## 17D15N AMAZING SPAIN, PORTUGAL & MOROCCO

### DAY 1 : DEPART KLIA ✈️ MADRID

- Arrival, pickup from airport arrival hall and transfer to hotel
- Evening transport to the Plaza Mayor and La Latina

**Welcome to Madrid!** Upon arriving at the airport, we will be waiting to transfer you to your hotel. You can enjoy some free time until the beginning of your tour. Please check the informative posters placed at the hotel reception area, which have all the information about the welcome meeting with your guide and fellow travelers. Towards the end of the day, we provide a **transfer to Plaza Mayor and La Latina**, Madrid's most famous area for night life and tapas restaurants where you can dine at your preferred restaurant: Indian, Chinese, Spanish and Middle Eastern are some of the options available.

### DAY 2 : MADRID



- Roaming Madrid city tour
- Stroll through the Retiro Park.

The morning starts with a **comprehensive tour** through the center of Madrid, including the Paseo del Prado, Cibeles, Neptuno, the Gate of Alcalá, Plaza de Colón and Plaza Mayor. Then we will visit Retiro Park, an oasis in the city center, where we will see the lake and the Glass Palace. Enjoy the rest of the afternoon at your own leisure. At the end of the evening we will return to the hotel.

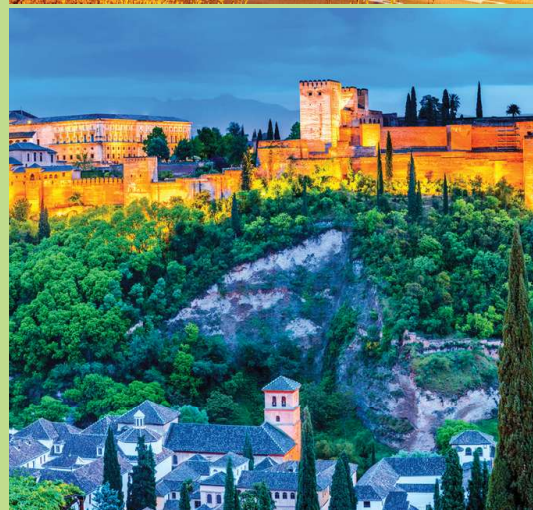
### DAY 3 : MADRID - GRANADA



- Journey through La Mancha with a stop in Puerto Lápice, enter Andalusia via Despeñaperros.
- Explore Granada, featuring the stunning Alhambra Palace and Generalife gardens.

We leave Madrid in the early morning. We travel to the south across La Mancha, making a stop in **Puerto Lápice**, a 'mancheño' village evoking the figure of Don Quixote. We will enter Andalusia via Despeñaperros, arriving in **Granada**. **Lunch included.** In the afternoon, if you purchased the trip with an included visit to the Alhambra, with a local guide we will visit the immense **Alhambra Palace** and its beautiful **Generalife gardens**, built in Arab times.

**Note:** The number of visitors allowed into the Alhambra is strictly regulated by law. To ensure your admission, tickets will be issued upon confirming your tour reservation. It's essential to provide accurate personal details (full name and passport/ID number) at the time of booking. Please be aware that ticket costs are non-refundable in case of cancellation. In rare cases where the Alhambra visit is not possible, we will instead tour the Royal Alcázar of Seville, which offers similar historical and architectural significance.

-258KM- MARRAKECH

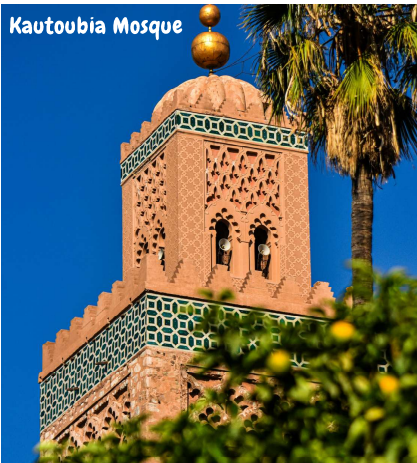
- Meet and greet at Mohammed V Int. Airport.
- After lunch, start the journey to **Marrakesh, the "Red City"** due to its distinctive red sandstone buildings nestled at the foothills of the Atlas Mountains.
- **Djma-el-Fna Square**, a UNESCO heritage site is the heart and soul of Marrakech filled with fortune tellers, acrobats, snake charmers, musicians and vendors and more.
- **Mosque of Koutoubia**, most iconic landmark with a towering minaret visible from many parts of Marrakech.
- **Overnight stay in Marrakesh. (D)**

