## 17D15N INCREDIBLE EUROPE (ITALY/AUSTRIA/SWITZERLAND/France/ENGLAND/NETHERLANDS/GERMANY)

### DAY 1 : CHECK IN /DEPART KLIA ✈️ ROME

Welcome to **Rome**! Upon your arrival, we'll be there to **transfer** you to your hotel. In the evening, we'll take you to **Via Cavour district**, an excellent introduction to Rome. Here, you'll find a variety of restaurants offering Italian, Indian, Chinese, and international cuisine.

### DAY 2 : ROME CITY TOUR & EVENING IN TRASTEVERE



- Discover Rome's timeless charm with a panoramic and walking tour showcasing iconic sites like the Colosseum. (Photo stops)
- Photo stop at Imperial Forums, and Vatican City. Lunch at Vatican square area on own
- Optional: Entrance to Vatican, Sistine Chapel EUR70/pax & follow by Rome Old City walking tour EUR40/pax.
- Afternoon free at own leisure or join optional, those pax not joining the optional please make your way to Trastevere area in evening to meet the group again, enjoying its quaint streets, vibrant trattorias to have dinner on own. Back to hotel with guide.

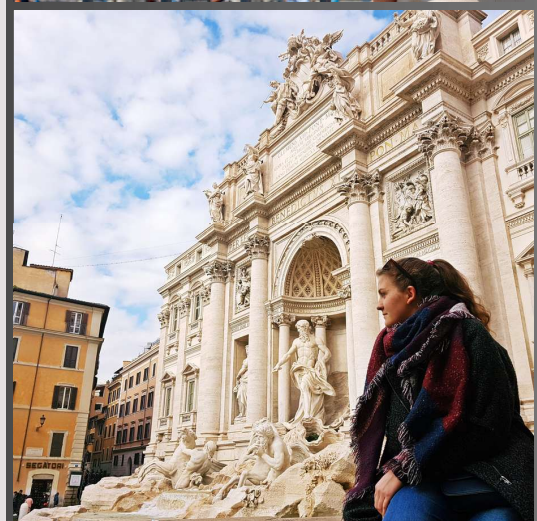
In the morning, we'll take a **three-hour guided tour** of the Eternal City, combining a walking tour through Imperial Rome with a panoramic bus ride to admire one of the oldest and most influential cities in Western civilization. During the tour, we'll see iconic landmarks such as the Arch of Constantine, the exterior of the Colosseum and the Imperial Forums, the Circus Maximus, the Baths of Caracalla, the Basilica of Saint Mary Major, the Pyramid of Cestius, and Castel Sant'Angelo. The tour will end at **Vatican City** around 11:00 a.m. Afterward, our guide will offer an optional visit to explore the Vatican Museums and the Sistine Chapel. At the end of the day, make your way **to the popular Trastevere neighborhood**, known for its cozy restaurants and lively atmosphere. Return to the hotel will be around 8:30 p.m.

### DAY 3 : ROME - FLORENCE



- Journey to Florence, admire city views from Piazzale Michelangelo.
- Explore landmarks like Ponte Vecchio, the Duomo, and Piazza della Signoria on a guided tour (Photostops), Free in afternoon in City center. Lunch & Dinner in Florence City center area on own before returning to hotel with group

Today, we'll leave Rome and head north, taking in the beautiful landscapes along the way. Upon reaching **Florence**, we'll go directly to the stunning Piazzale Michelangelo for breathtaking views of the city. In the evening, we'll enjoy a **guided walking tour** with a local expert through the historic center, visiting landmarks (photostops) such as the Ponte Vecchio, the Duomo, and Piazza della Signoria. This city is like an open-air museum. Afterward, you'll have some free time to explore at your leisure. In the evening, you'll have plenty of options for dinner, as this district offers many restaurants with a variety of international cuisines.





