DAY 1: BERLIN

· Arrival, Transfer to the hotel

Upon arriving at the airport, we will be waiting to transfer you to your hotel. Check the information boards in the hotel reception area for details next day plans

DAY 2 : BERLIN

 \triangle B

- · City tour of Berlin
- Holocaust Memorial
- Berlin Wall Museum

Ease your way into the local culture with a guided tour of Germany's incredible capital, Berlin. We will visit the historic center, Museum Island, the Reichstag, the Brandenburg Gate and the city's magnificent parks. We continue our visit by stopping at the Holocaust Memorial and the Berlin Wall Museum. Optionally you will have the opportunity to visit the Potsdam area with its beautiful palaces.

DAY 3 : BERLIN - DRESDEN - BAMBERG - NUREMBERG

Bavarian Republic of Germany

We will travel to DRESDEN, a city on the river Elba where we can admire its palace. We go on to Bavaria and our arrival in BAMBERG, a very beautiful city full of life; don't miss little Venice! We continue to NUREMBERG, the second largest city in Bavaria, and a city of great history where we suggest a visit to the place where Hitler's Coliseum stood.

DAY 4: NUREMBERG - KLOSTER - WELTENBURG - DACHAU - MUNICH 🔼 B

- · Cruise on the Danube
- Beautiful landscapes
- · Dachau concentration camp & BMW world

Today's journey is one of great surprises. From Kelheim we board a boat to make a short cruise along the Danube Valley, in the area of the Danube Gorges. We come to KLOSTER WELTENBURG, a very beautiful Benedictine monastery founded in 1040. We continue to DACHAU where we will visit the museum of the Nazi concentration camp. Continuation to MUNICH, where we visit the impressive BMW WELT (BMW world) complex, the very modern multifunctional exhibition facility of the prestigious German vehicle group BMW. We also see the park, where the Olympia stadium stands in its architectural beauty and where the famous Olympic Games of 1972 were held. After this we will have free time in the historic center to enjoy the typical beer houses







DAY 5: MUNICH - FUSSEN - ROTHENBURG - FRANKFURT

- Neuschwanstein Castle
- Rothenberg Christmas Museum
- Maria Bridge admire the fantastic scenery from this little bridge between the hills.

Amidst alpine summits and very beautiful scenery, we travel to FUSSEN and the Neuschwanstein Castle. We get on a bus to Maria Bridge and admire the fantastic scenery from this little bridge between the hills. You can either return on foot or horse and cart (not included). After this, continuing with our romantic route, we travel to ROTHENBURG, a very pretty city surrounded by walls, where we enter the beautiful Christmas Museum (entrance included). Next FRANKFURT, Germany's financial capital. Arrival in the evening.

DAY 6 : FRANKFURT - CRUISE ON THE RIVER RHINE - COLOGNE- DORTMUND B

- Cruise on the scenic Rhine River between Rudesheim and St. Goar, then lunch in Cochem with views of its ancient castle.
- Visit Cologne's iconic Gothic cathedral and explore the lively city center before heading to Dortmund for the night.

Today we will see the valleys of the Rhine and Mosel, two rivers loaded with history and sprinkled with charming villages. We take a short cruise on the Rhine, between the villages of RUDESHEIM and ST. GOAR, undoubtedly the most picturesque section of the river. Then we will go on to the river Mosel, and will have time for lunch in COCHEM, a very picturesque village on the bank of the river, dominated by its imposing castle, whose origin dates back more than a thousand years. After that we travel to COLOGNE. Time to visit its impressive Gothic cathedral, which with its 154 metres of height was the tallest building in the world until the end of the 19th century. You can also have a walk along the Rhine River and through the lively city center before going on to our hotel in DORTMUND. Note: On dates with trade fairs or congresses, accommodation may be given in a nearby city.

DAY 7 : DUSSELDORF - FAIRY TALE ROUTE - HANNOVER

- Explore Trendelburg's medieval castle, iconic Rapunzel Tower, journey through picturesque landscapes reminiscent of fairytales.
- Discover Hoxter's lively town center and Corvey Abbey, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, before photographing the ruins of "Cinderella's" castle in Polle, and immersing yourself in the folklore of "The Pied Piper of Hamelin" in Hamelin.

