DAY 1 : CHECK IN /DEPART KLIA ✈️ PARIS

Welcome to Paris ! We'll transfer you to the hotel and you'll have some free time.

DAY 2 : PARIS



- Visit Palace of Versailles
- Visit Montmartre, renowned for artists, painters, and cabarets
- Paris panoramic bus city tour & return to hotel

We'll immerse ourselves in the rich history of **France** at the magnificent Palace of Versailles (admission not included), renowned for its stunning gardens. On our return to Paris, we'll visit **Montmartre**, a charming bohemian neighborhood, famous for its artists, painters, and cabarets. To fully appreciate the grandeur of **Paris**, we'll embark on a **panoramic city tour** with a local guide, showcasing the city's impressive avenues and iconic monuments. Afterward, we'll return to the hotel. For those interested, there is an optional variety show in the evening.

DAY 3 : PARIS



- Visit the Eiffel Tower 2nd Floor tickets included
- Enjoy a relaxing boat cruise along the Seine River

We'll start our day in central **Paris**, beginning with a visit to the iconic **Eiffel Tower**. You'll have the chance to go up to the second floor of this famous iron landmark (tickets included). Afterwards, we'll enjoy a relaxing **boat cruise along the Seine**, which will last approximately one hour and fifteen minutes. You'll have a free afternoon to explore the city at your own pace, **back to hotel on own by taking Uber**.

Note: If wait times at the Eiffel Tower are too long, we might reschedule the visit to a different time (or on Sunday) for your convenience.

DAY 4 : PARIS - BURGUNDY - BEAUNE - LYON



- Stop will be Beaune, a charming town in the center of Burgundy
- Arrival at Lyon, the former capital of Roman Gaul
- Cable car up to Notre-Dame de Fourvière

Today, we'll journey to the heart of **France**, passing through the **Bourgogne** region, renowned for its picturesque vineyards and world-class wines. Our first stop will be **Beaune**, a charming town in the center of Burgundy known for its flower-filled streets, hospice, and wine museum. After some free time for lunch and a walk, we'll continue to **Lyon, the former capital of Roman Gaul**, located on the banks of the Rhône River. Lyon's historic center is a UNESCO World Heritage site. We'll take a **cable car up to Notre-Dame de Fourvière**, where we can enjoy a stunning view of the city. You'll have some free time to explore at your leisure.

NOTE : The group may choose to stay in Chambéry, a city near Lyon, for an overnight stay in the evening. The following morning, they will visit the medieval-style capital de la Savoie, known for its historic center and impressive castle.





DAY 5 : LYON - GENEVA - ZURICH

- Arrival in Geneva: Palace of Nations, English Garden, and Jet d'Eau (photostop)
- Continue journey through scenic routes by Lake Geneva and Lake Neuchâtel
- Drive along Three Lakes region, enjoying vineyard views.
- Stop in Neuchâtel for lake walk

Today, we'll travel to **Switzerland**. Upon arrival in **Geneva**, we'll pass by the Palace of Nations (the European headquarters of the United Nations) and explore the pretty English Garden with its flower clock and admire the Jet d'Eau, the tallest fountain in Europe. After lunch, we'll continue our journey through Switzerland, traveling along the scenic routes by **Lake Geneva** and **Lake Neuchâtel**. We'll drive along the Three Lakes region, enjoying views of magnificent vineyards set against the mountain backdrop. We'll stop in **Neuchâtel**, where you can enjoy a walk by the lake, explore the historic town center, or visit the beautiful 10th-century castle. Our journey will conclude in **Zurich**, where we'll arrive in the late afternoon.

Note: Depending on the number of passengers traveling from Geneva to Zurich, this part of the trip may be done by local train, in which case there will be no stop in Neuchâtel.



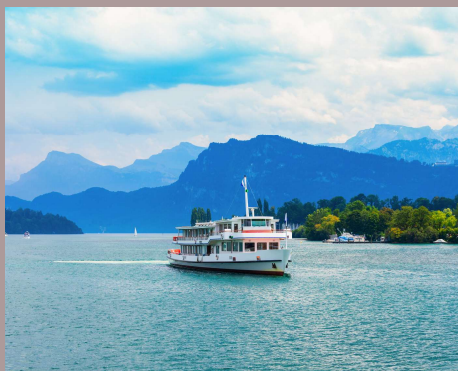
DAY 6 : ZURICH

B

- Enjoy a scenic cruise on Lake Zurich, stopping at charming villages
- Disembark in Rapperswil, renowned for its medieval castle
- Return to Zurich via local train, showcasing Swiss railway system's efficiency and punctuality

With our guide, we'll explore **Zurich**, the most populous city in **Switzerland**, and its financial and cultural heart. Known for its banks, Zurich has been twice recognized as the city with the best quality of life in the world. Afterwards, we'll embark on a scenic **cruise** of nearly two hours on **Lake Zurich**, with brief stops to enjoy the charming villages along the route. We'll disembark in **Rapperswil**, a picturesque village renowned for its medieval castle. We'll return to Zurich by **train**, providing an opportunity to experience the efficiency and punctuality of the Swiss railway system.

