Day 1 : Depart Kuala Lumpur

Day 2 : Arrival Hobart via domestic flight from MEL/SYD , SIC Transfer to Hotel

Upon arrival Tasmania, then transfer to Hotel by driver. Checkin hotel as per standard check in time. Free at leisure at your own time.

Day 3 : Mount Wellington & Wildlife Tour from Hobart (Tue/Wed/Fri)



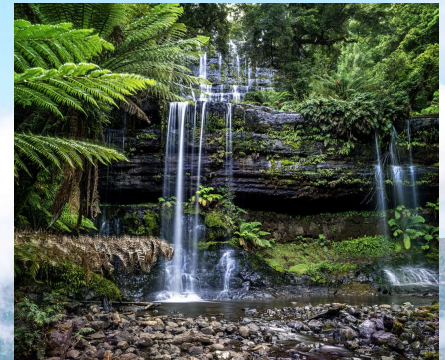
Mt. Field offers diverse walks in one of Tasmania’s oldest National Parks, just 1.5 hours from Hobart. Famous for Russell Falls and the Tall Trees track, this park features great short walks. The **Three Falls Circuit and Tall Trees Walk** loop through the lower rainforest section of the park. This 6km circuit, on easy terrain, showcases Russell Falls, Horseshoe Falls, Lady Barron Falls, and the Tall Trees Track. Choose to visit one, two, or all three waterfalls depending on your adventure level.

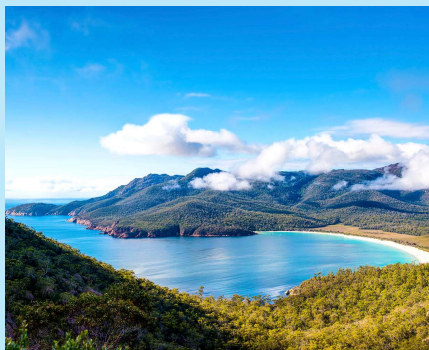
We start with **Russell Falls**, Tasmania’s most recognizable waterfall, with an easy walk through mixed forest and temperate rainforest. After soaking in the view, we continue to Horseshoe Falls, often considered more impressive than Russell Falls.

Next, we enter the **Tall Trees Track**, home to the towering Swamp Gums, the world’s tallest flowering plants. Fit participants can proceed to Lady Barron Falls, or we can return to the starting point for a relaxed experience. Lunch is enjoyed in a scenic picnic spot within the park. Then, we visit Bonorong Wildlife Sanctuary to meet native wildlife and learn about Tasmania’s rare fauna from expert staff. Our final stop is the summit of kunyani/Mount Wellington at 1271 meters. Enjoy sweeping views of Hobart, surrounding mountains, and the Derwent River system. We return to Hobart around 5:30 pm, having experienced Tasmania’s rainforests, waterfalls, wildlife, and stunning scenery.

Highlights

- Explore the Mt. Field National Park (4 hrs)
- Walk to the beautiful Russell Falls
- Count the stairs on the way up to Horseshoe Falls
- Be amazed along the Tall Trees Track
- Visit Bonorong Wildlife Park
- Join a wildlife tour conducted by Bonorong's expert staff
- Hand feed the wallabies
- Stand atop kiunanyi (Mt. Wellington 1271m) for amazing views across Southern Tasmania





Day 4 : Hobart - Wineglass Bay, Freycinet National Park (Tue,Wed,Thus,Fri)



We depart Hobart, heading east and then north along the coastline through Orford and Swansea to Freycinet National Park. Famous for its coastal landscapes, pink granite mountains, secluded bays, pristine waters, white sandy beaches, local wildlife, and amazing trails, **Freycinet** is one of Tasmania's first National Parks.

