Day 1 : KUALA LUMPUR PARIS

Welcome! Upon arrival, we'll provide a transfer to the hotel, where you'll have some free time. In the afternoon, you'll receive information about the start of your tour, either in person or through the information signs located at the hotel reception.

Day 2: PARIS



We'll immerse ourselves in the rich history of **FRANCE** at the magnificent Palace of Versailles (admission not included), renowned for its stunning gardens. On our return to **PARIS**, we'll visit Montmartre, a charming bohemian neighborhood famous for its artists, painters, and cabarets. To fully appreciate the grandeur of Paris, we'll embark on a **panoramic city tour** with a local guide, showcasing the city's impressive avenues and iconic monuments. Afterward, we'll return to the hotel. For those interested, there is an optional variety show in the evening.



Day 3: PARIS-ROUEN



We'll start our day in central **PARIS**, beginning with a **visit to the iconic Eiffel Tower**. You'll have the chance to go up to the second floor of this famous iron landmark (tickets included). Afterwards, we'll enjoy a relaxing **boat cruise along the Seine**. You'll have a free afternoon to explore the city at your own pace. Around 4:00 p.m., we'll depart Paris and head to **NORMANDY**, arriving in **ROUEN**. You'll have free time to explore the historic center of this vibrant city, which dates back to Roman times and boasts charming medieval architecture and an impressive Gothic cathedral, offering a delightful blend of history and culture.

Note: If wait times at the Eiffel Tower are too long, we might reschedule the visit to a different time (or on Sunday) for your convenience.



Day 4: ROUEN-ENGLISH CHANNEL - CANTERBURY-LONDON



Today, we'll have time to take a stroll through the center of **ROUEN**. After this, we'll travel to northern **FRANCE**. Crossing the English Channel **by ferry**, we'll reach **CANTERBURY**, the religious capital of England, known for its charming historic center. Our journey will continue to **LONDON**, where you'll have some free time in the Tower Bridge area, one of the city's most iconic symbols, before we head to the hotel.

Day 5: LONDON



Discover **LONDON** on a **panoramic tour** with a local guide that showcases the city's culture and history. You'll see famous sites such as the Parliament, the River Thames, and Buckingham Palace, where you might witness the iconic Changing of the Guard (depending on the dates). In the evening, we'll establish a meeting point in Piccadilly to take a stroll through Leicester Square, Chinatown, and Soho, areas renowned for their lively atmosphere, theaters, and entertainment options. You'll have plenty of restaurants to choose from for dinner before we return to the hotel.





Day 6: LONDON-COLCHESTER-VOLENDAM FERRY

 B

In the morning, we'll visit the British Museum, one of the world's oldest museums, where we'll see traces of cultures from all around the world. At lunchtime, after some free time, we'll head to **CAMDEN**, a district renowned for its vibrant and eclectic street market. There, you can explore unique items and artifacts from around the globe and enjoy lunch at one of its little restaurants or food stands. Around 4:00 p.m., we'll depart for **COLCHESTER**, the oldest recorded town in **ENGLAND**, and enjoy a leisurely stroll through its historic streets. We'll then continue to Harwich to **board the ferry for an overnight voyage** to the Netherlands, staying in en suite cabins.

Important note: Due to the limited number of cabins available on the ferry, the itinerary may be adjusted. We might travel from London to Amsterdam via a daytime ferry, with an overnight stay in Antwerp, or alternatively, take a train or flight to Amsterdam.



Day 7: COLCHESTER-VOLENDAM FERRY-AMSTERDAM

 B

Around eight in the morning, we arrive in the **NETHERLANDS** (Hoek van Holland) and visit **VOLENDAM**, a charming and picturesque fishing village. Afterwards, we travel to **AMSTERDAM**, and take a **guided tour** of the city, combining several highlights: the iconic image of the windmill and the Rembrandt statue, the contemporary elegance of the South District, and the centuries-old magic of diamond cutting at Museum Square. Finally, we'll leave the bus and walk into the heart of the city, where the tour will end, back to hotel on own Free time afterward.