Note: Depending on the number of travelers, transfers to and from the city center may be via local transport.



DAY 7 : ZURICH - LUCERNE - ZURICH

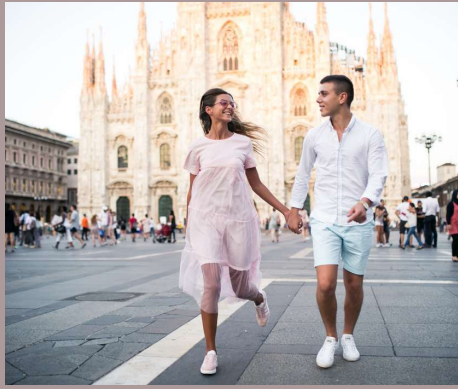

- Visits Grindelwald First cliff by Cable car included
- Walks along winding path to suspended bridge for glacier views
- Includes lunch on the mountain before returning
- Explores charming cityscape of Lucerne
- Returns to Zurich

Today's journey features stunning landscapes with tall mountains and pristine lakes. We'll enjoy breathtaking scenery in the **Interlaken** region. Our first stop will be **Grindelwald**, where we'll have time for a coffee before taking the cable car up the mountain. Once there, we'll walk along a winding path leading to a suspended bridge. For those who are adventurous, crossing the bridge offers spectacular views of the surrounding glaciers. We'll have **lunch on the mountain** (included) before heading back down. Our next destination is **Lucerne**, one of Switzerland's most beautiful cities, where you'll have time to explore and enjoy the charming cityscape. We'll then return to **Zurich**.

Note: The guide will offer an optional full-day excursion, starting in the morning. After some free time in Lucerne, we'll take a rotating cable car to the summit of Mount Titlis. At over 3,000 meters above sea level, the alpine summit offers breathtaking views of the glacier and the Alps.





DAY 8 : ZURICH - BELLINZONA - COMO - MILAN



- Crosses the Alps to reach the Italian-speaking part of Switzerland
- Bellinzona: known for UNESCO-listed medieval castles (Photostop)
- Free time to explore Bellinzona's charming center
- Milan: Visit the impressive Piazza del Duomo (photo stop)
- Free time to explore Milan before hotel transfer

We'll leave **Zurich** early in the morning, crossing the Alps to reach the Italian-speaking part of Switzerland. Our first stop will be **Bellinzona**, renowned for its three medieval castles, which are UNESCO World Heritage Sites. Perched on the hills overlooking the city, these castles highlight Bellinzona's historical significance as a key alpine stronghold. Enjoy some free time to wander through the charming streets of the center. Next, we'll enter Italy and stop in the charming town of **Como** for lunch. This town is considered the jewel of **Lombardy**, known for its beautiful gardens beside the lake and its spectacular cathedral.

We'll continue to **Milan**, where our guide will take us to the impressive Piazza del Duomo. You'll have some time to wander around before we transfer you to the hotel.



DAY 9 : MILAN - PISA - ROME



- Ride a small tourist train to the Piazza dei Miracoli (Square of Miracles)
- Admire the Leaning Tower of Pisa (photostop) and the beautiful art complex

Today, we'll continue our journey to **Pisa**. We'll ride a small **tourist train** to the Piazza dei Miracoli (Square of Miracles), where you'll have time to admire one of the most captivating and beautiful art complexes in **Italy**, including the famous Leaning Tower of Pisa. Afterwards, we'll head to **Rome**, arriving later in the day.

