13D11N ITALY SOUTH & SICILY HIGHLIGHTS

DAY 1 : CHECK IN /DEPART KLIA - ARRIVAL ROME

Upon arrival, we will transfer to Hotel, free at own leisure on this day

DAY 2 : ROME - SAN GIOVANNI IN VENERE ABBEY - TERMOLI - BARI



- Visit the San Giovanni in Venere Abbey.
- Explore the charming coastal city of Termoli.
- Discover the historic port city of Bari, with its narrow streets, churches

Today, we'll travel toward the Adriatic Sea, passing through the stunning landscapes of the Apennine Mountain range. Our first stop will be the **San Giovanni in Venere Abbey** (admission included), a beautiful 11th-century abbey built on the ruins of an ancient Roman temple.

Next, we'll visit **Termoli**, a charming coastal city where the beach is framed by the walled old town, with its 13th-century castle and Romanesque cathedral as the main attractions. You'll have time to enjoy lunch and take a leisurely walk.

We'll then continue to **Bari**, a historic port city inhabited since before Roman times. Here, you'll have the opportunity to explore and stroll through the old town. Its narrow streets, beautiful churches, and vibrant atmosphere make it a truly special city, full of southern Italian charm.

DAY 3 : BARI - BRINDISI - LECCE - GALLIPOLI - BRINDISI



- Explore Brindisi's Roman column and old quarter.
- Visit admire Lecce's baroque architecture.
- Wander through Gallipoli's charming old town with its cathedral, castle, and city walls.

We'll follow the coast to **Brindisi**, a walled port city where you can enjoy a pleasant stroll along the sea, admire the impressive Roman column, and explore the old quarter.

Our next stop will be **Lecce**, a charming city renowned for its stunning baroque architecture, earning the nickname "Florence of the South." The historic center is filled with beautifully ornate baroque buildings and churches.

You'll have time for a walk and lunch. In the afternoon, we'll visit **Gallipoli**, a coastal city on the Ionian Sea founded by the Greeks, who named it "beautiful town." Influenced by Arab, Norman, and Aragonese cultures, Gallipoli's old town is connected to the mainland by a 17th-century bridge. This charming area is a maze of narrow streets and historic buildings, with highlights including the cathedral, the castle, and the ancient city walls. We'll return to **Brindisi** at the end of the day for accommodation.





DAY 4 : BRINDISI - ALBEROBELLO - MATERA - NAPLES

B/L

- Visit Alberobello, famous for its unique "trulli" houses
- Continue to Matera, known for its ancient "Sassi di Matera" rock dwellings

Today we will visit two spectacular and authentic towns. **ALBEROBELLO**, charming town famous for its unique conical-shaped houses known as "trulli". These unique structures, with their stacked stone roofs, are a World Heritage Site and are considered an outstanding example of Italian rural architecture. After that we continue to **MATERA**, located in the Basilicata region, known for its ancient historic center with its "Sassi di Matera", a complex of ancient houses and buildings carved into the rock that date back thousands of years. It is a World Heritage Site and is one of the oldest continuously inhabited human settlements in the world. Time for a walk and lunch. In the afternoon we continue through Basilicata and Campania, admiring their beautiful mountain landscapes. **NAPLES**, arrival in the evening. Free time afterwards.

DAY 5 : NAPLES - CAPRI - SORRENTO - SALERNO

B

- Boat trip to the Island of Capri included
- Free time to stroll around Sorrento

After breakfast, we'll head to the port in **NAPLES** before boarding. Boat trip to the **ISLAND OF CAPRI** included. You may take a boat to the Blue Grotto or the cable car to Capri city. We will get on board again and continue to **SORRENTO**, a charming, tourist town nestled at the base of a cliff. Free time to stroll around. Our journey will then take us to the Gulf of Salerno, where we'll stay in the city of **Salerno**.

DAY 6 : SALERNO - PAOLA - MESINA - TAORMINA

B/D

- Travel to the south of Italy, crossing the Cilento National Park
- Continue to Villa San Giovanni for a short ferry crossing to Sicily

We travel to the south of "the boot". Attractive southern Italian scenery as we cross the Cilento National Park. We arrive in **PAOLA**, on the shores of the Tyrrhenian Sea, we visit the **sanctuary of St Francis of Paola** and we have free time for lunch in its pretty historic centre. We go on our way to **VILLA SAN GIOVANNI** where we take a **short ferry crossing** to the island of **SICILY**. Arrival in **MESSINA** where we will have time for a stroll and to visit the cathedral before continuing to **TAORMINA**. **Dinner will be included.**

Note: Accommodation will normally be in the Taormina region, but on certain dates, lodging may be provided in Messina.

