



12D9N BEST OF SCANDINAVIA (DENMARK/NORWAY/SWEDEN/FINLAND)

DAY 1 : CHECKIN /DEPART KLIA ✈️

DAY 2 : ARRIVAL COPENHAGEN

- Arrival, transfer from airport to Hotel

Welcome to Copenhagen! After arriving at the airport, you'll be transferred to your hotel, with free time until your tour begins. Check the hotel reception for information on the meeting place, time, and guide's name.

DAY 3 : COPENHAGEN - ODENSE - AARHUS

- Morning city Tour of Copenhagen
- Beautiful scenery of southern Denmark

In the morning we enjoy a **comprehensive tour of the Danish capital with a local guide**. Copenhagen is the largest Scandinavian city, and full of contrasts, the popular Tivoli, Christiansborg Palace, the terraces of Nyhavn, and The Little Mermaid (photostops). We will then travel to Jutland, passing through pleasant scenery on our way. En route we take a 20km bridge over the sea and stop at **ODENSE**, where we can visit its gothic cathedral and the house of Andersen. We continue on to **AARHUS** and our accommodation.



DAY 4 : ARHUS - KRISTIANSAND FERRY - KRISTIANSAND - STAVANGER



- Take a ferry from Hirtshals to Kristiansand, enjoy the scenic Norwegian coastline, visit Flekkefjord with its wooden houses, and arrive in Stavanger, a picturesque town by the fjord.

We will travel to **HIRTSHALS**, where we will take a **ferry** crossing the North Sea to **Norway**. A three-hour voyage to **KRISTIANSAND**. We will continue along Norway's southern coastline and enjoy its stunning landscapes. Next stop is **FLEKKEFJORD**, a town with its wooden houses and tiny restaurants on a fjord. Arrival to **STAVANGER**, a small picturesque town that has an active port by the fjord.

Note : Ferry operation hours vary depending on the months. Sometimes it is normally reserved to have lunch on the boat.

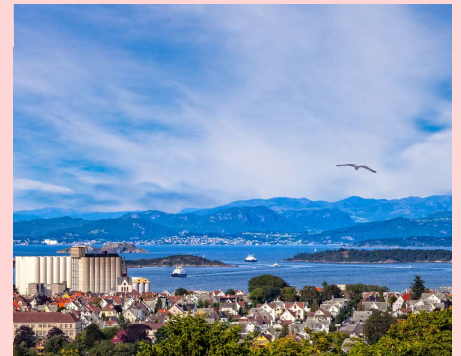
DAY 5 : STAVANGER - BERGEN



- Visit the 'Swords in Rock' monument, travel through tunnels and bridges, and enjoy boat trips along Norway's fjord coast, before arriving in Bergen for a cable car to Mount Fløyen

Upon leaving the city, we will stop at the **'Swords in Rock'** monument, where we will be reminded of the Vikings, before continuing the very beautiful scenic tour.

We follow the route going through tunnels, bridges and travel some stretches by boat to go along the **Fjord coast of Norway**. One of its undersea tunnels is the deepest one in the world. This stage gets more relaxed and spectacular with its two boat trips. We will arrive in **BERGEN** at lunch time. We take a **cable car to Mount Fløyen** which offers amazing views of the town and Bergen fjord. There will be some leisure time later to enjoy the capital city of fjords.





DAY 6 : BERGEN - SOGNE FJORD- OSLO

- Explore Norway's stunning landscapes, including Sognefjord, the Tvindefossen waterfall, a cruise between Gudvangen and Aurland, the Aurland Tunnel, the 12th-century Borgund Church, and free time in Oslo to enjoy its port, main streets, and Frognerparken artworks.

More fantastic landscapes today, images of Norway's interior region fjords, glaciers, lakes and forests. We will travel to **SOGNEFJORD**, Norway's largest fjord. Prior to arrival, we will make a stop at the beautiful **TVINDEFOSSEN waterfall**. We will take a magnificent **cruise** between the cities of **GUDVANGEN** and **AURLAND**; enjoy stunning landscapes during this an hour and a half voyage.

We continue our journey crossing magnificent snow-covered landscapes.

We travel through Aurland Tunnel, the longest in the world. Next, a visit (outside view) **BORGUND's 12th- century wooden church**, which is considered Norway's best-preserved medieval church (admission included). We arrive in **OSLO** with free time to have a walk through its port, main streets, and the artworks at Frognerparken.



