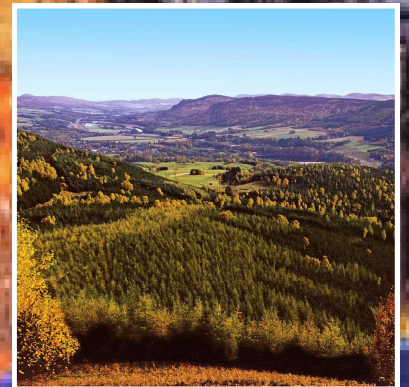
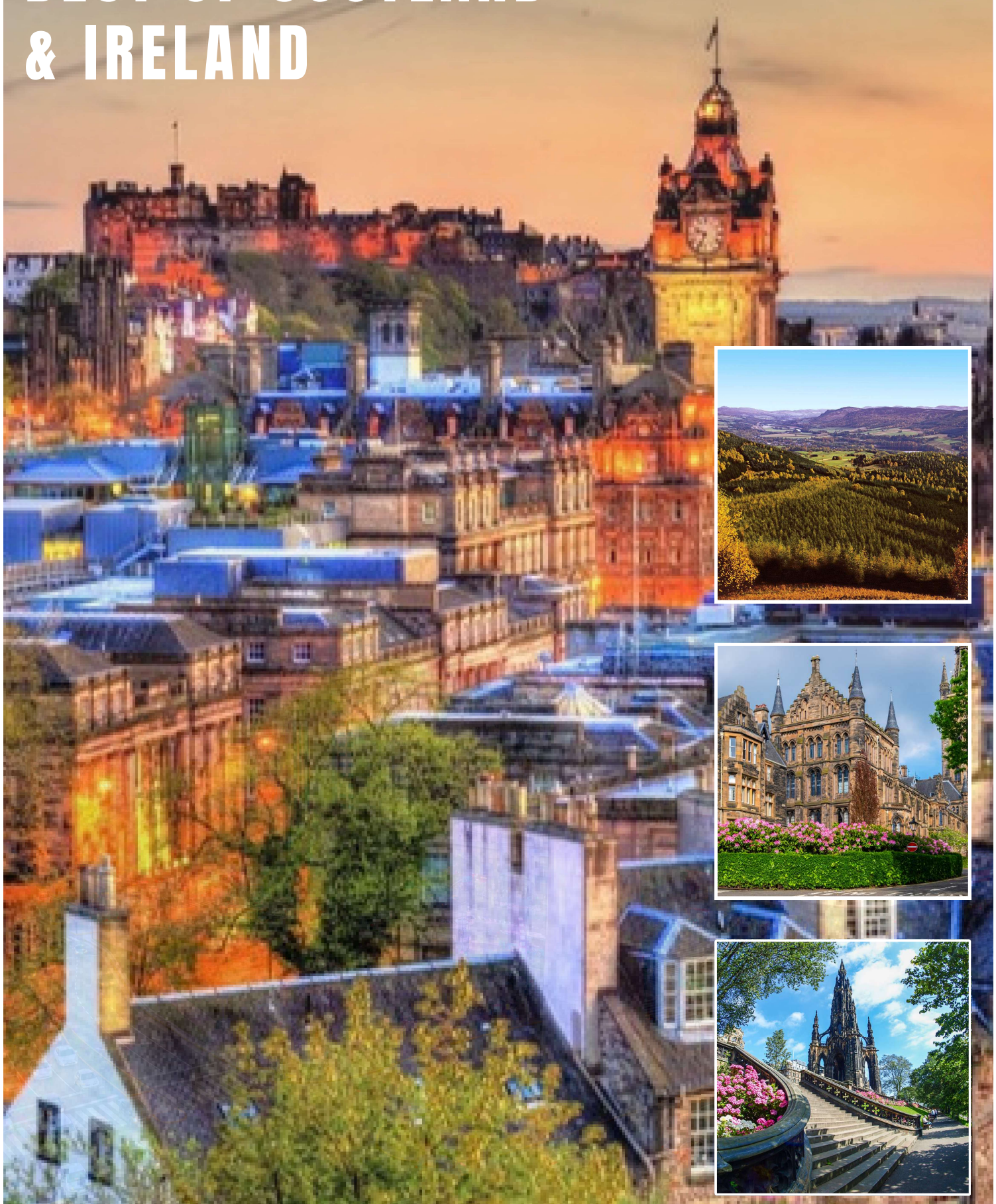

DAY 1 : KLIA DEPART - ARRIVAL EDINBURGH SCOTLAND



Check in at Kuala Lumpur International Airport for your flight to Scotland

- Arrival Edinburgh pickup by driver from airport arrival hall and transfer to hotel

DAY 2 : EDINBURGH



- Guided morning tour of New Town & historic Old Town with Local Guide

- Afternoon at leisure to explore the city
- Optional Scottish cultural evening with traditional food, bagpipes & Ceremony of the Haggis; selected August departures include Royal Edinburgh Military Tattoo tickets