Upon entering the Freycinet peninsula, we briefly stop at the Freycinet Marine Farm for fresh local oysters and mussels. We then take a moderate 45-minute uphill group walk to the **Wineglass Bay Lookout**. At the top, enjoy the iconic view of Wineglass Bay and Freycinet National Park. This 1.3 km uphill walk, one of Tasmania's Great Short Walks, requires good mobility and fitness. After soaking in the views and capturing photos, you can either return with the tour guide or continue to Wineglass Bay Beach. The **Wineglass Bay Beach Walk, a 2.5-hour return walk**, requires adequate fitness. The tour allows ample time to reach the beach, enjoy lunch, swim, or explore the white sands. For those opting for a shorter walk, return with the tour guide to explore Honeymoon Bay, Sleepy Bay, Cape Tourville Lighthouse, and another Great Short Walk. We re-group and make our final **East Coast stop at Devil's Corner Winery**. Enjoy the view, wine tasting, wood-fired pizza, fresh seafood, oysters, and ice cream (at your own expense). We return to Hobart around 6:00 - 6:30 pm.

Highlights

- Explore Freycinet National Park (4+ hours)
- Walk to the spectacular Wineglass Bay Lookout (moderate uphill walk 45 mins)
- Choose the option to extend your walk to the white sands of Wineglass Bay (longer walking option 2.5 hours)
- Visit the highlights of Freycinet National Park - Honeymoon Bay & Sleepy Bay
- Take in the spectacular 360 degree views on the Cape Tourville Lighthouse Walk (easy 20 mins)
- Afternoon break at Devil's Corner Winery site

Day 5 : Hobart - Full Day Bruny Island (Mon,Wed,Fri)



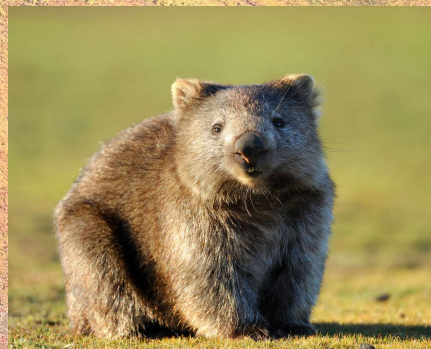
Also known as Lunawanna-allonah, **Bruny Island** is separated from mainland Tasmania by the D'Entrecasteaux Channel. Home to a small, adventurous population, Bruny boasts stunning beaches, forests, waves, and food. We set off early from Hobart to beat the crowds, enjoying a scenic drive and ferry crossing to the island. Our first stop is the **Cape Queen Elizabeth trail**, a 2-hour (6.5 km) return walk with spectacular views from Mars Bluff of Miles Beach and the Bruny Island Arch, a natural rock formation. Next, we visit **The Neck**, the isthmus joining North and South Bruny, and climb 279 stairs to Trugannini Lookout for fantastic views and penguin burrows among the sand dunes. We then head to Two Tree Point for local history before relaxing at Adventure Bay, a sheltered beach with giant eucalyptus trees. Here, you can enjoy free time on the beach or lunch at the Bruny Island Cruises Seafood Restaurant. After lunch, we explore **Bruny Island's artisan produce**, stopping at Bruny Island Chocolate Company for handmade cream fudges and chocolates, Bruny Island Honey for free tastings and honey ice cream, Bruny Island Cheese Co. for artisan cheese and brewery tastings, and Get Shucked Oyster Farm for fresh oysters. After a day of stunning scenery, seafood, beaches, and delicious treats, we return to Hobart around 5:00 pm.

Highlights

- Explore Bruny Island - an island off an island off an island!
- Walk to the spectacular Arch and rock formation on Miles Beach via Mars Bluff
- Climb the stairs to the top of Trugannini Lookout at The Neck
- Visit historic Two Tree Point
- Relax on the beach at Adventure Bay with your own lunch OR enjoy your lunch at Bruny Island Cruise restaurant (own expense)
- Visit Bruny Island Chocolate Co., Bruny Island Honey, Visit Bruny Island Cheese Co.
- Visit Get Shucked Oyster Farm for takeaway fresh oysters
