DAY 1 : CHECKIN /DEPART KLIA ✈️ BARCELONA

- Arrival BARCELONA, pickup from airport and transfer to Hotel

Welcome! We'll **transfer** you to the hotel and you'll have some free time. In the afternoon, you'll find information about the start of your tour on the boards located at the hotel reception.

DAY 2 : BARCELONA



- Panoramic city tour of Barcelona, one of Europe's most fascinating capitals
- View few of Gaudí's modernist architecture and key Olympic & World Expo landmarks during our drive through Barcelona main highlights tour
- Drive along the lively La Rambla
- Tour ends at Maremagnum by the Mediterranean, followed by free time



In the morning, we include a **panoramic tour** of **BARCELONA**, considered one of Europe's most fascinating capitals. Open to the Mediterranean Sea, the city is renowned for Gaudí and its modernist architecture, as well as for its lively Ramblas and the legacy of the World Expositions and Olympic Games held here.

Barcelona is often regarded as one of the most beautiful and captivating cities in Europe. The tour ends at the Maremagnum, a modern leisure and dining complex by the sea next to Columbus Square, where you can stroll through this lively area. Afternoon at leisure. Return to the hotel at the end of the day.

DAY 3 : BARCELONA - PENISCOLA - VALENCIA



- Travel south along the Mediterranean with a stop in Peñíscola, a charming medieval walled seaside town
- Free time to stroll through the old town and enjoy the coastal views
- Guided city tour of Valencia, featuring historic landmarks and the modern City of Arts and Sciences
- Free time after the tour, followed by a traditional local meal included

We'll travel south along the Mediterranean, stopping in **Peñíscola**, a charming medieval walled city surrounded by beautiful beaches, where you'll have time for a stroll. We'll continue to **Valencia**, arriving around lunchtime.

In the afternoon, you'll enjoy a **tour with a local guide** of this port city on the Levante coast, with over 2000 years of history. The city's urban layout is adorned with monuments from various eras, contrasting with the modern architecture of the City of Arts and Sciences.

After the tour, you'll have free time to explore at your leisure. A traditional **local meal** will be included.



DAY 4 : VALENCIA - ALICANTE - GUADIX - GRANADA

- Travel through the Valencian Community to Alicante, with free time to stroll its historic quarter and views of Santa Bárbara Castle
- Continue through the Murcia region, stopping en route for lunch
- Stop in Guadix, known for its unique cave houses and historic centre
- Arrive in Granada in the late afternoon; dinner included

We continue through pleasant landscapes in the Valencian Community. **ALICANTE**, a city bathed by the Mediterranean, combines golden sandy beaches with a charming historic quarter. The imposing Castle of Santa Bárbara stands out. Free time for a stroll.

We continue through arid landscapes in the region of **MURCIA**. Stop en route for lunch.

In Andalusia, we make our first stop in **GUADIX**, famous for its unique inhabited cave houses. Its historic quarter combines the Renaissance cathedral, traditional neighborhoods, and unique views of the Sierra Nevada.

We continue to **GRANADA**. Arrival in the late afternoon, dinner included.

DAY 5 : GRANADA

- Full day in Granada, a city rich in Moorish and Spanish heritage
- Visit the Alhambra and Generalife Gardens (if admission included), masterpieces of the Arab era
- Afternoon free time to explore the historic city at your own pace
- Visit the Granada Cathedral, home to the tombs of the Catholic Monarchs

We'll enjoy a full day in **Granada**. If your tour includes tickets, we'll explore the majestic **Alhambra Palace** and its stunning **Generalife Gardens**, both masterpieces from the Arab era. In the afternoon, you'll have free time to discover the city, including the cathedral that houses the tombs of the Catholic Monarchs.

VERY IMPORTANT NOTE:

The number of visitors allowed into the Alhambra is strictly regulated by law. To ensure your admission, tickets will be issued upon confirming your tour reservation. It's essential to provide accurate personal details (full name and passport/ID number) at the time of booking. Please be aware that ticket costs are non-refundable in case of cancellation. In rare cases where the Alhambra visit is not possible, we will instead tour the Royal Alcázar of Seville, which offers similar historical and architectural significance.

