### DAY 1 : MADRID

- **Pickup from airport and transfer to Hotel, Plaza Mayor and La Latina, Madrid's most famous neighborhood for nightlife and tapas restaurants.**

Welcome to Madrid! Upon arrival at the airport, we'll be ready to transfer you to your hotel. You'll have some free time until the tour begins. Please check the information signs in the hotel reception area for details about the welcome meeting with your guide and fellow travelers. In the evening, we'll provide a transfer to **Plaza Mayor and La Latina, Madrid's most famous neighborhood for nightlife and tapas restaurants.** You can choose to dine at a restaurant of your preference—options include Indian, Chinese, Spanish, and Middle Eastern cuisines.

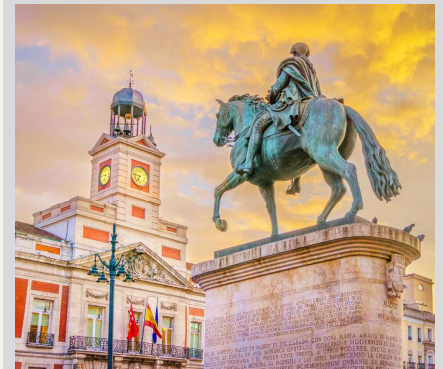


### DAY 2 : MADRID

 B

- **Outside view of key sites in central Madrid: Paseo del Prado, Cibeles, Neptuno, Puerta de Alcalá, Plaza de Colón, and Plaza Mayor.**
- **Enjoy a free afternoon before returning to the hotel in the evening.**

The morning will begin with a comprehensive tour of central Madrid, featuring highlights like **Paseo del Prado, Cibeles, Neptuno, Puerta de Alcalá, Plaza de Colón, and Plaza Mayor.** We'll then visit Retiro Park, a beautiful oasis in the city center, where we'll see the lake and the Palacio de Cristal. Enjoy the rest of the afternoon at your leisure. In the evening, we'll provide a return transfer to the hotel.



### DAY 3 : MADRID - GRANADA

- **Traveling south through La Mancha**
- **Stop in Puerto Lápice, a village reminiscent of Don Quixote**
- **Continue through Despeñaperros into Andalusia**
- **Arrive in Granada and have an included lunch**

We will depart from Madrid early in the morning, heading south through **La Mancha.** Our first stop will be in **Puerto Lápice,** a charming Manchego village evocative of **Don Quixote.** We will then continue into **Andalusia via Despeñaperros,** arriving in Granada, where lunch will be included. In the afternoon, if you have chosen the option that includes a visit to the **Alhambra,** we will explore the magnificent **Alhambra Palace** and its beautiful **Generalife Gardens,** both built during the Arab period, with a local guide.



**VERY IMPORTANT NOTE:** The number of visitors allowed into the ALHAMBRA is strictly regulated by law. To ensure your admission, tickets will be issued upon confirming your tour reservation. It's essential to provide accurate personal details (full name and passport/ID number) at the time of booking. Please be aware that ticket costs are non-refundable in case of cancellation. In rare cases where the ALHAMBRA visit is not possible, we will instead tour the ROYAL ALCÁZAR OF SEVILLE, which offers similar historical and architectural significance.



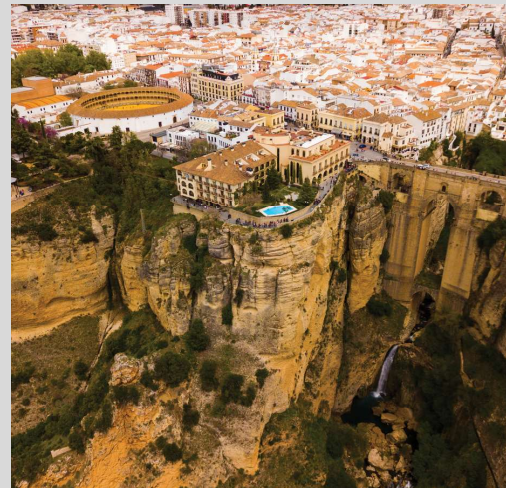


#### DAY 4 : GRANADA - MALAGA - MARBELLA - RONDA - SEVILLE

 B/D

- From Granada to Malaga (famous for cathedral, Picasso), then Puerto Banús (famous for luxury marina).
- Continue to Ronda (Famous for cliff views), arrive Seville
- Dinner included

Departure from Granada. We'll head towards the **Costa del Sol**. First stop, Malaga, where we'll have time for a stroll through its historic district, famous for its cathedral and the **Picasso Museum**. Afterward, we'll proceed along the coastal highway, enjoying picturesque views of the Mediterranean. **Puerto Banús**, in **Marbella**, is a stunning and sophisticated recreational harbor. In the afternoon, we'll continue our journey through the mountains listening to stories of bandits before reaching Ronda, a picturesque white town known for its cliffside location and a deep canyon that divides the town. Finally, Seville. We'll arrive in the evening and dinner will be included at the hotel.



