



7D6N AMAZING VIETNAM

DAY 1: ✈️ HANOI ARRIVAL - EXPLORE HANOI

(L/DINNER)

The tour guide will welcome guests at Noi Bai International Airport then transfer to the city and check in to the hotel (standard check-in time from 2.00 PM onwards). We will take off from the hotel for **Hanoi City tour attractions covering Tran Quoc Pagoda, Ba Dinh Square, President Palace, Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum, One-Pillar Pagoda, Hanoi Old City Gate, Hoan Kiem Lake, The Huc Bridge, St. Josephs Cathedral, Hanoi Opera House and Hanoi Old Quarter ~ The 36 Ancient Streets.** After dinner, return to the hotel then the tour program, tour guide, and transport service conclude. **Hanoi Old Quarters also known as The 36 Ancient Streets is the top special historical vestige and sight-seeing of the capital, the represented eternal soul of the city.** Our choice of hotels is located in the vibrant Hanoi Old Quarters and you may explore and sample varieties of local street foods like Pho - the national soup noodle dish, Banh Mi - the French-influenced baguette the Vietnam coffee, also many shopping streets for souvenirs, and the famous pub street.

DAY 2: HANOI - HALONG BAY

(B/LUNCH)

The program coordinator from **La Pandora Cruise** will meet the guests at the hotel lobby at approximately 7:30 AM and transfer them from Hanoi to **Tuan Chau Marina Harbour** via the Hai Phong expressway. The total distance covered is about 150 KM and the trip takes around 2.5 hours. La Pandora Cruise operator offers a seat-in-coach sharing transfer service from Hanoi City Hotel to Tuan Chau Marina Harbour.

Please note that a private transfer service is not available on this route. La Pandora Cruise Operator will self-operate the 02D/01N tour program in **Halong Bay.** The tour guide from Hanoi City will not escort the guests for the Halong Bay trip. Upon reaching the La Pandora Cruise check-in counter, the cruise manager will welcome the guests to embark on board the cruises dining deck. Later, there will be a briefing about the cabin crew, cruise facility, safety equipment, tour programs, and activities for the day. The cruise will start cruising to the famous Lan Ha Bay - Halong Bay where guests will be amazed by the limestone karst formations rising out of the sea impressively. While cruising through **Con Vit islet (Duck Islet), Thumb islet, and Gia Luan Harbour,** guests can enjoy a lunch serving and pass by **Lan Ha Bay and Da Chong isle,** where they can see a lighthouse built by the French 100 years ago. All guests can enjoy swimming and kayaking activities at **Ba Trai Dao (Three Peaches) beach,** which is a secluded sea. As not many cruise ships use the route, guests can have a peaceful time. The cruise will continue to anchor at the Tra Bau area, where guests can continue swimming or just relax on the cruise sun deck. The chef on board will conduct cooking classes, and guests can participate and learn how to make Vietnam Spring Roll. In the evening, guests can enjoy the dinner buffet menu, and later, they can go squid fishing with the cabin crew or relax on the sun deck to view the blanket of stars at night.

DAY 3: LA PANDORA CRUISE - HANOI

(B/LUNCH)

Guests may join Tai Chi Class starts from 0615-0645 AM. Breakfast will serve while continuing cruising to visit **the Dark & Bright Cave** and islets also may enjoy self-kayaking or take a sampan boat paddle by the local villager to explore the local village and the magnificent view of the bay. Enjoy brunch served on board the cruise, and later return to Tuan Chau Marina Harbour for a seat-in-coach sharing type transfer service return to Hanoi, and the tour programs and transport services conclude.



DAY 4: HA NOI ✈️ HO CHI MINH

(DINNER)

Upon arrival at **Tan Son Nhat International Airport** in Ho Chi Minh City, a tour guide will be waiting to welcome you. You will then be transferred to your hotel where you can check-in, relax, and freshen up. At approximately 4:00 PM, we will begin our tour by visiting some local landmarks such as the **Saigon Central Post Office and Notre Dame Cathedral**. Afterward, we will head to a restaurant for dinner and continue with a scenic night-view tour of Ho Chi Minh City. This tour will include some more notable attractions like the Peoples Committee Hall, the **Opera House, Nguyen Hue Walking Street, and the Bach Dang Wharf Park**. Finally, we will transfer you back to your hotel where the tour programs, transport, and tour guide services will end.



DAY 5: HO CHI MINH - CU CHI TUNNELS - SAIGON

(B/L/D)

Today, we'll be departing early to visit the **Cu Chi Tunnels** - a massive network of interconnected tunnels located in the Cu Chi District, which is approximately 55 km or 90 minutes drive from the city center. Upon arrival, our local tour guide will take us on a journey to explore the vast underground tunnels, which were initially built in the 1940s and later expanded by guerrilla Viet Cong forces during the American War. We'll get to see firsthand some of the tunnels that remain unchanged and witness plenty of evidence of the fierce battles that took place here. After the tour, we'll head back to the city center for lunch in a local restaurant. Following that, we'll visit the **War Remnants Museum, Independence Palace, Vincom Center Landmark 81**, and then enjoy dinner in another local restaurant. The tour will conclude after dinner, and we'll return to the hotel.



DAY 6: HO CHI MINH - MYTHO @ MEKONG DELTA

(B/L/D)

Today, we will depart early to **MyTho at the Mekong Delta**, approximately 70 KM southwest of Ho Chi Minh City. The driving duration may take 2 hours, and we will pass by beautiful rice fields on the way. Upon arrival at MyTho tourists' jetty, we will take a boat ride to **Thoisson Island** to sample seasonal tropical fruits fresh from the orchards, taste Vietnamese tea mixed with honey, watch local villagers perform traditional folk songs, experience a sampan boat ride under the shadow of the sea coconut palms, and later enjoy an authentic Mekong Delta cuisine for lunch at a local restaurant. Next, we will return to the main boat and continue the boat ride to **Ben Tre village** to visit local home industries and watch the process of producing coconut candies and rice paper for Vietnamese rolls. Upon the tours completion, we will transfer the guests back to Ho Chi Minh City. We will drop off the guests at Takashimaya, an airy, posh shopping center with designer boutiques, gourmet eateries & a glamorous vibe. Finally, enjoy dinner in a local restaurant, and after dinner, return to the hotel. Tour programs, transport, and tour guide services end here.



DAY 7: HO CHI MINH DEPARTURE

(BREAKFAST)

Breakfast at the hotel and free at leisure until transfer to Tan Son Nhat International Airport for flight back home.
