



## 10D7N ENGLAND & SCOTLAND

### DAY 1 : DEPART KLIA/CHECKIN

### DAY 2 : ARRIVAL LONDON

- Welcome to London
- Pickup from airport & transfer to hotel

We'll transfer you to the hotel and you'll have some free time.

### DAY 3 : LONDON



- Morning City tour of London (photostops)
- Afternoon free time or Optional visit to Thames Valley and Windsor Castle
- Evening in Piccadilly, Leicester Square, Chinatown, and Soho

In the morning, we'll go on a **city tour of London**, visiting **Westminster**, the Parliament, the City, and the Thames. In the afternoon, you'll have free time, during which we'll offer an optional visit to the Thames Valley, including the town of Windsor, crowned by the stunning Windsor Castle. In the evening, we'll meet at Piccadilly for a **walk through Leicester Square, Chinatown, and Soho**, known for its vibrant atmosphere, theaters, and entertainment (in some cases, this evening program might be organized for the previous day, upon arrival in London). Afterward, we'll return to the hotel by bus.



### DAY 4 : LONDON



- Free and easy day

Free day to explore. A day to enjoy the moment, discover new landscapes, and let every corner reveal its own story and beauty in peace.



### DAY 5 : LONDON - CAMBRIDGE - YORK - DURHAM



- Visit to Cambridge and York
- Explore Durham a vibrant medieval town

We'll start the day by leaving London and heading towards northern England. Our first stop will be **Cambridge**, where we'll admire the beautiful colleges. After lunch, we'll continue to **York**, where the stunning cathedral, Roman walls, and lively shopping streets will leave a lasting impression. You'll have some free time to explore. Afterwards, we'll proceed north to **Durham**, a vibrant medieval town featuring a magnificent cathedral in front of the castle.



### DAY 6 : DURHAM - ALNWICK - EDINBURGH



- Travel to Scotland
- Stop in Alnwick and Edinburgh

We'll travel to **Scotland**, with a stop in **Alnwick**, a picturesque town known for its beautiful gardens and large medieval castle, famously featured in the Harry Potter films. We'll then continue to **Edinburgh**, arriving around midday. As Scotland's capital and one of the most vibrant cities in Northern Europe, Edinburgh's monumental center has been declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site. The castle overlooks the city's steep streets and parks. We'll enjoy a **panoramic tour** with a local guide.





## DAY 7: EDINBURGH - INVERNESS - LOCH NESS - FORT AUGUSTUS - GLASGOW B

- Journey through the Scottish Highlands
- Boat trip on Loch Ness and visit Urquhart Castle

Today, we have an exciting journey through the **Scottish Highlands** ahead of us, starting with a coffee and a stroll in **Pitlochry**, a charming village. Next, we'll pass through Inverness in northern Scotland, near the mysterious **Loch Ness**. We'll embark on a **boat trip** on its dark waters and visit **Urquhart Castle** (admission included). Next, we'll pass through **Fort Augustus** with its sluice system and **Fort William**, a tourist center at the foot of Ben Nevis, the highest summit in the United Kingdom. Heading south, we'll travel through the high plateaus, where snow is often visible, and skirt the picturesque shores of Loch Lomond. We'll arrive in **Glasgow** at the end of the day to take a short stroll around the city center and settle into our accommodation.

**Note:** Groups arriving in Edinburgh from the **15th of November until the end of February** will follow this adjusted itinerary due to the shorter days and frequent snow on the roads:

08:00 a.m. - Departure from Edinburgh to **Pitlochry** (09:45 a.m. - 11:15 a.m.), a picturesque city in the heart of the Scottish region known for its whisky production. We will visit a traditional whisky distillery (admission included). Our journey will continue to Stirling (12:30 p.m. - 03:30 p.m.), with its impressive historic center dominated by the grand Stirling Castle (tickets included). This castle is one of the most significant in Scotland, having witnessed numerous historical events, including battles and the coronation of several kings. After some time for lunch we'll stop to photograph **The Kelpies**, enormous sculptures of two horse heads inspired by Scottish mythology. Finally, we'll continue to **Glasgow**. We'll arrive at around 05:00 p.m. with time to stroll through the city center.

## DAY 8 : GLASGOW - LICHFIELD - LONDON B

- Return to London

We'll depart early in the morning for the south of **Scotland** and **England**. We'll enjoy pleasant green landscapes with small villages along our route. In **Lichfield**, we'll stop for a walk and lunch in this little picturesque town, famous for its cathedral with three spires. Its historic center, with cobbled streets and old buildings, is of great beauty. We'll then continue to London, arriving in the late afternoon.

**Note:** If the number of travelers on this stage is small, the journey may be done by train or plane, and the stop in Lichfield will be omitted.

## DAY 9 : LONDON - HOME DEPARTURE B

- End of the journey

After breakfast, our journey will come to an end, leaving you with wonderful lasting memories. check-out max 12pm and transfer to airport for flight back home
