### DAY 1 : CHECK IN /DEPART KLIA ✈️ PARIS

Welcome **Paris!** Upon arrival, we'll provide a transfer to the hotel, where you'll have some free time. In the afternoon, you'll receive information about the start of your tour, either in person or through the information signs located at the hotel reception.

### DAY 2 : PARIS TOUR



- Visit the **Palace of Versailles**, famous for its rich history and stunning gardens (admission not included).
- Explore **Montmartre**, a charming bohemian neighborhood known for artists, painters, and cabarets.
- Enjoy a **panoramic city tour of Paris** with a local guide, showcasing iconic avenues and monuments.

We'll immerse ourselves in the rich history of **France** at the magnificent Palace of Versailles (admission not included), renowned for its stunning gardens. On our return to **Paris**, we'll visit **Montmartre**, a charming bohemian neighborhood famous for its artists, painters, and cabarets. To fully appreciate the grandeur of **Paris**, we'll embark on a **panoramic city tour** with a local guide, showcasing the city's impressive avenues and iconic monuments. Afterward, we'll return to the hotel. For those interested, there is an optional variety show in the evening.

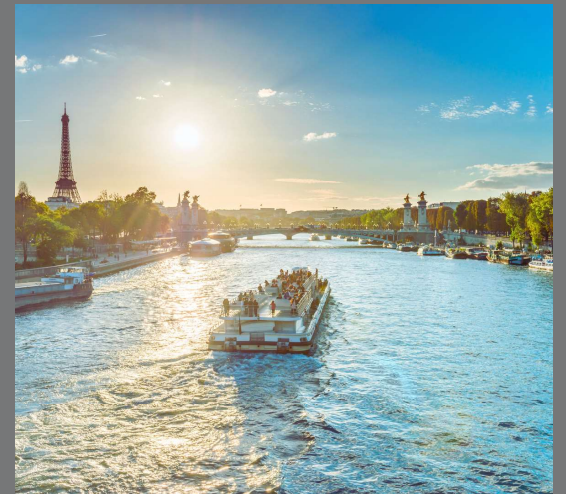
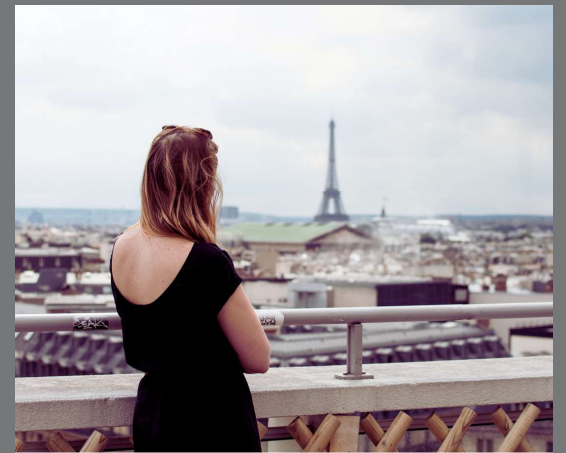
### DAY 3 : PARIS TOUR

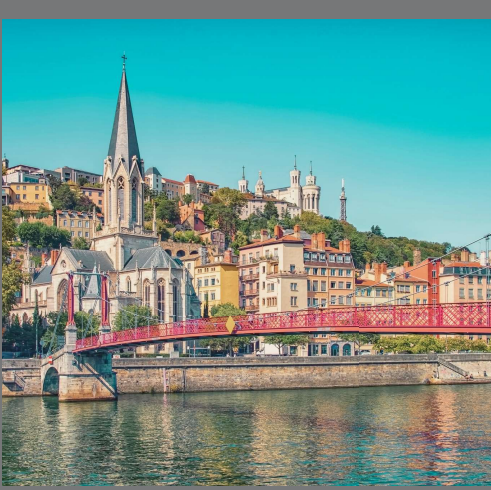


- Visit the **Eiffel Tower** and ascend to the second floor (tickets included).
- Enjoy a **Seine River cruise** lasting approximately 1 hour and 15 minutes.
- Free afternoon to explore Paris at your own pace.

We'll start our day in central **Paris**, beginning with a visit to the iconic **Eiffel Tower**. You'll have the chance to go up to the second floor of this famous iron landmark (tickets included). Afterwards, we'll enjoy a relaxing **boat cruise along the Seine**, which will last approximately one hour and fifteen minutes. You'll have a free afternoon to explore the city at your own pace. **Back to hotel on own expenses**

**Note:** If wait times at the Eiffel Tower are too long, we might reschedule the visit to a different time (or on Sunday) for your convenience.





