DAY 1 : CHECKIN /DEPART KLIA ✈️ PARIS

DAY 2 : PARIS

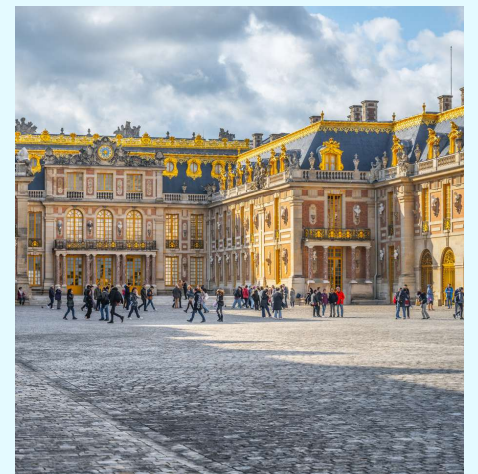
- **Arrival Paris, pickup from airport and transfer to Hotel**

Welcome! Upon arrival, we'll provide a transfer to the hotel, where you'll have some free time. In the afternoon, you'll receive information about the start of your tour, either in person or through the information signs located at the hotel reception.

DAY 3 : PARIS

- **Visit the Palace of Versailles**
- **Explore Montmartre's artistic and bohemian atmosphere**
- **Guided city tour of Paris**

We'll immerse ourselves in the rich history of **France** at the magnificent **Palace of Versailles** (admission not included), renowned for its stunning gardens. On our return to **Paris**, we'll visit **Montmartre**, a charming bohemian neighborhood famous for its artists, painters, and cabarets. We'll embark on a **panoramic city tour** with a local guide, showcasing the city's impressive avenues and iconic monuments. Afterward, we'll return to the hotel. For those interested, there is an optional variety show in the evening.



DAY 4 : PARIS - ROUEN

- **Visit the Eiffel Tower (ticket to the second floor included)**
- **Boat cruise along the River Seine**

We go to the **center of Paris**, starting at the **Eiffel Tower** area. You will have the opportunity to climb up to the **second floor** of this remarkable metal monument (ticket included). Then, we enjoy a **boat cruise along the Seine River**, which divides the north of Paris from the south. Enjoy a free afternoon to explore as you choose. At around 16:00 hrs, we will leave Paris for **Rouen**, a museum city with half-timbered houses, narrow streets, and **Gothic cathedral**. Accommodation in the city.

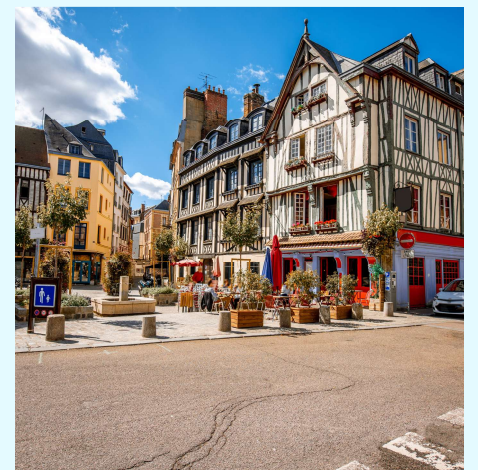
Note: If wait times at the Eiffel Tower are too long, we might reschedule the visit to a different time (or on Sunday) for your convenience.



DAY 5 : ROUEN - ENGLISH CHANNEL - CANTERBURY - LONDON

- **Stroll in Rouen to see the cathedral and historic center**
- **Cross the English Channel by ferry to Canterbury**

Today we will take a stroll in the **center of Rouen** to admire its magnificent cathedral and the ancient streets of the historic center. After this we travel to the **north of France**. Travelling by ferry, we will cross the **English Channel** to reach **Canterbury**, the religious capital of England with a very attractive historic center. Continuing to **London**, arriving with time to explore, visit **Tower Bridge** to see it lit up and admire the modern buildings. Time for dinner in one of the many restaurants offering a variety of cuisines. After dinner, return to the hotel.





DAY 6 : LONDON

🏠 B

- **Guided tour: Houses of Parliament, River Thames, Tower of London, Buckingham Palace**
- **"Changing of the Guard" (seasonal), afternoon free time or join optional**

Discover **London** on a **panoramic tour with a local guide** that showcases the city's culture and history. You'll see famous sites such as the **Parliament**, the **River Thames**, and **Buckingham Palace**, where you might witness the iconic **Changing of the Guard** (depending on the dates). In the evening, we'll establish a meeting point in **Piccadilly** to take a stroll through **Leicester Square**, **Chinatown**, and **Soho**, areas renowned for their lively atmosphere, theaters, and entertainment options. You'll have plenty of restaurants to choose from for dinner before we return to the hotel.



DAY 7 : LONDON - CAMBRIDGE - YORK - DURHAM

🏠 B

- **Depart London for northern England**

We'll start the day by leaving London and heading towards **northern England**. Our first stop will be **Cambridge**, where we'll admire the beautiful colleges. After lunch, we'll continue to **York**, where the stunning cathedral, Roman walls, and lively shopping streets will leave a lasting impression. You'll have some free time to explore. Afterwards, we'll proceed north to **Durham**, a vibrant medieval town featuring a magnificent cathedral in front of the castle.