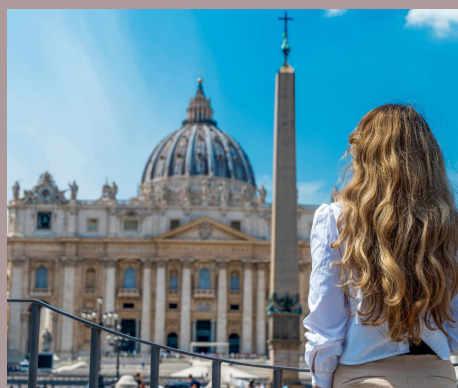
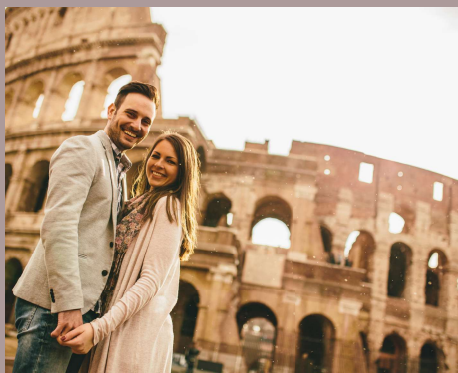


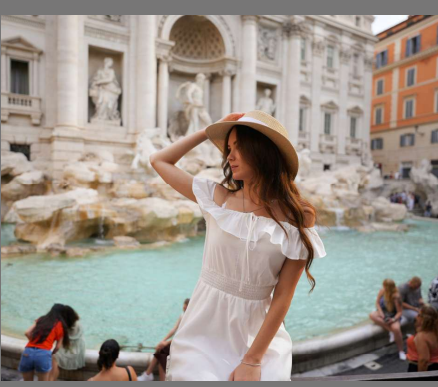
DAY 10 : ROME



- Morning Bus City tour of Eternal City
- See Arch of Constantine, Colosseum (from the outside), Imperial Forums, Circus
- Maximus, Baths of Caracalla, Basilica of Saint Mary Major, Pyramid of Cestius, and Castel Sant' Angelo (Photo Stop)
- Optional visit to Vatican Museums and Sistine Chapel
- Evening transfer to Trastevere neighborhood for dinner and leisure

In the morning, we'll take a **three-hour guided tour** of the Eternal City, combining a walking tour through Imperial Rome with a panoramic bus ride to admire one of the oldest and most influential cities in Western civilization. During the tour, we'll see iconic landmarks such as the Arch of Constantine, the exterior of the Colosseum (**from the outside**) and the Imperial Forums, the Circus Maximus, the Baths of Caracalla, the Basilica of Saint Mary Major, the Pyramid of Cestius, and Castel Sant'Angelo. The tour will end at **VATICAN CITY** around 11:00 a.m. Afterward, our guide will offer an optional visit to explore the Vatican Museums and the Sistine Chapel. At the end of the day we'll include a **transfer to the popular Trastevere neighborhood**, known for its Cozy restaurants and lively atmosphere. Return to the hotel will be around 8:30 p.m





DAY 11 : ROME - FLORENCE

B

- Visit Piazzale Michelangelo for panoramic views of Florence
- Guided walking tour with a local expert through Florence's historic center
- Visit landmarks: Ponte Vecchio, the Duomo, and Piazza della Signoria (Photoshop)
- Free time to explore Florence at your leisure back to hotel in evening

Today, we'll leave Rome and head north, taking in the beautiful landscapes along the way. Upon reaching **Florence**, we'll go directly to the stunning Piazzale Michelangelo for breathtaking views of the city. In the evening, we'll enjoy a **guided walking tour** with a local expert through the historic center, visiting landmarks such as the Ponte Vecchio, the Duomo, and Piazza della Signoria. This city is like an open-air museum. Afterward, you'll have some free time to explore at your leisure. In the evening, you'll have plenty of options for dinner, as this district offers many restaurants with a variety of international cuisines.

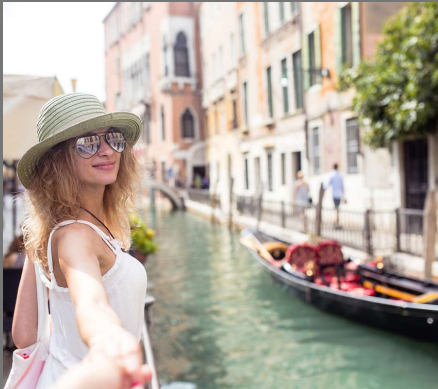


DAY 12 : FLORENCE - VENICE

- Free time to explore Venice (Gondola Optional Eur40/PAX) back to hotel

Today, we'll enjoy the stunning mountain landscapes as we cross the Apennines. Upon arriving in **Venice**, we'll take a **boat across the Giudecca Canal** to the Island of Venice. With a local guide, we'll visit the marvelous St. Mark's Square. Afterwards, we'll tour the Murano Glass Factory, where you'll see the fascinating techniques used to create this ancient glass. You'll have some free time to explore on your own. Accommodation will be in the Mestre district.