## DAY 4 : PARIS - BURGUNDY - BEAUNE - LYON

 B

- Travel through the Bourgogne region and stop in Beaune, known for its flower-filled streets, hospice, and wine museum.
- Continue to Lyon and explore the historic UNESCO World Heritage city.
- Ride the cable car to Notre-Dame de Fourvière for panoramic views.

Today, we'll journey to the heart of **France**, passing through the **Bourgogne** region, renowned for its picturesque vineyards and world-class wines. Our first stop will be **Beaune**, a charming town in the center of Burgundy known for its flower-filled streets, hospice, and wine museum. After some free time for lunch and a walk, we'll continue to Lyon, the former capital of Roman Gaul, located on the banks of the Rhône River. Lyon's historic center is a UNESCO World Heritage site. We'll take a **cable car up to Notre-Dame de Fourvière**, where we can enjoy a stunning view of the city. You'll have some free time to explore at your leisure.

**Note:** In some cases, part of the group will stay in Chambéry, a city near Lyon. In these instances, we'll travel to Chambéry in the evening for an overnight stay. In the morning, you'll have time to visit this medieval-style city, the capital de la Savoie, known for its beautiful historic center and impressive castle.



## DAY 5 : LYON - GENEVA - MILAN

 B

- In Geneva, pass by the Palace of Nations, English Garden, flower clock, and see the Jet d'Eau fountain.
- Continue through the Alps via the Mont Blanc tunnel into Italy.
- Arrive in Milan, Photostop at Piazza del Duomo, and enjoy free time in the historic center.

We have a wonderful day planned as we travel to Switzerland. In **Geneva**, our coach will pass by the Palace of Nations, the European headquarters of the United Nations, and the beautiful English Garden, where we'll see the famous flower clock and the Jet d'Eau, the tallest fountain in Europe. After some free time to stroll around this Swiss city on the shores of its lake, we'll continue our journey toward the Alps, home to the highest peaks in Europe. After, a long tunnel under Mont Blanc will take us into Italy. We'll arrive in **Milan** in the afternoon, where our guide will lead us to the impressive Piazza del Duomo. You'll have time to stroll through the historic center.



## DAY 6 : MILAN - VENICE

 B

- Travel from Milan through the Po River plains, arriving in Venice around 1:00 p.m.
- Take a boat to St. Mark's area and enjoy a panoramic tour of Venice in the afternoon.

We'll depart from Milan, traveling through the lush plains of the Po River. We'll arrive in **Venice** around 1:00 p.m. and take a **boat to the St. Mark's area**. In the afternoon, we'll enjoy a **panoramic tour of Venice**. For a complete experience, consider an optional gondola ride. We'll be staying in the Mestre area.



## DAY 7 : VENICE - FLORENCE

 B

- Cross the scenic Apennines and arrive in Florence, starting with a visit to Piazzale Michelangelo for panoramic city views (Photostops)
- Enjoy free time for lunch, followed by a guided city tour to see the Ponte Vecchio, Duomo, and Piazza della Signoria (Photostops)
- Free time in the afternoon to continue exploring Florence at your own pace.

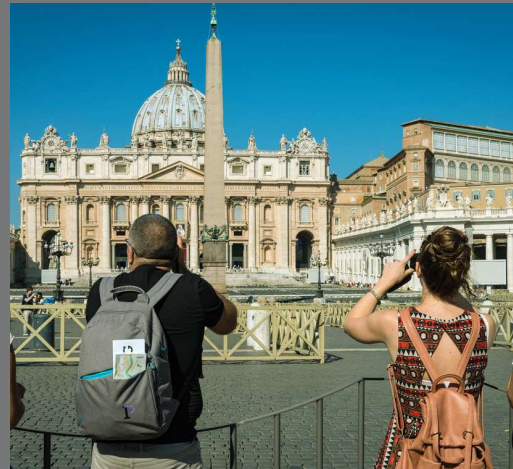
After crossing the picturesque landscapes of the Apennines, we'll arrive in **Florence**. Our first stop will be **Piazzale Michelangelo**, which offers a breathtaking view of the city. You'll have free time for lunch. In the afternoon, we'll include a guided **tour of the city center with a local guide**, seeing iconic sites like the Ponte Vecchio, Duomo, and Piazza della Signoria. This city is truly an open-air museum. Enjoy some additional free time to explore at your leisure.

