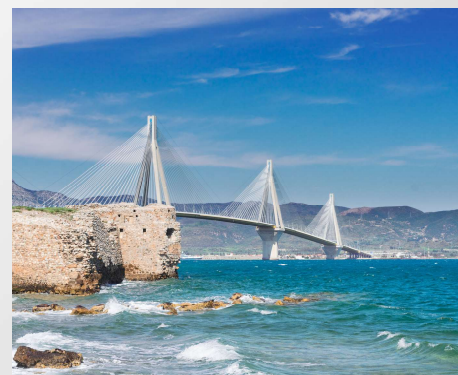
DAY 3 : ATHENS



B

- Discover Athens' iconic landmarks, from the Acropolis and historic sites to modern Olympic legacies. (admission not included)
- enjoy the lively charm of Plaka with its Greek tavernas and rich folklore.

We'll embark on a **city tour of Athens** with a local guide, visiting landmarks such as the Presidential Mansion, the Panathenaic Stadium where the first modern Olympic Games were held, the National Library, and the bustling squares of the city center. We'll also explore the newer neighborhoods that developed after the 2004 Olympic Games. The tour will conclude at the Acropolis (admission not included). In the evening, we'll provide a **transfer to the historical neighborhood of Plaka**, renowned for its charming Greek tavernas and opportunities to immerse yourself in the rich folklore of this country.



DAY 4 : ATHENS - TRIPOLI- OLYMPIA - PATRAS



B/D

- Explore Greece's rich history admire the Corinth Channel.
- Visit Olympia's ancient ruins including the Temple of Zeus.
- Experience the lively port city of Patras with its grand cathedral and medieval fortress.

We travel to the Peloponnese region. We make a brief stop next to the Corinth Channel, an impressive work of art from the end of the nineteenth century. We continue through the mountains towards **Tripoli**, capital of the Arcadia region. Stop in this active city and time for a stroll around the area of the Plaza Areos with its cafes and restaurants. We continue our route to **Olympia** where we will visit the **Archaeological Site** (entrance and visit with a local guide included). The first Olympic Games were held here in 776 B.C., where athletes from all over Greece and its colonies participated. Highlights include the Temple of Zeus, the stadium, the gymnasium, and the arena. We continue to **Patras**, the third most populous city in Greece, a lively port city with a remarkable medieval fortress. Its cathedral is the largest church in Greece and next to it, the small church of St. Andrew is a place of pilgrimage. **Dinner included.**

DAY 5 : PATRAS - IGOUMENITSA - IGUMENTSA BRINDISI FERRY - BRINDISI



B

- Journey through Greece and Italy cross the stunning Rio-Antirrio Bridge.
- Explore the port town of Igoumenitsa.
- Enjoy a scenic ferry ride across the Ionian Sea to Brindisi, Italy.

After breakfast, we'll cross the Rio-Antirrio Bridge, a spectacular suspension bridge that connects the Peloponnese with the Greek mainland. We'll travel through the regions of Central Greece and Epirus. Upon arrival in **Igoumenitsa**, a port town, there will be time for a stroll before boarding the modern **ferry** at 02:00 p.m. to sail across the Ionian Sea to **Italy**. We'll reach **Brindisi** by the end of the day, around 09:00 p.m., where we'll spend the night.



DAY 6 : BRINDISI - ALBEROBELLO - MATERA - NAPLES

B/L

- Discover Alberobello's iconic trulli houses.
- Explore Matera's ancient "Sassi" cave dwellings.
- Enjoy scenic drives through Basilicata and Campania.

Today, we'll visit two extraordinary and authentic towns. Our first stop will be **Alberobello**, famous for its unique conical-shaped houses known as trulli. These distinctive structures, with their stacked stone roofs, are a UNESCO World Heritage Site and represent a remarkable example of Italian rural architecture. Next, we'll head to **Matera**, located in the Basilicata region, renowned for its ancient historic center and the Sassi di Matera—a complex of ancient dwellings and buildings carved into the rock, dating back thousands of years. Not only is it a World Heritage Site, but also one of the oldest continuously inhabited human settlements in the world. In the afternoon, after enjoying an **included lunch in Matera**, we'll continue our journey through Basilicata and Campania, taking in the beautiful mountain landscapes. We'll arrive in **Naples** by evening, where you'll have free time to explore.



DAY 7 : NAPLES - CAPRI - SORRENTO - SALERNO

B

- Experience coastal charm: sail to Capri to explore its natural wonders or vibrant city.
- Enjoy free time in picturesque Sorrento.
- End the day in the scenic Gulf of Salerno, staying in the city of Salerno.

After breakfast, we'll head to the port in **Naples** to board a boat to the **Island of Capri**, where you can choose to take a boat to Grotta Bianca or the funicular to Capri city. After lunch, we'll reboard and head to **Sorrento**, a charming tourist town nestled at the base of a cliff, where you'll have free time to wander. Our journey will then take us to the Gulf of Salerno, where we'll stay in the city of **Salerno**.



DAY 8 : SALERNO - PAOLA - MESINA - TAORMINA

B/D

- Travel south through scenic Cilento National Park.
- Visit Paola's St. Francis of Paola sanctuary.
- Cross to Sicily from Villa San Giovanni.
- Explore Messina, visit the cathedral, head to Taormina.

