DAY 2 : VIENNA

- See grand avenues, palaces, parks and city landmarks
- Free time to explore the city at own leisure
- Evening transfer to Grinzing wine village

Today, we'll embark on a **panoramic tour** of this impressive city with a local guide. We'll explore its majestic avenues, beautiful palaces, large parks and vibrant city center. In the afternoon, you'll have free time to explore on your own. In the evening, we'll include a **transfer to the Grinzing district**, an old wine-growing village now part of the city, known for its traditional taverns. You'll have free time to dine in the area. **Overnight in Vienna**

DAY 3 : VIENNA – BUDAPEST

🍽️ B

- Travel from Vienna to Budapest (approx. 3 hours)
- Free time at Váci utca for lunch and shopping
- Danube River cruise with views of Buda and Pest
- Panoramic city tour with optional Magyar show in the evening

After about three hours of travel, we'll arrive in **BUDAPEST**, the capital of **HUNGARY**. Our first stop will be the lively area of Váci utca, where you'll have free time for lunch. After, we'll kick off our exploration of Budapest with an included **boat trip on the Danube River**, with historic Buda on one bank and cosmopolitan Pest on the other. The views are unbeatable. Following this, we'll begin a **panoramic tour** of the so-called "Queen of the Danube." You'll have some free time afterwards. In the evening, we'll offer an optional outing to a Magyar show, with dinner included. **Overnight in Budapest**

DAY 4 : BUDAPEST – BRATISLAVA – PRAGUE

- Travel from Budapest to Bratislava, capital of Slovakia
- Free time to explore the charming historic center
- Continue journey to Prague, Czech Republic
- Scenic drive through Central Europe

We will leave **Budapest** early and head for **Bratislava**, the capital of **Slovakia**, a charming city along the Danube with an attractive historic center. You'll have time to explore and enjoy lunch. After, we'll continue our journey to the Czech Republic, arriving in **Prague** in the evening. **Overnight in Prague**





DAY 5 : PRAGUE

- Guided panoramic tour of Prague, the “Baroque Jewel of Europe”
- Visit Prague Castle (admission included)
- Enjoy a Vltava River cruise

Today, we’ll visit the capital, **PRAGUE**, the Baroque jewel of Europe. Our local tour guide will lead an informative **panoramic tour**, highlighting the city’s most outstanding monuments. During the tour, there will be a visit to Prague Castle (admission included). After that, enjoy a **boat ride** on the Vltava River (included). In the afternoon, you’ll have free time to explore the city on your own. **Overnight in Prague**



DAY 6 : PRAGUE – PILSEN – ROTHENBURG – FRANKFURT

 B

- Stop in Pilsen, famous for its beer and historic Old Town
- Cross into Germany and travel along the Romantic Road
- Visit Rothenburg, a picturesque fairy-tale medieval town
- Continue to Frankfurt, Germany’s financial capital

We’ll depart early from **PRAGUE** and stop in **PILSEN**, in western Bohemia, a city renowned for its beer. You’ll have time to stroll through its historic center, where you’ll find the Old Town Square, the cathedral, the Plague Column, and a Renaissance-era town hall. We’ll then cross into **GERMANY** and follow part of the **Romantic Road**. We’ll visit **ROTHENBURG**, a town that seems to come straight out of a fairy tale and is considered one of the most beautiful villages in the country. Afterward, we’ll head to **FRANKFURT**, the financial capital of Germany. After our arrival in the evening, enjoy free time in the historic city center, where you’ll find a wide variety of restaurants offering Indian, Asian, Italian, and international cuisines. **Overnight in Frankfurt**



DAY 7 : FRANKFURT – RHINE CRUISE – COLOGNE – AMSTERDAM

- Scenic Rhine River cruise between Rüdesheim and St. Goar
- Enjoy views of castles and vineyards along the river
- Visit Cologne, famous for its Gothic cathedral
- Continue to Amsterdam, Netherlands