Today we will have a stage full of magic, reminding us about the stories and movies from our childhood, as we travel through towns that inspired the Brothers Grimm and that is called today the Fairytales Route. We will travel to TRENDELBURG, a picturesque walled village dominated by its large medieval castle. We visit the castle with its RAPUNZEL TOWER (entrance included). We continue along small roads, crossing forests while we imagine "Hansel and Gretel". Time for lunch in HOXTER, a small town full of life where Corvey Abbey is located, an ancient monastery from the 9th century, a World Heritage Site (a stop to photograph its walls and interior patios). We continue our route making a brief stop in POLLE to photograph the exterior ruins of "Cinderella's" castle. We continue to HAMELIN, a city popular for the story of "The Pied Piper of Hamelin". After enjoying following the mouse tracks we continue to HANNOVER with some time to get to know the center of this thriving city and a walk next to the old town hall. Note: On dates of fairs or conferences, accommodation may be provided in a nearby city.

DAY 8: HANNOVER - HAMBURG - FLENSBURG - ARHUS

 \triangle B

North of Germany and farming regions of Jutland

After breakfast, we leave Hannover for HAMBURG, where we go around its lake and see its busy port full of life, time for lunch. After lunch we travel to FLENSBURG a pretty seaside village with its marina on the border with Denmark. Our route goes on to AARHUS, Denmark's second largest city in the center of Jutland.

DAY 9: AARHUS - KRISTIANSAND FERRY- KRISTIANSAND - STAVANGER 🛆 B

- Embark on a ferry journey from Hirtshals to Kristiansand, enjoying a scenic three-hour voyage across the North Sea.
- Explore Norway's southern coastline, with stops in picturesque towns like Flekkefjord, known for its wooden houses and fjord views, before arriving in Stavanger, a charming port town nestled by the fjord.

We will travel to HIRTSHALS, where we will take a ferry crossing the North Sea to Norway. A three-hour voyage to KRISTIANSAND. We will continue along Norway's southern coastline and enjoy its stunning landscapes. Next stop in FLEKKEFJORD, a town with its wooden houses and tiny restaurants on a fjord. Arrival to STAVANGER, a small picturesque town that has an active port by the fjord. Note: Ferry operation hours vary depending on the months. Normally you will have time to have lunch on the boat.

DAY 10: STAVANGER - BERGEN

 \triangle B

- · Stop at the 'Swords in Rock' monument
- Take a cable car to Mount Fløyen for panoramic views of Bergen and the fjord, with leisure time to explore the city.

Upon leaving the city, we will stop at the 'Swords in Rock' monument, where we will be reminded of the Vikings, before continuing the very beautiful scenic tour. We follow the route going through tunnels, bridges and travel some stretches by boat to go along the fjord coast of Norway. One of its undersea tunnels is the deepest one in the world. This stage gets more relaxed and spectacular with its two boat trips. We will arrive in BERGEN at lunch time. We take a cable car trip to Mount Fløyen which offers amazing views of the town and Bergen fjord. There will be some leisure time later to enjoy the capital city of fjords.

DAY 11: BERGEN - SOGNE FJORD - OSLO

- Spectacular scenery of mountains and fjords and Cruise
- Photostop at BORGUND's 12th century wooden church

More fantastic landscapes today, images of Norway's interior region fjords, glaciers, lakes and forests. We will travel to SOGNEFJORD, Norway's largest fjord. Prior to arrival, we will make a stop at the beautiful TVINDEFOSSEN waterfall. We will take a magnificent cruise between the cities of GUDVANGEN and AURLAND; enjoy stunning landscapes during this an hour and a half voyage. We continue our journey crossing magnificent snow-covered landscapes. We travel through Aurland Tunnel, the longest in the world. Next, a visit to BORGUND's 12th century wooden church (from the outside), which is considered Norway's best-preserved medieval church. We arrive in OSLO with free time to have a walk through its port, main streets, and the artworks at Frognerparken.

DAY 12: OSLO

 \triangle B

• Sighseeing tour in Oslo.

We include a sightseeing tour with a local guide of the Norwegian capital; this city combines its vibrant modern architecture with its classical buildings, magnificent scenery and large parks with sculptures. It has been nominated the "European green capital". Free time after the city tour, back to hotel on own

DAY 13 : OSLO 🛪 KUALA LUMPUR

After breakfast, check-out as per hotel standard policy then free at own leisure till transfer to airport for flight back to Malaysia.