DAY 7 : TAORMINA

B/D

- Stroll around the ancient city center, full of life and charm
- Visit the Greek theater(outside view) overlooking breathtaking scenery

At the foot of the Etna volcano, the very beautiful city of **TAORMINA** was defined by Churchill as the prettiest place on earth. Time to stroll around the ancient city centre full of life, its Greek theatre overlooking unforgettable scenery. You can also enjoy the beach. **Dinner will be included.**

DAY 8 : TAORMINA - CATANIA - SYRACUSE - AGRIGENTO

B/D

- Discover Catania's baroque charm.
- Explore Caltagirone's UNESCO-listed Sicilian ceramics and streets via a tourist train.
- Visit SYRACUSE, an ancient city of Magna Graecia on the Ionian Sea and enjoy views of Agrigento's Valley of the Temples.

We'll travel to **Catania**, a city founded by the Greeks, which, despite the destruction caused by volcanic eruptions, still boasts a beautiful baroque center. Next, we'll head to the heart of the island to visit **Caltagirone**, a UNESCO World Heritage city. You'll enjoy a ride on the **tourist train** and have time to stroll through the streets and admire its famous Sicilian ceramics. Afterwards, we continue to **SYRACUSE**, an ancient city of Magna Graecia on the Ionian Sea. The city has also been declared a World Heritage Site; its island of Ortigia, connected by bridges, is the oldest part of town, with lively narrow streets, the cathedral, the ancient castle, seaside terraces, and markets. Free time to stroll and have lunch. We'll then proceed to **Agrigento**, where, before heading to the hotel, we'll enjoy views of the magnificent Valley of the Temples from the comfort of our coach. **Dinner will be included.**

DAY 9 : AGRIENTO - MARSALA - ERICE - PALERMO

 B/D

- Visit the Valley of the Temples, MARSALA
- ERICE, a very picturesque Phoenician town overlooking the sea

With a local guide we visit the **Valley of the Temples**, an impressive archaeological site considered the most complete complex of Greek temples (ticket included). We travel to **MARSALA**, a historic city with a lot of atmosphere and a famous wine, and time for lunch. We go on around the Marsala salt marshes to **ERICE**, a very picturesque Phoenician town overlooking the sea. Time to stroll. We carry on to **PALERMO**. **Dinner included.**

DAY 10 : PALERMO - MONREALE - PALERMO - NAPLES FERRY

 B

- **MONREALE**, with its beautiful Arab-Norman cathedral (entrance included)

After breakfast visit of **PALERMO** including a transfer to the beautiful village (today outskirts of the city) of **MONREALE**, with its beautiful **Arab-Norman cathedral** (entrance included), a World Heritage Site, for its impressive golden mosaics that cover the interior. **Palermo** is a city rich in contrasts, reflecting the history of Arabs, Normans, and Baroque splendor. Highlights include the **Cathedral** (entrance included) and the Palace of the Normans with its Palatine Chapel. Free time at the end of the visit. In the late afternoon we board a modern **night ferry**. Accommodation in double cabins with en-suite bathrooms.

DAY 11 : PALERMO - NAPLES FERRY - NAPLES - POMPEII - ROME

 B

- Visit Pompeii with a local guide to see remains of the ancient Roman city
- Enjoy a walk and lunch in Naples' UNESCO World Heritage old town

Arrival in Naples early in the morning (**breakfast not included**) and continue to **POMPEII** where you can admire the remains of this Roman city that was covered by the ashes of Mount Vesuvius with a **local guide** (entrance and visit with a local guide included). After that, we visit **NAPLES**, one of the most fascinating cities in **Italy** and one of the oldest and most continuously inhabited in Europe. The old town of Naples is one of the largest in Europe and has been declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Time for a walk and lunch. We'll conclude our day with an arrival in **Rome**.

DAY 12 : ROME KUALA LUMPUR

 B

After breakfast, check-out as per hotel standard policy then free at own leisure till transfer to airport for flight back to Malaysia (**You have the option to extend your stay in Rome**)

DAY 13 : ARRIVE KUALA LUMPUR

Arrive Kuala Lumpur, Welcome Back Home!