Today, we’ll **take a scenic cruise** on the Rhine between the villages of **RÜDESHEIM** and **ST. GOAR**, the river’s most picturesque section. After that, we’ll travel to **COLOGNE**, known for its immense Gothic cathedral. Then, we’ll head to **HOLAND**, arriving in **AMSTERDAM** in the evening. **Overnight in Amsterdam**



DAY 8 : AMSTERDAM

 B

- Visit Zaanse Schans with windmills and traditional houses
- Explore Volendam, a charming fishing village
- Boat ride to Marken, known for its wooden houses
- Guided city tour of Amsterdam with free time

Today we’ll visit some truly picturesque places; the Holland of our dreams. First, we head to Zaanse Schans, with its charming houses, canals, and windmills.

Then on to **VOLENDAM**, a very scenic fishing village. From Volendam, we’ll take a short **boat ride** t

o Marken, once an island now connected to the mainland by a fixed dike. Its houses were traditionally built on stilts to protect from flooding.

In the afternoon, we’ll enjoy a **guided tour of AMSTERDAM**, combining several highlights: the iconic image of the windmill and the Rembrandt statue, the contemporary elegance of the South District, and the centuries-old magic of diamond cutting at Museum Square.

Finally, we make our way to the Central Station, where the tour will end. The guide will provide you with information to explore Amsterdam’s famous canals, street markets, and cafés., back to hotel on own. **Overnight in Amsterdam**



DAY 9 : AMSTERDAM – BRUSSELS – PARIS



- Travel from Amsterdam to Brussels, capital of Belgium
- Photo stop at the iconic Atomium
- Visit Grand Place and see the Manneken Pis
- Continue to Paris, France

After breakfast, we set out for **BELGIUM**. Just over 200 km away lies **BRUSSELS**, the Belgian capital and home to the main European institutions, a city that blends elegance with multiculturalism. Before arriving at the city center, we'll make a brief stop at The Atomium, Brussels most iconic landmark. We will admire its impressive Grand Place, a jewel of Flemish Baroque, and stroll past the symbolic Manneken Pis. This city fuses history, chocolate, and modernity. In the afternoon, we continue into **FRANCE**, arriving in Paris at the end of the day. **Overnight in Paris**

DAY 10 : PARIS



- Visit Palace of Versailles
- Explore Montmartre, the artistic district of Paris
- Panoramic Paris city tour with local guide
- Optional evening variety show

We'll immerse ourselves in the rich history of **FRANCE** at the magnificent Palace of Versailles (admission not included), renowned for its stunning gardens. On our return to **PARIS**, we'll visit Montmartre, a charming bohemian neighborhood famous for its artists, painters, and cabarets. To fully appreciate the grandeur of Paris, we'll embark on a **panoramic city tour** with a local guide, showcasing the city's impressive avenues and iconic monuments. Afterward, we'll return to the hotel. For those interested, there is an optional variety show in the evening. **Overnight in Paris**

DAY 11 : PARIS – ROUEN



- Visit the iconic Eiffel Tower with access to the 2nd level (included)
- Enjoy a relaxing Seine River cruise with views of Paris landmarks
- Free afternoon to explore Paris at your own pace
- Travel to Rouen, a historic city known for its Gothic cathedral and medieval streets

We'll start our day in central **PARIS**, beginning with a **visit to the iconic Eiffel Tower**. You'll have the chance to go up to the second floor of this famous iron landmark (tickets included). Afterwards, we'll enjoy a relaxing **boat cruise along the Seine**. You'll have a free afternoon to explore the city at your own pace. Around 4:00 p.m., we'll depart Paris and head to **NORMANDY**, arriving in **ROUEN**. You'll have free time to explore the historic center of this vibrant city, which dates back to Roman times and boasts charming medieval architecture and an impressive Gothic cathedral, offering a delightful blend of history and culture. **Overnight in Rouen**

Note: If wait times at the Eiffel Tower are too long, we might reschedule the visit to a different time (or on Sunday) for your convenience.

