## DAY 1 : CHECK IN/DEPARTURE KUALA LUMPUR ✈️ ARRIVAL ROME

**Welcome to Rome!** Upon arrival, we will **transfer** you to your hotel.

You may also find details at the information sign located at the hotel reception area.

In the evening, we will take you to **Via Cavour**, a lively area offering a wide selection of Italian, Indian, Chinese, and international restaurants an excellent introduction to the Eternal City. Return to Hotel and Overnight in Rome.

## DAY 2 : ROME

- Three-hour guided tour combining walking visit of Imperial Rome & panoramic bus tour
- View Arch of Constantine, exterior of the Colosseum & Imperial Forums
- See Circus Maximus, Baths of Caracalla, Basilica of Saint Mary Major, Pyramid of Cestius & Castel Sant'Angelo
- Tour ends at Vatican City with optional visit to the Vatican Museums & Sistine Chapel
- Evening transfer to Trastevere district with return around 8:30 p.m.

In the morning, we'll take a **three-hour guided tour** of the Eternal City, combining a walking tour through Imperial Rome with a panoramic bus ride to admire one of the oldest and most influential cities in Western civilization. During the tour, we'll see iconic landmarks such as the Arch of Constantine, the exterior of the Colosseum and the Imperial Forums, the Circus Maximus, the Baths of Caracalla, the Basilica of Saint Mary Major, the Pyramid of Cestius, and Castel Sant'Angelo. The tour will end at **VATICAN CITY** around 11:00 a.m.

Afterward, our guide will offer an optional visit to explore the Vatican Museums and the Sistine Chapel. At the end of the day, we'll include a **transfer to the popular Trastevere neighborhood**, known for its cozy restaurants and lively atmosphere. Return to the hotel will be around 8:30 p.m. Overnight in Rome.

## DAY 3 : ROME – FLORENCE

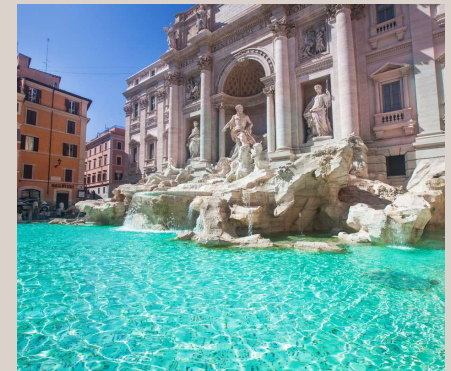

- Depart Rome and travel north through scenic Italian countryside to Florence
- Stop at Piazzale Michelangelo for panoramic views over the city
- Guided walking tour of Florence's historic center, visiting Ponte Vecchio, the Duomo and Piazza della Signoria
- Free time to explore this open-air museum city and enjoy dinner in the lively city center

Today, we'll leave **ROME** and head north, taking in the beautiful landscapes along the way. Upon reaching **FLORENCE**, we'll go directly to the stunning Piazzale Michelangelo for breathtaking views of the city. We will then walk toward the historic center where, after some time for lunch, we'll enjoy a **guided walking tour** with a local expert through the historic center, visiting landmarks such as the Ponte Vecchio, the Duomo, and Piazza della Signoria. This city is like an open-air museum.

Afterward, you'll have some free time to explore at your leisure. In the evening, you'll have plenty of options for dinner, as this district offers many restaurants with a variety of international cuisines. Overnight in Florence.





## DAY 4 : FLORENCE – VENICE



- Scenic journey across the Apennine Mountains enjoying beautiful Italian landscapes
- Boat transfer across the Giudecca Canal to the Island of Venice
- Guided visit to St. Mark's Square followed by tour of a traditional Murano Glass Factory
- Free time to explore Venice at your leisure before return to hotel with guide

Today, we'll enjoy the stunning mountain landscapes as we cross the Apennines. Upon arriving in **Venice**, we'll take a **boat across the Giudecca Canal** to the Island of Venice.

With a local guide, we'll visit the marvelous St. Mark's Square. Afterwards, we'll tour the Murano Glass Factory, where you'll see the fascinating techniques used to create this ancient glass.

You'll have some free time to explore on your own. Accommodation will be in the Mestre district. Overnight in Mestre (Venice area).



## DAY 5 : VENICE – INNSBRUCK – SALZBURG



- Depart Venice and travel into Austria, arriving in Innsbruck, capital of Tyrol
- Free time to explore Innsbruck's historic center and enjoy lunch
- Scenic mountain drive to Kitzbühel, renowned ski resort village
- Continue through alpine landscapes to Salzburg

We will depart from Venice, traveling to **AUSTRIA!** Upon arriving in **INNSBRUCK**, you'll have time to stroll through the historic city center and enjoy lunch in the Austrian Tyrolean capital.

Afterward, we'll journey along beautiful scenic roads through the mountains to **KITZBÜHEL**. Once there, you'll have time to explore this picturesque village, a famous ski resort where snow can be enjoyed for most of the year.

