DAY 1 : CHECKIN /DEPART KLIA ✈️

DAY 2 : COPENHAGEN

- Arrival, transfer from airport to Hotel

Arrival. Transfer to the hotel. Welcome to **COPENHAGEN!!!**. Upon arriving at the airport we will be waiting to transfer you to your hotel. You can enjoy free time until your tour starts.

DAY 3 : COPENHAGEN - ODENSE - AARHUS

- Morning city Tour of Copenhagen
- Beautiful scenery of southern Denmark

In the morning we enjoy a **comprehensive tour of the Danish capital with a local guide**. Copenhagen is the largest Scandinavian city, and full of contrasts, the popular (**photostops**) at Tivoli, Amalienborg Palace, the terraces of Nyhavn, and The Little Mermaid. We will then travel to Jutland, passing through pleasant scenery on our way. En route we take a 20km bridge over the sea and stop at **ODENSE**, where we can visit its gothic cathedral and the house of Andersen. We continue on to **AARHUS** and our accommodation.

DAY 4 : ARHUS - KRISTIANSAND FERRY - KRISTIANSAND- STAVANGER

- Take a ferry from Hirtshals to Kristiansand, enjoy the scenic Norwegian coastline, visit Flekkefjord with its wooden houses, and arrive in Stavanger, a picturesque town by the fjord.

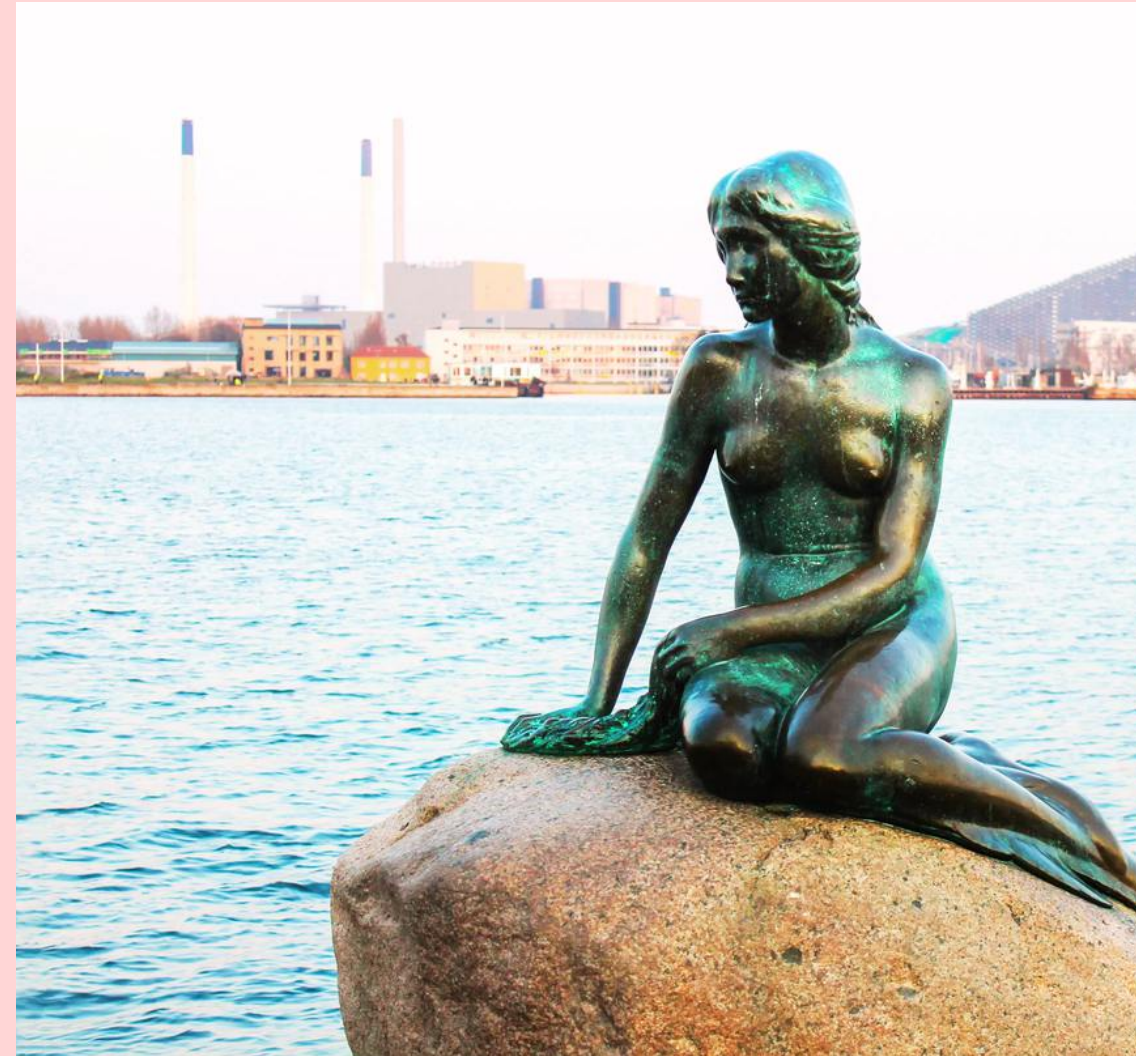
We will travel to **HIRTSHALS**, where we will take a **ferry** crossing the North Sea to **Norway**. A three-hour voyage to **KRISTIANSAND**. We will continue along Norway's southern coastline and enjoy its stunning landscapes. Next stop in **FLEKKEFJORD**, a town with its wooden houses and tiny restaurants on a fjord. Arrival to **STAVANGER**, a small picturesque town that has an active port by the fjord.

