### DAY 1 : CHECK IN /DEPART KLIA ✈️

### DAY 2 : ROME

Welcome! Upon arrival, we'll provide a transfer to the hotel. You can enjoy free time until your tour starts next day

### DAY 3 : ROME



- Discover Rome's timeless charm with a panoramic and walking tour showcasing iconic sites like the Colosseum. (Photo stops)
- Photo stop at Imperial Forums, and Vatican City. Lunch at Vatican square area on own.
- Optional: Entrance to Vatican, Sistine Chapel EUR70/pax & follow by Rome Old City walking tour EUR40/pax.
- Afternoon free at own leisure or join optional, those pax not joining the optional please make your way to Trastevere area in evening to meet the group again, enjoying its quaint streets, vibrant trattorias to have dinner on own. Back to hotel with guide.

In the morning, we'll take a **three-hour guided tour** of the Eternal City, combining a walking tour through Imperial Rome with a panoramic bus ride to admire one of the oldest and most influential cities in Western civilization. The Colosseum, Arch of Constantine, the Baths of Caracalla, the Basilica of Saint Mary Major, the Pyramid of Cestius, and Castel Sant'Angelo. We finish in St. Peter's of the **Vatican**, an independent state within the city of Rome and center of the Catholic Church. You can visit the basilica and the museums. In the evening make your way to meet guide again at **Trastevere**, a lively neighborhood of the city known for its small traditional restaurants. Return to the hotel will be around 8:30 p.m.

### DAY 4 : ROME - SAN GIOVANNI IN VENERE ABBEY - TERMOLI - BARI



- Today we journey through the Apennines to the Adriatic, visiting historic abbeys, charming coastal towns, and ending with a stroll in Bari's old town.

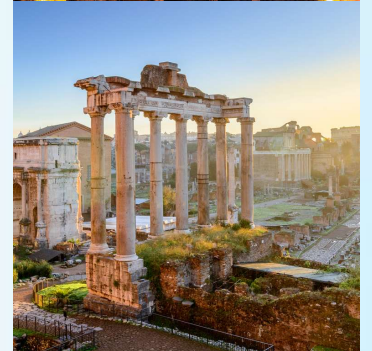
Today, we'll travel toward the Adriatic Sea, passing through the stunning landscapes of the Apennine Mountain range. Our first stop will be the **San Giovanni in Venere Abbey** (admission included), a beautiful 11th-century abbey built on the ruins of an ancient Roman temple. Next, we'll visit **Termoli**, a charming coastal city where the beach is framed by the walled old town, with its 13th-century castle and Romanesque cathedral as the main attractions. You'll have time to enjoy lunch and take a leisurely walk. We'll then continue to **Bari**, a historic port city inhabited since before Roman times. Here, you'll have the opportunity to explore and stroll through the old town. Its narrow streets, beautiful churches, and vibrant atmosphere make it a truly special city, full of southern Italian charm.

### DAY 5 : BARI - BRINDISI - LECCE - GALLIPOLI - BRINDISI



- After breakfast in Bari, we visit the historic and lively old towns of Brindisi, Lecce, and Taranto, each with unique architecture and charm, before returning to Brindisi for the night.

We'll follow the coast to **Brindisi**, a walled port city where you can enjoy a pleasant stroll along the sea, admire the impressive Roman column, and explore the old quarter. Our next stop will be **Lecce**, a charming city renowned for its stunning baroque architecture, earning the nickname "Florence of the South." The historic center is filled with beautifully ornate baroque buildings and churches. You'll have time for a walk and lunch. In the afternoon, we'll visit **Gallipoli**, a coastal city on the Ionian Sea founded by the Greeks, who named it "beautiful town." Influenced by Arab, Norman, and Aragonese cultures, Gallipoli's old town is connected to the mainland by a 17th-century bridge. This charming area is a maze of narrow streets and historic buildings, with highlights including the cathedral, the castle, and the ancient city walls. We'll return to **Brindisi** at the end of the day for accommodation.





