



## 16D14N ICONIC EUROPEAN LANDSCAPES (PARIS TO BARCELONA)

### DAY 1 : CHECK IN /DEPART KLIA ✈️ PARIS

Welcome to Paris !

We'll **transfer** you to the hotel and you'll have some free time. In the afternoon, you'll find information about the start of your tour on the boards located at the hotel reception. and you'll have some free time.

### DAY 2 : PARIS

🍽️ B

- Visit the Palace of Versailles and its stunning gardens
- Explore Montmartre, a bohemian neighborhood known for artists, painters, and cabarets.
- Enjoy a panoramic city tour of Paris with a local guide, featuring grand avenues and iconic monuments.

We'll immerse ourselves in the rich history of **France** at the magnificent Palace of Versailles (admission not included), renowned for its stunning gardens.

On our return to **Paris**, we'll visit **Montmartre**, a charming bohemian neighborhood famous for its artists, painters, and cabarets. To fully appreciate the grandeur of **Paris**, we'll embark on a **panoramic city tour** with a local guide, showcasing the city's impressive avenues and iconic monuments.

Afterward, we'll return to the hotel. For those interested, there is an optional variety show in the evening.

### DAY 3 : PARIS

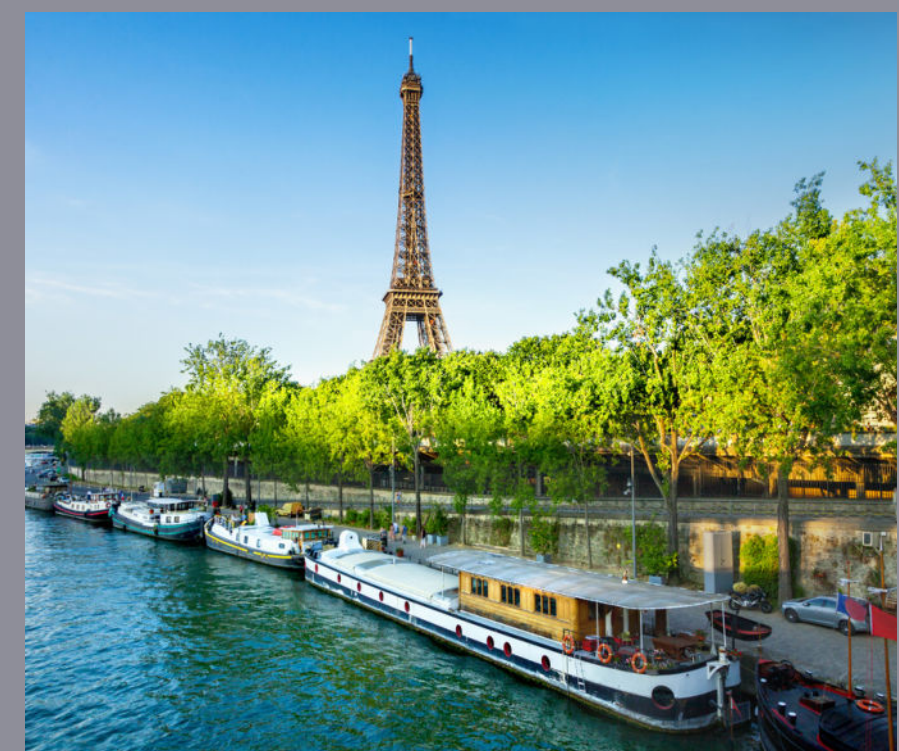

- Visit the Eiffel Tower with access to the second floor (tickets included).
- Enjoy a Seine River cruise lasting about 1 hour and 15 minutes.
- Free afternoon to explore Paris at your own pace.
- **Note: Eiffel Tower visit may be rescheduled if wait times are too long.**

We'll start our day in central **Paris**, beginning with a **visit to the iconic Eiffel Tower**. You'll have the chance to go up to the second floor of this famous iron landmark (tickets included).