## DAY 3

MARRAKECH -213KM-  
QUARZAZATE

- Visit the **Bahia Palace**, a masterpiece of Moroccan architecture adorned with intricate woodwork and serene courtyards.
- **Majorelle Garden**, a botanical paradise created by French painter Jacques Majorelle and later lovingly restored by Yves Saint Laurent.
- Journey from Marrakesh to **Ouarzazate** via the **Tizi-n-Tichka Pass**, the highest mountain pass (2,260m) with breathtaking landscapes dotted with traditional **Berber villages** and historic sites.
- Explore the ancient village of **Kasbah Ait Ben Haddou**, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, before visiting the renowned **Atlas Film Studio**, where numerous Hollywood blockbusters have been filmed.
- **Overnight stay in Ouarzazate. (B/D)**

## DAY 4

QUARZAZATE  
SAHARA DESERT -365KM-

- Enjoy the scenic drive as you journey deeper into the majestic **Sahara Desert**, passing through valleys, gorges, and lush oases.
- Discover the **Dades Valley**, known as the **"Valley of a Thousand Kasbahs,"** dotted with ancient fortresses and rock formations.
- Continue to the winding **Dades Gorges**, where striking red and orange cliffs create a spectacular landscape popular among hikers and photographers.
- **Todra Gorges**, featuring towering limestone cliffs that soar up to 300m, with a gentle river flowing through the gorge and forming a serene oasis at its base.
- **Tinghir and the Todra Valley**, a picturesque town surrounded by a vibrant palm grove stretching for miles along the river.
- Enjoy a **4WD vehicle** for the final stretch to the **Erg Chebbi Dunes**.
- **Sahara Desert tour, ride camels** across the golden dunes at sunset, then arrive at your desert campsite for a traditional dinner around a campfire. Later, retire to your Berber tent and sleep under a canopy of stars, embracing the magical atmosphere of the Sahara Desert.
- **Overnight stay in Sahara Desert Camp. (B/D)**

## DAY 5

MERZOUGA

- Embark on an exciting tour of the **desert dunes** to witness the stunning contrasts of the Sahara and gain fascinating insights into the nomadic way of life.
- Visit the **'black village' of Khamlia** and be captivated by the hypnotic rhythms of the Gnawa musicians while enjoying a traditional Berber tea
- Continue to **Rissani**, a historic town famed for its vibrant weekly markets, where nomads gather to trade goods. En route, pass by the lake in Merzouga, a rare picturesque sight that adds to the desert's unique charm.
- **Overnight stay in Merzouga. (B/D)**

Tizi-n-Tichka Pass



- Begin your exploration of Morocco's most mystical imperial city with a visit to the **medieval Medina**, where narrow alleys lead to bustling souks filled with artisans practicing age-old crafts.
- Stroll through the **Mellah (Jewish Quarter)**, step inside the **Medersa Bou Inania**, and admire the exquisite woodwork at **Nejjarine Square**. Pass through the iconic **Bab Boujloud**, also known as the Blue Gate.
- Stop for an outside view of the **Quaraouiyine Mosque**, one of the oldest universities in the world. Gain fascinating insight into **traditional leather-making** and witness the famous tanneries, where leather is dyed using centuries-old methods without modern technology.
- Conclude your tour with a visit to the historic palaces of **Fes El Bali**, followed by a scenic drive through the modern city of Fes.
- **Overnight stay in Fez. (B/D)**

#### DAY 4: GRANADA - TANGIERS - ASILAH - RABAT

B/D

- Travel from Granada across Costa del Sol and cross the Strait of Gibraltar by ferry.
- Explore the vibrant walled city of Asilah, and end the day in Rabat with an included dinner.

Departing from Granada, we'll traverse the Costa del Sol. Upon reaching Algeciras or Tarifa, we'll board a modern **ferry to cross the Strait of Gibraltar** (tickets included). Passengers will need to carry their own luggage as the bus typically does not make the crossing. Upon arrival in Morocco, we'll journey through breathtaking landscapes. Our first stop will be **Asilah**, a charming walled city nestled on the Atlantic coast, once a historic port and pirate stronghold, now bustling with vibrant life. There will be time for lunch before we head to Rabat. Upon arrival in **Rabat**, **dinner will be included**.