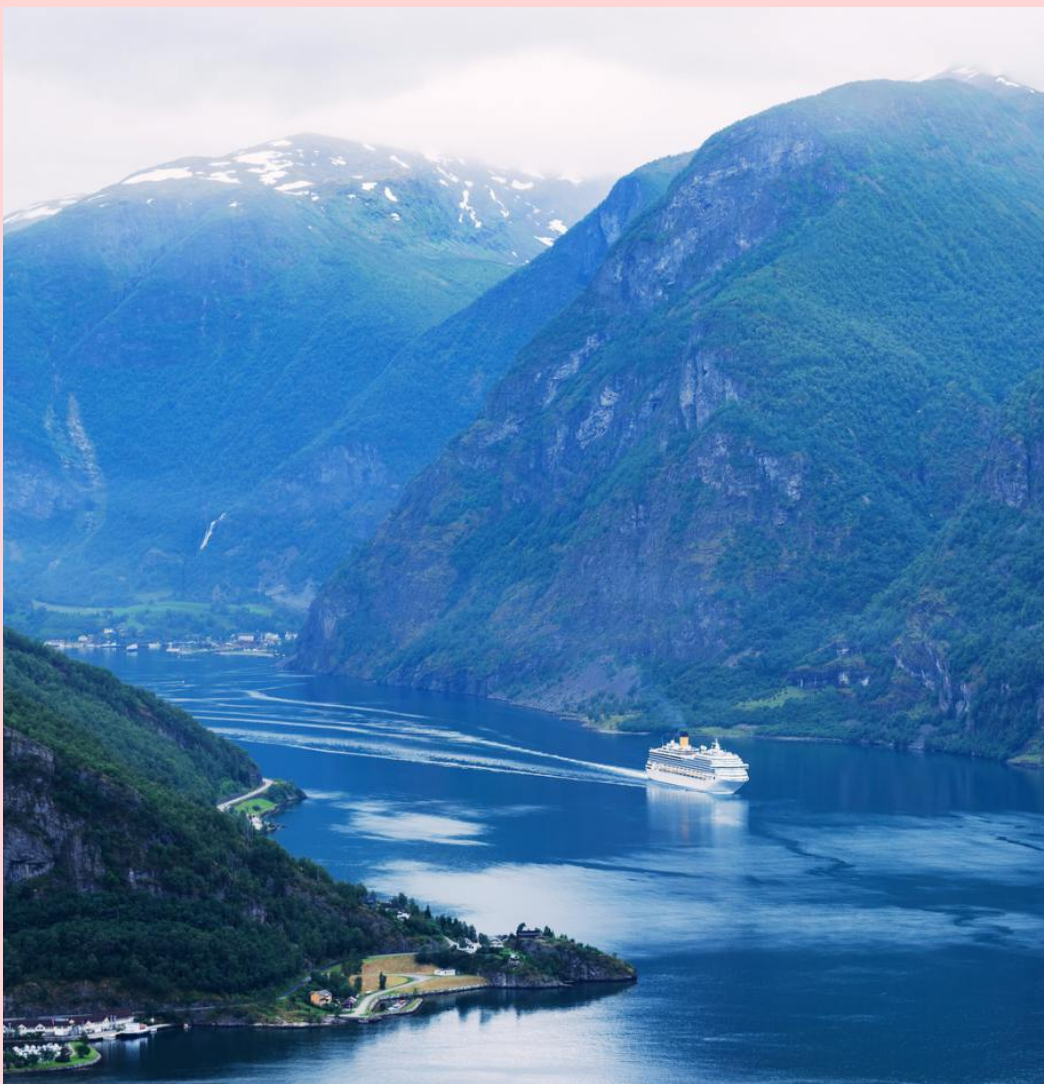
Note: Ferry operation hours vary depending on the months. Sometimes it is normally reserved to have lunch on the boat.

