DAY 1 : CHECK IN /DEPART KLIA ✈️

DAY 2 : ROME

- Arrival Rome, transfer to Hotel
- Evening transfer to the **Via Cavour** a tourist hotspot

Welcome to Rome! Upon your arrival, we'll be there to transfer you to your hotel. In the evening, we'll take you to **Via Cavour**, an excellent introduction to Rome. Here, you'll find a variety of restaurants offering Italian, Indian, Chinese, and international cuisine.

DAY 3 : ROME



- Discover Rome's timeless charm with a panoramic and walking tour showcasing iconic sites like the Colosseum. (Photo stop)
- Photo stop at Imperial Forums, and Vatican City.
- Optional tour: Entrance to Vatican, Sistine Chapel EUR70/pax
- Afternoon free at own leisure or join optional, make your way to Trastevere area, enjoying its quaint streets, vibrant trattorias. Back to hotel

In the morning, we'll enjoy a **panoramic tour** of Italy's capital, the Eternal City, one of the oldest and most influential cities in Western civilization. We'll combine a **walking tour** with a **panoramic bus ride**. During the walking tour, we'll admire the Arch of Constantine, the Colosseum (from the outside), and the impressive Imperial Forums. After that, we'll continue by bus, exploring this open-air-museum city with majestic basilicas and churches, passing by Tiber Island, Lungotevere Avenue, and Castel Sant'Angelo. The tour will finish at Vatican City, an independent state within Rome and the center of the Catholic Church. The afternoon will be free. We recommend visiting St. Peter's Basilica and the Vatican Museums. In the evening, we'll provide a **transfer to Trastevere**, perfect for a leisurely stroll through its charming, narrow cobblestone streets. This district is rich in hidden gems, from quaint medieval churches and quirky shops selling unique items to everyday scenes of local life. You'll find many trattorias (casual eating establishments, typically less formal than a ristorante) and osterias (similar to taverns), each exuding Italian charm and ready to serve you authentic local dishes. Additionally, the area offers a variety of restaurants serving Indian, Chinese, and international cuisine. We'll return to the hotel at the end of the evening.

DAY 4 : ROME - FLORENCE



- Travel north to Florence, where you'll enjoy stunning views from Piazzale Michelangelo, a guided walking tour of historic landmarks like Ponte Vecchio and Piazza della Signoria (outside view)
- Have a free time to explore this open-air museum city.

Today, we'll leave Rome and head north, taking in the beautiful landscapes along the way. Upon reaching **Florence**, we'll go directly to the stunning Piazzale Michelangelo for breathtaking views of the city. In the evening, we'll enjoy a **guided walking tour** with a local expert through the historic center, visiting landmarks such as the Ponte Vecchio, the Duomo, and Piazza della Signoria. This city is like an open-air museum. Afterward, you'll have some free time to explore at your leisure. In the evening, you'll have plenty of options for dinner, as this district offers many restaurants with a variety of international cuisines.





DAY 5 : FLORENCE - VENICE

- **Cross the scenic Apennines to Venice, explore St. Mark's Square with a local guide, visit the Murano Glass Factory to witness traditional glassmaking, and enjoy free time on the enchanting island before staying in the Mestre district.**

Today, we'll enjoy the stunning mountain landscapes as we cross the Apennines. Upon arriving in **Venice**, we'll take a **boat across the Giudecca Canal** to the Island of Venice. With a local guide, we'll visit the marvelous St. Mark's Square. Afterwards, we'll tour the Murano Glass Factory, where you'll see the fascinating techniques used to create this ancient glass. You'll have some free time to explore on your own. Accommodation will be in the Mestre district. Gondola ride is optional EUR40/PAX

DAY 6 : VENICE - INNSBRUCK - ZURICH

- **Travel from Venice to Innsbruck to explore its historic town center, then journey through the picturesque Tyrolean landscapes and into Switzerland, concluding the day in Zurich.**

We'll depart Venice and make our way to **Austria**. Upon arriving in **Innsbruck**, you'll have time to explore the historic town center and enjoy lunch. Afterward, we'll continue our journey through the beautiful Tyrolean landscapes as we cross into Switzerland, arriving in **Zurich**.



DAY 7 : ZURICH - LUCERNE - ZURICH

- **Experience stunning alpine landscapes in Interlaken, enjoy a thrilling suspended bridge walk in Grindelwald, have lunch with glacier views, and explore the charming cityscape of Lucerne before returning to Zurich.**

Today's journey features stunning landscapes with tall mountains and pristine lakes. We'll enjoy breathtaking scenery in the **Interlaken** region. Our first stop will be **Grindelwald**, where we'll have time for a coffee before taking the cable car up the mountain. Once there, we'll walk along a winding path leading to a suspended bridge. For those who are adventurous, crossing the bridge offers spectacular views of the surrounding glaciers. We'll have **lunch on the mountain (included)** before heading back down. Our next destination is **Lucerne**, one of Switzerland's most beautiful cities, where you'll have time to explore and enjoy the charming cityscape. We'll then return to **Zurich**.

Note: The guide will offer an optional full-day excursion, starting in the morning. After some free time in Lucerne, we'll take a rotating cable car to the summit of Mount Titlis. At over 3,000 meters above sea level, the alpine summit offers breathtaking views of the glacier and the Alps.