Afterwards, we'll enjoy a relaxing **boat cruise along the Seine**, which will last approximately one hour and fifteen minutes. You'll have a free afternoon to explore the city at your own pace. (**transfer back to the hotel not included**).

**Note:** If wait times at the Eiffel Tower are too long, we might reschedule the visit to a different time (or on Sunday) for your convenience.



## DAY 4 : PARIS - BURGUNDY - BEAUNE - LYON



- Travel through Bourgogne, stopping in Beaune, known for its wine, flower-filled streets, and historic hospice.
- Continue to Lyon, the former Roman capital, and explore its UNESCO-listed historic center.
- Ride the cable car to Notre-Dame de Fourvière for panoramic city views and enjoy free time to explore.

Today, we'll journey to the heart of **France**, passing through the **Bourgogne** region, renowned for its picturesque vineyards and world-class wines. Our first stop will be **Beaune**, a charming town in the center of Burgundy known for its flower-filled streets, hospice, and wine museum. After some free time for lunch and a walk, we'll continue to **Lyon**, the former capital of Roman Gaul, located on the banks of the Rhône River. Lyon's historic center is a UNESCO World Heritage site. We'll take a **cable car up to Notre-Dame de Fourvière**, where we can enjoy a stunning view of the city. You'll have some free time to explore at your leisure.

**Note:** In some cases, part of the group will stay in Chambéry, a city near Lyon. In these instances, we'll travel to Chambéry in the evening for an overnight stay. In the morning, you'll have time to visit this medieval-style city, the capital de la Savoie, known for its beautiful historic center and impressive castle.

## DAY 5 : LYON - GENEVA - ZURICH



- Arrive in Geneva, pass by the Palace of Nations, visit the English Garden with its flower clock, and admire the Jet d'Eau fountain.
- Travel scenic routes along Lake Geneva, Lake Neuchâtel, and the Three Lakes region with vineyard and mountain views.
- Stop in Neuchâtel for a lakeside walk, visit the old town, or explore the 10th-century castle.
- Arrive in Zurich in the late afternoon.

Today, we'll travel to **Switzerland**. Upon arrival in **Geneva**, we'll pass by the Palace of Nations (the European headquarters of the United Nations) and explore the pretty English Garden with its flower clock and admire the Jet d'Eau, the tallest fountain in Europe. After lunch, we'll continue our journey through Switzerland, traveling along the scenic routes by **Lake Geneva** and **Lake Neuchâtel**. We'll drive along the Three Lakes region, enjoying views of magnificent vineyards set against the mountain backdrop. We'll stop in **Neuchâtel**, where you can enjoy a walk by the lake, explore the historic town center, or visit the beautiful 10th-century castle. Our journey will conclude in **Zurich**, where we'll arrive in the late afternoon.

**Note:** Depending on the number of passengers traveling from Geneva to Zurich, this part of the trip may be done by train, in which case there will be no stop in Neuchâtel.

## DAY 6 : ZURICH



- Explore Zurich with a guide, Switzerland's financial and cultural hub, known for its top quality of life.
- Enjoy a scenic 2-hour cruise on Lake Zurich, with stops at charming lakeside villages.
- Visit Rapperswil, a picturesque village famous for its medieval castle.
- Return to Zurich by train, experiencing the Swiss railway system.

With our guide, we'll explore **Zurich**, the most populous city in **Switzerland**, and its financial and cultural heart. Known for its banks, Zurich has been twice recognized as the city with the best quality of life in the world. Afterwards, we'll embark on a scenic **cruise** of nearly two hours on **Lake Zurich**, with brief stops to enjoy the charming villages along the route. We'll disembark in **Rapperswil**, a picturesque village renowned for its medieval castle. We'll return to Zurich by **train**, providing an opportunity to experience the efficiency and punctuality of the Swiss railway system.