DAY 5 : STAVANGER - BERGEN

- Visit the 'Swords in Rock' monument, travel through tunnels and bridges, and enjoy boat trips along Norway's fjord coast, before arriving in Bergen for a cable car to Mount Fløyen

Upon leaving the city, we will stop at the '**Swords in Rock**' monument, where we will be reminded of the Vikings, before continuing the very beautiful scenic tour. We follow the route going through tunnels, bridges and travel some stretches by boat to go along the **fjord coast of Norway**. One of its undersea tunnels is the deepest one in the world. This stage gets more relaxed and spectacular with its two boat trips. We will arrive in **BERGEN** at lunch time. We take a **cable car to Mount Fløyen** which offers amazing views of the town and Bergen fjord. There will be some leisure time later to enjoy the capital city of fjords.





DAY 6 : BERGEN -SOGNEFJORD - OSLO

B

- Explore Norway’s stunning landscapes, including Sognefjord, the Tvindefossen waterfall, a cruise between Gudvangen and Aurland, the Aurland Tunnel, the 12th-century Borgund Church, and free time in Oslo to enjoy its port, main streets, and Frognerparken artworks.

More fantastic landscapes today, images of Norway’s interior region fjords, glaciers, lakes and forests. We will travel to **SOGNEFJORD**, Norway’s largest fjord. Prior to arrival, we will make a stop at the beautiful **TVINDEFOSSEN waterfall**. We will take a magnificent **cruise** between the cities of **GUDVANGEN** and **AURLAND** enjoy stunning landscapes during this an hour and a half voyage. We continue our journey crossing magnificent snow-covered landscapes. We travel through Aurland Tunnel, the longest in the world. Next, a visit (outside view) **BORGUND’s 12th century wooden church**, which is considered Norway’s best-preserved medieval church. We arrive in OSLO with free time to have a walk through its port, main streets, and the artworks at Frognerparken.

DAY 7 : OSLO - OREBRO - STOCKHOLM

B

- Explore Oslo's blend of modern and classical architecture, large parks, and sculptures, then travel through scenic forests and lakes to Orebro, known for its castle and charming historic center. Continue on to Stockholm, arriving in the evening.

We include a **sightseeing tour with a local guide** of the Norwegian capital; this city combines its vibrant modern architecture with its classical buildings, magnificent scenery and large parks with sculptures. It has been nominated the "European green capital". After the tour, free time. Departure for **Sweden**. Enjoy landscapes with forests and lakes. Next stop in **OREBRO**, a town next to a beautiful lake with a castle and charming historic center. Time for stroll. Continuing to **STOCKHOLM**, arriving in the evening.