#### DAY 5 : SEVILLE

 B

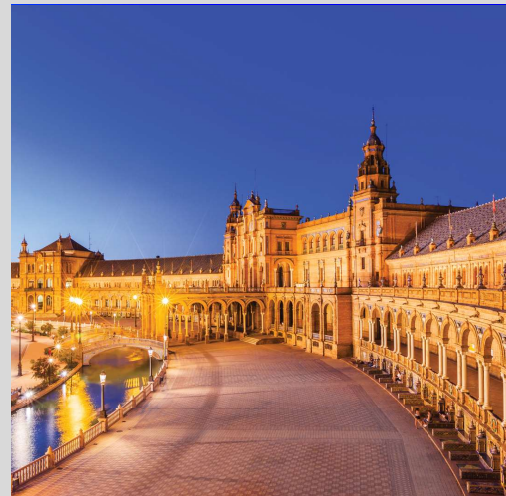
- Morning tour of Seville: photostops at cathedral, Giralda, Santa Cruz, and Triana; includes a scenic Guadalquivir River cruise.
- Evening optional: Flamenco show at a local tablao.

In the morning, we'll embark on a city tour of Seville, where you'll see the cathedral with its famous **Giralda**, the banks of the **Guadalquivir River**, and the popular neighborhoods of **Santa Cruz** and **Triana**. After the tour, enjoy a relaxing boat ride on the **Guadalquivir River** offering stunning panoramic views (included). In the evening, you'll have the option to attend a popular flamenco tablao.

#### DAY 6 : SEVILLE - MERIDA - EVORA - LISBON

 B

- Travel from Seville through scenic rolling hills to Mérida, where you'll have outside views of UNESCO-listed Roman Theater and Amphitheater, followed by free time in the charming historic center.
- Continue to Portugal, stopping in Évora to admire (photostops) at its whitewashed streets, Renaissance palaces, and cathedral, before arriving in Lisbon in the evening.



We'll leave Seville, traveling through pleasant landscapes of rolling hills and expansive pasturelands as we head towards **Extremadura**. In Mérida, admission is included to the **Archaeological Ensemble of Mérida**, which features a Roman Theater and Amphitheater. This site is renowned for its excellent preservation and its designation as a **World Heritage Site**. You'll have time for lunch and a stroll through the vibrant pedestrian historic center, filled with restaurants and local charm. We will then continue to Portugal, stopping in Évora, another World Heritage Site, known for its whitewashed streets, Renaissance palaces, and cathedral. We'll arrive in Lisbon in the evening.

#### DAY 7 : LISBON

 B

- Enjoy a sightseeing tour of Lisbon, exploring the charming alleys, iconic tiles, and the historic Belem neighborhood, where Portuguese navigators once set sail.
- After free time in the afternoon to visit Bairro Alto and optional trips to Sintra, Cascais, and Estoril, return to the hotel from the lively Restauradores Square.



In the morning, we'll embark on a sightseeing tour of Lisbon, exploring the Portuguese capital of the seven hills, with its charming alleys, iconic tiles, the feeling of "saudade," and the beautiful Atlantic light. We'll also visit the Belem neighborhood, from where the great Portuguese navigators set sail to cross the oceans in the 15th century. Free time in the afternoon to walk and go to the **Bairro Alto** and its viewpoint; if you'd like to, you could take an optional trip to the towns of **Sintra**, **Cascais** and **Estoril**. In the evening, we'll return to the hotel from the lively **Restauradores Square**, filled with vibrant bars and cafes.

## DAY 8 : LISBON - FATIMA - PORTO



- Travel to the north of Portugal, visiting the important pilgrimage site of Fátima before continuing to Porto, where you'll enjoy a 50-minute cruise on the Douro River aboard a traditional "Rabelo" boat.
- After lunch, explore Porto's lively Ribeira district with its narrow streets, historic merchant houses, and cafés, before heading to the hotel.

