## 14D12N SPAIN, SWITZERLAND & ITALY

### DAY 1 : CHECK IN /DEPART KLIA ✈️ MADRID

- Pickup from airport and transfer to hotel
- Transfer to Plaza Mayor and La Latina a tourist famous district

**Welcome to Madrid!** Upon arrival at the airport, we'll be ready to transfer you to your hotel. You'll have some free time until the tour begins. Please check the information signs in the hotel reception area for details about the welcome meeting with your guide and fellow travelers.

In the evening, we'll provide a **transfer to Plaza Mayor and La Latina**, Madrid's most famous neighborhood for nightlife and tapas restaurants. You can choose to dine at a restaurant of your preference—options include Indian, Chinese, Spanish, and Middle Eastern cuisines.



### DAY 2 : MADRID



- Comprehensive tour of central Madrid including Paseo del Prado, Cibeles, Neptuno, Puerta de Alcalá, Plaza de Colón, and Plaza Mayor (Photostops)
- Visit to Retiro Park with lake and Palacio de Cristal
- Admission to Santiago Bernabéu Stadium, home of Real Madrid

The morning will begin with a **comprehensive tour** of central Madrid, featuring highlights like Paseo del Prado, Cibeles, Neptuno, Puerta de Alcalá, Plaza de Colón, and Plaza Mayor.

We'll then visit Retiro Park, a beautiful oasis in the city center, where we'll see the lake and the Palacio de Cristal. Enjoy the rest of the afternoon at your leisure. In the evening, we'll provide a return transfer to the hotel.



### DAY 3 : MADRID - ZARAGOZA - POBLET - BARCELONA



- Travel to Aragon
- Zaragoza's Cathedral-Basilica of Our Lady of the Pillar
- Visit Poblet Abbey, a world-renowned medieval monastery
- Arrive in Barcelona in the evening

In the morning, we'll leave for **Aragon**, travelling through the lands of Castile. Our first stop will be in **Zaragoza** to admire the stunning Cathedral-Basilica of Our Lady of the Pillar.

We'll then journey to the serene **Poblet Abbey**, one of the best-preserved medieval monasteries in the world (tickets included). Finally, we'll head to **Barcelona**, where we'll arrive in the evening.





#### DAY 4 : BARCELONA - GIRONA

 B

- **Photostop : City of Counts**
- **Explore its rich history, including the Universal Exposition and Olympics**
- **Take a walk in Girona famous for Jewish quarter, and cathedral**

In the morning, we'll embark on a **tour of the City of Counts**. This vibrant city, nestled along the Mediterranean Sea, is famous for Gaudi's modernist architecture, the bustling Ramblas, and its rich history, highlighted by the Universal Exposition and the Olympics hosted here. Barcelona is renowned as one of the most beautiful and fascinating European capitals. In the evening, we'll leave Barcelona and travel north into Catalonia. Before settling into our hotel, we'll take a walk in **Girona**, exploring its historic center, known for its colorful houses, the old Jewish quarter, and its impressive cathedral.

#### DAY 5 : GIRONA - CAREERS OF LIGHT - CHAMBERY

 B

- **First stop will be Arles, a small UNESCO World Heritage city**
- **Entrance to Carrières des Lumières, an incredible underground art experience**
- **Chambery, the charming capital of Savoy**

We'll head to **France**, traveling through the **Provence** region. First stop will be **Arles**, a small UNESCO World Heritage city known for its connections to Van Gogh. We can visit the Roman theater and quaint Romanesque churches. There will be time to explore and have lunch. Next, we'll include a visit to **Carrières des Lumières**, an incredible underground art experience featuring a captivating display of art, images, and sound in an ancient quarry. We'll arrive in **Chambery**, the charming capital of Savoy, for the evening, a medieval style city with beautiful historic center and large castle.

**Note:** If tickets for the Carrières des Lumières show are unavailable due to high demand, we will provide an alternative visit to the Pont du Gard, a famous Roman aqueduct



#### DAY 6 : CHAMBERY - GENEVA - GRUYERS - LEYSIN

 B/D

- **Arriving in Geneva**
- **Nestlé's Maison Cailler Chocolate Factory**
- **Chillon Castle on Lake Geneva**
- **Leysin, a holiday village with stunning views of the Rhône Valley & Mont Blanc**

This tour takes you to **Switzerland**, arriving in **Geneva**. You'll visit the United Nations headquarters, the English Garden, and the Jet d'Eau fountain. We'll visit **Gruyères**, a cheese-rich village, and visit Switzerland's major chocolate factories, including Nestlé's **Maison Cailler Chocolate Factory**. The tour continues through scenic mountain landscapes and wooden villages, reaching Chillon Castle on Lake Geneva. We'll arrive in Leysin, a holiday village with stunning views of the Rhône Valley and Mont Blanc, known for its winter sports resort and hiking options. Dinner is included.

**Note:** Depending on availability, accommodation may sometimes be in another charming Swiss town nestled in the Alps, such as Martigny.



#### DAY 7 : LEYSIN - INTERLAKEN - LUCERNE - ZURICH

 B

- **Swiss Alpine scenery with glaciers and mountains**
- **Glacier 3000 and its cable car and visit Lucerne**

We'll experience stunning mountain scenery today, so be sure to pack your winter clothes. We'll ascend to **Glacier 3000 by cable car ride**, one of the most spectacular spots in Switzerland featuring ice and snow year-round, and where you can walk on the suspended bridge between two mountain peaks, explore the Ice Cathedral, or enjoy the Fun Park. We'll stop in **Interlaken** for lunch before traveling to **Lucerne**, one of the most beautiful cities in Switzerland. In the evening, we'll arrive in **Zurich**, with some time to explore the center before heading to the hotel.