We'll continue our journey to **SALZBURG**, arriving by the end of the day. Overnight in Salzburg

**Note:** If there are few travelers, we may take a train from Venice to Innsbruck.



## DAY 6 : SALZBURG – LAKE TRAUNSEE – VIENNA



- Morning visit of Salzburg, Mozart's birthplace, exploring its Renaissance and Baroque old town beneath the imposing fortress
- Scenic journey through Austria's lake district to St. Wolfgang, a famous pilgrimage town
- Stop at Traunkirchen and enjoy an included cruise on Lake Traunsee, viewing four lakeside castles before arriving in Gmunden
- Continue to Vienna, arriving in the evening

Today, we'll get to know **AUSTRIA** better. During the morning, we'll explore **SALZBURG**, Mozart's city. Its Renaissance and Baroque center is filled with beauty, all in the shadow of the grand castle.

Next, we'll travel through lakes and mountains to reach **ST. WOLFGANG**, a renowned pilgrimage site in Austria. We'll then head to **TRAUNKIRCHEN**, located beside the beautiful Traunsee Lake, where we'll take an **included cruise** to see four of the lake's castles before disembarking in **GMUNDEN**.

Afterward, we'll continue to **VIENNA**, arriving in the evening. Overnight in Vienna



## DAY 7 : VIENNA



- Panoramic city tour of Vienna with a local guide, exploring its grand avenues, palaces and historic landmarks
- View the elegant Ringstrasse, impressive imperial buildings and vibrant city center
- Free time in the afternoon to explore at your own pace
- Evening transfer to Grinzing, traditional wine village district with time for dinner

Today, we'll embark on a **panoramic tour** of this impressive city with a local guide. We'll explore its majestic avenues, beautiful palaces, large parks and vibrant city center. In the afternoon, you'll have free time to explore on your own or back to hotel on own.

In the evening, we'll include a **transfer to the Grinzing district**, an old wine-growing village now part of the city, known for its traditional taverns. You'll have free time to dine in the area. Overnight in Vienna.



## DAY 8 : VIENNA – BUDAPEST



- Travel to Budapest, capital of Hungary, arriving after approximately three hours
- Free time for lunch in the lively Váci utca area
- Included Danube River cruise offering panoramic views of historic Buda and vibrant Pest
- Panoramic city tour of Budapest with optional evening Magyar folklore show and dinner

After about three hours of travel, we'll arrive in **BUDAPEST**, the capital of **HUNGARY**. Our first stop will be the lively area of Váciutca, where you'll have free time for lunch. After, we'll kick off our exploration of Budapest with an included **boat trip on the Danube River**, with historic Buda on one bank and cosmopolitan Pest on the other. The views are unbeatable. Following this, we'll begin a **panoramic tour** of the so-called "Queen of the Danube." You'll have some free time afterwards. In the evening, we'll offer an optional outing to a Magyar show, with dinner included. Overnight in Budapest.



## DAY 09 : BUDAPEST – BRATISLAVA – PRAGUE



- Early departure from Budapest to Bratislava, capital of Slovakia
- Free time to explore Bratislava's charming Old Town and enjoy lunch
- Continue to the Czech Republic through scenic Central European landscapes
- Arrival in Prague in the evening

We will leave **Budapest** early and head for **Bratislava**, the capital of **Slovakia**, a charming city along the Danube with an attractive historic center. You'll have time to explore and enjoy lunch. After, we'll continue our journey to the **Czech Republic**, arriving in **Prague** in the evening. Overnight in Prague.



## DAY 10 : PRAGUE



- Panoramic guided tour of Prague, the Baroque jewel of Europe
- Visit Prague Castle (admission included), one of the largest castle complexes in the world
- Included boat ride on the Vltava River with scenic city views
- Free time in the afternoon to explore at leisure

Today, we'll visit the capital, **PRAGUE**, the Baroque jewel of Europe. Our local tour guide will lead an informative **panoramic tour**, highlighting the city's most outstanding monuments. During the tour, there will be a visit to Prague Castle (admission included). After that, enjoy a **boat ride** on the Vltava River (included). In the afternoon, you'll have free time to explore the city on your own. Overnight in Prague



## DAY 11 : PRAGUE – PILSEN – ROTHENBURG – FRANKFURT



- Early departure from Prague with stop in Pilsen, famous for its beer and historic Old Town Square
- See the Cathedral, Plague Column and Renaissance Town Hall in western Bohemia
- Cross into Germany along part of the Romantic Road to visit Rothenburg, a fairy-tale medieval town
- Continue to Frankfurt, Germany's financial capital, with free time in the historic center

We'll depart early from **PRAGUE** and stop in **PILSEN**, in western Bohemia, a city renowned for its beer. You'll have time to stroll through its historic center, where you'll find the Old Town Square, the cathedral, the Plague Column, and a Renaissance-era town hall. We'll then cross into **GERMANY** and follow part of the **Romantic Road**. We'll visit **ROTHENBURG**, a town that seems to come straight out of a fairy tale and is considered one of the most beautiful villages in the country. Afterward, we'll head to **FRANKFURT**, the financial capital of Germany. After our arrival in the evening, enjoy free time in the historic city center, where you'll find a wide variety of restaurants offering Indian, Asian, Italian, and international cuisines. Overnight in Frankfurt.

