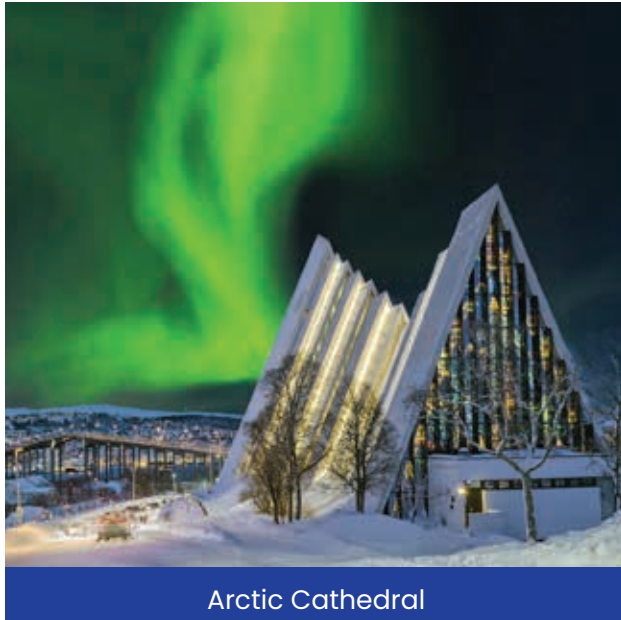

DAY 02

HELSINKI > TROMSØ

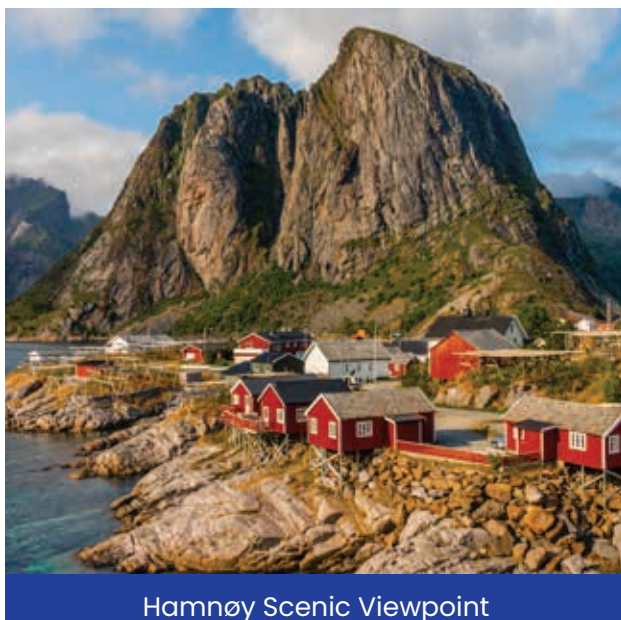

DAY 04

LOFOTEN ISLANDS

Breakfast

- Today, we venture deeper into the heart of the Lofoten Islands, with our first stop at the iconic **Hamnøy Scenic Viewpoint**, one of the most photographed spots in Lofoten. Capture the perfect shot of the picturesque village, frequently featured across the internet.
- Our journey continues to **Reine**, Lofoten's most scenic and photographed fishing village. Nestled between fjords and towering mountains, with a shoreline dotted with charming red and yellow fishermen's cabins, Reine is an absolute must-see for anyone visiting Lofoten.
- A trip to Lofoten is not complete without another photo stop at the iconic **Sakrisøy Yellow House**, which is highly featured in Lonely Planet.
- *Tonight, we will hunt the Northern Lights with a walk together with your Tour Manager.*

DAY 05

LOFOTEN ISLANDS – NARVIK

Breakfast | Dinner

- In the morning, travel to **Henningsvær** – often referred to as the “Venice of Lofoten” for its artistic charm. Surrounded by sharp mountain peaks and crystal-clear waters, this village offers breathtaking views at every turn.
- Next, we travel north past various fjords and scenery to Narvik.
- It is an inlet of the Norwegian Sea located about 200km above the Arctic Circle, yet it remains a year-round ice-free port.
- *Together with your Tour Manager, you may ascend to the hotel bar for a view of the Northern Lights. (For groups staying in Scandic Narvik)*

DAY 06

NARVIK – ABISKO (KIRUNA) – LAPLAND

Breakfast | Dinner

- **[SPECIAL BONUS] Board the Arctic Circle Train to the Abisko region.**
- The train line was initially opened to carry iron ore from Kiruna to Narvik and is widely used by both locals and tourists.
- Departure time varies depending on availability and train schedule.
- Overnight in Lapland.
- *Tonight, we will hunt the Northern Lights with a walk together with your Tour Manager.*

DAY 07

LAPLAND – REINDEER FARM – LAPLAND

Breakfast | Dinner

- Our wonderful Sami guide will teach you about all the characteristics of their reindeer.
- **Hands-on experience feeding** the reindeers.
- Ride the traditional **Reindeer Sledge** (400m).
- Overnight in Lapland.
- *Tonight, we will hunt the Northern Lights with a walk together with your Tour Manager.*

DAY 08

LAPLAND – SANTA CLAUS VILLAGE – WINTER HORSE SLEDGING – MOUNTAIN TOP GLASS CABIN

Breakfast | Lunch | Dinner

- Visit **Santa Claus Village**, where you will have the opportunity to post a postcard from the Main Post Office. All postcards sent from there will receive a special Arctic Circle Stamp.
- Collect an **Arctic Circle Certificate**.
- Photo opportunity with Santa Claus. (Own expenses)
- Visit an **authentic horse farm**.
- Ride a **traditional horse sledge** (400m), pulled by an instructor, and learn about the life and habits of an Irish Cob.
- Overnight in Lapland.