A full day to enjoy the **Scottish capital**. Morning sightseeing with a Local Guide introduces you to the 200-year-old "New Town", home to famous scientists, inventors, and novelists. In the "Old Town,"

Visit **Edinburgh Castle** to admire Scotland's Crown Jewels. Afternoon at leisure. No trip to Scotland is complete without an authentic Scottish night out! Join an optional evening filled with traditional food, drinks, singers, dancers, bagpipes and of course the unforgettable Ceremony of the **Haggis!**

For departures August 9, 16 and 23, tickets are included for tonight's performance of the world-renowned **Royal Edinburgh Military Tattoo**, a vast spectacle of amassed Scottish pipe bands that takes place in an arena on the esplanade of Edinburgh Castle.

DAY 3 : EDINBURGH-ST. ANDREWS - PITLOCHRY - CULLODEN MOOR - HIGHLANDS

- Cross the Firth of Forth to St. Andrews, birthplace of golf & home of the Royal & Ancient Golf Club
- Travel via Dundee & Perth into the Highlands with a stop in Victorian Pitlochry
- Visit historic Culloden Moor, battlefield of Bonnie Prince Charlie
- Continue to your Highland destination (225 mi / 260 km)

A day of memorable sightseeing cross the **Firth of Forth** and head to **St. Andrews**, whose Royal and Ancient Golf Club has given us the rules of golfing then cross the **Firth of Tay and, via Dundee and Perth**, head into the Highlands with a stop in the **Victorian mountain** resort of Pitlochry. Cross the battlefield of **Culloden Moor** with its **memories of Bonnie Prince Charlie** before reaching your Highland destination.
Today's Distance: 225 mi/ 260 km



DAY 4 : HIGHLANDS - FORT WILLIAM - GLASGOW

- Scenic drive past Loch Ness with views of the legendary monster's waters
- Travel via Fort William beneath Ben Nevis, Britain's highest mountain
- Pass through dramatic Glen Coe, site of the 1692 MacDonald Clan massacre
- Drive along the "Bonnie Banks" of Loch Lomond en route to Glasgow (183 mi / 293 km)

Look out for signs of the **mysterious Loch Ness monster** and proceed via **Fort William, beneath Ben Nevis**. **Glen Coe**, where the MacDonald Clan was massacred in 1692, and a drive along the "**Bonnie Banks**" of Loch Lomond are scenic highlights on the way to **Glasgow**.

Today's Distance: 183 mi/ 293 km



DAY 5: GLASGOW - ALLOWAY - BELFAST, NORTHERN IRELAND

 B

- Morning orientation drive in Glasgow, Scotland's largest city, featuring the 12th-century Cathedral, grand university buildings & elegant Georgian squares
- Stop at Alloway, birthplace of Scotland's national poet Robert Burns
- Ferry crossing across the Irish Sea to Belfast
- Travel distance: 143 mi / 229 km

On this morning's orientation drive through **Scotland's** largest city, see the fine 12th-century cathedral, imposing university buildings, and elegant **Georgian squares**, built by wealthy tobacco barons.

Stop at **Alloway**, the birthplace of Robert Burns, before boarding the ferry for the **Irish Sea** crossing to Belfast.

Today's Distance: 143 mi/ 229 km



DAY 6 : BELFAST



- Leisure day in Belfast or optional city tour with visit to Titanic Belfast, tracing the ship's construction and legacy
- Optional excursion to the UNESCO-listed Giant's Causeway
- View the dramatic coastline and 40,000 basalt columns formed 60 million years ago

A full day to enjoy **Belfast** on your own or experience the legend and legacy of the **ill-fated ocean liner, Titanic**, on a morning optional city tour that includes a visit to **Titanic Belfast**. Be moved by the compelling story of the Titanic from conception to construction and launch and its subsequent place in history. This afternoon, why not join an optional to the UNESCO World Heritage site of the **Giant's Causeway**. Taking its name from the legendary **Irish giant Finn McCool**, 40,000 basalt columns were formed around 60 million years ago to create a **unique rock formation** that is a sight to behold.

DAY 7 : BELFAST - DUBLIN, IRELAND



- Morning drive south to Dublin with arrival before lunchtime

- Travel distance: 105 mi / 168 km

Head south this morning for arrival in **Dublin** before lunchtime. Your orientation drive through **Ireland's capital** includes statue-lined **O'Connell Street**, elegant **Georgian squares**, and **St. Patrick's Cathedral**. This evening's optional excursion toasts Irish tradition with a visit to the **Guinness Storehouse** where Ireland's most famous export has been brewed since 1759. A guided tour is followed by a "pint of the black stuff" and dinner.

Today's Distance: 105 mi/ 168 km