## DAY 8 : FLORENCE - SIENA - ASSISI - ROME



- Visit Siena to photostops at Piazza del Campo and its impressive cathedral.
- Continue to Assisi for a guided visit to the Basilica, with free time for lunch.
- Arrive in Rome in the evening.

We'll travel to **Siena**, where we'll have the chance to see the stunning Piazza del Campo and its beautiful cathedral. Next, we'll head to **Assisi** for an included **visit to the Basilica** with a local guide or a Franciscan monk. Free time for lunch. Arrival in **Rome** in the evening.

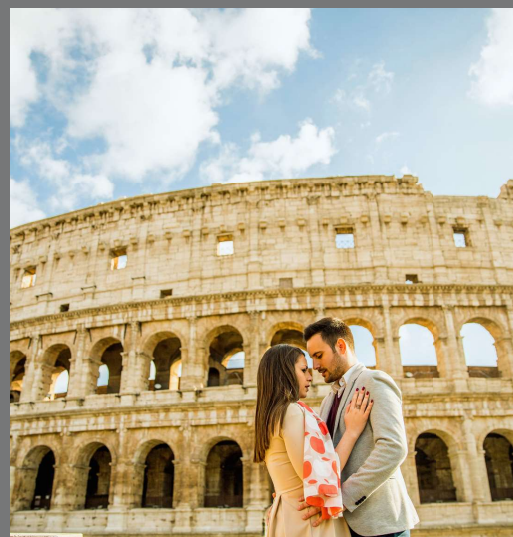


## DAY 9 : ROME



- Enjoy a three-hour panoramic tour of Rome, combining a bus ride and photosops at the Arch of Constantine, Colosseum exterior, and Imperial Forums.
- Pass by iconic sites like the Circus Maximus, Baths of Caracalla, Basilica of Saint Mary Major, Pyramid of Cestius, and Castel Sant'Angelo
- Afternoon free time or join Vatican, Sistine Chapel, Basilica EUR70/pax

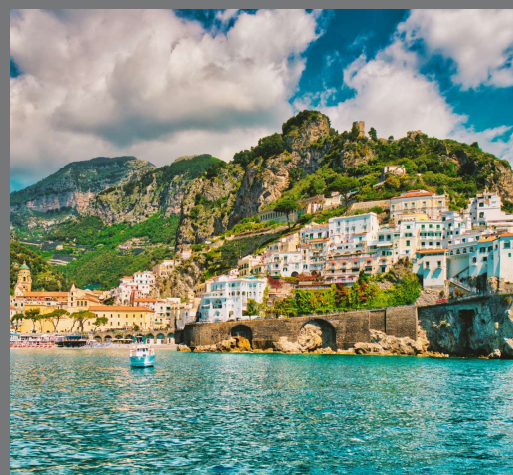
In the morning, we'll take a three-hour **panoramic tour of Rome**, combining a bus ride with a walking tour through Imperial Rome, where we'll see, among other landmarks, the Arch of Constantine, the exterior of the Colosseum, and the Imperial Forums. During the bus portion, we'll pass by iconic sites such as the Circus Maximus, the Baths of Caracalla, the Basilica of Saint Mary Major, the Pyramid of Cestius, and Castel Sant'Angelo. The tour will end in **Vatican City** around 11:30 a.m. Free time in the afternoon, back to hotel on own.

Free day to continue exploring the city.



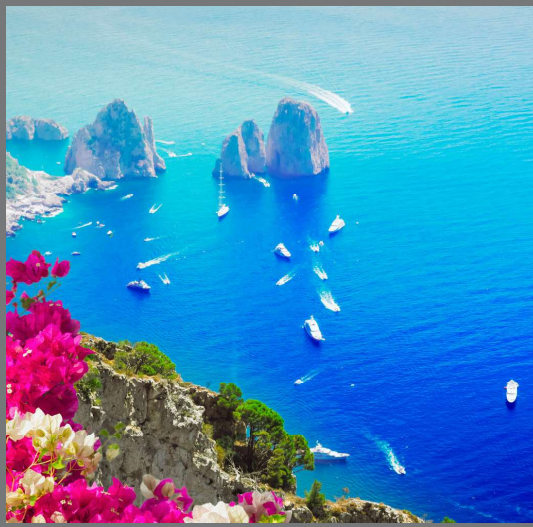
## DAY 11 : ROME - SAN GIOVANNI IN VENERE ABBEY - TERMOLI - BARI



- Travel through the Apennine Mountains to visit the San Giovanni in Venere Abbey (admission included), an 11th-century abbey built on Roman ruins.
- Stop in Termoli, a coastal city with a 13th-century castle, Romanesque cathedral, and scenic beach, with free time for lunch and a leisurely walk.
- Continue to Bari, a historic port city, and explore its old town, narrow streets, beautiful churches, and vibrant atmosphere.

