



## 10D7N LONDON, AMSTERDAM, BRUGES & PARIS (ENGLAND/NETHERLANDS/BELGIUM/FRANCE)

### DAY 1 : DEPART KLIA/CHECKIN

### DAY 2 : ARRIVAL ✈️ LONDON

- Arrival London, pickup from airport and transfer to Hotel

On arrival at the airport we shall be waiting to transfer you to the hotel. You can enjoy your free time until the tour starts next day

### DAY 3 : LONDON TOUR

- Morning London City Tour
- Watch the famous "Changing of the Guard" (If operating)
- Afternoon free at own leisure OR join optional tour
- Meet guide at Soho a tourist hotspot area then back to hotel



Get to know **LONDON** on a locally guided tour featuring style, culture and history. See the Houses of Parliament, the River Thames, the Tower of London and Buckingham Palace, where we will be able to watch the famous "Changing of the Guard" (depending on the dates). Afternoon at leisure. In the evening, take walk-through on own at Leicester Square, China Town and Soho, with a lively atmosphere, theatres and entertainment. Sit down for dinner at your preferred restaurant. Return to the hotel.



### DAY 4 : LONDON - COLCHESTER - COLCHESTER - VOLENDAM FERRY



- Visit British Museum (Photostop)
- Afternoon free at own leisure
- Pleasant views on our journey as we travel on bus
- Overnight Ferry crossing England to Holland (Inside Cruise type cabin)

After breakfast we will go to **the British Museum**, one of the oldest museums in the world. At lunch time we transfer to **Camden**, a district famous for having one of the most varied and extravagant street markets in London where we can see relics from cultures all around the world. Enjoy some leisure time. At around 16.00 we will leave for **COLCHESTER**, known as the most ancient city in England. Time for a stroll. We will then board the ferry in Harwich, **taking a night voyage** to the Netherlands.

**Note:** Due to the limited number of cabins available on the ferry, the itinerary may be adjusted. We might travel from London to Amsterdam via a daytime ferry, with an overnight stay in Antwerp, or alternatively, take a train or flight to Amsterdam.

### DAY 5 : COLCHESTER - VOLENDAM FERRY - VOLENDAM - AMSTERDAM

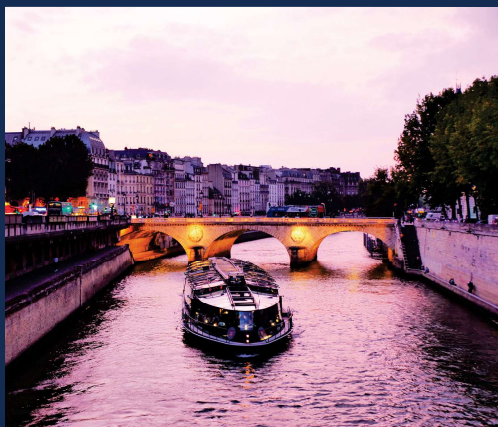
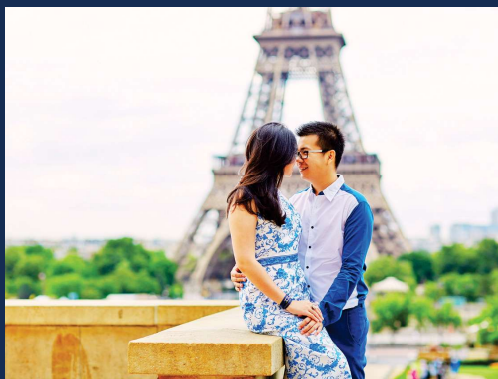


- We will visit Picturesque typical village of Volendam
- Amsterdam City Tour, Diamond Cutting Workshop & Red Light district

At around 08:00 in the morning we will reach the **Netherlands** (Hoek Van Holland), making a stop in **VOLENDAM**, a very picturesque fishing village. After this, we travel to **AMSTERDAM** and take a **guided tour** of the city, combining several highlights: the iconic image of the windmill and the Rembrandt statue, the contemporary elegance of the South District, and the centuries-old magic of diamond cutting at Museum Square.

Finally, we'll leave the bus and walk into the heart of the city, where the tour will end. Free time afterward.





## DAY 6 : AMSTERDAM - BRUSSELS - PARIS

- Visit Brussels, the capital of Belgium admire the Grand Place and Manneken Pis, then continue to Paris, the City of Lights.

After breakfast, we set out for **BELGIUM**. Just over 200 km away lies **BRUSSELS**, the Belgian capital and home to the main European institutions, a city that blends elegance with multiculturalism. We will admire its impressive Grand Place, a jewel of Flemish Baroque, and stroll past the symbolic Manneken Pis. This city fuses history, chocolate, and modernity.

In the afternoon, we continue into **FRANCE**, arriving in Paris at the end of the day.

## DAY 7 : PARIS

 B

- Transfer to Versailles Palace
- Visit the famous Montmartre district
- Bus City tour in Paris, back to hotel

We'll immerse ourselves in the rich history of **France** at the magnificent Palace of Versailles (admission not included), renowned for its stunning gardens. On our return to **Paris**, we'll visit **Montmartre**, a charming bohemian neighborhood famous for its artists, painters, and cabarets. To fully appreciate the grandeur of **Paris**, we'll embark on a **panoramic city tour** with a local guide, showcasing the city's impressive avenues and iconic monuments. Afterward, we'll return to the hotel. For those interested, there is an optional variety show in the evening.

## DAY 8 : PARIS

 B

- Eiffel Tower 2nd floor (Entrance included)
- Seine River Boat cruise
- Afternoon free at own leisure

We go to the centre of **Paris**, starting by the **Eiffel Tower** area. You will have the opportunity to climb up to the second floor of this remarkable metal monument (ticket included). Then, we enjoy a **boat cruise along the River Seine**, which divides the north of Paris from the south. Enjoy a free afternoon to explore as you choose. Note: Sometimes queues to climb the Eiffel Tower are long. For organizational reasons, if deemed appropriate, the climb can be made at a different moment of the day.

**Afternoon is free & easy time & back to hotel on own expenses by Uber**

**During free time you can visit Louvre Museum or Paris Disneyland on own**

**Note: If wait times at the Eiffel Tower are too long, we might reschedule the visit to a different time (or on Sunday) for your convenience.**

## DAY 9 : PARIS ✈️ KUALA LUMPUR

After breakfast, check-out as per hotel standard policy (leave baggage with hotel's baggage counter) then free at own leisure till transfer to airport for flight back to Malaysia.
