DAY 1 : CHECK IN / DEPART KLIA 🇲🇾

DAY 2 : ROME

Arrival. Transfer to the hotel. Welcome to Europe!!! Upon arriving at the airport we will be waiting to transfer you to your hotel. You can enjoy free time until your tour starts.

DAY 3 : ROME



- Discover Rome's timeless charm with a panoramic and walking tour showcasing iconic sites like the Colosseum. (Photo stops)
- Photo stop at Imperial Forums, and Vatican City. Lunch at Vatican square area on own.
- Optional: Entrance to Vatican, Sistine Chapel EUR70/pax & follow by Rome Old City walking tour EUR40/pax.
- Afternoon free at own leisure or join optional, those pax not joining the optional please make your way to Trastevere area in evening to meet the group again, enjoying its quaint streets, vibrant trattorias to have dinner on own. Back to hotel with guide.

In the morning, we'll take a **three-hour guided tour** of the Eternal City. We include a panoramic bus tour of the capital of Italy and one of the oldest and most influential cities in Western civilization. The Colosseum, the Arch of Constantine, the Roman forums, the Baths of Caracalla, the Basilica of Saint Mary Major, the Pyramid of Cestius, and Castel Sant'Angelo, the great life of the city. We finish in St. Peter's of the **Vatican City** an independent state within the city of Rome and center of the Catholic Church. You can visit the basilica and the museums. In the evening make your way to meet guide again at **Trastevere**, a lively neighborhood of the city known for its small traditional restaurants.

DAY 4 : ROME



The day at leisure to rest and relax or explore the city of Rome further.

DAY 5 : ROME - FLORENCE

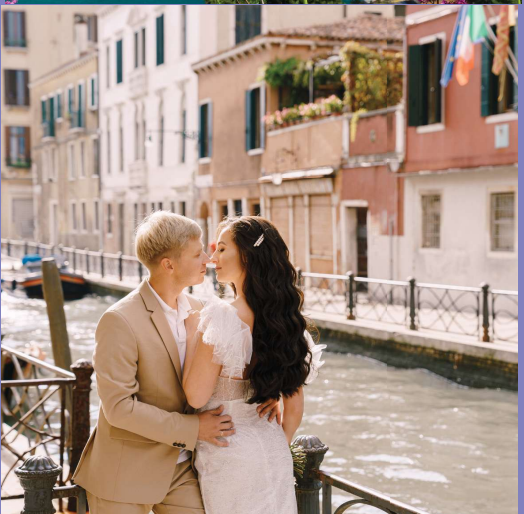


- Walking Tour with a local expert from Florence exploring historic city center photostops at Gothic cathedral (duomo), the ancient Stone Bridge (Ponte Vecchio), goldsmiths' shops and the Signoria square
- View from Piazzale Michelangelo

We will leave **Rome** and travel to the capital of Tuscany - **Florence**, upon arrival we will make a stop to take a photo at the **Michelangelo viewpoint**, where we can have one of the most beautiful views over the city. After that we include a **sightseeing tour with a local guide** of the capital of Tuscany, one of the most visited cities in the country, considered the cradle of the Renaissance and few of the most influential artists and thinkers in history, such as Leonardo da Vinci, Michelangelo, Botticelli or Raphael. Highlights include photostops at Gothic cathedral (duomo), the ancient Stone Bridge (Ponte Vecchio) with its goldsmiths' shops and the Signoria square - the political heart of the city with the town hall in a medieval building. Afternoon have free time to have lunch, dinner in city center then back to hotel

Note: We recommend wearing comfortable shoes for the visit to Florence.





DAY 6 : FLORENCE - PISA - CINQUE TERRE - GENOA

B

- Wonderful Ligurian coast, little tourist train & Photostop at Pisa
- Train to Cinque Terre, most picturesque villages in Italy

Today we continue our journey towards **Pisa**. On a **little tourist train** we will travel to the Piazza Dei Miracoli (Square of Miracles), where there will be time to admire one, the well known Leaning Tower of Pisa. After this we head to the Ligurian Coast, with some of the prettiest coastlines in Europe. We will visit the **Cinque Teere**, which has been declared UNESCO World Heritage Site. It comprises of five villages, almost isolated by road, which live on fishing and tourism. We arrive by train, ticket included, to one of its charming towns (normally **Vernezza**, but on busy tourist dates it could be Manarola or Corniglia, very similar towns that are somewhat less crowded). Time to have a lunch. Afterwards we travel by **train** to **Levanto**, where we take the bus to continue to **Genoa**.