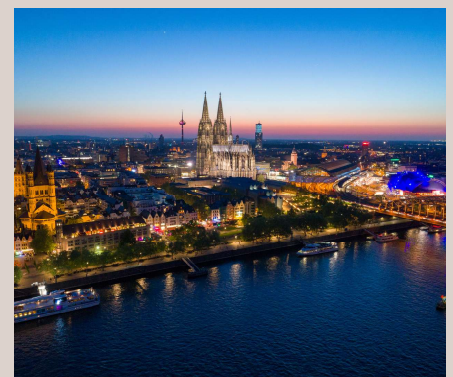


## DAY 12 : FRANKFURT – RHINE CRUISE – COLOGNE – AMSTERDAM



- Scenic cruise along the most picturesque stretch of the Rhine between Rüdesheim and St. Goar
- Travel to Cologne to admire its impressive Gothic Cathedral

Today, we'll **take a scenic cruise** on the Rhine between the villages of **RÜDESHEIM** and **ST. GOAR**, the river's most picturesque section. After that, we'll travel to **COLOGNE**, known for its immense Gothic cathedral. Then, we'll head to **HOLLAND**, arriving in **AMSTERDAM** in the evening. Overnight in Amsterdam





## DAY 13 : AMSTERDAM

- Excursion to Zaanse Schans with traditional windmills, canals and wooden houses, followed by visit to the fishing village of Volendam
- Short boat ride to Marken, known for its stilt houses and historic charm
- Guided panoramic tour of Amsterdam including Museum Square, Rembrandt statue and the elegant South District
- Walking tour in the city center with free time to explore the canals, markets and cafés

Today we'll visit some truly picturesque places; the Holland of our dreams. First, we head to Zaanse Schans, with its charming houses, canals, and windmills. Then on to **VOLENDAM**, a very scenic fishing village. From Volendam, we'll take a short **boat ride** to Marken, once an island now connected to the mainland by a fixed dike. Its houses were traditionally built on stilts to protect from flooding.

In the afternoon, we'll enjoy a **guided tour** of **AMSTERDAM**, combining several highlights: the iconic image of the windmill and the Rembrandt statue, the contemporary elegance of the South District, and the centuries-old magic of diamond cutting at Museum Square. Finally, we'll leave the bus and walk into the heart of the city, where the tour will end. Free time to explore Amsterdam's famous canals, markets, and cafés. Overnight in Amsterdam.



## DAY 14 : AMSTERDAM – BRUSSELS – PARIS

- Morning departure to Brussels, capital of Belgium and headquarters of the European institutions
- Visit the magnificent Grand Place, a masterpiece of Flemish Baroque architecture
- See the iconic Manneken Pis and enjoy free time in the historic center

After breakfast, we set out for **BELGIUM**. Just over 200 km away lies **BRUSSELS**, the Belgian capital and home to the main European institutions, a city that blends elegance with multiculturalism. We will admire its impressive Grand Place, a jewel of Flemish Baroque, and stroll past the symbolic Manneken Pis. This city fuses history, chocolate, and modernity. In the afternoon, we continue into **FRANCE**, arriving in Paris at the end of the day. Overnight in Paris.

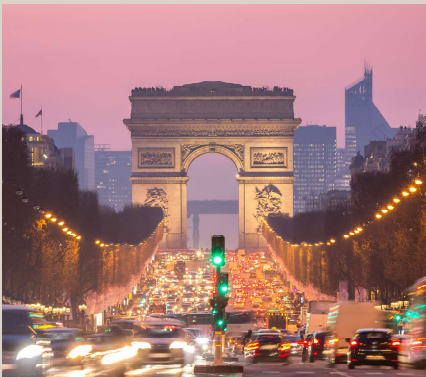


## DAY 15 : PARIS

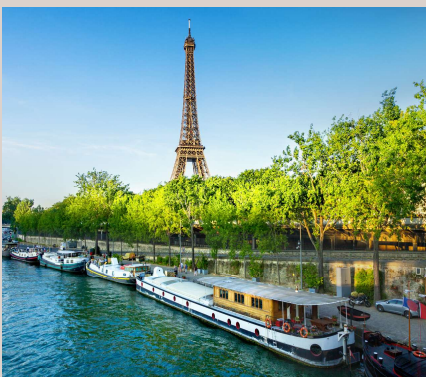
- Visit the iconic Eiffel Tower with included access to the second floor

Afterwards, we'll enjoy a relaxing **boat cruise along the Seine**, which will last approximately one hour and fifteen minutes. You'll have a free afternoon to explore the city at your own pace (transfer back to the hotel not included).