**Note:** In case of adverse weather conditions or other unforeseen circumstances, the Glacier 3000 cable car may be closed. If this happens, we will offer an equally spectacular alternative to enjoy the alpine landscapes.



## DAY 8 : ZURICH - BELLINZONA - COMO - MILAN



- Depart Zurich , crossing the Alps to Italian-speaking Switzerland
- Visit Bellinzona known for UNESCO World Heritage castles
- Visit Como, Italy before arrival Milan's famous Duomo Square

We'll leave Zurich early in the morning and cross the Alps to reach Italian-speaking Switzerland. Our first stop is **Bellinzona**, known for its three medieval castles, which are UNESCO World Heritage Sites. We'll then visit Italy, stopping in **Como**, known as the jewel of **Lombardy**, for lunch. Como is known for its beautiful gardens and cathedral. We'll then continue to **Milan**, where our guide will take us to the impressive Piazza del Duomo. We'll have time to explore before being transferred to our hotel.

## DAY 9 : MILAN - PISA - ROME



- Journey to Pisa and take a tourist train to Piazza dei Miracoli
- Admire the captivating art complex, Photostop at Leaning Tower of Pisa
- Head to Rome, arriving later in the day

Today, we'll continue our journey to **Pisa**. We'll ride a small **tourist train** to the Piazza dei Miracoli (Square of Miracles), where you'll have time to admire one of the most captivating and beautiful art complexes in **Italy**, including the famous Leaning Tower of Pisa. Afterwards, we'll head to **Rome**, arriving later in the day.

## DAY 10 : ROME



- Discover Rome's timeless charm with a panoramic and walking tour showcasing iconic sites like the Colosseum. (Photo stops)
- Photo stop at Imperial Forums, and Vatican City. Lunch at Vatican square area on own
- Optional: Entrance to Vatican, Sistine Chapel EUR70/pax & follow by Rome Old City walking tour EUR40/pax.
- Afternoon free at own leisure or join optional, those pax not joining the optional please make your way to Trastevere area in evening to meet the group again, enjoying its quaint streets, vibrant trattorias to have dinner on own. Back to hotel with guide.

In the morning, we'll take a **three-hour guided tour** of the Eternal City, combining a walking tour through Imperial Rome with a panoramic bus ride to admire one of the oldest and most influential cities in Western civilization. During the tour, we'll see iconic landmarks such as the Arch of Constantine the exterior of the Colosseum and the Imperial Forums, the Circus Maximus, the Baths of Caracalla, the Basilica of Saint Mary Major, the Pyramid of Cestius, and Castel Sant'Angelo. The tour will end at **VATICAN CITY** around 11:00 a.m. Afterward, our guide will offer an optional visit to explore the Vatican Museums and the Sistine Chapel. At the end of the day, make your way to the **popular Trastevere neighborhood**, known for its cozy restaurants and lively atmosphere. Return to the hotel will be around 8:30 p.m.

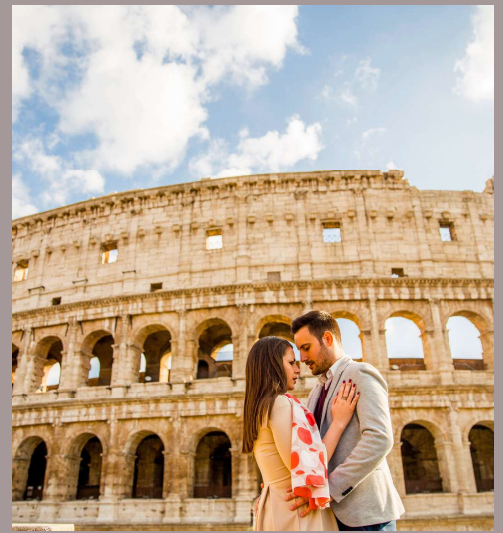
## DAY 11 : ROME - FLORENCE



- Enjoying beautiful landscapes from Rome to Florence
- Visiting Piazzale Michelangelo (Outside view)
- Visiting landmarks during walking tour (outside view)
- Afternoon few hours free at leisure during Florence city center, back to hotel

Today, we'll leave Rome and head north, taking in the beautiful landscapes along the way. Upon reaching **Florence**, we'll go directly to the stunning Piazzale Michelangelo for breathtaking views of the city.

In the afternoon we'll enjoy a **guided walking tour** with a local expert through the historic center, visiting landmarks such as the Ponte Vecchio, the Duomo, and Piazza della Signoria. This city is like an open-air museum. Afterward, you'll have some free time to explore at your leisure. In the evening, you'll have plenty of options for dinner, as this district offers many restaurants with a variety of international cuisines.





## DAY 12 : FLORENCE - VENICE

 B

- Crossing the Apennines to arrive Venice
- Taking a Water Taxi across the Giudecca Canal to Venice Island
- Touring the Murano Glass Factory
- Free time to explore Venice (Gondola Optional Eur40/PAX) back to hotel

Today, we'll enjoy the stunning mountain landscapes as we cross the Apennines. Upon arriving in Venice, we'll take a **boat across the Giudecca Canal** to the Island of **Venice**. With a local guide, we'll visit the marvelous St. Mark's Square. Afterwards, we'll tour the Murano Glass Factory, where you'll see the fascinating techniques used to create this ancient glass. You'll have some free time to explore on your own. Accommodation will be in the Mestre district.



## DAY 13 : VENICE