DAY 6 : GRANADA - NERJA - MALAGA - RONDA - SEVILLE

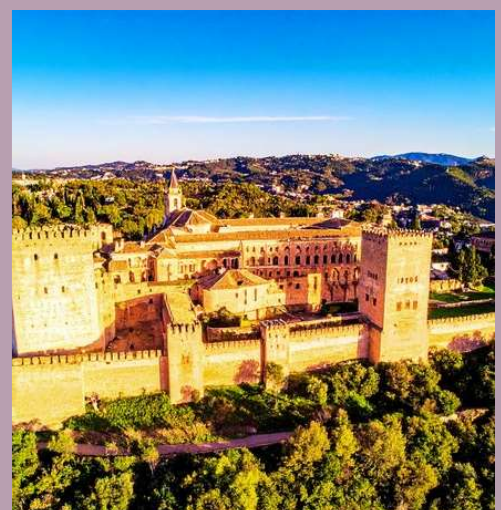
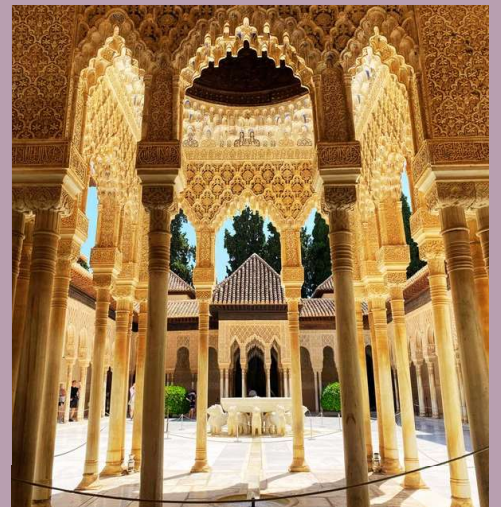
- Scenic drive from Sierra Nevada along the Mediterranean Tropical Coast
- Stop in Nerja, a charming seaside town with dramatic cliffs
- Visit Málaga for lunch and a stroll through the historic centre
- Continue via Ronda to Seville; dinner included at the hotel

Today we'll enjoy spectacular landscapes as we leave behind the Sierra Nevada mountain range. We'll then continue along the Mediterranean, on the so-called Tropical Coast, where the mild year-round microclimate allows for the cultivation of tropical fruits such as guavas, mangoes, and avocados, and in the past, sugar cane.

We stop in **NERJA**, a charming seaside town with impressive cliffs. We continue on to **MÁLAGA**, the capital of the Costa del Sol, full of life and boasting a beautiful historic center. Time for lunch and a stroll through the city center.

Afterward, we head into the Andalusian sierras and arrive in **RONDA**, a stunning white town famous for its dramatic gorge that splits the city in two.

We continue to **SEVILLE**, arriving in the late afternoon. Dinner included at the hotel.



DAY 7 : SEVILLE



- Guided city tour of Seville, including the Cathedral and iconic Giralda
- See the banks of the Guadalquivir River and the historic Santa Cruz & Triana neighbourhoods
- Relaxing boat cruise on the Guadalquivir River with panoramic city views (included)
- Optional evening flamenco show at a traditional tablao

In the morning, we'll embark on a **city tour of Seville**, where you'll see the cathedral with its famous Giralda, the banks of the Guadalquivir River, and the popular neighborhoods of Santa Cruz and Triana.

After the tour, enjoy a relaxing **boat ride on the Guadalquivir River** offering stunning panoramic views (included).

Afternoon free time to explore Seville city area, back to hotel on own

In the evening, you'll have the option to attend a popular flamenco tablao.

DAY 8 : SEVILLE - MÉRIDA - (PORTUGAL) ÉVORA - LISBON



- Depart Seville, traveling through the pastoral landscapes of Extremadura
- Visit Mérida, including admission to the Roman Theatre & Amphitheatre (World Heritage Site)
- Continue to Portugal with a stop in Évora, famous for its whitewashed streets and historic monuments
- Arrive in Lisbon in the evening

We'll leave Seville, traveling through pleasant landscapes of rolling hills and expansive pasturelands as we head towards Extremadura.

In **Mérida**, admission is included to the **Archaeological Ensemble of Mérida**, which features a Roman Theater and Amphitheater.

This site is renowned for its excellent preservation and its designation as a World Heritage Site. You'll have time for lunch and a stroll through the vibrant pedestrian historic center, filled with restaurants and local charm.

We will then continue to Portugal, stopping in **Évora**, another World Heritage Site, known for its whitewashed streets, Renaissance palaces, and cathedral. We'll arrive in **Lisbon** in the evening.

