Day 1 : Depart Kuala Lumpur

Day 2 : Arrival Sydney Airport , SIC Transfer to Hotel

Upon arrival Sydney, then transfer to Hotel by driver.

Checkin hotel as per standard check in time. Free at leisure at your own time.

Day 3 : Blue Mountains with entrance to Scenic World



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Journey to the heart of the **Blue Mountains on this full-day tour from Sydney**, including hotel pick-up. Kick-off your adventure seeing a koala or a kangaroo at Wildlife Park, then enjoy a dramatic view of the Three Sisters rocks from Echo Point. After lunch (own expense), head to **Scenic World to ride the Cableway, Skyway and Railway (entrance fee included)** for unbeatable aerial views of the Jamison Valley and Katoomba Falls. Finish with a leisurely cruise along the Parramatta River to Sydney's Darling Harbour or Circular Quay.

- See iconic Australian wildlife including koalas, kangaroos, and native animals.
- Opportunity to take photos with a koala (Admission included)
- Visit the famous Three Sisters rock formation.
- Enjoy panoramic views over the Jamison Valley.
- Learn about the Aboriginal legend behind the Three Sisters.
- Experience the Scenic Railway (world's steepest incline railway)
- Ride the Scenic Cableway with spectacular valley views.
- Walk through the World Heritage rainforest boardwalk.
- View Katoomba Falls, Orphan Rock, Mt Solitary, and the Three Sisters
- Relax on a scenic ferry cruise (**AUD10/pax pay on spot excluded**) from Parramatta River to Darling Harbour or Circular Quay.
- Enjoy Sydney Harbour and waterfront views.
- Once reached **Sydney Central Business District** by ferry you have option to walk to hotel on own or take short uber driver (depending on hotel's location)

Day 4 : Arrival Hobart via domestic flight, SIC Transfer to Hotel



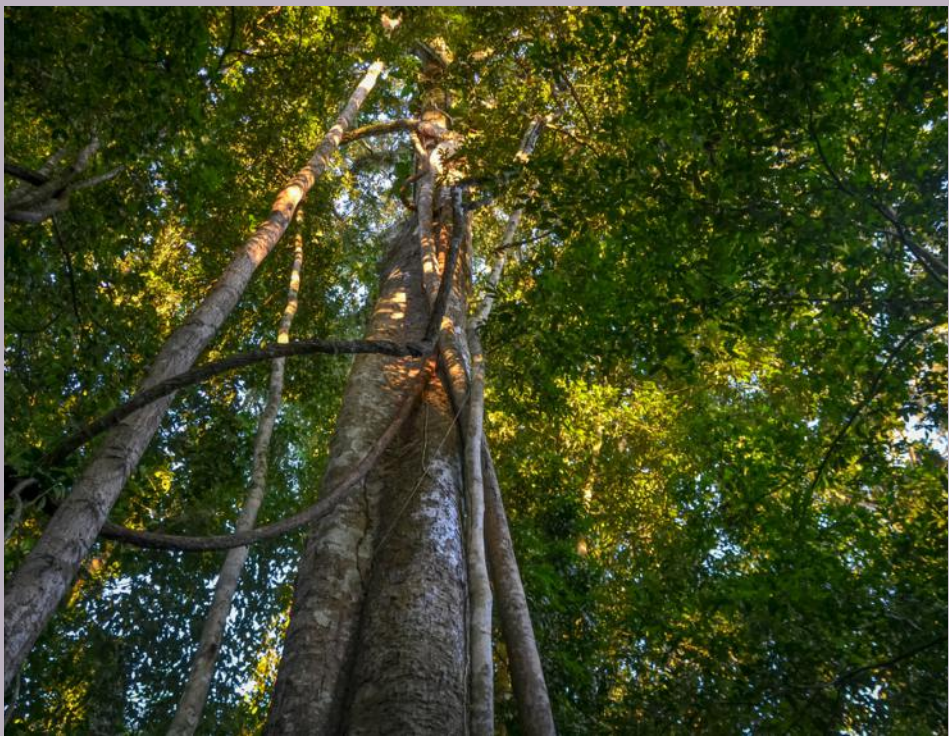
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Morning we will transfer to SYD airport for domestic flight to Hobart Tasmania.

Day 5 : Hobart - Mount Field, Mount Wellington & Wildlife

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- Explore Mount Field National Park (approx. 3.5 hrs)
- Walk to the beautiful Russell Falls
- Continue to Horseshoe Falls
- Optional Three Falls Circuit including Lady Barron Falls
- Walk through the famous Tall Trees Track
- Enjoy a picnic lunch surrounded by rainforest (own expense)
- Visit Bonorong Wildlife Sanctuary
- Experience the Tasmanian Devil Feeding
- Visit kunanyi / Mt Wellington (1,271m) for spectacular panoramic views
- Return to Hobart around 5:30pm

Explore the ancient temperate rainforests and alpine wonders of Tasmania with this comprehensive day tour to Mt. Field National Park, located just a 1.5-hour scenic drive from Hobart.