FREE UPGRADE TO MOUNTAIN TOP GLASS CABIN
(selected dates)

- *Tonight, with minimal light pollution above the mountain, you will have a high chance of catching the Northern Lights on your own.*

DAY 09

LAPLAND – RANUA WILDLIFE – GLASS IGLOO / RESORT

Breakfast | Buffet Lunch

- Excursion to **Ranua Wildlife Park** (the world's northernmost zoo), which consists of approximately 50

- wild animal species and 200 individual animals.
- You will have the chance to be in close contact with various Nordic and Arctic animals such as bears, reindeers, wolves, gluttons, lynxes, moose, birds and Finland's polar bear.

DAY 10

LAPLAND – HUSKY DOG FARM > HELSINKI

Breakfast | Dinner

- **Husky Dog Farm (2-hour activity)** – Meet the dogs and take a closer look at them. The guide will tell you about their life habits and the special characteristics of husky dogs. The highlight of the tour is a **ride on a dog sledge**. Please note: Most husky farms in Lapland use crossbreed huskies meant for racing.
- In the afternoon, enjoy free time at leisure. You may want to try skiing at the nearby ski slope.
- Transfer to the airport for our domestic flight to Helsinki.

HELSINKI

- Overnight in Helsinki.

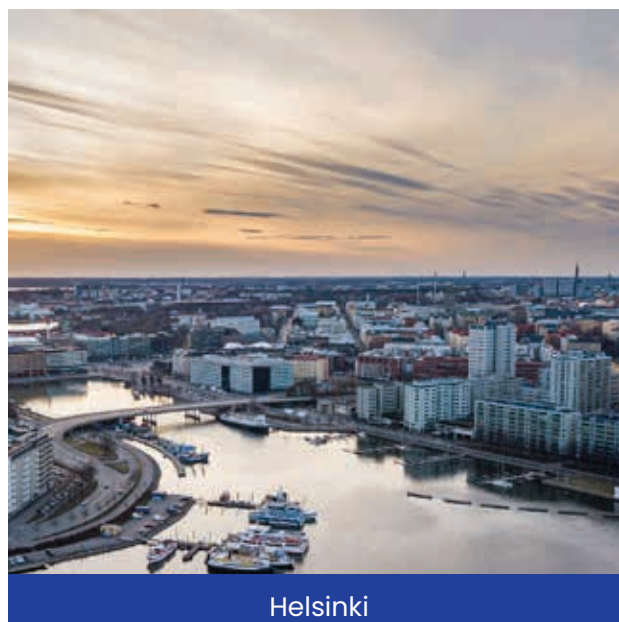
DAY 13

REMARKS

1. We partners with 11 different Glass Resorts in Lapland and operates over 200 departures each season. Each resort offers its own unique features, advantages and considerations. Please note that not all units come with an attached private sauna. If you are unsure about specific facilities, kindly check with us for clarification.
2. In Finland, names like Glass Igloo, Glass Chalet, Glass Villa or Glass Resort all refer to special glass accommodations designed for Northern Lights viewing. They may not always have the traditional dome shape, but they offer the same experience – enjoying the chance to view the Northern Lights from the comfort of your room.
3. The sequence of the itinerary may change due to the availability of glass resorts, domestic flight schedules or weather conditions.
4. Northern Lights are a natural phenomenon and we cannot guarantee their appearance due to weather conditions.

5. Snow activities are subject to weather conditions. As snowfall for the end of 2026 cannot be predicted, if the King Crab Safari including snowmobile cannot take place due to insufficient snow, the King Crab activity will still proceed but the snowmobile will be replaced with an additional meal. No refunds will be issued for the Winter Horse or Reindeer Farm visit.
6. Safety is our top priority. In the event of inadequate snowfall or icy roads, the Husky Sledge Ride may be replaced with a Husky Cart Ride, a shorter ride, Rinki, or a Husky Farm Kennel visit. The estimated 2-hour duration at the Husky Farm is only an estimate and may vary.
7. Lapland hotels in Norway and Finland do not have an official star rating. However, equivalent accommodations will be provided.
8. Weather conditions in Lapland are highly unpredictable and roads or attractions may close with little notice. In such cases, we will adjust the itinerary accordingly. The Driver and Tour Manager will make the final decision on whether to proceed or cancel the day's programme.
9. During peak seasons, the Tour Manager may not fly with the group but a check-in staff member will be assigned. The Tour Manager will meet the group upon arrival.
10. Some accommodations may not offer twin or double room options.
11. Passengers may opt to use a bus for a longer Northern Lights hunting excursion with prior agreement from the entire group. This must be confirmed at least 3 days in advance and costs will be shared equally among group members.
12. The Glass Resort images are for illustration purposes only.
13. Upgrades to Glass Resorts are subject to availability. Please check with us for confirmation of your booked igloo or resort.
14. Upgrades to Mountain Top Glass Cabins are only available for departures from 1 November 2026 – 9 December 2026. Outside of these dates, hotel accommodation will be provided instead. However, not all groups departing during this period are entitled to the 2-night free upgrade. Please check with us.
15. Northern Lights hunting depends on the KP index and weather forecasts. The Tour Manager will decide whether to proceed based on these factors. As adequate rest is required for the Tour Manager, the tour manager will not wait beyond 11:00 PM.
16. The Arctic Circle Train may close unexpectedly due to adverse weather or schedule changes. There will be no replacement or refund in such cases.
17. We reserve the right to use a different supplier for the King Crab Safari depending on the itinerary. If conducted at a different location, the experience may vary. In Kirkenes, Norwegian Shrimp will be replaced with Cod Fish Cake and the King Crab will not be slaughtered in front of guests.
18. For guests joining the 14-day / 15-day extension, an additional charge of EUR 10 per person per extra day will apply.
