DAY 1 : CHECK IN/DEPARTURE KUALA LUMPUR ✈

DAY 2 : ARRIVAL PARIS - LOIRE VALLEY - TOURS

- Paris → Loire Valley - Evening departure from Paris to Tours
- Tours - Explore the charming old town & enjoy dinner at leisure

Welcome to France, at around 05:30 p.m., we'll depart **Paris** for the **Loire Valley**. We'll arrive in **Tours**, the regional capital of the **Loire**, in the late afternoon. We recommend taking some time to explore the beautiful old town and enjoy a nice dinner.

DAY 3 : TOURS - BORDEAUX - LOURDES

🍽 B/D

- Bordeaux - UNESCO-listed center, Port of the Moon & St. Andrew's Cathedral (Photostops)
- Lourdes - Evening arrival with optional candlelight procession & hotel dinner included

Today we'll journey to the south of **France** through vineyards, arriving in **Bordeaux**, whose town center is a UNESCO World Heritage Site. You'll have time for lunch and to explore. We suggest visiting the Port of the Moon and the Cathedral of St. Andrew. We'll then continue towards the Pyrenees, reaching **Lourdes** in the late afternoon. Here, you can attend the candlelight procession (held from late March to the end of October) and visit various places of worship. **Dinner will be included** at hotel.

DAY 4 : LOURDES - CARCASSONNE - NARBONNE - MARSEILLE

🍽 B

- Carcassonne & Narbonne - Walk the walled medieval city and explore Narbonne's historic old town (photostops)
- Marseille - Arrive in France's 2nd-largest city and stroll the lively Vieux-Port (Old Port)

We'll travel through the south of France, stopping in **Carcassonne**, a city surrounded by some of the most beautiful walls in Europe. You'll have time to walk and explore. After lunch, we'll continue to **Narbonne**, where you'll have free time to discover this historic Occitan city with its picturesque old town. In the late afternoon, we'll arrive in **Marseille**, France's second-largest city. We recommend a walk through its vibrant Vieux-Port (Old Port), bustling with life and dotted with charming small restaurants.





DAY 5 : MARSEILLE - ARLES - AVIGNON - LYON

- Arles & Les Baux – Roman & medieval heritage, Van Gogh's inspiration, Carrières de Lumières show (photostops)
- Avignon – Lunch & stroll by the Palais des Papes
- Lyon – Old Town walk & cable car to Notre-Dame de Fourvière Basilica

Villages, landscapes, history – today we'll see some of the most beautiful places in **Provence**. In **Arles**, a UNESCO World Heritage city, we'll explore its Roman and medieval legacy and be reminded of Van Gogh. In **Les Baux**, we'll visit this small medieval village and include admission to **Carrières de Lumières**, an impressive underground show that combines art, image, and sound in its old quarries. We'll have time for lunch and a stroll in **Avignon**, home to the immense Palais des Papes. Our journey will continue to **Lyon**, where we'll walk through the World Heritage Site old town and take the **cable car** up to Notre-Dame de Fourvière, a huge basilica offering a great view over the city.

Note: If tickets for the Carrières de Lumières show are unavailable due to closure or high demand, we will instead transfer to the Roman aqueduct of Pont du Gard.

DAY 6 : LYON - TOURNUS - SAVIGNY CASTLE - BEAUNE - DIJON

🏠 B

- Tournus & Beaune – Charming town, photostops grand abbey, wine capital with museum & hospice
- Savigny Castle – 15th-century château with unique museums (cars, bikes, planes, helicopters)
- Dijon – Lively streets, photostops medieval gems & Palace of the Dukes

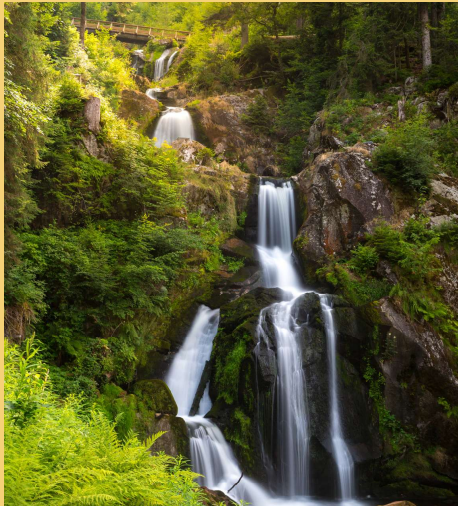
We'll set off from **Lyon** and head to the **Burgundy** region. Our first stop will be **Tournus**, a quaint little town with an imposing stone gate and a large abbey. After that, we'll travel to **Beaune**, where we'll have time for lunch and to explore the wine capital of **Burgundy**. We recommend visiting the wine museum or the historic hospice. Next, we'll visit the **Savigny Castle**, situated in the heart of this winemaking region. Built in the 15th century, the castle houses extraordinary museums featuring motorbikes, racing cars, planes, and helicopters. Our journey will continue to **Dijon**, the capital of **Burgundy**, known for its lively streets and numerous medieval and Renaissance buildings, including the standout **Palace of the Dukes**.