#### DAY 4 : FLORENCE - VENICE

- Travel through the scenic Apennines to Venice, Water taxi to Venice Island
- Visit St. Mark's Square and tour the Murano Glass Factory
- Enjoy your free time exploring the island, with accommodation in Mestre

Today, we'll enjoy the stunning mountain landscapes as we cross the Apennines. Upon arriving in **Venice**, we'll take a **boat across the Giudecca Canal** to the Island of Venice. With a local guide, we'll visit the marvelous St. Mark's Square. Afterwards, we'll tour the Murano Glass Factory, where you'll see the fascinating techniques used to create this ancient glass. You'll have some free time to explore on your own. Accommodation will be in the Mestre district. **Gondola ride optional EUR40/pax**

#### DAY 5 : VENICE - INNSBRUCK - ZURICH

🏠 B

- Journey from Venice to Zurich with beautiful Austrian Alps and amazing scenery along the way, with stops to explore Innsbruck's historic center and admire the scenic Tyrolean landscapes

We'll depart Venice and make our way to **Austria**. Upon arriving in **Innsbruck**, you'll have time to explore the historic town center and enjoy lunch. Afterward, we'll continue our journey through the beautiful Tyrolean landscapes as we cross into Switzerland, arriving in **Zurich**.

#### DAY 6 : ZURICH - LUCERNE - ZURICH

- Explore the stunning Interlaken region, take a cable car to Grindelwald's suspended bridge for breathtaking glacier views, enjoy lunch on the mountain.
- Visit the charming city of Lucerne before returning to Zurich.

Today's journey features stunning landscapes with tall mountains and pristine lakes. We'll enjoy breathtaking scenery in the **Interlaken** region. Our first stop will be **Grindelwald**, where we'll have time for a coffee before taking the cable car up the mountain. Once there, we'll walk along a winding path leading to a suspended bridge. For those who are adventurous, crossing the bridge offers spectacular views of the surrounding glaciers. We'll have **lunch on the mountain (included)** before heading back down. Our next destination is **Lucerne**, one of Switzerland's most beautiful cities, where you'll have time to explore and enjoy the charming cityscape. We'll then return to **Zurich**.

**Note:** The guide will offer an optional full-day excursion, starting in the morning. After some free time in Lucerne, we'll take a rotating cable car to the summit of Mount Titlis. At over 3,000 meters above sea level, the alpine summit offers breathtaking views of the glacier and the Alps.

#### DAY 7 : ZURICH - STRASBOURG - PARIS

🏠 B

- Travel from Zurich to Strasbourg, the charming Alsace capital blending French and German influences, before continuing to Paris in the evening.

We'll depart from Zurich and travel to the French region of Alsace, where we'll visit its capital, **Strasbourg**—a charming city that beautifully blends French and German influences. You'll have time to explore and get to know the city. Afterward, we'll continue our journey to **Paris**, arriving in the evening.

#### DAY 8 : PARIS

🏠 B

- Visit Palace of Versailles and its stunning gardens
- Montmartre, will take us up to this charming bohemian neighborhood, famous for its artists, painters, and cabarets.
- Enjoy a panoramic Paris city tour, (Photo stop) passing iconic monuments, before returning to the hotel.

We'll immerse ourselves in the rich history of **France** at the magnificent Palace of Versailles (admission not included), renowned for its stunning gardens. On our return to **Paris**, we'll visit Montmartre, will take us up to this charming bohemian neighborhood, famous for its artists, painters, and cabarets. To fully appreciate the grandeur of Paris, we'll embark on a **panoramic city tour** with a local guide, showcasing the city's impressive avenues and iconic monuments. Afterward, we'll return to the hotel. For those interested, there is an optional variety show in the evening.



## DAY 09 : PARIS - ROUEN

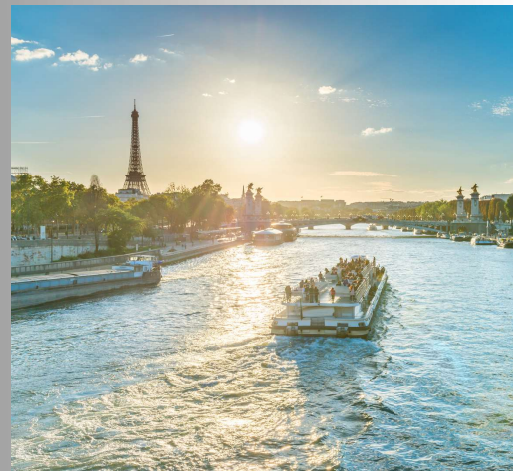


- Visit the Eiffel Tower and enjoy views from the second floor, followed by a relaxing 2hrs+ boat cruise on the Seine River
- Explore Paris at your own pace before heading to Rouen in Normandy to discover its historic center, medieval architecture, and Gothic cathedral.

