DAY 1 : CHECK IN /DEPART KLIA ✈️ ARRIVAL ROME

Welcome to Rome! Upon your arrival, we'll transfer you to the hotel and you'll have some free time. In the afternoon, you'll find information about the start of your tour on the boards located at the hotel reception.

DAY 2 : ROME



- Discover Rome's timeless charm with a panoramic and walking tour showcasing iconic sites like the Colosseum. (Photo stops)
- Photo stop at Imperial Forums, and Vatican City. Lunch at Vatican square
- Entrance to Vatican, Sistine Chapel EUR70/pax follow by Rome Old City walking tour EUR40/pax
- Afternoon free at own leisure or join optional, those pax not joining the optional please make your way to Trastevere area in evening to meet the group again, Back to hotel

In the morning, we'll take a **three-hour guided** tour of the Eternal City, combining a walking tour through Imperial Rome with a panoramic bus ride to admire one of the oldest and most influential cities in Western civilization. During the tour, we'll see iconic landmarks (photostops) at the Arch of Constantine, the exterior of the Colosseum and the Imperial Forums, the Circus Maximus, the Baths of Caracalla, the Basilica of Saint Mary Major, the Pyramid of Cestius, and Castel Sant' Angelo.

The tour will end at **VATICAN CITY** around 11:00 a.m. Afterward, our guide will offer an optional visit to explore the Vatican Museums and the Sistine Chapel & Rome Old Square walking tour in late afternoon

Make your way **to the popular Trastevere neighborhood**, known for its cozy restaurants and lively atmosphere. Return to the hotel will be around 8:30 p.m.

DAY 3 : ROME



- Free day with the option to join an optional excursion.

DAY 4 : ROME - FLORENCE



- Depart from Rome and travel north to Florence, enjoying scenic views along the way. Visit the famous Michelangelo Viewpoint for a stunning panoramic view of Florence.
- Explore the historic city center with a local guide, including the Duomo, Ponte Vecchio, and Piazza della Signoria (photostops)
- Enjoy free time in the afternoon, back to hotel in evening

Today we will leave **ROME** and head north, enjoying the beautiful landscapes along the way. We will arrive in **FLORENCE**, where we will go directly to the Michelangelo Viewpoint, which offers an impressive panoramic view of the city. Afterward, **we will walk to the historic city center**, where, after some free time for lunch, we will take a **guided walking tour** with a local guide of Tuscany's capital—one of the most visited cities in the country, considered the birthplace of the Renaissance and home to some of the most influential artists and thinkers in history, such as Leonardo da Vinci, Michelangelo, Botticelli, and Raphael. Highlights include the Gothic cathedral (the Duomo), the ancient stone bridge Ponte Vecchio with its traditional goldsmith shops, and Piazza della Signoria—the political heart of the city, featuring the medieval town hall. The rest of the afternoon will be free.

Note: We recommend wearing comfortable shoes for the visit to Florence.





DAY 5 : FLORENCE - VENICE



- Travel from Florence to Venice, crossing the Apennine Mountains.
- Take a water taxi boat to the city center for a guided walking tour of the San Marco district, including the Basilica and Campanile.
- Visit a Murano Glass Factory before heading to your accommodation in the Mestre area.

We'll leave **Florence** early and head towards northern **Italy**, crossing the Apennines. In **Venice**, we'll take a **boat transfer to the city center** for a **walking tour of the San Marco district**, where you'll see the Basilica and the Campanile. We'll also visit a Murano Glass Factory to admire traditional glass-working techniques. Accommodation will be in the Mestre area.

DAY 6 : VENICE



Free day to explore. A day to enjoy the moment, discover new landscapes, and let every corner reveal its own story and beauty in peace. Accommodation will be in the Mestre area.



DAY 7 : VENICE - PADUA - SAN MARINO - GUBBIO - PERUGIA



- Visit Padua, including the renowned Saint's Basilica, an important pilgrimage site.
- Continue to San Marino, an independent hilltop republic with beautiful fortified views.
- Travel across the Apennines to Gubbio, known for the Palace of Consuls and its 12th-century cathedral.
- End the day in the historic and charming city of Perugia.

We'll embark on our journey to **Padua**, a revered destination for many pilgrims, where we'll visit the magnificent Saint's Basilica. Our adventure will continue to the stunning Adriatic coast, bringing us to **San Marino**, a charming independent country perched atop a fortified mountain. After lunch, we'll traverse the picturesque Apennines, soaking in the breathtaking mountain scenery as we head to **Gubbio**, a beautifully preserved town known for the impressive Palace of Consuls and the 12th-century cathedral. Finally, we'll arrive in the enchanting city of **Perugia**.

DAY 8: PERUGIA - ASSISI - ROME



- Enjoy a panoramic tour of Perugia with a local guide, including its famous moving walkways and medieval underground streets.
- Explore charming squares and learn why Perugia is known as the "city of chocolate."
- Travel to Rome in the afternoon, arriving later in the day.

We'll go on a **panoramic tour** of **Perugia**, a beautiful historic city, also known as the city of chocolate. Accompanied by a local guide, we'll ascend via the moving walkways that cross the rocky outcrop and be amazed as we explore its medieval underground city, with stone-paved streets and charming squares. Afterwards, we'll travel to **Rome**, arriving in the afternoon.

DAY 09 : ROME - KL DEPARTURE



After breakfast, our journey will come to an end, leaving you with wonderful lasting memories. We will provide transfer to FCO Rome intl airport for flight back home.