**Note:** Depending on the number of travelers, transfers to and from the city center may be via public transport.



## DAY 7 : ZURICH - LUCERNE - ZURICH

🏠 B/L

- Travel through the Interlaken region, surrounded by mountains and lakes.
- Stop in Grindelwald, take a cable car ride, and walk to a suspended bridge with glacier views.
- Lunch on the mountain (included), then descend and continue to Lucerne.
- Explore Lucerne, one of Switzerland's most beautiful cities, before returning to Zurich.

Today's journey features stunning landscapes with tall mountains and pristine lakes. We'll enjoy breathtaking scenery in the **Interlaken** region. Our first stop will be **Grindelwald**, where we'll have time for a coffee before taking the cable car up the mountain. Once there, we'll walk along a winding path leading to a suspended bridge. For those who are adventurous, crossing the bridge offers spectacular views of the surrounding glaciers. We'll have **lunch on the mountain** (included) before heading back down. Our next destination is **Lucerne**, one of Switzerland's most beautiful cities, where you'll have time to explore and enjoy the charming cityscape. We'll then return to **Zurich**.

**Note:** The guide will offer an optional full-day excursion, starting in the morning. After some free time in Lucerne, we'll take a rotating cable car to the summit of Mount Titlis. At over 3,000 meters above sea level, the alpine summit offers breathtaking views of the glacier and the Alps.

## DAY 8 : ZURICH - BELLINZONA - COMO - MILAN

🏠 B

- Cross the Alps to Bellinzona, famous for its three UNESCO-listed medieval castles.
- Enjoy free time to explore Bellinzona's historic center.
- Stop in Como for lunch, known for its lakeside gardens and magnificent cathedral.
- Continue to Milan, visit Piazza del Duomo, and transfer to the hotel.

We'll leave **Zurich** early in the morning, crossing the Alps to reach the Italian-speaking part of Switzerland. Our first stop will be **Bellinzona**, renowned for its three medieval castles, which are UNESCO World Heritage Sites. Perched on the hills overlooking the city, these castles highlight Bellinzona's historical significance as a key alpine stronghold.

Enjoy some free time to wander through the charming streets of the center. Next, we'll enter Italy and stop in the charming town of **Como** for lunch. This town is considered the jewel of **Lombardy**, known for its beautiful gardens beside the lake and its spectacular cathedral. We'll continue to **Milan**, where our guide will take us to the impressive Piazza del Duomo. You'll have some time to wander around before we transfer you to the hotel.

## DAY 9 : MILAN - PISA - ROME

🏠 B

- Small tourist train to the Piazza dei Miracoli (Square of Miracles)
- Famous Leaning Tower of Pisa (photostop)
- Travel to Rome

Today, we'll continue our journey to Pisa.

We'll ride a small tourist train to the Piazza dei Miracoli (Square of Miracles), where you'll have time to admire one of the most captivating and beautiful art complexes in Italy, including the famous Leaning Tower of Pisa (photostop).

Afterwards, we'll head to Rome, arriving later in the day.



## DAY 10 : ROME



- Panoramic tour of Rome with a local guide, including the Colosseum (exterior), Arch of Constantine, and Imperial Forums (photostops)
- Drive past major landmarks: Circus Maximus, Baths of Caracalla, Basilica of Saint Mary Major, Pyramid of Cestius, and Castel Sant'Angelo (exterior).
- Tour ends at Vatican City, with an optional visit to the Vatican Museums and Sistine Chapel . Afternoon free time at own or join another optional walking tour
- Make your way to Trastevere area, known for its lively streets and charming restaurants. Return to hotel around 8:30 p.m.

In the morning, we'll go on a **three-hour panoramic tour of Rome** with a local guide, combining a bus ride with a walking section through part of Imperial Rome. We'll see, among other highlights, the Arch of Constantine, the exterior of the Colosseum, and the Imperial Forums—an architectural complex that was the political heart of the ancient world. During the bus route, we'll pass by some of the city's most iconic landmarks, including the Circus Maximus, the Baths of Caracalla, the Basilica of Saint Mary Major, the Pyramid of Cestius, and the exterior of Castel Sant'Angelo.