Today, we'll travel toward the Adriatic Sea, passing through the stunning landscapes of the Apennine Mountain range. Our first stop will be the **San Giovanni in Venere Abbey** (admission included), a beautiful 11th-century abbey built on the ruins of an ancient Roman temple. Next, we'll visit **Termoli**, a charming coastal city where the beach is framed by the walled old town, with its 13th-century castle and Romanesque cathedral as the main attractions. You'll have time to enjoy lunch and take a leisurely walk. We'll then continue to **Bari**, a historic port city inhabited since before Roman times. Here, you'll have the opportunity to explore and stroll through the old town. Its narrow streets, beautiful churches, and vibrant atmosphere make it a truly special city, full of southern Italian charm.





## DAY 12 : BARI - BRINDISI - LECCE - GALLIPOLI - BRINDISI

 B

- Travel to Brindisi, a walled port city where you can stroll along the sea, see the Roman column, and explore the old quarter (photostops)
- Visit Lecce, known for its stunning baroque architecture, and enjoy time for a walk and lunch.
- Continue to Gallipoli, a coastal city with narrow streets

We'll follow the coast to **Brindisi**, a walled port city where you can enjoy a pleasant stroll along the sea, admire the impressive Roman column, and explore the old quarter. Our next stop will be **Lecce**, a charming city renowned for its stunning baroque architecture, earning the nickname "Florence of the South." The historic center is filled with beautifully ornate baroque buildings and churches. You'll have time for a walk and lunch. In the afternoon, we'll visit **Gallipoli**, a coastal city on the Ionian Sea founded by the Greeks, who named it "beautiful town." Influenced by Arab, Norman, and Aragonese cultures, Gallipoli's old town is connected to the mainland by a 17th-century bridge. This charming area is a maze of narrow streets and historic buildings, with highlights including the cathedral, the castle, and the ancient city walls. We'll return to **Brindisi** at the end of the day for accommodation.

## DAY 13 : BRINDISI - ALBEROBELLO - MATERA - NAPLES

 B/L

- Visit Alberobello, famous for its UNESCO-listed trulli houses with conical roofs
- Explore Matera, known for its ancient Sassi di Matera, cave dwellings carved into the rock
- After lunch in Matera, travel through Basilicata and Campania to arrive in Naples by evening, with free time to explore.

Today, we'll visit two extraordinary and authentic towns. Our first stop will be **Alberobello**, famous for its unique conical-shaped houses known as trulli. These distinctive structures, with their stacked stone roofs, are a UNESCO World Heritage Site and represent a remarkable example of Italian rural architecture. Next, we'll head to **Matera**, located in the Basilicata region, renowned for its ancient historic center and the Sassi di Matera—a complex of ancient dwellings and buildings carved into the rock, dating back thousands of years. Not only is it a World Heritage Site, but also one of the oldest continuously inhabited human settlements in the world. In the afternoon, after enjoying an included lunch in Matera, we'll continue our journey through Basilicata and Campania, taking in the beautiful mountain landscapes. We'll arrive in **Naples** by evening, where you'll have free time to explore.

## DAY 14 : NAPLES - CAPRI - POMPEII - ROME

 B

- Take a ferry to Capri, with optional tour to visit the Grotta Bianca or ride the cable car to Capri town and the Gardens of Augustus for scenic views.
- Return to Naples for a walk and lunch, then visit Pompeii with an included guided tour and admission.
- Continue the journey and arrive in Rome by the end of the day.

We'll take a ferry to **Capri**, and after a 45-minute crossing, we'll arrive on this island, famous for its natural beauty and luxurious lifestyle. If you'd like, you can take optional activities i-e boat to the Grotta Bianca or ride the cable car up to Capri town and visit the Gardens of Augustus for stunning panoramic views. We'll then return to **Naples**, where you'll have time for a walk and lunch. In the afternoon, we'll visit **Pompeii** (admission and guided tour included), the once-thriving city that was buried under ash and rubble when Mount Vesuvius erupted in 79 AD. We'll continue to **Rome**, arriving at the end of the day.

## DAY 15 : ROME ✈️ KUALA LUMPUR

 B

After breakfast, check-out as per hotel standard policy then free at own leisure till transfer to airport for flight back to Malaysia.
