Day 1 : Arrival Siem Reap - City Tour

Upon your arrival at Siem Reap Airport, you will be warmly welcomed by our guide and driver, who will take you to visit the **War Museum** Cambodia. This museum serves as a solemn reminder of Cambodia's civil war history, preserving its unique collection for future generations. Next, in the heart of the city, you will witness hundreds of visitors streaming in and out of a small alcove, where the stately brass and bronze statues of **Preah Ang Chek** and **Ang Chom stood**, revered for their spiritual significance.

Enjoy dinner at a local restaurant, followed by free time at **Pub Street** (Night Market) to soak in the vibrant nightlife. Overnight in Siem Reap.



Day 2 : Siem Reap - Angkor Thom - Angkor Wat - Ta Prohm

At 08:00 AM, we begin our day exploring the immense walled city of **Angkor Thom**, home to the **Terrace of the Leper King**, **Baphuon**, and the iconic **Bayon Temple**, a masterpiece of King Jayavarman VII. Following the Cham occupation of Angkor from 1177 to 1181, the king built this grand fortress as the heart of his empire. Next, we continue to the temple of **Ta Prohm**, famous for its mystical atmosphere and towering trees entwined with ancient stone this temple was also a filming location for Tomb Raider. As one of the largest temples built during the Khmer Empire, its outer laterite wall stretches an impressive 1,000m by 600m. In the afternoon, we visit the Mother of all temples - **Angkor Wat**. Recognized as the world's largest religious monument, this architectural wonder is a perfect fusion of symbolism and symmetry, serving as a source of pride and strength for all Khmers. Finally, we end the day with a breathtaking sunset view from **Bakheng Mountain**. Enjoy lunch at a local restaurant, followed by dinner at a local restaurant, and conclude the day with an overnight stay in Siem Reap.

(Note: Due to new regulations, only 300 visitors are allowed to ascend Bakheng Hill at a time, so we must arrive by 4:00 PM.)



Day 3 : Siem Reap - City Tour - Boat Trip

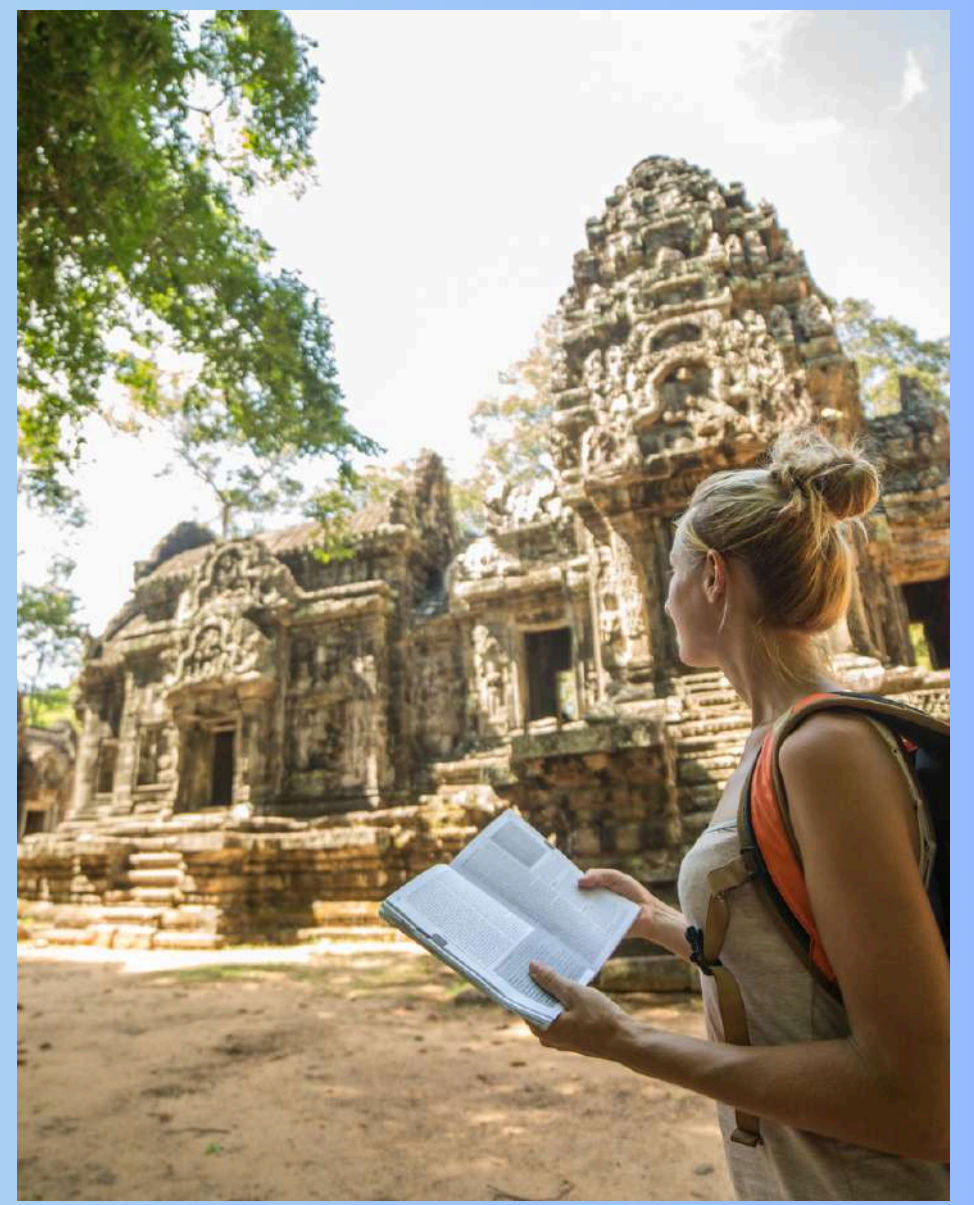
At 08:30 AM, we start the day by visiting the 19th-century temple of **Wat Bo**, one of Siem Reap's most important pagodas. Then, enjoy shopping around the **Old Market** before heading to the **Western Baray**, the largest reservoir built during the Khmer Empire, stretching 8km in length and 2km in width. This impressive water system helped the ancient Khmers manage seasonal water cycles. In the afternoon, visit the **Floating Village (Tonle Sap)**, a vast body of water fed by the Mekong and Tonle Sap River, making it Cambodia's most significant topographical feature. After that, explore the Chantiers Ecole workshop of **Artisans d'Angkor**, a handicrafts cooperative dedicated to reviving the artisan skills of the Angkor era. Enjoy lunch at a local restaurant, followed by a buffet dinner at a local restaurant with a Cultural Apsara Dance Show. Overnight in Siem Reap.