The tour will end in **Vatican City** at around 11:00 a.m., an independent state within the city of Rome and the center of the Catholic Church. After the panoramic tour, our guide will offer an optional visit to explore the Vatican Museums and the Sistine Chapel in greater detail (EUR70/pax) The afternoon will be free or join another optional Rome old city square walking tour EUR40/pax.

At the end of the day, we'll include a **transfer to the popular Trastevere district**, known for its charming restaurants and lively atmosphere. Return to the hotel around 8:30 p.m.

## DAY 11 : ROME - MADRID



- Transfer to the airport for a domestic flight (included in the trip).
- Upon arrival, transfer to your hotel at the new destination.
- Your guide will contact you in the late afternoon.
- You may also check the hotel reception for updated information.

At the time informed by the guide, we will make a **transfer to the airport** to catch a **domestic flight included** in your trip. On arrival at destination we will give you another **hotel transfer**. Your guide will contact you at the end of the afternoon or you can consult the information in your hotel reception.

**Note:** remember that on domestic flights, the luggage normally allowed is one suitcase of up to 20 kg in the hold. Passengers must pay for all excess luggage directly to the airline.

## DAY 12 : MADRID



- Morning tour of central Madrid, including Paseo del Prado, Cibeles, Neptuno, Puerta de Alcalá, Plaza de Colón, and Plaza Mayor.
- Visit Retiro Park, with highlights like the lake and Palacio de Cristal.
- Free afternoon to explore the city at your own pace.
- Evening transfer back to the hotel.

The morning will begin with a **comprehensive tour** of central Madrid, featuring highlights like Paseo del Prado, Cibeles, Neptuno, Puerta de Alcalá, Plaza de Colón, and Plaza Mayor.

We'll then visit Retiro Park, a beautiful oasis in the city center, where we'll see the lake and the Palacio de Cristal. Enjoy the rest of the afternoon at your leisure.

In the evening, we'll provide a return transfer to the hotel.



## DAY 13 : MADRID - ZARAGOZA - POBLET - BARCELONA



- Depart for Aragon, passing through the scenic landscapes of Castile.
- Stop in Zaragoza to admire the Cathedral-Basilica of Our Lady of the Pillar.
- Visit the Poblet Abbey, one of the best-preserved medieval monasteries (tickets included).
- Continue to Barcelona, arriving in the evening.

In the morning, we'll leave for **Aragon**, travelling through the lands of Castile. Our first stop will be in **Zaragoza** to admire the stunning Cathedral-Basilica of Our Lady of the Pillar. We'll then journey to the serene **Poblet Abbey**, one of the best-preserved medieval monasteries in the world (tickets included). Finally, we'll head to **Barcelona**, where we'll arrive in the evening.

## DAY 14 : BARCELONA



- Morning panoramic tour of Barcelona, highlighting Gaudi's architecture, Las Ramblas, and the city's rich history.
- Learn about major events like the Universal Exposition and the Olympic Games hosted in the city.
- Free time in the afternoon to explore at your own pace or Join optional tour Entrance to Sagrada Familia inside guided visit EUR60/pax
- Evening transfer to Maremagnum, a lively seaside complex near Plaza de Colón with dining and entertainment options, back to hotel evening

In the morning, we include a **panoramic tour of BARCELONA**, considered one of Europe's most fascinating capitals. Open to the Mediterranean Sea, the city is renowned for Gaudi and its modernist architecture, as well as for its lively Ramblas and the legacy of the World Expositions and Olympic Games held here. Barcelona is often regarded as one of the most beautiful and captivating cities in Europe. The tour ends at the Maremagnum, a modern leisure and dining complex by the sea next to Columbus Square, where you can stroll through this lively area. Afternoon at leisure. Return to the hotel at the end of the day.

## DAY 15 : BARCELONA ✈️ KUALA LUMPUR



After breakfast, check-out as per hotel standard policy then free at own leisure till transfer to airport for flight back to Malaysia