DAY 8 : ZURICH - STRASBOURG - PARIS

- **Travel from Zurich to Strasbourg, the charming capital of Alsace with French-German influences, then continue to Paris, arriving in the evening.**

We'll depart from Zurich and travel to the French region of Alsace, where we'll visit its capital, **Strasbourg**—a charming city that beautifully blends French and German influences. You'll have time to explore and get to know the city. Afterward, we'll continue our journey to **Paris**, arriving in the evening.



DAY 9 : PARIS

🏠 B

- **Explore the Palace of Versailles with its stunning gardens, visit the bohemian Montmartre via cable car, and enjoy a guided panoramic tour of Paris' iconic landmarks before returning to the hotel.**

We'll immerse ourselves in the rich history of **France** at the magnificent Palace of Versailles (admission not included), renowned for its stunning gardens. On our return to **Paris**, we'll visit **Montmartre**, where a **cable car (included)** will take us up to this charming bohemian neighborhood, famous for its artists, painters, and cabarets. To fully appreciate the grandeur of **Paris**, we'll embark on a **panoramic city tour** with a local guide, showcasing the city's impressive avenues and iconic monuments. Afterward, we'll return to the hotel. For those interested, there is an optional variety show in the evening.

DAY 10 : PARIS - ROUEN



- Visit the iconic Eiffel Tower 2nd floor & enjoy Seine River cruise.
- Explore Paris at your own pace, and head to Rouen to discover its historic center, Roman heritage, medieval charm, and Gothic cathedral.

We'll start our day in central **Paris**, beginning with a visit to the iconic **Eiffel Tower**. You'll have the chance to go up to the second floor of this famous iron landmark (tickets included). Afterwards, we'll enjoy a relaxing **boat cruise along the Seine**. You'll have a free afternoon to explore the city at your own pace.

Around 4:00 p.m., we'll depart Paris and head to **Normandy**, arriving in **Rouen**. You'll have free time to explore the historic center of this vibrant city, which dates back to Roman times and boasts charming medieval architecture and an impressive Gothic cathedral, offering a delightful blend of history and culture.

Note: If wait times at the Eiffel Tower are too long, we might reschedule the visit to a different time (or on Sunday) for your convenience.



DAY 11 : ROUEN - ENGLISH CHANNEL - CANTERBURY - LONDON



- Stroll through Rouen's historic center, cross the English Channel to Canterbury's charming historic capital.
- End the day in London with free time around the iconic Tower Bridge.

Today, we'll have time to take a stroll through the center of **Rouen**. After this, we'll travel to northern **France**. Crossing the English Channel by **ferry**, we'll reach Canterbury, the religious capital of England, known for its charming historic center. Our journey will continue to London, where you'll have some free time in the **Tower Bridge** area, one of the city's most iconic symbols, before we head to the hotel.

DAY 12 : LONDON



- Explore London's iconic landmarks like Buckingham Palace and the River Thames on a panoramic tour. (Photo stop)
- Enjoy the vibrant energy of Piccadilly, Leicester Square, Chinatown, and Soho in the evening.

Discover **London** on a **panoramic tour** with a local guide that showcases the city's culture and history. You'll see famous sites such as the Parliament, the River Thames, and Buckingham Palace, where you might witness the iconic Changing of the Guard (depending on the dates). In the evening, we'll establish a meeting point in Piccadilly to take a stroll through Leicester Square, Chinatown, and Soho, areas renowned for their lively atmosphere, theaters, and entertainment options. You'll have plenty of restaurants to choose from for dinner before we return to the hotel.

DAY 13 : LONDON - COLCHESTER - FERRY COLCHESTER VOLENDAM



- Discover global history at the British Museum.
- Explore the lively Camden Market for unique finds and delicious food, stroll through historic Colchester.
- End the day with an overnight ferry to the Netherlands. (Cruise type inside cabin with private washroom)

In the morning, we'll visit the **British Museum**, one of the world's oldest museums, where we'll see traces of cultures from all around the world. At lunchtime, after some free time, we'll head to **Camden**, a district renowned for its vibrant and eclectic street market. There, you can explore unique items and artifacts from around the globe and enjoy lunch at one of its little restaurants or food stands.

Around 4:00 p.m., we'll depart for **Colchester**, the oldest recorded town in England, and enjoy a leisurely stroll through its historic streets. We'll then continue to Harwich to board the ferry for an **overnight voyage** to the Netherlands, staying in en suite cabins.

Important note: Due to the limited number of cabins available on the ferry, the itinerary may be adjusted. We might travel from London to Amsterdam via a daytime ferry, with an overnight stay in Antwerp, or alternatively, take a train or flight to Amsterdam.

DAY 14 : FERRY COLCHESTER VOLENDAM - VOLENDAM - AMSTERDAM B

- Explore the charming fishing village of Volendam.
- Enjoy a panoramic tour of Amsterdam with its iconic landmarks and diamond-cutting tradition,
- Savor global cuisine at Rembrandtplein, near the vibrant Red Light District.

Around 8:00 a.m., we'll arrive in **Hoek van Holland** (Hook of Holland) and make a stop in Volendam, a picturesque fishing village. Then, we'll travel to **Amsterdam** for a **panoramic tour** of the city, where we'll see its most iconic landmarks. We'll also see the famous diamond-cutting technique. For dinner, we'll provide a **transfer to Rembrandtplein**, a vibrant area filled with restaurants offering cuisine from all over the world, and located near the famous Red Light District, known for its diverse nightlife.

DAY 15 : AMSTERDAM KUALA LUMPUR B

After breakfast, check-out as per hotel standard policy then free at own leisure till transfer to airport for flight back to Malaysia.

DAY 16 : ARRIVE KUALA LUMPUR