Day 8: AMSTERDAM-HAMELIN- BERLIN

 B

We'll depart from **AMSTERDAM** and head towards **GERMANY**. Our first stop is **HAMELIN**, a picturesque German town with shops and streets reminiscent of the Pied Piper of Hamelin fairy tale by Brothers Grimm. We'll then continue towards Berlin, passing through Marienborn, the former border that separated East and West Germany until 1990. We'll arrive in **BERLIN** in the evening.

Day 9: BERLIN

 B

Immerse yourself in the local culture with a **tour of BERLIN**, the incredible capital of **GERMANY**, accompanied by a local guide. From our coach, you'll have the chance to see the Museum Island, the Television Tower, the city center's main shopping streets, the old cathedral destroyed during World War II, the Brandenburg Gate, the Reichstag, and the city's expansive parks. We'll stop to **visit the Holocaust Memorial and the Berlin Wall Memorial Museum**—two powerful landmarks that remind us of Germany's challenging history in the previous century. You'll have the afternoon free to explore the city at your own pace. In the early evening, we'll provide a **transfer to the lively Kantstrasse area**.



Day 10: BERLIN- DRESDEN-PRAGUE

 B

We'll journey through forests towards **Dresden**, a city renowned for its exceptional architectural and artistic heritage, making it one of Germany's top tourist destinations. You'll have time to explore some of the impressive palaces and enjoy lunch at one of its many restaurants and coffee shops. Later, we'll depart for the **Czech Republic**, arriving in **Prague**. We'll head to the **Old Town Square**, a vibrant area full of energy and tourist activities, ideal for your first experience of Prague. Dine at one of the numerous restaurants offering a variety of international cuisines, including Czech, Chinese, Indian, and Italian. Afterwards, we'll return to the hotel.

Day 11: PRAGUE

 B

Today, we'll visit the capital, **PRAGUE**, the Baroque jewel of Europe. Our local tour guide will lead an informative **panoramic tour**, highlighting the city's most outstanding monuments. During the tour, there will be a visit to Prague Castle (admission included). After that, enjoy a **boat ride** on the Vltava River (included). In the afternoon, you'll have free time to explore the city on your own.



Day 12: PRAGUE-MUNICH-INNSBRUCK



We'll depart early and head to Bavaria, **GERMANY**. We'll arrive in **MUNICH** by midday, where you'll have free time to stroll through the historic city center and enjoy lunch. In the afternoon, we'll continue to **AUSTRIA**. Upon arrival in the heart of the Alps, you'll have time to explore **INNSBRUCK**, the capital of Tyrol. There will be time for dinner in the Golden Roof area and Old Town.

Day 13: INNSBRUCK-ZURICH



Start your day with a visit to the **Swarovski Museum**, the famous home of crystals. We'll explore its impressive gardens and learn about the creation process behind the stunning Swarovski pieces. Afterward, enjoy some free time to stroll around before we head to Zurich, enjoying the beautiful Tyrolean scenery along the way. In Zurich, spend the evening in the historic center by the lake, where you can choose from a variety of restaurants offering Indian, Oriental, Italian, International, and Swiss cuisine.

