DAY 1: DEPART KL

Check in at Kuala Lumpur International Airport for your flight to **Kenya**.

DAY 2 : ARRIVAL NAIROBI

- Arrival in Nairobi, the capital city of Kenya
- Transfer from airport to hotel

Arrive in **Nairobi**, the gateway to your **Kenya safari adventure**.

Upon arrival, transfer to your hotel and enjoy the rest of the day at leisure to relax after your journey or explore the surroundings at your own pace.

DAY 3 : LAKE ELEMENTAITA - SOYSAMBU CONSERVANCY B/L/D

- Scenic drive through the Great Rift Valley to Lake Elementaita
- Guided nature walk to discover the lake's ecosystem and birdlife
- Game drive in Soysambu Conservancy, home to diverse wildlife and over 450 bird species
- Orientation meeting with Tour Manager followed by dinner

Depart for a morning drive through the **Great Rift Valley** to the shore of the 'pink' **Lake Elementaita**, overlooking the vast unspoilt plains. Take a guided nature walk to learn about the ecosystem and the different birds found here. Later, join a game drive to **Soysambu Conservancy**, a 48,000-acre wildlife conservancy, which protects over 450 bird species and 15,000 wild animals. It is home to a variety of flora and fauna. Tonight, attend an orientation meeting with your Tour Manager, followed by dinner

Overnight: Lake Elementaita

DAY 4 : AFTERNOON GAME DRIVE IN MASAI MARA B/L/D

- Travel to the famous Masai Mara National Reserve
- Scenic journey through Kenya's countryside and savannah landscapes
- Afternoon game drive to spot wildlife including lions, elephants, buffalo and rhinos
- Explore one of Africa's most renowned safari destinations

Travel to **Masai Mara National Reserve** in the southwest corner of Kenya, renowned for its game viewing. Have lunch at the camp before going out on the afternoon game drive. The vast savannahs are a backdrop to the diverse and abundant wildlife, including lions, elephants, buffalo, and rhinos, as well as antelopes, gazelles, and hippos

Overnight: Masai Mara National Reserve



DAY 5 : MORNING & AFTERNOON GAME DRIVES IN MASAI MARA

B/L/D

- Morning game drive across the vast Masai Mara savannah
- Opportunity to spot the Big Five and diverse wildlife
- Afternoon game drive for more wildlife viewing
- Enjoy the natural beauty of one of Africa's top safari destinations

Spend the day exploring the spectacular **Masai Mara National Reserve** with both morning and afternoon game drives. Search for a wide variety of wildlife across the open plains, including lions, elephants, buffalo, antelopes, and many other species. Between drives, relax at the camp and enjoy the peaceful surroundings before returning in the evening for dinner.

Overnight: Masai Mara National Reserve

DAY 6 : KAREN BLIXEN MUSEUM AND GIRAFFE CENTRE

B/D

- Travel back to Nairobi from Masai Mara
- Visit the Giraffe Centre and hand-feed Rothschild giraffes
- Explore the historic Karen Blixen Museum, former home of the author of *Out of Africa*
- Farewell dinner with your Tour Manager

Bid farewell to the Mara and return to **Nairobi**. In the afternoon, travel toward the **Ngong Hills** to visit the **Giraffe Centre**, where you can hand-feed Rothschild giraffes from an elevated feeding platform and learn more about the successful breeding program and ongoing conservation efforts. Continue to the **Karen Blixen Museum**, once the farmhouse of the prominent author of *Out of Africa*. Tonight, at dinner, bid farewell to your Tour Manager