We'll start our day in central **Paris**, beginning with a visit to the iconic **Eiffel Tower**. You'll have the chance to go up to the second floor of this famous iron landmark (tickets included). Afterwards, we'll enjoy a relaxing **boat cruise along the Seine**. You'll have a free afternoon to explore the city at your own pace.

Around 4:00 p.m., we'll depart Paris and head to **Normandy**, arriving in **Rouen**. You'll have free time to explore the historic center of this vibrant city, which dates back to Roman times and boasts charming medieval architecture and an impressive Gothic cathedral, offering a delightful blend of history and culture.

**Note:** If wait times at the Eiffel Tower are too long, we might reschedule the visit to a different time (or on Sunday) for your convenience.



## DAY 10 : ROUEN - ENGLISH CHANNEL - CANTERBURY - LONDON



- Stroll through the historic center of Rouen, then cross the English Channel to Canterbury, known for its charming historic center
- Continue to London and enjoy free time near the iconic Tower Bridge before heading to the hotel

Today, we'll have time to take a stroll through the center of **Rouen**. After this, we'll travel to northern **France**. Crossing the English Channel by **ferry**, we'll reach **Canterbury**, the religious capital of England, known for its charming historic center. Our journey will continue to **London**, where you'll have some free time in the **Tower Bridge** area, one of the city's most iconic symbols, before we head to the hotel.



## DAY 11 : LONDON



- Explore London with a panoramic tour featuring landmarks like Parliament, the River Thames, and Buckingham Palace. (Photo stops), free in afternoon or join optional tour. In the evening, stroll through vibrant areas like Leicester Square, Chinatown, and Soho, known for their lively atmosphere, theaters.

Discover **London** on a **panoramic tour** with a local guide that showcases the city's culture and history. You'll see famous sites such as the Parliament, the River Thames, and Buckingham Palace, where you might witness the iconic Changing of the Guard (depending on the dates). In the evening, we'll establish a meeting point in Piccadilly to take a stroll through Leicester Square, Chinatown, and Soho, areas renowned for their lively atmosphere, theaters, and entertainment options. You'll have plenty of restaurants to choose from for dinner before we return to the hotel.



## DAY 12 : LONDON - COLCHESTER - FERRY COLCHESTER VOLENDAM



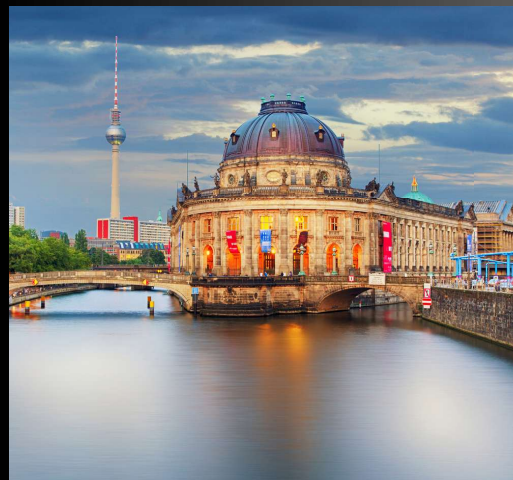
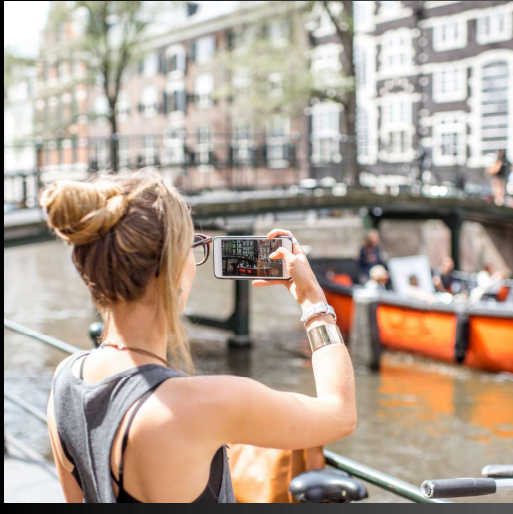
- Visit the British Museum
- Explore the vibrant Camden Market
- Stroll through historic Colchester before boarding an overnight ferry to the Netherlands (Cruise type cabin with washroom)