Day 14: ZURICH-LUCERNE- ZURICH



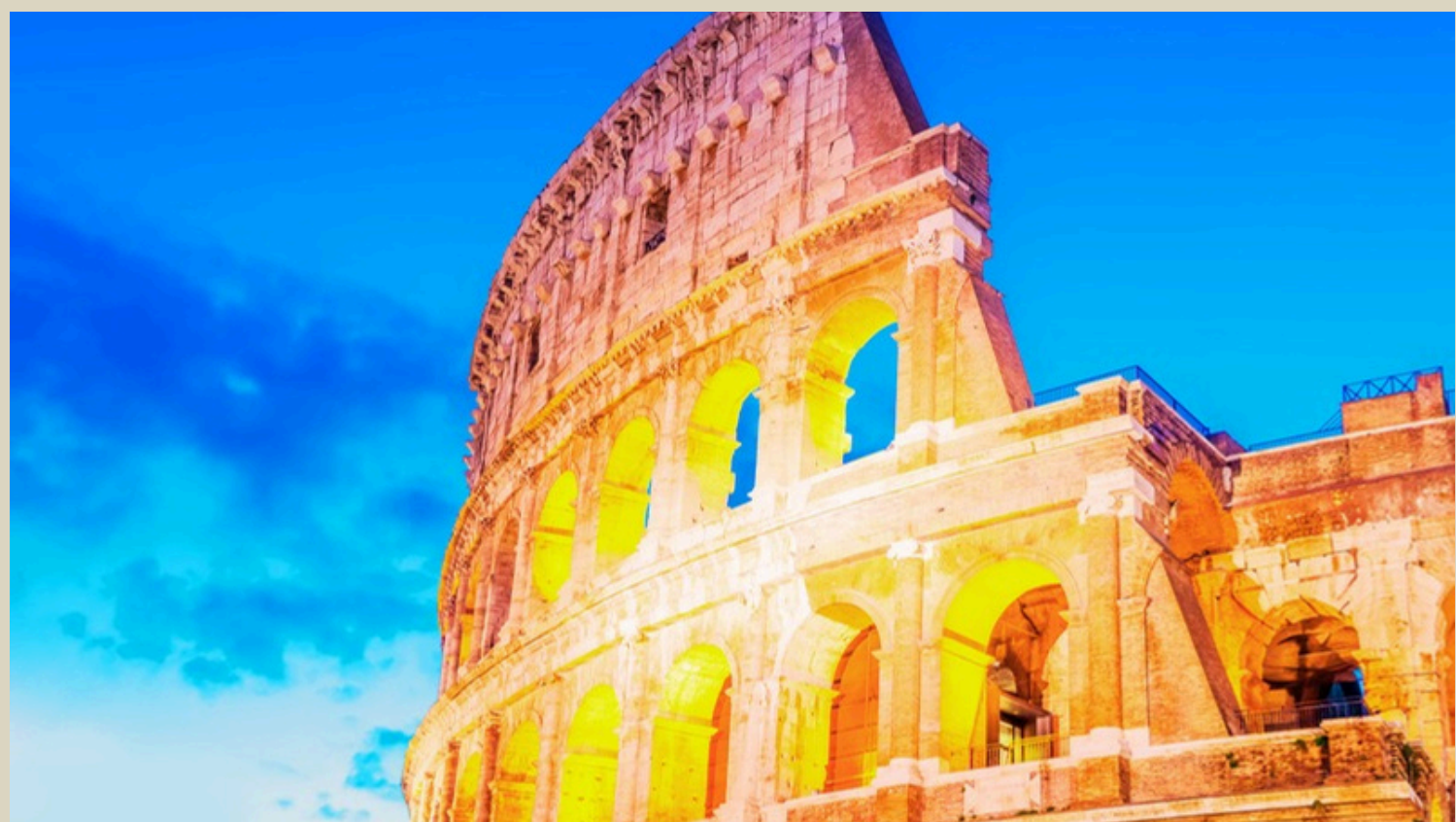
Today's journey features stunning landscapes with tall mountains and pristine lakes. We'll enjoy breathtaking scenery in the **Interlaken** region. Our first stop will be **Grindelwald**, where we'll have time for a coffee before taking the cable car up the mountain. Once there, we'll walk along a winding path leading to a suspended bridge. For those who are adventurous, crossing the bridge offers spectacular views of the surrounding glaciers. We'll have **lunch on the mountain** (included) before heading back down. Our next destination is **Lucerne**, one of Switzerland's most beautiful cities, where you'll have time to explore and enjoy the charming cityscape. We'll then return to Zurich.

