DAY 1: DEPART KLIA ✈️ MADRID

Welcome to Madrid! Upon arrival at the airport, we'll be ready to transfer you to your hotel. You'll have some free time until the tour begins. Please check the information signs in the hotel reception area for details about the welcome meeting with your guide and fellow travelers.

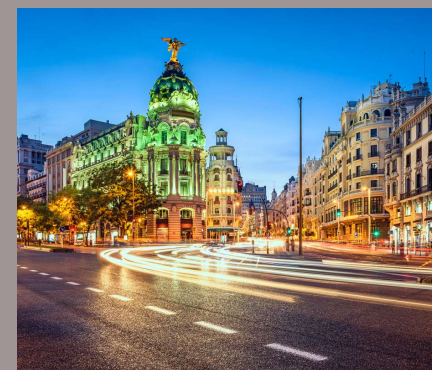
In the evening, we'll provide a transfer to Plaza Mayor and La Latina, Madrid's most famous neighborhood for nightlife and tapas restaurants. You can choose to dine at a restaurant of your preference—options include Indian, Chinese, Spanish, and Middle Eastern cuisines.

DAY 2 : MADRID



- Visit key sites in central Madrid: Paseo del Prado, Cibeles, Neptuno, Puerta de Alcalá, Plaza de Colón, and Plaza Mayor (photostops)
- Enjoy a free afternoon before returning to the hotel in the evening

The morning will begin with a **comprehensive tour** of central Madrid, featuring highlights like Paseo del Prado, Cibeles, Neptuno, Puerta de Alcalá, Plaza de Colón, and Plaza Mayor. We'll then visit Retiro Park, a beautiful oasis in the city center, where we'll see the lake and the Palacio de Cristal. Enjoy the rest of the afternoon at your leisure. In the evening, we'll provide a return transfer to the hotel.



DAY 3 : MADRID - ZARAGOZA - POBLET - BARCELONA



- Depart for Aragon via Castile
- Visit Zaragoza's Cathedral-Basilica
- Explore the medieval Poblet Abbey
- Arrive in Barcelona by evening

In the morning, we'll leave for **Aragon**, travelling through the lands of Castile. Our first stop will be in **Zaragoza** to admire the stunning Cathedral-Basilica of Our Lady of the Pillar. We'll then journey to the serene **Poblet Abbey**, one of the best-preserved medieval monasteries in the world (tickets included). Finally, we'll head to **Barcelona**, where we'll arrive in the evening.

DAY 4 : BARCELONA



- Morning panoramic tour of Barcelona, famous for Gaudi's architecture, the Ramblas, and rich history
- Afternoon free for exploration
- Explore Maremagnum for dining and a seaside stroll

In the morning, we'll set off on a **panoramic tour of Barcelona (photostops)**, celebrated as one of Europe's most captivating capitals. This lively city, situated along the Mediterranean coast, is known for Gaudí's modernist architecture, the vibrant Ramblas, and its rich history, marked by the Universal Exposition and the Olympics held here.

The afternoon is yours to explore at your own pace. Explore **Maremagnum**, a modern entertainment and dining hub by the sea, close to Plaza de Colón. Here, you can take a relaxed walk through the bustling area and select from various dining options.





DAY 5 : BARCELONA - PENISCOLA - VALENCIA

- Travel south to **Peniscola**, a charming medieval walled city with beautiful beaches
- Arrive in **Valencia** for a guided tour of its historic sites and the modern City of Arts and Sciences
- Enjoy free time to explore **Valencia** at your leisure


We'll travel south along the Mediterranean, stopping in **Peniscola**, a charming medieval walled city surrounded by beautiful beaches, where you'll have time for a stroll.

We'll continue to **Valencia**, arriving around lunchtime. In the afternoon, you'll enjoy a **tour with a local guide** of this port city on the Levantine coast, with over 2000 years of history. The city's urban layout is adorned with monuments from various eras, contrasting with the modern architecture of the City of Arts and Sciences. After the tour, you'll have free time to explore at your leisure.

A traditional **local dinner** will be included.



DAY 6 : VALENCIA - ALICANTE - GUADIX - GRANADA

 B/D

- Explore the picturesque coast of **Alicante** and enjoy a leisurely walk
- Visit **Caravaca de la Cruz**, a Holy City with a relic of the Cross, and take a tourist train to the historic area
- Travel to **Granada** in Andalusia for dinner after a scenic journey

We continue through pleasant landscapes in the Valencian Community. **ALICANTE**, a city bathed by the Mediterranean, combines golden sandy beaches with a charming historic quarter. The imposing Castle of Santa Bárbara stands out. Free time for a stroll.

We continue through arid landscapes in the region of **MURCIA**. Stop en route for lunch.

In Andalusia, we make our first stop in **GUADIX**, famous for its unique inhabited cave houses. Its historic quarter combines the Renaissance cathedral, traditional neighborhoods, and unique views of the Sierra Nevada.

We continue to **GRANADA**. Arrival in the late afternoon, dinner included.

DAY 7 : GRANADA

 B

- Spend a full day in **Granada**, exploring the **Alhambra Palace** and **Generalife Gardens** if tickets are included
- Enjoy free time in the afternoon to discover the city and its cathedral

We'll enjoy a full day in **Granada**. If your tour includes tickets, we'll explore the majestic **Alhambra Palace** and its stunning **Generalife Gardens**, both masterpieces from the Arab era. In the afternoon, you'll have free time to discover the city, including the cathedral that houses the tombs of the Catholic Monarchs.