We'll travel to the north of Portugal, where we'll visit Fátima, an important pilgrimage site. We'll then continue to Porto, the country's second-largest city. After lunch, we'll enjoy a 50-minute cruise along the **Douro River** aboard a traditional Portuguese "Rabelo" boat, offering a unique perspective of the city's beautiful riverside. Afterwards, you'll have free time to explore the lively medieval Ribeira district, known for its narrow streets lined with historic merchant houses and charming cafés, before heading to the hotel.

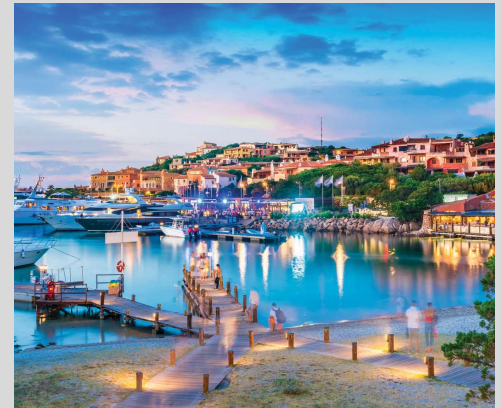


## DAY 9 : PORTO - BOM JESUS DO MONTE SANCTUARY - CAMBADOS - SANTIAGO DE COMPOSTELA



- Visit Braga to ride the world's oldest water-operated cable car to the Sanctuary of Bom Jesus, then descend via its picturesque staircase.
- In Galicia, enjoy a glass-bottom boat trip in Cambados with wine and mussel tasting, before arriving in Santiago de Compostela for a city tour of its medieval streets and pilgrimage sites.

Today, we'll travel through stunning landscapes. In Braga, we'll take a ride on the world's oldest water-operated cable car to reach the **Sanctuary of Bom Jesus**, where breathtaking views await. After exploring the sanctuary, we recommend descending via its picturesque staircase. Our journey continues into Galicia, where we'll visit the historic town of **Cambados in Rías Baixas**. Here, we'll embark on a glass-bottom boat trip along the **Ría de Arousa**, learning about mussel and oyster production. Enjoy wine and mussel tasting onboard. At lunchtime, we'll arrive in **Santiago de Compostela** for a city tour led by a local guide, exploring its medieval streets and renowned pilgrimage sites dating back to the **Middle Ages**.

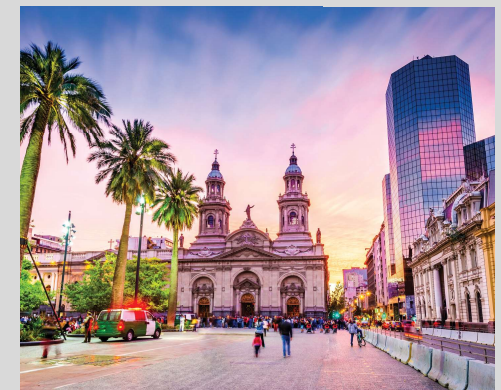


## DAY 10 : SANTIAGO DE COMPOSTELA - LUGO - O CEBREIRO - LEON - OVIEDO



- Explore Lugo's historic center and Roman walls, then visit the charming village of O Cebreiro before heading to León for outside views of its Gothic cathedral and a stroll through the town center.
- Cross the Cantabrian Range to Oviedo for a city tour (photostops) of its 9th-century cathedral and other landmarks, followed by a optional traditional Asturian dinner in a cider house.

We'll begin along the **Way of St. James in Lugo**, exploring its historic town center and UNESCO-listed Roman walls. Next, we'll visit the charming village of O Cebreiro before heading to León to see its Gothic cathedral and stroll through the town center. After crossing the **Cantabrian Range**, we'll arrive in Oviedo for a guided tour of the 9th-century cathedral, **Calatrava Congressional Palace**, **Campoamor Theatre**, and **Calle de la Rua**, followed by a traditional Asturian dinner in a cider house.



## DAY 11 : OVIEDO - COVADONGA - SANTILLANA DEL MAR - SANTANDER



- Visit the **Basilica of Covadonga**, then travel along the coastline to **Santillana**, a medieval town, and the **Altamira Cave Museum** (tickets included).
- Continue to **Santander** for a panoramic tour with a local guide, exploring the coastal city's stunning views of mountains and beaches.