DAY 7: OSLO - OREBRO - STOCKHOLM

- Explore Oslo's blend of modern and classical architecture, large parks, and sculptures, then travel through scenic forests and lakes to Orebro, known for its castle and charming historic center, Enjoy landscapes with forests and lakes
- Continue on to Stockholm, arriving in the evening

We include a **sightseeing tour with a local guide** of the Norwegian capital; this city combines its vibrant modern architecture with its classical buildings, magnificent scenery and large parks with sculptures. It has been nominated the "European green capital". After the tour, free time. Departure for **Sweden**. Enjoy landscapes with forests and lakes. Next stop is **OREBRO**, a town next to a beautiful lake with a castle and charming historic center. Time for a stroll. Continuing to **STOCKHOLM**, arriving in the evening.



DAY 8 : STOCKHOLM

 B

- Take a sightseeing tour of Stockholm, Photostops at Gamla Stan, the Nobel Museum, Stortorget Square, the Cathedral, and the Royal Palace, with a scenic view from Fjällgatan viewpoint.
- Enjoy free time to visit museums and parks, with an optional tour of City Hall and the Vasa Museum.

Today we take a **sightseeing tour** of this very beautiful capital city built on 14 islands joined together. We will see the Gamla Stan or the "City between the Bridges", the old quarter of the city, full of life where there are many monumental buildings such as the Nobel Museum, alongside the main square of Stortorget, which pays tribute to the winners of the Nobel Prizes, the Cathedral and the Royal Palace. Whenever possible, we will enjoy a pretty view from the Fjällgatan viewpoint. Then leisure time. We recommend visiting the museums and parks. Optional Tour we suggest a visit to the City Hall and to the Vasa museum.



DAY 9 : STOCKHOLM -TURKU FERRY

- Enjoy a free day in Stockholm before boarding a modern ferry for an overnight journey to Finland, staying in en-suite cabins with private washrooms (cruise type inside cabins)

Enjoy a free day in **Stockholm**. In the evening, we'll board a **modern ferry** for an overnight journey to **Finland**. Accommodation will be in double en-suite cabins.

DAY 10 : TURKU FERRY - NAANTALI - HELSINKI



- Arrive in Finland and enjoy a sunrise view from the ship's deck as you sail past the Åland Islands, then explore Turku and the picturesque town of Naantali before heading to Helsinki.
- Spend the afternoon enjoying leisure time in the Finnish capital, visiting the old market, Russian-influenced buildings, and beautiful churches.

As we arrive in **Finland**, we recommend heading to the ship's deck for sunrise to enjoy the mesmerizing landscapes as we sail past the Åland Islands, a collection of hundreds of forested islands. After disembarking the ferry, you'll have time to explore **Turku**, a city with a strong Swedish influence. We'll then continue our journey to the neighboring city of **Naantali**, a picturesque town with charming wooden houses by the sea. Our travels will take us to **Helsinki**, where we'll arrive around lunchtime. In the afternoon, you'll have leisure time to explore the city, including its old market, Russian-influenced buildings, and beautiful churches.



DAY 11 : HELSINKI ✈️ KUALA LUMPUR



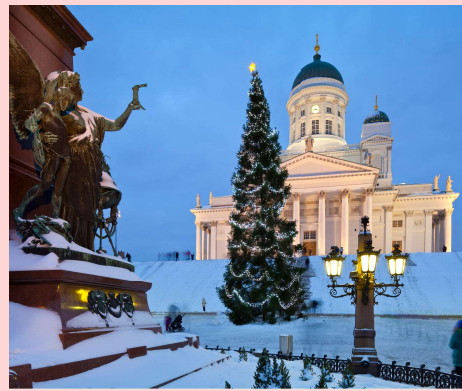
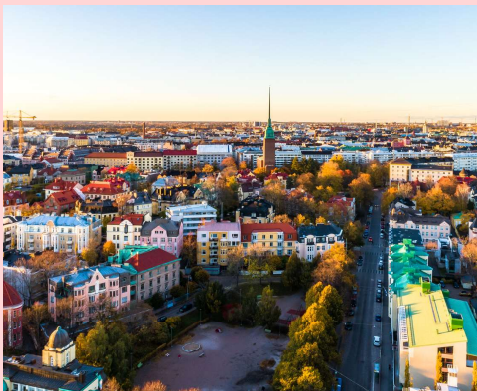
After breakfast, check-out as per hotel standard policy then free at own leisure till transfer to airport for flight back to Malaysia.