DAY 7 : DIJON - BESANCON - COLMAR - RIQUEWIHR - STRASBOURG

🏠 B

- Besançon & Colmar – Photostops Roman heritage, citadel views, canals & colorful half-timbered houses
- Riquewihr & Strasbourg – Fairy-tale village with wine tasting

While still in the Burgundy region, we'll stop in Besançon, a city of Roman origin with a beautiful historic center and a 17th-century citadel that overlooks the town. We'll then continue our journey to Alsace, a French region that has been contested between France and Germany for centuries. Alsace retains its own German dialect, Alsatian, along with architecture and traditions deeply rooted in Germanic culture. Our first stop in Alsace will be Colmar, a city with unique architecture, colorful half-timbered houses and canals winding through the town. Colmar is also famous for its white wine and gastronomy. You'll have time for lunch and a leisurely walk. In the afternoon, we'll visit one of the most beautiful towns in Alsace: Riquewihr, a medieval town with cobblestone streets and colorful houses that look like they're straight out of a fairy tale—it even inspired scenes from Beauty and the Beast. We will also take the opportunity to visit an old winery and have a tasting of local wine with a typical sweet. We'll arrive in Strasbourg in the evening. We recommend taking a walk around the cathedral area and Petite France



DAY 8 : STRASBOURG - FRIBOURG - TRIBERG - GENGEBACH - BADEN BADEN B

- **Strasbourg & Black Forest – Canal boat in Petite France, cross into Germany via scenic towns, visit Freiburg & Triberg Waterfalls**
- **Gengenbach & Baden-Baden – Stop for photos in Gengenbach, overnight in elegant spa town Baden-Baden**

We'll start our day in **Strasbourg**, the capital of Alsace and home to the European Parliament. The city's historic center is a true gem, with its charming medieval streets, a stunning Gothic cathedral, and picturesque canals lined with flowers. We'll include a **boat trip through the canals** of Petite France to fully appreciate this beautiful area. Afterward, we'll cross into **Germany**, passing through the scenic mountain landscapes and towns of the **Black Forest**. In **Freiburg**, you'll have time for lunch and a walk through this lively university city, known for its medieval center and impressive cathedral. We'll then continue through the Black Forest to **Triberg**, one of the most picturesque towns in the region, famous for its cuckoo clocks. We'll include admission to the **Triberg Waterfalls**, Germany's highest waterfalls, which we'll reach via a lovely walking path. Next, we'll make a quick stop so you can take some pictures of **Gengenbach**, a charming town with a beautiful central square, before heading to **Baden-Baden** for the night. This spa town, once a favorite retreat for European nobility and the upper bourgeoisie, still exudes an air of elegance with its casinos, architecture, and parks.

DAY 9 : BADEN BADEN - SPEYER - HEIDELBERG - FRANKFURT B

- **Baden-Baden, Speyer & Heidelberg – Morning stroll, photostops at UNESCO cathedral, cable car to Heidelberg Castle with gardens & museum**
- **Frankfurt – Explore old town & enjoy beer garden tasting with sausage and sauerkraut**

We'll begin the day with some free time in **Baden-Baden** for a relaxing stroll through its lovely parks before we head to **Rhineland-Palatinate**. Our first stop will be **Speyer**, a historic city along the Rhine River. Here, you can explore the grand Romanesque cathedral, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, and wander through the old quarter, where Alte Münze stands out. We'll then make our way to **Heidelberg**, where a **cable car** will take us up to the impressive **castle**, offering breathtaking views over the city (tickets included). Your ticket includes access to the **castle's gardens, wineries, and the apothecary museum**. Afterward, you'll have time for lunch and a leisurely walk through the old town, including the Marktplatz. In the afternoon, we'll arrive in Frankfurt, a bustling financial center known for its modern skyscrapers, historic old town, scenic views of the Rhine River, and vibrant nightlife. In a typical beer garden located in the historic heart of the city, Römerberg Square, we'll enjoy a tasting of a classic German specialty: beer paired with Frankfurt sausage and sauerkraut.

DAY 10 : FRANKFURT - FLIGHT TO MALAYSIA B

After breakfast, check-out as per hotel standard policy then free at own leisure till transfer to airport for flight back to Malaysia.
