reichstag**, the **Brandenburg Gates** and the city's magnificent parks. We continue our visit by stopping at the **Holocaust Memorial and the Berlin Wall Museum**. This visit helps us to understand the difficult situation the city experienced during the Twentieth Century. Time to explore the city. Enjoy an evening in the lively area of Kantstrasse, a district that offers different types of ethnic restaurants to dine in (Indian, Oriental, Italian, German, and so on).

DAY 7: BERLIN - DRESDEN - PRAGUE



- · Visit Dresden famous for architectural and artistic heritage
- Evening transfer in Prague to Tourist area of Old Town Square

We journey through forests towards DRESDEN, a city which, due to its exceptional architectural and artistic heritage, has become one of the main tourist destinations in Germany. Time to explore some of the impressive palaces and to have lunch at one of its many restaurants and coffee shops. Later, we depart for the Czech Republic. Prague Arrival. We will make our way to the Old Town Square. This central location provides a great introduction to Prague, full of energy and touristic activities. You can have your dinner at one of the restaurants offering international cuisines, including Czech, Chinese, Indian and Italian. Return to hotel.

DAY 8 : PRAGUE

- Visit to Prague Castle (entrance included)
- · Boat tour along the river

Today we will visit the capital, Prague, the Baroque jewel of Europe.

Our local expert will provide an informative city tour, which will include outstanding monuments. During the visit we walk through Prague Castle (admission included). Subsequently, we shall take a boat tour on the Vltava River. In the afternoon enjoy some free time to explore the city.
