

9D7N HUNZA PAKISTAN AUTUMN TOUR

Hunza valley is famous for autumn colors among the travelers around the world, autumn is Hunza and the other surrounding? Valleys from the 2nd week of October and last till mid September every year. We offer fixed departure tours to this beautiful valley during autumn, we also organize private tours for photographers and couples on request.

DAY 1 KLIA - Islamabad

Arrival at the airport and transfer to the hotel for overnight stay.

DAY 2 Islamabad - Chilas

Drive to Chilas on Karakoram Highway, arrive and transfer to the hotel.

Karakoram Highway is a 1,300 km national highway which extends from Hasan Abdal in the Punjab province of Pakistan to the Khunjerab Pass in Gilgit-Baltistan, where it crosses into China and becomes China National Highway 314



DAY 3 GILGIT – PASSU

Departure for **Passu**, en-route short stop at **Nanga Parbat View point**, Junction point of three great mountain ranges and at Rakaposhi view point, arrive and transfer to the hotel.

Nanga Parbat, locally known as Diamer, is the ninth highest mountain in the world at 8,126 metres (26,660 ft) above sea level. Located in the Diamer District of Pakistan's Gilgit Baltistan region, Nanga Parbat is the western anchor of the Himalayas. The name Nanga Parbat is derived from the Sanskrit words nanga and parvata which together mean "Naked Mountain". The mountain is locally known by its Punjabi name Diamer or Deo Mir, meaning "huge mountain".

Rakaposhi is a mountain in the Karakoram mountain range in the Gilgit-Baltistan .lt is situated in the middle of the Nagar and Bagrote valleys and danyor , approximately 100 km (62 mi) north of the capital city Gilgit of Pakistani Province Gilgit Baltistan. Rakaposhi means "snow covered" in the local language. Rakaposhi is also known as Dumani ("Mother of Mist" or "Mother of Clouds"). It is ranked 27th highest in the world.



DAY 4 KHUNJERAH PASS (PAKISTAN/CHINA BORDER)

Full day excursion to Khunjerab Pass, in the evening drive back to Passu arrive and transfer to the hotel.

Khunjerab Pass is a high mountain pass in the Karakoram Mountains in a strategic position on the northern border of Pakistan and on the southwest border of China.



DAY 5 PASSU - KARIMABAD

Departure for **Karimabad (Hunza)**, en-rouet visit **Hoper Glacier/Valley**, after having lunch at Hoper valley drive to Karimabad, arrive and transfer to the hotel.

Hopar Valley is a cluster of villages around a natural bowl at a bend of Baltoro Glacier. Opposite to Hopar the white Bualtar is joined by the Barpu Glacier. This is a base camp for treks into the high, glacier-draped peaks called the Hispar Muztagh. The valley has a number of natural formations, including glaciers, lakes, and high mountains.



DAY 6 KARIMABAD

Day to explore around, visit **Baltit Fort** or **Altit Fort**, Channel walk and Karaimabad Local market.

Baltit Fort is a fort in the Hunza valley, near the town of Karimabad, in the Gilgit-Baltistan region of northern Pakistan. Founded in the 8th CE, it has been on the UNESCO World Heritage Tentative list since 2004.

Altit Fort is an ancient fort at Altit town in the Hunza valley in Gilgit Baltistan, Pakistan. It was originally home to the hereditary rulers of the Hunza state who carried the title Mir, although they moved to the somewhat younger Baltit fort nearby three centuries later.

DAY 7 Gilgit – Besham/Naran

Departure for **Besham/Naran**, short stops en-route for lunch and photography , arrive and transfer to the hotel.

Besham is the largest town and commercial centre of the Shangla District in Khyber-Pakhtunkhwa province of Pakistan. It is on the Silk Route connecting Pakistan with China

Naran is a medium-sized town in upper Kaghan Valley in Mansehra District of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa province of Pakistan. It is located 119 kilometers from Mansehra city at the altitude of 2,409 meters. It is located about 65 kilometers away from Babusar Top.



DAY 8 Besham - Islamabad - Fly to KLIA

Depature for **Islamabad**, en-route short stops for photography, lunch and visit **Taxila museum**, later drive to Islamabad, arrive explore the city, later drive to the airport and fly to your desatination.

Taxila Museum is located at Taxila, Punjab, Pakistan. The museum is home to a significant and comprehensive collection of Gandharan art dating from the 1st to the 7th centuries CE. Most objects in the collection were excavated from the ruins of ancient Taxila.

Islamabad is the capital city of Pakistan, and is federally administered as part of the Islamabad Capital Territory. Islamabad is the ninth largest city in Pakistan, while the larger Islamabad-Rawalpindi metropolitan area is the country's fourth largest with a population of about 7.4 million.