DAY 8 : STOCKHOLM

B

- Take a sightseeing tour of Stockholm, Photostops at Gamla Stan, the Nobel Museum, Stortorget Square, the Cathedral, and the Royal Palace, with a scenic view from Fjällgatan viewpoint. Enjoy free time to visit museums and parks, with an optional tour of City Hall and the Vasa Museum.

Today we take a **sightseeing tour** of this very beautiful capital city built on 14 islands joined together. We will see the Gamla Stand or the “City between the Bridges”, the old quarter of the city, full of life where there are many monumental buildings such as the Nobel Museum, alongside the main square of Stortorget, which pays tribute to the winners of the Nobel Prizes, the Cathedral and the Royal Palace. Whenever possible, we will enjoy a pretty view from the Fjällgatan viewpoint. Then leisure time. We recommend visiting the museums and parks. Optional Tour we suggest a visit to the City Hall and to the Vasa museum.

DAY 9 : STOCKHOLM -TURKU FERRY

B

- Enjoy a free day in Stockholm before boarding a modern ferry for an overnight journey to Finland, staying in en-suite cabins with private washrooms (cruise type inside cabins)

Enjoy a free day of leisure in **Stockholm**. In the evening we will take a **modern ferry** traveling overnight to **Finland**, where accommodation will be in **double cabins with private bathrooms**.Embark on a mesmerizing journey with an overnight ferry to Finland. Drift across the Baltic Sea under the moonlit sky, embracing the tranquility of the voyage. Wake up to a new day in a different land, ready to explore the enchanting wonders of Finland.

DAY 10 : STOCKHOLM - TURKU FERRY - NAANTALI - HELSINKI B

- Arrive in Finland and enjoy a sunrise view from the ship’s deck as you sail past the Åland Islands, then explore Turku and the picturesque town of Naantali before heading to Helsinki. Spend the afternoon enjoying leisure time in the Finnish capital, visiting the old market, Russian-influenced buildings, and beautiful churches.

Upon arriving in **Finland**, catch the sunrise from the ferry's deck as we sail past the scenic Åland Islands. Explore **Turku** with its strong Swedish influence, then proceed to the charming town of **Naantali**. By lunchtime, we'll reach **Helsinki**, allowing you an afternoon of leisure to discover the city's highlights, from the old market to Russian-influenced architecture and captivating churches. Enjoy the blend of history and modernity in the Finnish capital.

DAY 11 : HELSINKI - TALLIN FERRY - TALLINN B

- Embark on a boat trip to the Suomenlinna Islands to explore a World Heritage fortress, then enjoy a scenic ferry ride 2HR 30MIN to Tallinn, Estonia, with stunning views of the surrounding islands.

We enjoy a **boat trip** to **Suomenlinna Islands**, a group of islands where we can witness a great fortress that used to protect the sea entry to the city, it has been declared World Heritage. Take time to walk around, it is possible to cross the islands through small pedestrian bridges. Later we will board a **ferry to Estonia**. The ferry trip will be around 2 hours 30 minutes. During the departure from Helsinki you have great views of the surrounding islands. Arrival in TALLINN! Note: On some occasions, the transfer to the Suomenlinna islands will take place on Thursday afternoon.

DAY 12 : TALLINN TOUR B

- Explore Tallinn's well-preserved medieval center on a sightseeing tour, visiting its walls, churches, squares, and charming streets, followed by free time in the afternoon.

Tallinn, the capital of Estonia is a wonderful city with a well-conserved medieval center. We will enjoy a **sightseeing tour of the city**, its walls, churches, squares, and its medieval streets filled with tourist attractions. Free time in the afternoon.

DAY 13 : TALLINN KUALA LUMPUR B

After breakfast, check-out as per hotel standard policy then free at own leisure till transfer to airport for flight back to Malaysia.
