HISTORIC SPOT "They may take away our lives, but they'll never take our freedom!" Explore Stirling Castle, a great symbol of Scottish national pride and the place Mel Gibson fought for in Braveheart. Through the centuries it was used as a royal residence for Scotland's Kings and Queens, a fortress, and a battlefield for independence. Now a museum, Stirling is one of the best-preserved, ornately decorated and furnished Renaissance castles in the UK.



DAY 4 : GLASGOW - FORT WILLIAM - INVERNESS

- Enjoy a scenic drive along the picturesque shores of Loch Lomond.
- Visit Fort William for clear views of Ben Nevis, the UK's highest peak (Photostops)
- Travel the entire stretch of the legendary Loch Ness.
- Experience the dramatic moors and glens of the Scottish Highlands.

After breakfast, embark on an epic journey through the heart of the Scottish Highlands, beginning with a scenic drive along the peaceful shores of Loch Lomond.

Continue to Fort William, where you'll take in views of the mighty Ben Nevis—the highest peak in the UK—before travelling the full length of the legendary Loch Ness, surrounded by moors, glens, and the enchanting landscapes that define Scotland's wilderness.

Covering a total of 178 miles (286 km), your day concludes with a relaxing dinner.

After breakfast, travel through the scenic Highlands with a visit to the poignant Culloden Moor battlefield, where one of Scotland's most defining clashes took place. Continue to the charming Victorian resort town of Pitlochry for a pleasant stroll before making your way to St. Andrews, the historic university town celebrated as the birthplace of golf and home to some of the world's most iconic fairways. Conclude the day with your arrival in Edinburgh, where you'll have free time this evening to explore the city at your own pace, after covering a total distance of 202 miles (326 km).

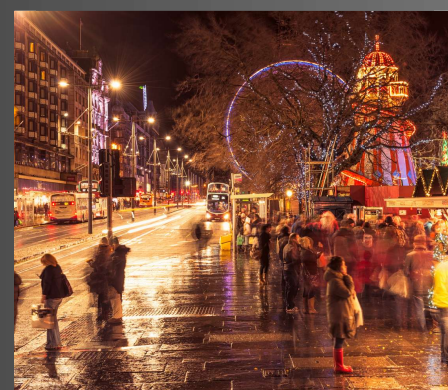