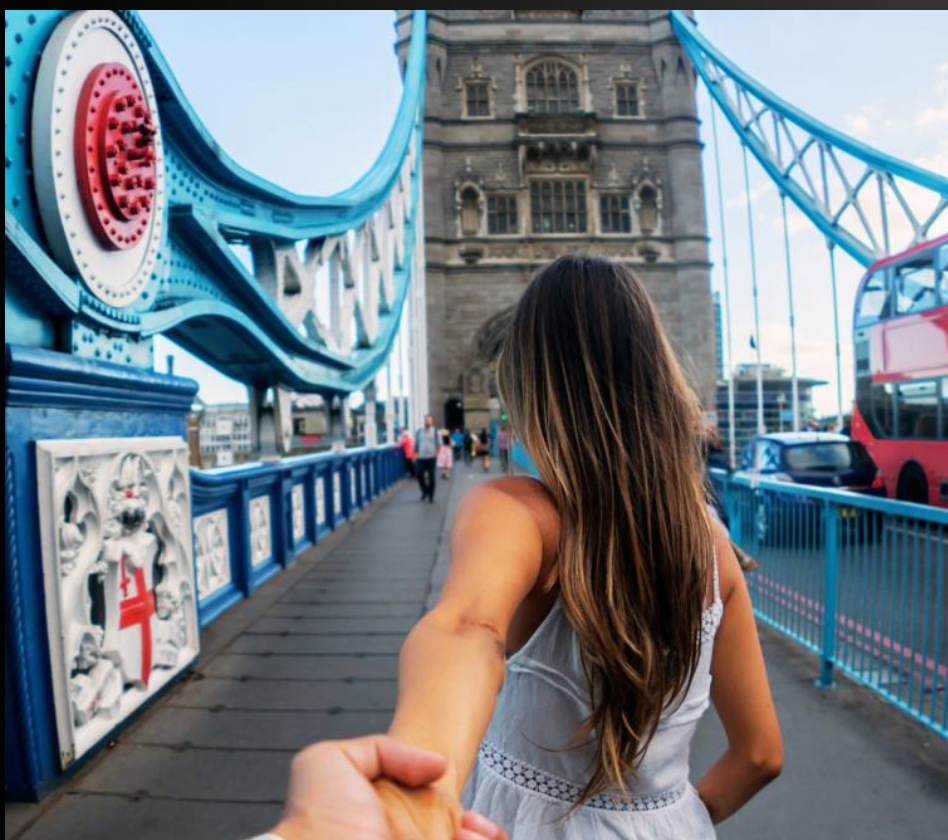
DAY 12 : ROUEN – ENGLISH CHANNEL – CANTERBURY – LONDON

Today, we'll have time to take a stroll through the center of **ROUEN**. After this, we'll travel to northern **FRANCE**. Crossing the English Channel **by ferry**, we'll reach **CANTERBURY**, the religious capital of England, known for its charming historic center. Our journey will continue to **LONDON**, where you'll have some free time in the Tower Bridge area, one of the city's most iconic symbols, before we head to the hotel. **Overnight in London**





DAY 13 : LONDON

- Chance to witness the Changing of the Guard (subject to schedule)
- Afternoon free time or join optional tour to visit Windsor Town
- Evening walk through Piccadilly, Leicester Square, Chinatown & Soho

Discover **LONDON** on a **panoramic tour** with a local guide that showcases the city's culture and history. You'll see famous sites such as the Parliament, the River Thames, and Buckingham Palace, where you might witness the iconic Changing of the Guard (depending on the dates). In the evening, we'll establish a meeting point in Piccadilly to take a stroll through Leicester Square, Chinatown, and Soho, areas renowned for their lively atmosphere, theaters, and entertainment options. You'll have plenty of restaurants to choose from for dinner before we return to the hotel. **Overnight in London**