In the morning, we'll visit the **British Museum**, one of the world's oldest museums, where we'll see traces of cultures from all around the world. At lunchtime, after some free time, we'll head to **Camden**, a district renowned for its vibrant and eclectic street market. There, you can explore unique items and artifacts from around the globe and enjoy lunch at one of its little restaurants or food stands.

Around 4:00 p.m., we'll depart for **Colchester**, the oldest recorded town in England, and enjoy a leisurely stroll through its historic streets. We'll then continue to Harwich to board the ferry for an **overnight voyage** to the Netherlands, staying in en suite cabins.

**Important note:** Due to the limited number of cabins available on the ferry, the itinerary may be adjusted. We might travel from London to Amsterdam via a daytime ferry, with an overnight stay in Antwerp, or alternatively, take a train or flight to Amsterdam.





## DAY 13 : COLCHESTER - VOLEDAM FERRY - VOLEDAM - AMSTERDAM B

- Arrive in Hoek van Holland, visit the charming fishing village of Volendam.
- Enjoy a panoramic tour of Amsterdam's iconic landmarks. (Photo stop)

Around 8:00 a.m., we'll arrive in **Hoek van Holland** (Hook of Holland) and make a stop in **Volendam**, a picturesque fishing village. Then, we'll travel to **Amsterdam** for a **panoramic tour** of the city, where we'll see its most iconic landmarks. We'll also see the famous diamond-cutting technique. For dinner, we'll provide a **transfer to Rembrandtplein**, a vibrant area filled with restaurants offering cuisine from all over the world, and located near the famous Red Light District, known for its diverse nightlife.

## DAY 14 : AMSTERDAM - HAMELIN - BERLIN B

- Journey from Amsterdam to Berlin with stops in Hamelin, the fairy tale town of the Pied Piper, and Marienborn. (Photo stop)
- Passing through Marienborn, the historic former East-West German border.

We'll depart from **Amsterdam** and head towards **Germany**. Our first stop is **Hamelin**, a picturesque German town with shops and streets reminiscent of the Pied Piper of Hamelin fairy tale by Brothers Grimm. We'll then continue towards **Berlin**, passing through Marienborn, the former border that separated East and West Germany until 1990. We'll arrive in **Berlin** in the evening.

## DAY 15 : BERLIN B

- Explore Berlin's rich history and landmarks, including the **Brandenburg Gate, Reichstag, Holocaust Memorial, and Berlin Wall Museum**.
- Enjoy free time to explore the city at your own space and an evening in the vibrant **Kantstrasse area**.

Immerse yourself in the local culture with a **tour of Berlin**, the incredible capital of **Germany**, accompanied by a local guide. From our coach, you'll have the chance to see the Museum Island, the Television Tower, the city center's main shopping streets, the old cathedral destroyed during World War II, the Brandenburg Gate, the Reichstag, and the city's expansive parks. We'll stop to visit the **Holocaust Memorial** and the **Berlin Wall Memorial Museum**—two powerful landmarks that remind us of Germany's challenging history in the previous century. You'll have the afternoon free to explore the city at your own pace. In the early evening, we'll provide a **transfer to the lively Kantstrasse area**.

## DAY 16 : BERLIN KUALA LUMPUR B

After breakfast, check-out as per hotel standard policy then free at own leisure till transfer to airport for flight back to Malaysia.