## DAY 6 : BRINDISI - ALBEROBELLO - MATERA - NAPLES

B

- Today we visit Alberobello's "Trulli" houses and Matera's "Sassi" dwellings, then travel to Naples by evening

Today, we'll visit two extraordinary and authentic towns. Our first stop will be **Alberobello**, famous for its unique conical-shaped houses known as trulli. These distinctive structures, with their stacked stone roofs, are a UNESCO World Heritage Site and represent a remarkable example of Italian rural architecture. Next, we'll head to **Matera**, located in the Basilicata region, renowned for its ancient historic center and the Sassi di Matera—a complex of ancient dwellings and buildings carved into the rock, dating back thousands of years. Not only is it a World Heritage Site, but also one of the oldest continuously inhabited human settlements in the world. In the afternoon, after enjoying an included lunch in Matera, we'll continue our journey through Basilicata and Campania, taking in the beautiful mountain landscapes. We'll arrive in **Naples** by evening, where you'll have free time to explore.

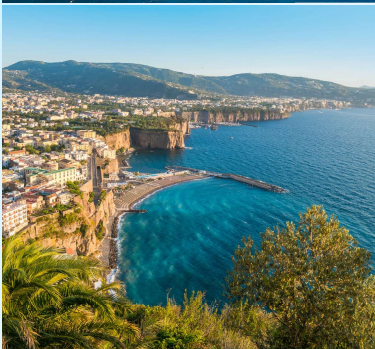


## DAY 7 : NAPLES - CAPRI - SORRENTO - SALERNO

B

- Trip to the ISLAND OF CAPRI and GROTTA BIANCA
- Continue to the Gulf of Salerno SORRENTO, a charming, touristic town

After breakfast, we'll head to the port in **Naples** to board a boat to the **Island of Capri**, where you can choose to take a boat to Grotta Bianca or the funicular to Capri city. After lunch, we'll reboard and head to **Sorrento**, a charming tourist town nestled at the base of a cliff, where you'll have free time to wander. Our journey will then take us to the Gulf of Salerno, where we'll stay in the city of **Salerno**.



## DAY 8 : SALERNO - POMPEII - NAPLES - CASSINO - ROME

B

- Visit POMPEII: tour and entrance included, Visit old town of Naples
- Top at CASSINO: visit the abbey

We'll begin our day with a visit to **Pompeii**, where you'll have the chance to admire the remains of this ancient Roman city, buried by the ashes of Mount Vesuvius (tickets and guided tour included). Afterward, we'll head to **Naples**, one of Italy's most captivating cities and among the oldest continuously inhabited areas in Europe. The historic quarter of Naples, one of the largest in Europe, is a UNESCO World Heritage Site. You'll have time to explore and enjoy lunch. We'll then continue to **Cassino**, where you can visit the breathtaking abbey, the site of one of World War II's fiercest battles. Our journey will conclude in **Rome**, arriving in the evening.



## DAY 9 : ROME - FLORENCE

B

- Visit to Pompeii (tickets included)
- Tour with a local expert from Florence exploring historic city centre
- View from Piazzale Michelangelo

We'll journey to **Florence**, the capital of Tuscany. Upon arrival, we'll stop at the Michelangelo viewpoint for a photo opportunity, offering one of the most stunning views of the city. Following this, we'll embark on a **sightseeing tour with a local guide** of this renowned city, one of Italy's most visited destinations considered the cradle of the Renaissance and some of the most influential artists and thinkers in history, such as Leonardo da Vinci, Michelangelo, Botticelli, and Raphael. Highlights of the tour include outside views of Gothic cathedral Duomo di Firenze, the historic Ponte Vecchio, known for its goldsmith workshops along its paved streets and Piazza della Signoria, the city's political heart featuring the medieval town hall. Free time in afternoon.

**Note:**We recommend wearing comfortable shoes for the visit to Florence.



## DAY 10 : FLORENCE - VENICE

B

- Water Taxi to reach Venice Island
- Entrance ticket included to the St. Mark's Basilica
- Admire the technique of crafting Murano Glass, Gondola Optional

We'll leave **Florence** early and head towards northern **Italy**, crossing the Apennines. In **Venice**, we'll take a **boat transfer to the city center** for a walking tour of the **San Marco district**, where you'll see the Basilica and the Campanile. We'll also visit a Murano Glass Factory to admire traditional glass-working techniques. Accommodation will be in the Mestre area.