DAY 9 : LISBON (PORTUGAL)



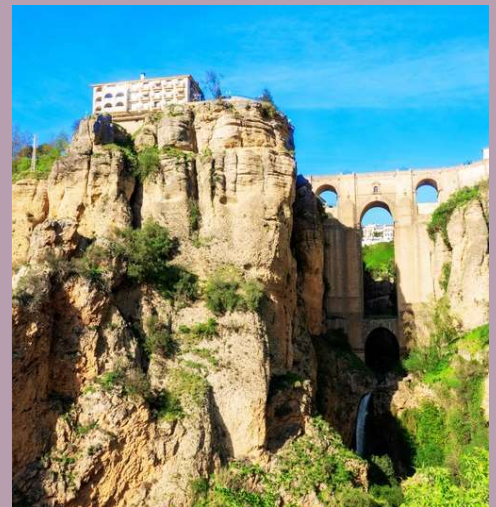
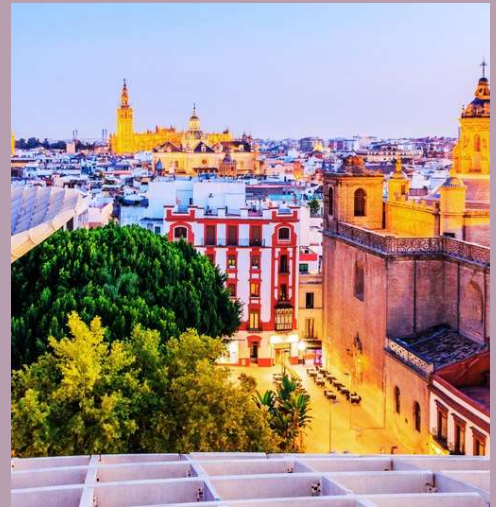
- Sightseeing tour of Lisbon, the capital of the seven hills, known for its historic alleys and iconic azulejo tiles
- Visit the historic Belém district, linked to Portugal's Age of Discoveries
- Afternoon free time to explore Bairro Alto or join an optional excursion to Sintra, Cascais & Estoril
- Evening return from Restauradores Square, a lively area with cafés and bars

In the morning, we'll embark on a **sightseeing tour of Lisbon**, exploring the Portuguese capital of the seven hills, with its charming alleys, iconic tiles, the feeling of "saudade," and the beautiful Atlantic light.

We'll also visit the Belem neighborhood, from where the great Portuguese navigators set sail to cross the oceans in the 15th century.

Free time in the afternoon to walk and go to the Bairro Alto and its viewpoint; if you'd like to, you could take an optional trip to the towns of Sintra, Cascais and Estoril.

In the evening, we'll return to the hotel from the lively Restauradores Square, filled with vibrant bars and cafes.



DAY 10 : PORTUGAL LISBON - (SPAIN) CÁCERES - MADRID



- Early departure from Portugal, crossing the scenic Alentejo region
- Coffee stop in Estremoz, a charming town with a medieval castle and cobblestone streets
- Continue to Cáceres for lunch and a stroll through its well-preserved historic centre
- Arrive in Madrid in the evening, with transfer to Plaza Mayor

We'll depart from Portugal early, crossing the picturesque region of **Alentejo**. We'll stop for a coffee in **Estremoz**, a charming town with a medieval castle, cobblestone streets, beautiful architecture, and a peaceful atmosphere that embody the Portuguese identity. Continuing our journey towards Spain, we'll arrive in **Cáceres**, where you can enjoy lunch and a stroll through its historic center—an exceptionally well-preserved medieval and Renaissance urban complex. Finally, we'll proceed to **Madrid**, arriving in the evening.

DAY 11 : MADRID



- Guided city tour of Madrid, covering Paseo del Prado, Cibeles, Neptuno, Puerta de Alcalá and Plaza de Colón
- Visit Plaza Mayor, one of the city's most iconic squares
- Stroll through Retiro Park, including the lake and Palacio de Cristal
- Admission included to the Santiago Bernabéu Stadium, the home of Real Madrid
- Afternoon at leisure, with evening transfer back to the hotel

The morning will begin with a **comprehensive tour** of central Madrid, featuring highlights like Paseo del Prado, Cibeles, Neptuno, Puerta de Alcalá, Plaza de Colón, and Plaza Mayor. We'll then visit Retiro Park, a beautiful oasis in the city center, where we'll see the lake and the Palacio de Cristal. Admission is included to the Santiago Bernabéu Stadium, the home of Real Madrid—considered by many to be the best football club in the world. Enjoy the rest of the afternoon at your leisure. In the evening, we'll provide a return transfer to the hotel.

DAY 12 : MADRID ✈️ KUALA LUMPUR



After breakfast, check-out as per hotel standard policy then free at own leisure till transfer to airport for flight back to Malaysia.