DAY 8 : DURHAM - ALNWICK - EDINBURGH

- **Travel to Scotland**
- **Continue to Edinburgh, arriving in the afternoon**

We'll travel to **Scotland**, with a stop in **Alnwick**, a picturesque town known for its beautiful gardens and large medieval castle, famously featured in the Harry Potter films. We'll then continue to **Edinburgh**, arriving around midday. As Scotland's capital and one of the most vibrant cities in Northern Europe, Edinburgh's monumental center has been declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site. The castle overlooks the city's steep streets and parks. We'll enjoy a **panoramic tour** with a local guide.



DAY 9 : EDINBURGH - INVERNESS - LOCH NESS - FORT AUGUSTUS - GLASGOW

- **Coffee and stroll in Pitlochry, a charming village**
- **Pass by Inverness, near the mysterious Loch Ness**
- **Visit Urquhart Castle with included entrance**

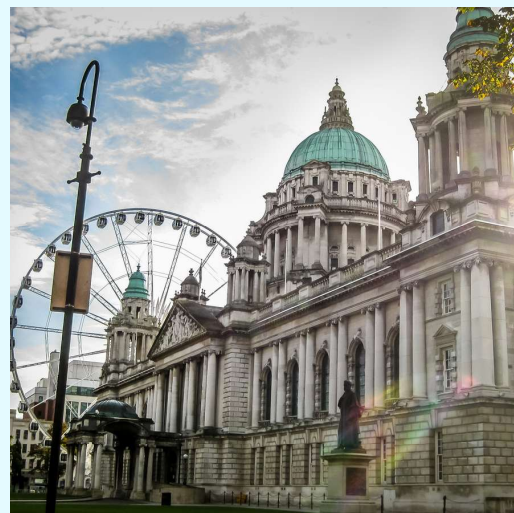
Today, we have an exciting journey through the **Scottish Highlands** ahead of us, starting with a coffee and a stroll in **Pitlochry**, a charming village. Next, we'll pass through **Inverness** in northern Scotland, near the mysterious **Loch Ness**. After, we'll visit **Urquhart Castle** (admission included) from where we'll embark on a **boat ride** on the **dark waters of Loch Ness**. Next, we'll pass by **Fort Augustus** with its sluice system and **Fort William**, a tourist center at the foot of **Ben Nevis**, the highest summit in the **United Kingdom**. Heading south, we'll travel through the high plateaus, where snow is often visible, and skirt the picturesque **shores of Loch Lomond**. We'll arrive in **Glasgow** at the end of the day.

DAY 10 : GLASGOW - BELFAST - DUBLIN



- Transfer to Southern Scotland
- Ferry to Cairnryan to Northern Ireland, Belfast
- Continue to Eire before Dublin

Today we'll leave Glasgow and head towards southern Scotland to board a **ferry in Cairnryan**. Our journey will take us to Northern Ireland, arriving in **Belfast**, the capital of Northern Ireland, a monumental city that is emerging from its historical religious conflicts. We'll then continue into **Eire**, Ireland, with our final stop in **Dublin**, arriving by the end of the day.

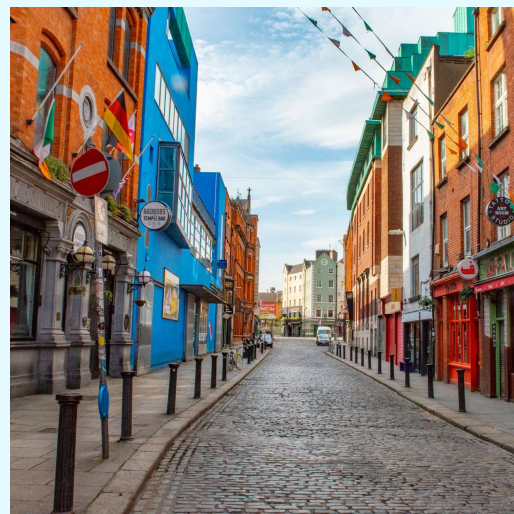


DAY 11 : DUBLIN

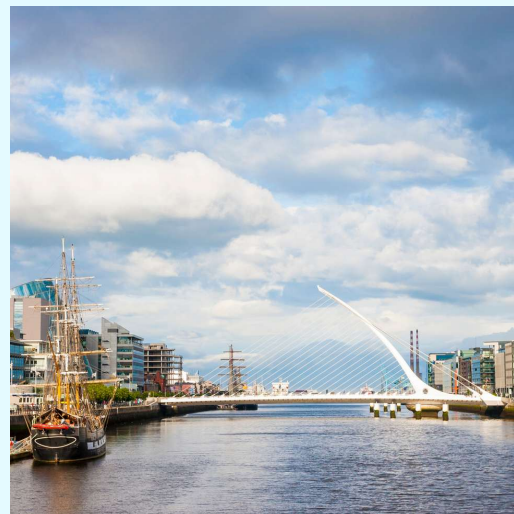
DAY 12 : DUBLIN ✈️ KUALA LUMPUR