Mount Field National Park & The Three Falls Circuit As one of Tasmania's oldest and most diverse National Parks, Mt. Field is world-renowned for its "Tall Trees" and spectacular waterfalls. You will have the flexibility to tailor your experience: choose a relaxed walk to a single waterfall or take on the full 6km Three Falls Circuit.

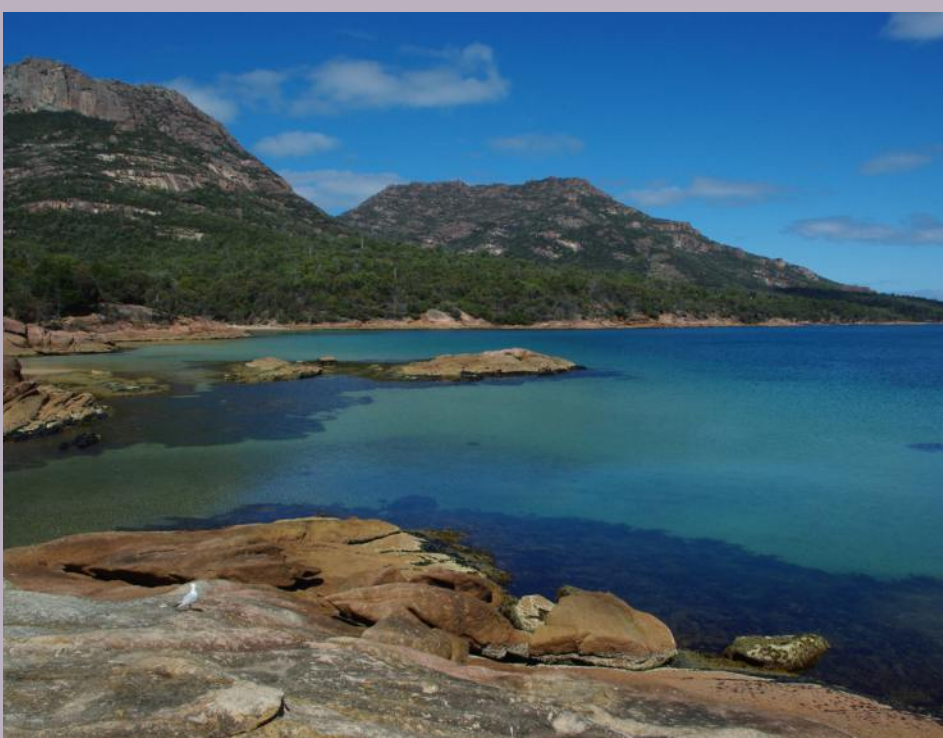
- **Russell Falls:** Start with an easy walk through mixed forest to witness Tasmania's most iconic 3-tiered waterfall. It is the most photographed site in the state for a reason!
- **Horseshoe Falls:** A short climb leads you to this majestic, secluded gem nestled deep in the forest.
- **Tall Trees Track:** Be dwarfed by giant Swamp Gums. Standing at roughly 80 meters tall, these are the world's tallest flowering plants.
- **Lady Barron Falls:** For those seeking more adventure, complete the circuit by continuing to these stunning falls before enjoying a peaceful lunch in the park's beautiful picnic settings.

Bonorong Wildlife Sanctuary After exploring the forest, we visit Bonorong for an informative wildlife tour. This is your chance to meet rare and precious native fauna, including Tasmanian Devils, wombats, and kangaroos, while learning about the sanctuary's important conservation work.

kunanyi/Mount Wellington Summit We wrap up the day at the 1,271-meter summit of Mount Wellington. Standing high above Hobart, you will enjoy sweeping, panoramic views of the entire city, the surrounding mountains, and the sparkling Derwent River system.

Day 6 : Hobart - Wineglass Bay, Freycinet National Park



- **Explore Freycinet National Park**
- **Walk to Wineglass Bay Lookout (45-min moderate uphill walk)**
- **Optional Wineglass Bay Beach Walk (2.5 hrs return)**
- **Visit Honeymoon Bay & Sleepy Bay**
- **Cape Tourville Lighthouse Walk (20-min easy walk with 360° coastal views)**
- **Afternoon stop at Devil's Corner Winery (wine, pizza, coffee & artisan gelato available - own expense)**
- **Return to Hobart around 6:00pm**

Travel along Tasmania's stunning east coast through Orford and Swansea to the spectacular Freycinet National Park. Enjoy a scenic hike to the world-famous Wineglass Bay Lookout, with the option to continue down to the pristine white sands of Wineglass Bay Beach. For a shorter walk, explore the beautiful Honeymoon Bay, Sleepy Bay, and Cape Tourville Lighthouse. End the day relaxing at Devil's Corner Winery before returning to Hobart.

We depart Hobart heading east then following the coastline north. We travel through the seaside towns of Orford and Swansea as we make our way to **Freycinet National Park**.