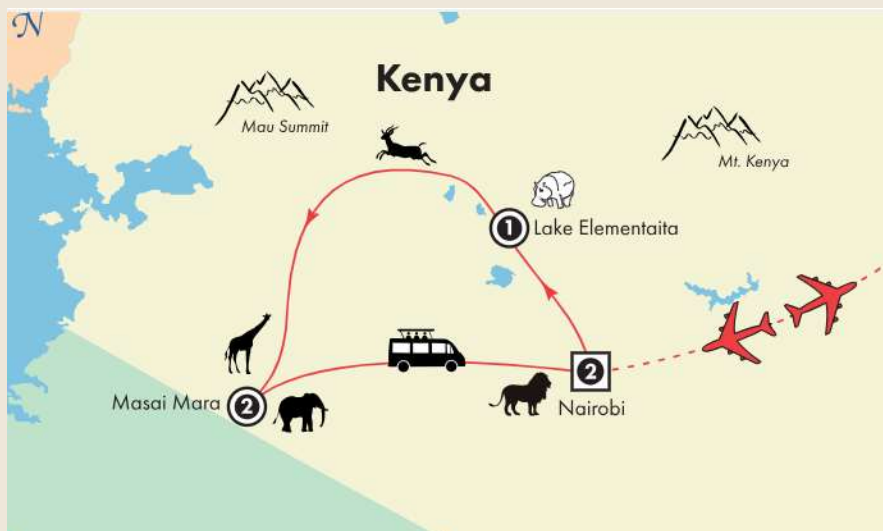
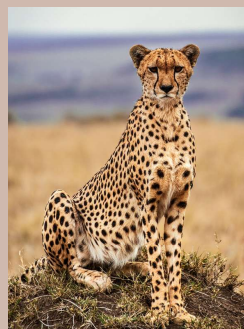

GENERAL INFORMATION OF KENYA

Kenya is a country in East Africa. It's known for its wildlife, savannas, and Great Rift Valley.

Geography:

- Kenya is located in East Africa.
- It is bordered by the Indian Ocean, Uganda, Tanzania, Ethiopia, South Sudan, and Somalia.
- The country has diverse landscapes, including savannas, mountains, lakes, and forests.
- Kenya is home to the Great Rift Valley and famous national parks.

Culture:

- The official languages are English and Swahili.
- Kenya has over 40 ethnic groups, each with unique traditions.
- Traditional music and dance play a big role in Kenyan culture.
- Some English words have Swahili origins, like "safari."

Environment:

- Kenya has rich biodiversity, including lions, elephants, giraffes, and rhinos.
- It is famous for the Maasai Mara migration, one of the greatest wildlife spectacles in the world.

Weather:

- In July, Kenya experiences cool and dry weather, as it is the peak of the dry season and part of the cool season (June–August).
- Nairobi Temperature: 10°C - 22°C
- Masai Mara Temperature: 12°C - 25°C
- This period is also part of the long rainy season, bringing lush green landscapes.

Uniqueness of Destination: Accommodations may require walking outside or traversing stairs between public areas and tents. Several accommodations are built in the traditional local style and have no air-conditioning. Electricity for some properties is provided by generators and may not be available 24 hours a day.

Things to Consider: Expect several days with early mornings. This tour uses 4X4 safari vehicles that have high ground clearance and require agility to embark and disembark. Driving is over roads that are often rough, and bumpy in safari vehicles that cannot be air-conditioned. Only "bush toilets" are available during game drives.

This tour includes animal-related activities which carry inherent risks, as animal behavior can be unpredictable. You may choose not to participate. **Visitors to Kenya are required to carry proof of yellow fever vaccination** if traveling through or from a country with risk of yellow fever and are encouraged to consult their health care providers regarding malaria prophylaxis. We suggest you check with your health care provider before signing up for this tour.

Transportation: There are two days with over 6 hours of driving. Additionally, there are four days with 7-8 hours spent in a safari vehicle driving over rough terrain.

Pace: Expect 1-2 hours of walking on included sightseeing days, as well as considerable time standing.

Terrain: On this tour, you may need to walk on uneven and challenging terrain, navigate steep steps or slopes.

Suggested Tipping Gratuities

Tipping is always at your personal discretion. For your convenience, please refer to the summary below as a guideline for recommended gratuity amounts. Gratuities may be paid in local currency or in the U.S. dollar equivalent where accepted, and we recommend keeping small bills on hand for tipping.

Please note that in many destinations, tipping is considered a customary part of local compensation. While you may occasionally be approached for additional tips, you should never feel pressured to do so.