Note: The train to Cinque Terre is a regular local railway service, not a tourist service. Sometimes the trains are full (it is not possible to book places on these trains) so it might be necessary, on occasion, to travel standing and not seated. In these cases we suggest walking to the monumental site (approximately 900 meters).

DAY 7 : GENOA - PORTOFINO - MILAN

B

- Boat trip to Portofino, one of the most exclusive places in Europe
- Milan is a cosmopolitan metropolis with a European flair, and is considered one of the world's fashion and design capitals.

We will continue our journey to the nearby city of **Santa Magherita Ligure**, where we will embark for **Portofino**, one of the most exclusive places in Europe. Enjoy a stroll by the sea and time at leisure. After lunch, we continue to **Milan**, the busy northern city in which we recommend a visit to the Gothic cathedral in Piazza del Duomo.

Note: From May 30th to November 2nd, tourist buses are not allowed access to Santa Margherita Ligure. During this period, the stop will be in RAPALLO, another stunning coastal destination in the Liguria region, where we will board the boat to Portofino.

Additional Note: Due to weather conditions in winter, sometimes the boat to Portofino does not operate, in which case access will be by urban microbus (poor quality service, sometimes long waiting times).

DAY 8 : MILAN - LAKES REGION - VERONA

B

- Explore the stunning Italian Lakes region, including a train ride to the medieval town of Orta San Giulio and a boat trip to the peaceful Island of San Giulio with its historic monastery.
- Visit scenic Lake Maggiore with a stop in Stresa and an optional visit to Isola Bella, before continuing on to the romantic city of Verona.

Today we see one of the most beautiful scenic areas of Europe, the region of the **Italian lakes**. First we will travel to **Lake Orta** in **Orta of San Giulio**, a well-preserved medieval city. We take a train ride to reach the center of the medieval town, and then a boat to the **ISLAND OF SAN GIULIO**, a little island on the lake with a monastery. After this we go on to **Lake Maggiore**, making a stop in **Stresa**, where we have the option to visit the Borromean Islands, and especially **Isola Bella**, with its gardens and palace (closed in the winter). Time for lunch. After lunch we go on to **Verona**.

Note: during the winter months the Orta train does not operate. In that case you will access the medieval town by walking approximately 800 meters from the bus parking lot.

DAY 9 : VERONA - VENICE

B

- We will take water Taxi to reach Venice Island
- Guided Venice City Tour & Murano glass factory
- Venice Gondola Ride Optional Eur40/pax

We will have time to see **Verona**, the city of Romeo and Juliet before leaving for **Venice**, where we arrive at about 13.00 hrs. We include a **boat trip** to the area of St. Mark's Square, followed by a **guided walking tour** of the City of Canals. There will also be a chance to admire the glasswork of Murano. Afterwards enjoy some leisure time, maybe a trip in a gondola? Accommodation in the Mestre district.

DAY 10 : VENICE - PADUA - SAN MARINO - GUBBIO - PERUGIA



- Visit Padua to see the famous Saint's Basilica, then continue to San Marino, a hilltop republic on the Adriatic coast.
- Cross the scenic Apennines to Gubbio, known for its medieval charm, and end the day in the historic city of Perugia.

Today we embark for **Padua**, the destination of many pilgrims, where we will see the Saint's Basilica. Then we will go on to the Adriatic coast to see **San Marino**, a small independent country on top of a strongly fortified mountain. Time for lunch. We travel on through pretty mountain countryside, crossing the Apennines to **Gubbio**, a marvelously preserved town in which the Palace of Consuls and the 12th century cathedral stand out. Continuing to **Perugia**.

DAY 11 : PERUGIA - ASSISI - ROME



- Enjoy a guided panoramic tour of Perugia, famed for its medieval charm and chocolate, walk through its underground city
- Travel to Rome in the afternoon to continue your Italian adventure

Perugia is a historic city, also known as the City of Chocolate. With a local guide we will explore, climbing its ramps that cross the rocky outcrop, and we will be surprised by its squares and stone streets. After this we travel to **Assisi**. Afterwards, we travel to Rome, arriving in the afternoon.

DAY 12 : ROME



After breakfast, check-out as per hotel standard policy then free at own leisure till transfer to airport for flight back to Malaysia.

DAY 13 : ROME ✈️ KUALA LUMPUR

Arrive Kuala Lumpur, Welcome Back Home!
