DAY 2 : PALERMO



- Guided sightseeing in Palermo

Visit a traditional **Carrettieri workshop** to learn about the intricate art of Sicilian cart making, a UNESCO-recognized cultural heritage. Spend the remainder of the day at your leisure.

DAY 7: RAGUSA - NOTO - SYRACUSE

 B

- Scenic drive to Noto, famous for its Baroque architecture
- Stroll along Corso Vittorio Emanuele and visit San Nicolò Cathedral
- Continue to Syracuse, a city rich in ancient history
- Guided visit to Neapolis Archaeological Park
- Explore the Greek Theatre and Roman Amphitheatre

Begin your journey with a scenic drive to **Noto**, renowned for its elegant Baroque architecture. Enjoy a leisurely walk along **Corso Vittorio Emanuele**, lined with stunning buildings, and admire the magnificent **San Nicolò Cathedral**, a gem of Sicilian design.

DAY 8 : SYRACUSE - CATANIA - TAORMINA RIVIERA

- Orientation walk: Piazza del Duomo, Fontana dell'Elefante, St. Agata Cathedral
- Free time at Via Etnea or La Pescheria fish market
- Scenic coastal drive to Taormina Riviera

Depart Syracuse and head north to **Catania**, a vibrant city nestled at the foot of **Mount Etna**. Join an orientation walk to discover the heart of the city, including the striking **Piazza del Duomo** with its iconic **Fontana dell'Elefante** and **the grand St. Agata Cathedral**. Enjoy free time to explore the bustling Via Etnea or visit the lively **La Pescheria** fish market, brimming with local color and fresh seafood.

Continue with a scenic drive along the coast to the **Taormina Riviera**, where you'll have free time in the afternoon and evening to relax or explore this charming coastal area at your leisure.

DAY 9 : TAORMINA RIVIERA - EXCURSION TO SAVOCA

- Visit the Greek Theatre with views of Mount Etna and the Ionian Sea

Step into cinematic history with a visit to **Savoca**, one of Sicily's most charming hilltop villages made famous by The Godfather films. Enjoy an orientation walk through its quiet streets before indulging in a **Local Favorite** - tasting authentic **granita** and **brioche** at the iconic **Bar Vitelli**.

Return to **Taormina Riviera** for an orientation walk and free time to explore or have lunch overlooking the sea. In the afternoon, visit the beautifully preserved **Greek Theatre**, offering sweeping views of Mount Etna and the Ionian coast. Cap off your Sicilian journey with a farewell dinner at a local restaurant.





DAY 10 : CATANIE - LA VALLETA, MALTA - ST JULIAN

B

- Fly from Catania to Malta
- Orientation walk in La Valletta, a UNESCO World Heritage Site
- Enjoy views from Upper Barakka Gardens overlooking the Grand Harbour
- Continue to St. Julian, known for its nightlife and seaside charm

Depart Catania by flight and arrive in the captivating island nation of **Malta**. Begin your exploration with an orientation walk through the capital city of **La Valletta**, a UNESCO World Heritage site rich in history and Mediterranean charm.

Admire panoramic views from the **Upper Barakka Gardens**, a peaceful colonnaded garden originally built in 1661 as private grounds for the Knights of the Order of St. John. Overlooking the stunning **Grand Harbour**, you'll enjoy views of the **Three Cities** and gain a first glimpse into Malta's layered history. Afterward, continue on to **St. Julian**, a seaside town known for its vibrant nightlife and relaxed Mediterranean atmosphere.

DAY 11 : ST JULIAN

Enjoy a full free day in the charming seaside town of **St. Julian**, where you can relax along the picturesque waterfront, explore local shops, or dine on fresh seafood by the bay.

DAY 12 : ST JULIAN - EXCURSION TO RABAT, MOSTA & MDINA B/D

- Visit Rabat to explore ancient Roman catacombs
- Photo stop at the Rotunda of Mosta, known for its massive dome and WWII miracle
- Walk through Mdina, the silent, walled city with panoramic views
- End the day with a farewell dinner at a local restaurant

Embark on a cultural journey through Malta's timeless towns and hidden history. Begin the day with a stop in **Rabat**, renowned for its **catacombs** that date back to Roman times, offering a glimpse into the island's early Christian past.

Continue to **Mosta** for a photo stop at the spectacular **Rotunda of Mosta**, one of the largest unsupported domes in the world. This Roman Catholic church has a dramatic history—most famously for surviving a direct hit from a WWII bomb that miraculously did not explode.

Then, step into another era as you enter **Mdina**, Malta's former capital also known as the **"Silent City."** Walk along its narrow, winding streets and enjoy breathtaking views from the ancient fortified walls. With no cars allowed and signs reminding visitors to maintain peace, Mdina retains a mystical, quiet charm.

In the evening, enjoy a **farewell dinner** at a local restaurant to celebrate the end of your journey through the wonders of Sicily and Malta.