NOTE:

The number of visitors allowed into the Alhambra is strictly regulated by law. To ensure your admission, tickets will be issued upon confirming your tour reservation. It's essential to provide accurate personal details (full name and passport/ID number) at the time of booking. Please be aware that ticket costs are non-refundable in case of cancellation. In rare cases where the Alhambra visit is not possible, we will instead tour the Royal Alcázar of Seville, which offers similar historical and architectural significance.



DAY 8 : GRANADA - NERJA - MÁLAGA - RONDA - SEVILLE

 B/D

- Enjoy spectacular landscapes as we leave behind the Sierra Nevada mountain range
- NERJA, a charming seaside town with impressive cliffs
- RONDA, a stunning white town famous for its dramatic gorge

Today we'll enjoy spectacular landscapes as we leave behind the **Sierra Nevada mountain range**. We'll then continue along the Mediterranean, on the so-called Tropical Coast, where the mild year-round microclimate allows for the cultivation of tropical fruits such as guavas, mangoes, and avocados, and in the past, sugar cane.

We stop in **NERJA**, a charming seaside town with impressive cliffs.

We continue on to **MÁLAGA**, the capital of the Costa del Sol, full of life and boasting a beautiful historic center. Time for lunch and a stroll through the city center.

Afterward, we head into the Andalusian sierras and arrive in **RONDA**, a stunning white town famous for its dramatic gorge that splits the city in two.

We continue to **SEVILLE**, arriving in the late afternoon. Dinner included at the hotel.

DAY 09: SEVILLE

 B

- Embark on a morning city tour of Seville, photostops at the cathedral with the famous Giralda and exploring the Santa Cruz and Triana neighborhoods along the Guadalquivir River
- After the tour, enjoy a relaxing boat ride on the river for stunning panoramic views (included)
- In the evening, you have the option to attend a popular flamenco tablao (optional)

In the morning, we'll set off on a **city tour of Seville**, where you'll visit the cathedral featuring the iconic Giralda, stroll along the banks of the Guadalquivir River, and explore the vibrant neighborhoods of Santa Cruz and Triana. Following the tour, you'll have the opportunity to enjoy a leisurely **boat ride on the Guadalquivir River**, providing breathtaking panoramic views (included). In the evening, you can choose to attend a renowned flamenco tablao.

DAY 10: SEVILLE - MERIDA - EVORA - LISBON

 B

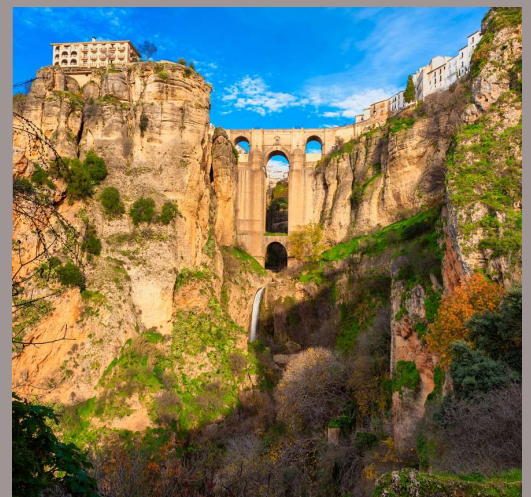
- Depart Seville, heading to Extremadura and visiting the Archaeological Ensemble in Mérida (admission included)
- Enjoy lunch and a stroll in Mérida's historic center
- Continue to Évora, then arrive in Lisbon in the evening

We'll leave Seville, traveling through pleasant landscapes of rolling hills and expansive pasturelands as we head towards Extremadura.

In **Mérida**, admission is included to the **Archaeological Ensemble of Mérida**, which features a Roman Theater and Amphitheater. This site is renowned for its excellent preservation and its designation as a World Heritage Site. You'll have time for lunch and a stroll through the vibrant pedestrian historic center, filled with restaurants and local charm.

We will then continue to Portugal, stopping in **Évora**, another World Heritage Site, known for its whitewashed streets, Renaissance palaces, and cathedral.

We'll arrive in **Lisbon** in the evening.





DAY 11 : LISBON



- Sightseeing tour of Lisbon, including the Belem neighborhood
- Free time in Bairro Alto, with an optional trip to Sintra, Cascais, and Estoril
- Return to the hotel from Restauradores Square, known for its bars and cafes

In the morning, we'll embark on a **sightseeing tour of Lisbon**, exploring the Portuguese capital of the seven hills, with its charming alleys, iconic tiles, the feeling of "saudade," and the beautiful Atlantic light. We'll also visit the Belem neighborhood, from where the great Portuguese navigators set sail to cross the oceans in the 15th century. Free time in the afternoon to walk and go to the Bairro Alto and its viewpoint; if you'd like to, you could take an optional trip to the towns of Sintra, Cascais and Estoril. In the evening, we'll return to the hotel from the lively Restauradores Square, filled with vibrant bars and cafes.

DAY 12 : LISBON - CACERES - MADRID



- Depart Portugal early, stopping for coffee in Estremoz, known for its medieval charm.
- Cross into Spain and explore Cáceres, a UNESCO World Heritage site, & having lunch.
- Continue to Madrid, arriving in the evening.

We'll depart from **Portugal** early, crossing the picturesque region of **Alentejo**. Our journey will include a coffee stop in **Estremoz**, a charming town known for its medieval castle, cobblestone streets, beautiful architecture, and calming atmosphere, all of which reflect Portuguese authenticity. We'll then cross into **Spain**. In **Cáceres**, you'll have the chance to enjoy lunch and explore its historic center, renowned as one of the best-preserved medieval and Renaissance urban complexes in the world. We'll continue to **Madrid**, arriving in the evening.

DAY 13 : MADRID ✈️ KUALA LUMPUR



After breakfast, check-out as per hotel standard policy then free at own leisure till transfer to airport for flight back to Malaysia