Freycinet is one of Tasmania's first National Parks, famous for its rich and stunning coastal landscapes. Pink Granite Mountains form the backdrop for secluded bays, pristine waters, white sandy beaches, local wildlife and amazing walking trails.

As we enter the Freycinet peninsula, we have a brief stop at the **Freycinet Marine Farm** for anyone interested in the local oysters and mussels fresh from the surrounding waters.

We walk as a group to the **Wineglass Bay Lookout**, this is a moderate uphill walk of around 45 minutes. Once at the top you are rewarded with that world famous view of Wineglass Bay and the stunning Freycinet National Park.

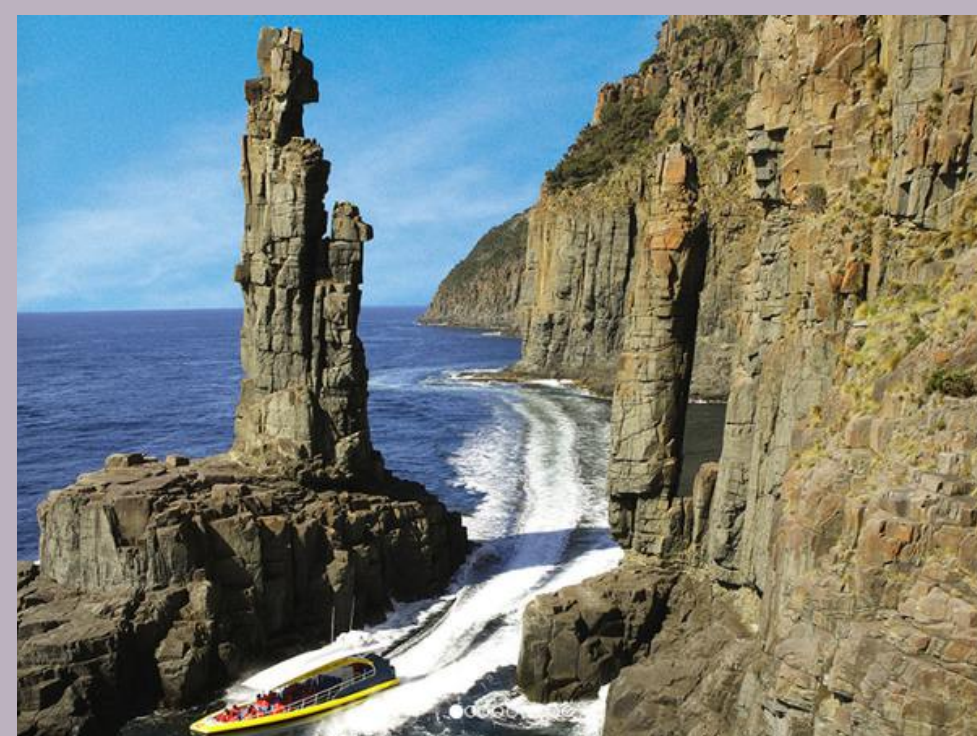
Enjoy the moment, take in the views and let our guides help you with those sought after photographs. The walk to Wineglass Bay Lookout is one of the Great Short Walks of Tasmania and requires good mobility and adequate fitness. It is 1.3 km uphill, before returning downhill.

From the Lookout you have the option to return to the start of the walk with our tour guide, or for the keen walkers you can choose to spend the rest of your time completing the walk down to Wineglass beach.

Wineglass Bay Beach Walk – This is a 2.5 hr return walk and adequate fitness is required. Our tour has ample time for you to do the full walk to Wineglass Bay Beach and return. Once on the beach you can enjoy your lunch in this stunning setting, jump in the pristine waters for a swim, or wander along the white sands. This is one of the most rewarding walks in Tasmania to a stunning location.

If you prefer to select the shorter walking option, then we return from the Lookout with our Tour Guide and explore other areas of Freycinet National Park. Visit Honeymoon Bay, Sleepy Bay, Cape Tourville Lighthouse & Great Short Walk.

If all that scenery has worked up an appetite, you'll love our afternoon stop at Devil's Corner winery. Perched high on a hill overlooking Freycinet, it's the ideal place to kick back with a glass of wine, fresh seafood platter, woodfired pizza, tea, coffee or artisan gelato at the end of a glorious day. **We return to Hobart around 6.00pm**



Day 7 : Hobart - Bruny Island Adventure

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Travel from Hobart by scenic coastal drive and ferry to the beautiful Bruny Island. Hike the Cape Queen Elizabeth Trail to The Arch and enjoy spectacular views of Mars Bluff and Miles Beach. Visit The Neck, Trugannini Lookout, Two Tree Point, and relax at the stunning Adventure Bay. Spend the afternoon tasting Bruny Island's famous artisan produce, including chocolate, honey, cheese, and fresh oysters. Return to Hobart around 5:00pm after a day of breathtaking scenery, beaches, gourmet delights, and local flavours. Bruny Island Gourmet & Nature Tour Duration: 7:00am – 5:00pm