#### DAY 5 : RABAT - CASABLANCA - MARRAKECH

B/D

- Visit Rabat's landmarks.
- Tour Casablanca's Hassan II Mosque, and enjoy a Kalesa ride in Marrakech ending at Djema Square with dinner.

We will go on a **panoramic tour of Rabat**, in which we will visit the immense Royal Palace, the Mohamed V Mausoleum and the mighty Kasbah of the Udayas. At midday we will travel to **Casablanca**, where we'll go on a short **city tour with a local guide**. The tour includes a visit to the outside of what is considered one of the most important mosques in the Arab world, the great Hassan II mosque. Then, we will head to **Marrakech**. After arriving at the hotel, you will be able to experience a **traditional Kalesa ride** up to the famous Djema square. **Dinner buffet included**.



#### DAY 6 : MARRAKECH

B/L

- Explore Marrakech's highlights, including Jemaa el-Fnaa Square, the Medina, Koutoubia Mosque, and Bahia Palace.
- Free time to relax or shop, with an optional evening Fantasy Party.

Today, we'll explore one of the most fascinating places in the world, the city that gave Morocco its name. Our **city tour** will take us through its strong walls, the bustling Jemaa el-Fnaa square, the Medina, the Koutoubia Mosque, and the **Bahia Palace** (tickets included). Afterward, you'll have free time for lunch (included) and to relax by the pool or in the hotel garden, or to shop in the souks. In the evening, you can join the Fantasy Party, an optional excursion.



#### DAY 7 : MARRAKECH - AIT BENHADOU - OUARZAZATE - BOUMALNE DADES B/D

- Cross the Atlas Mountains, visit Ait Benhaddou's iconic village.
- Explore Ouarzazate's Kasbah, and enjoy the scenic Valley of Roses en route to Boumalne Dades.

We'll set out to cross the Atlas Mountains, where lofty peaks often covered in snow bid us farewell as we leave the palm groves of Marrakech. You'll see small Berber villages clinging to the edges of deep gorges. Our journey includes a stop at the fortified village of **Ait Benhaddou**, renowned for its appearances in numerous movies. As we travel through landscapes reminiscent of biblical scenes, we'll pause in **Ouarzazate**, known for its impressive Kasbah. Continuing through the Valley of Roses, we'll reach **Boumalne Dades** where **dinner will be included**.

**NOTE:** Occasionally in winter, roads may close due to snowdrifts. If necessary, this part of the itinerary will be rescheduled according to our alternative plan. (Access to the Sahara Desert depends on road conditions).

## DAY 8 : BOUMALNE DADES- TODGHA - ERFOUD

🏠 B/L

- Journey through the Sahara Desert via the Valley of the Kasbahs.
- Visit the majestic Todgha Gorge.
- Explore a desert town near Khorbat,

Embark on an exhilarating journey through the **Sahara Desert**: traverse the Valley of the Kasbahs, river valleys surrounded by thousands of palm trees, rocky plains merging into lush oases and adobe villages, and formidable fortresses guarding ancient thoroughfares. Our visit includes the awe-inspiring **Todgha Gorge**, a majestic canyon with towering walls rising more than 100 meters on both sides. En route, we'll stop at a small adobe town near **Khorbat**, where you can learn about the desert community supported by the Foundation (access may be affected by weather conditions such as river flooding). We'll proceed towards **Erfoud**. For those interested, an off-road excursion to the Sahara Desert sand dunes offers a breathtaking sunset experience. **Lunch will be included.**



## DAY 9: ERFOUD - FEZ

🏠 B/L/D

- Cross the Atlas Mountains' gorges and plateaus.
- Visit the "House of the Cedars" and monkey colonies near Azrou.
- Explore Bhalil's Berber culture and cave houses, and end with a panoramic view of Fez from the Marinid tombs.

We will leave Erfoud early, crossing the **Atlas Mountains** powerful gorges and stunning landscapes. We then cross a high and cold plateau area inhabited by nomadic shepherds. Stop at **Midelt**, in the center of this region. We'll continue our route with a stop for **lunch** (included) in the Middle Atlas, by a lake in a beautiful natural setting. The scenery will change dramatically as we enter a region rich in forests, where snow is common in winter. Near **Azrou**, in the National Park we visit "**The House of the Cedars**", a small museum that illustrates about the region, we will be amused by the colonies of monkeys that inhabit this area. We continue to **Bhalil**, small and quiet town inhabited by Berbers of the middle Atlas with a very picturesque old city center with colorful streets, traditionally the population lived in caves, today these caves have been integrated into the houses. Continue to **Fez**, before going to the hotel we will admire the view of the city from the Marinid Tombs. **Dinner included.**



## DAY 10 : FEZ - TANGIER

🏠 B/L/D

- Discover Fez's highlights: the Royal Palace, Jewish Quarter, vibrant souks, Tanners' Quarter, and the historic Medina, ending with a palace lunch.
- Travel north to Tangier, arriving by evening with dinner included.