We'll journey to the south of the boot, marveling at the stunning southern Italian scenery as we cross the Cilento National Park. We'll arrive in **Paola**, located on the shores of the Tyrrhenian Sea, where we'll visit the **Sanctuary of St. Francis of Paola** and enjoy free time for lunch in its charming historic center. Our adventure will then take us to **Villa San Giovanni**, where we'll board a **short ferry crossing** to the island of **Sicily**. Upon arrival in **Messina**, we'll have time to stroll around the cathedral. Finally, we'll continue to **Taormina**. **Dinner will be included.**

Note: Accommodation will normally be in the Taormina region, but on certain dates, lodging may be provided in Messina.

DAY 9 : TAORMINA

B/D

- Explore Taormina, dubbed the "prettiest place on earth" by Churchill

At the foot of Mount Etna lies the enchanting city of **Taormina**, once described by Churchill as the most beautiful place on earth. You'll have time to explore the lively historic quarter, with its Greek theater dominating the mesmerizing landscape. You can also relax on the beach. **Dinner will be included.**



DAY 10 : TAORMINA - CATANIA - VILLA ROMANA DEL CASALE - B/D AGRIENTO

- Explore Catania's baroque charm, Caltagirone's iconic Sicilian ceramics with a tourist train ride, and the awe-inspiring Roman mosaics at Villa Romana del Casale.
- Conclude with scenic views of Agrigento's Valley of the Temples. Dinner included.

We'll travel to **Catania**, a city founded by the Greeks, which, despite the destruction caused by volcanic eruptions, still boasts a beautiful baroque center. Next, we'll head to the heart of the island to visit **Caltagirone**, a UNESCO World Heritage city. You'll enjoy a ride on the **tourist train** and have time to stroll through the streets and admire its famous Sicilian ceramics. After lunch, we'll continue to the impressive **Villa Romana del Casale** (admission included), renowned for its remarkably well-preserved Roman mosaics, considered some of the most beautiful in the world. We'll then proceed to **Agrigento**, where, before heading to the hotel, we'll enjoy views of the magnificent Valley of the Temples from the comfort of our coach. **Dinner will be included.**

DAY 11 : AGRIENTO - MARSALA - ERICE - PALERMO B/D

- Explore the Valley of the Temples, enjoy Marsala's wine and charm, admire the scenic salt pans.
- Stroll through Erice before reaching Palermo for dinner.

We'll visit the **Valley of the Temples** with a **local guide**, an impressive archaeological site known as the most complete complex of Greek temples (admission included). Then, we'll travel to **Marsala**, a historic city renowned for its vibrant atmosphere and famous wine, where we'll have time for lunch. Our journey will continue around the scenic Marsala salt pans to **Erice**, a charming Phoenician town overlooking the sea, perfect for a leisurely stroll. Finally, we'll head to **Palermo**. **Dinner will be included.**

DAY 12 : PALERMO - MONREALE - PALERMO - NAPLES FERRY B

- Visit Monreale's stunning Arab-Norman cathedral.
- Explore Palermo's historic sites like the Cathedral and Norman Palace.
- Enjoy free time, and board a night ferry with comfortable cabin accommodations.

After breakfast, we'll explore **Palermo**, starting with a transfer to the picturesque village of **Monreale**, now on the outskirts of the city. We'll visit the breathtaking **Arab-Norman cathedral**, a World Heritage Site famed for its magnificent golden mosaics (tickets included). **Palermo** is a city rich in contrasts, reflecting the history of Arabs, Normans, and Baroque splendor. Key sights include the **Cathedral** (tickets included) and the Norman Palace, featuring the exquisite Palatine Chapel. After our tour, we'll enjoy some free time. Later in the afternoon, we'll board a modern **night ferry**. Accommodation will be in double cabins with en suite bathrooms.



DAY 13 : PALERMO - NAPLES FERRY - NAPLES - POMPEII - ROME

 B

- Explore the ancient ruins of Pompeii with a guided tour.
- Stroll through Naples' historic UNESCO-listed center.
- Conclude the day with an evening arrival in Rome.

We'll arrive in Naples early in the morning (**breakfast not included**) and continue to **Pompeii**, where we'll admire the remains of this ancient Roman city, buried under the ashes of Mount Vesuvius. A **local guide** will accompany us (**tickets and tour are included**). Afterward, we'll explore **Naples**, one of the most fascinating cities in **Italy** and among the oldest populated places in Europe. The historic center of Naples, one of the largest in Europe, is a UNESCO World Heritage Site. There will be time for a stroll and lunch. We'll conclude our day with an arrival in **Rome**.



DAY 14 : ROME ✈️ KUALA LUMPUR

After breakfast, check-out as per hotel standard policy then free at own leisure till transfer to airport for flight back to Malaysia.

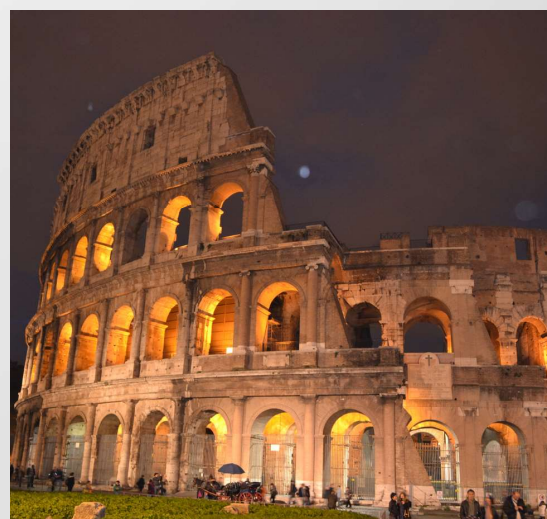
DAY 15 : ARRIVE KUALA LUMPUR