We'll travel to the **Picos de Europa** (Peaks of Europe). Our journey will begin with a visit to the **Basilica of Covadonga** (outside view). From there, we'll follow the coastline to Santillana, one of Spain's most beautiful towns with an intact medieval quarter. We'll also visit the **Altamira Cave Museum** (tickets included), located nearby. Later, we'll head to **Santander**, the capital of the region, a coastal city offering stunning views of both mountains and beaches. A panoramic tour with a local guide is included, allowing us to explore this elegant coastal city and its beautiful bay.





## DAY 12 : SANTANDER - BILBAO - FORONDA SERVICE AREA - LA RIOJA - ZARAGOZA B

- Travel along the Cantabrian coast to Bilbao for a city tour, visiting the Guggenheim area, the old quarter, and the outside view of its Cathedral, followed by free time to enjoy "pintxos."
- Continue to La Rioja to visit the Wine Culture Museum in Briones before arriving in Zaragoza in the evening.

We'll follow the motorway along the Cantabrian coast, passing through stunning landscapes where mountains meet the sea. Our journey will lead us to Bilbao, the largest city in the **Basque Country**. There, we'll embark on a brief city tour with a local guide, exploring highlights such as the Guggenheim area, the old quarter, and the Cathedral. Following the tour, you'll have free time to savor authentic "pintxos". Later, we'll continue our travels to La Rioja, renowned for its exceptional wines. We'll visit the **Wine Culture Museum** in Briones to delve into the ancient art of winemaking. We'll arrive in Zaragoza in the evening.



## DAY 13 : ZARAGOZA - POBLET - BARCELONA B

- Start the day with a panoramic tour of Zaragoza, outside views of the Cathedral-Basilica of Our Lady of the Pillar, Goya's masterpieces, the Roman theatre, a Renaissance palace, and the Aljafería Palace.
- After lunch, visit the Poblet Abbey, one of the best-preserved medieval monasteries, before continuing to Barcelona, arriving in the evening.

We'll start the day with a morning panoramic tour of Zaragoza guided by a local expert. Our first stop will be the **Cathedral-Basilica of Our Lady of the Pillar**. We'll also delve into the works of the famous painter Goya and discover some of his masterpieces. The tour will move on to the Roman theatre and a Renaissance palace, and then we'll take a stroll by the **Aljafería Palace**. (photostops at above sightseeing)

After lunch, we'll head to Catalonia to visit the **Poblet Abbey**, a stunning walled monastery set amidst beautiful scenery. It is one of the best-preserved medieval monasteries in the world (tickets included). Our journey will then take us to Barcelona, where we'll arrive in the evening.



## DAY 14 : BARCELONA B

- Enjoy a panoramic tour of Barcelona, with photostops at Gaudi's modernist architecture, the Ramblas, and key historical landmarks like the Universal Exposition and Olympic sites.
- After free time in the afternoon, transfer to Maremagnum, a contemporary entertainment complex by the sea, for a leisurely stroll and dining options.

In the morning, we'll embark on a panoramic tour of Barcelona, renowned as one of the most fascinating European capitals. This vibrant city, nestled along the **Mediterranean Sea**, is famous for Gaudi's modernist architecture, the bustling Ramblas, and its rich history, highlighted by the Universal Exposition and the Olympics hosted here. You'll have free time in the afternoon. In the evening, we'll provide a transfer to Maremagnum, a contemporary entertainment and dining complex by the sea, located near **Plaza de Colón**. Here, you can enjoy a leisurely stroll through the lively area and choose from a variety of dining options.

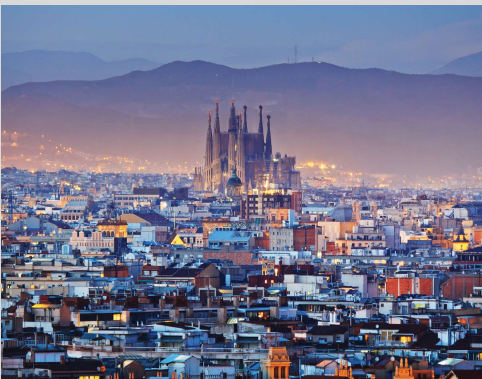


## DAY 15 : BARCELONA - KUALA LUMPUR B