We'll go on a **tour of Fez**, entering through the Bronze Gates of the Royal Palace and exploring the Jewish quarter, its lively souks, and the Tanners' Quarter. The cultural capital of the country is renowned for its impressive Medina, which preserves the traditional Arab atmosphere like no other. We'll conclude our visit with an **included lunch** at a historic palace in the Medina.

In the afternoon, we'll journey north through **Morocco** on a modern highway, reaching **Tangier** by evening. **Dinner will be included.**



## DAY 11 : TANGIERS - SEVILLE

🏠 B/D

- Enjoy free time in Tangier for last-minute shopping, then ferry back to Spain.
- Travel to Seville, arriving by evening with dinner included.

Free time in **Tangier** – do you feel like doing some last-minute shopping? We'll take a **ferry** back to **Spain**. The bus will not be on board, so each passenger must take their luggage on the ferry. We'll arrive in Algeciras or Tarifa and continue to **Seville**. We'll arrive in the evening and **dinner will be included.**





## DAY 12 : SEVILLE

 B

- Explore Seville's cathedral, Giralda, Santa Cruz, and Triana neighborhoods.
- Enjoy a Guadalquivir River boat ride.

In the morning, we'll embark on a **city tour of Seville**, where you'll see the cathedral with its famous Giralda, the banks of the Guadalquivir River, and the popular neighborhoods of Santa Cruz and Triana. After the tour, enjoy a relaxing **boat ride on the Guadalquivir River** offering stunning panoramic views (included). In the evening, you'll have the option to attend a popular flamenco tablao.

## DAY 13 : SEVILLE - MERIDA - EVORA - LISBON

 B

- Visit Mérida's Roman Theater and Amphitheater.
- Explore Évora's whitewashed streets and Renaissance palaces before arriving in Lisbon.

We'll leave Seville, traveling through pleasant landscapes of rolling hills and expansive pasturelands as we head towards Extremadura. In **Mérida**, admission is included to the **Archaeological Ensemble of Mérida**, which features a Roman Theater and Amphitheater. This site is renowned for its excellent preservation and its designation as a World Heritage Site. You'll have time for lunch and a stroll through the vibrant pedestrian historic center, filled with restaurants and local charm. We'll then continue to Portugal, stopping in **Évora**, another World Heritage Site, known for its whitewashed streets, Renaissance palaces, and cathedral. We'll arrive in **Lisbon** in the evening.

## DAY 14 : LISBON

 B

- Explore Lisbon's charming alleys, Belem neighborhood, and Bairro Alto.

In the morning, we'll embark on a **sightseeing tour of Lisbon**, exploring the Portuguese capital of the seven hills, with its charming alleys, iconic tiles, the feeling of "saudade," and the beautiful Atlantic light. We'll also visit the Belem neighborhood, from where the great Portuguese navigators set sail to cross the oceans in the 15th century. Free time in the afternoon to walk and go to the Bairro Alto and its viewpoint; if you'd like to, you could take an optional trip to the towns of Sintra, Cascais and Estoril. In the evening, we'll return to the hotel from the lively Restauradores Square, filled with vibrant bars and cafes.

## DAY 15 : LISBON - CACERES - MADRID

 B

- Visit Estremoz's medieval castle and cobblestone streets, explore Cáceres' well-preserved medieval and Renaissance center, and arrive in Madrid.

We'll depart from **Portugal** early, crossing the picturesque region of **Alentejo**. Our journey will include a coffee stop in **Estremoz**, a charming town known for its medieval castle, cobblestone streets, beautiful architecture, and calming atmosphere, all of which reflect Portuguese authenticity. We'll then cross into **Spain**. In **Cáceres**, you'll have the chance to enjoy lunch and explore its historic center, renowned as one of the best-preserved medieval and Renaissance urban complexes in the world. We'll continue to **Madrid**, arriving in the evening.