Day 15: ZURICH-BELLINZONA-COMO-MILAN

We'll leave **ZURICH** early in the morning, crossing the Alps to reach the Italian-speaking part of Switzerland. Our first stop will be **BELLINZONA**, renowned for its three medieval castles, which are UNESCO World Heritage Sites. Perched on the hills overlooking the city, these castles highlight Bellinzona's historical significance as a key alpine stronghold. Enjoy some free time to wander through the charming streets of the center. Next, we'll enter Italy and stop in the charming town of **COMO** for lunch. This town is considered the jewel of **LOMBARDY**, known for its beautiful gardens beside the lake and its spectacular cathedral. We'll continue to **MILAN**, where our guide will take us to the impressive Piazza del Duomo. You'll have some time to wander around before we transfer you to the hotel.

Day 16: MILAN - PISA - ROME

Today, we'll continue our journey to **Pisa**. We'll ride a small **tourist train** to the Piazza dei Miracoli (Square of Miracles), where you'll have time to admire one of the most captivating and beautiful art complexes in **Italy**, including the famous Leaning Tower of Pisa. Afterwards, we'll head to **Rome**, arriving later in the day.





Day 17: ROME



In the morning, we'll take a **three-hour guided tour** of the Eternal City, combining a walking tour through Imperial Rome with a panoramic bus ride to admire one of the oldest and most influential cities in Western civilization. During the tour, we'll see iconic landmarks such as the Arch of Constantine, the exterior of the Colosseum and the Imperial Forums, the Circus Maximus, the Baths of Caracalla, the Basilica of Saint Mary Major, the Pyramid of Cestius, and Castel Sant'Angelo. The tour will end at **VATICAN CITY** around 11:00 a.m. Afterward, our guide will offer an optional visit to explore the Vatican Museums and the Sistine Chapel. At the end of the day, we'll include a **transfer to the popular Trastevere neighborhood**, known for its cozy restaurants and lively atmosphere. Return to the hotel will be around 8:30 p.m



Day 18: ROME-MADRID



At the time informed by the guide, we will make a **transfer to the airport** to catch a **domestic flight included** in your trip. On arrival at destination we will give you another **hotel transfer**. Your guide will contact you at the end of the afternoon or you can consult the information in your hotel reception.

Note: remember that on domestic flights, the luggage normally allowed is one suitcase of up to 20 kg in the hold. Passengers must pay for all excess luggage directly to the airline.



Day 19: MADRID



The morning will begin with a **comprehensive tour** of central Madrid, featuring highlights like Paseo del Prado, Cibeles, Neptuno, Puerta de Alcalá, Plaza de Colón, and Plaza Mayor. We'll then visit Retiro Park, a beautiful oasis in the city center, where we'll see the lake and the Palacio de Cristal. Admission is included to the **Santiago Bernabéu Stadium**, the home of Real Madrid—considered by many to be the best football club in the world. Enjoy the rest of the afternoon at your leisure. In the evening, we'll provide a return transfer to the hotel.



Day 20: MADRID-ZARAGOZA-POBLET-BARCELONA



In the morning, we'll leave for **ARAGON**, travelling through the lands of Castile. Our first stop will be in **ZARAGOZA** to admire the stunning Cathedral-Basilica of Our Lady of the Pillar. We'll then journey to the serene **Poblet Abbey**, one of the best-preserved medieval monasteries in the world (**tickets included**). Finally, we'll head to **BARCELONA**, where we'll arrive in the evening.

Day 21: BARCELONA



In the morning, we include a **panoramic tour** of **BARCELONA**, considered one of Europe's most fascinating capitals. Open to the Mediterranean Sea, the city is renowned for Gaudí and its modernist architecture, as well as for its lively Ramblas and the legacy of the World Expositions and Olympic Games held here. Barcelona is often regarded as one of the most beautiful and captivating cities in Europe. The tour ends at the Maremagnum, a modern leisure and dining complex by the sea next to Columbus Square, where you can stroll through this lively area. Afternoon at leisure. Return to the hotel at the end of the day.

Day 22: BARCELONA



After breakfast, our journey will come to an end, leaving you with wonderful lasting memories.
