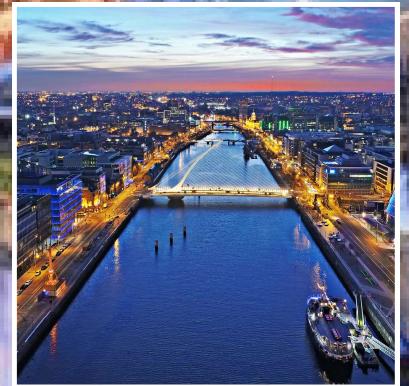

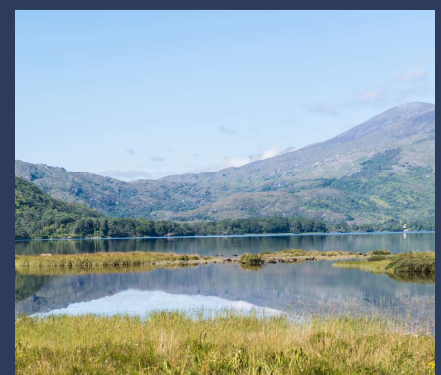
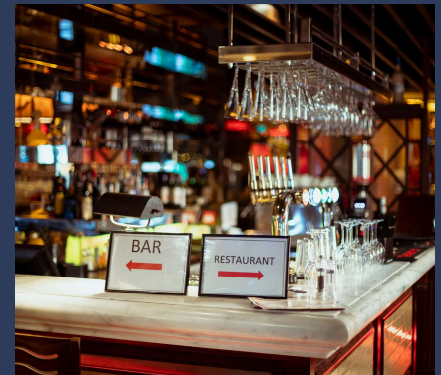


## 13D11N IRELAND & SCOTLAND LEGENDS & LANDSCAPES

Toast Ireland with an optional excursion to learn about the history, traditions, and brewing techniques behind one of the world's most popular beers on this fascinating tour, tasting and dinner at Dublin's legendary Guinness Storehouse.

### DAY 3 : DUBLIN - KILKENNY - WATERFORD - TRAMORE



- **Visit Kilkenny - Stroll medieval streets and enjoy a morning coffee.**
- **Explore Waterford - Discover the city renowned for its crystal.**
- **Arrive in Tramore - Relax at this charming seaside resort.**
- **Optional Irish Pub Experience - Enjoy live music, local charm, and two drinks.**

Kilkenny, with its medieval cobblestone streets and Old-World charm, is your first destination today. There is time to stroll through pretty lanes with vibrantly painted houses and enjoy a morning coffee (own expenses) Continue on to Waterford, famous for its exquisite crystal, before arriving at the seaside resort of Tramore. Enjoy a bit of craic (conversation) with an early evening optional of authentic Irish local flavor. Take a scenic drive to a traditional pub with a local musician ready to entertain you and give you wonderful memories of this beautiful country. Two drinks of your choice are included.



## DAY 4 : TRAMORE - BLARNEY - RING OF KERRY - KILLARNEY



- Visit Blarney - See the famous Stone of Eloquence and shop for Irish crafts.
- Explore Kenmare - Join part of the scenic Ring of Kerry.
- Ladies View Stop - Capture stunning views of the Lakes of Killarney.
- Arrive in Killarney - Enjoy this vibrant resort town.

The first of today's highlights is Blarney, famous for its Stone of Eloquence, with time at leisure to see the castle and shop for Irish handicrafts and handmade crystal. At Kenmare, join part of the Ring of Kerry, and stop for spectacular photos of the Lakes of Killarney from Ladies View before arriving in the popular resort town of Killarney. Today's Distance: 165 mi/ 265 km

## DAY 5 : KILLARNEY - ADARE



- Optional Jaunting Car Ride - Scenic tour along Killarney National Park to Ross Castle.
- Visit Adare - Explore Ireland's prettiest town with charming thatched cottages and historic ruins.
- Optional Medieval Banquet - Enjoy a 4-course feast with wine, music, and storytelling in an authentic Irish castle.

In Killarney this morning, there is time for an optional horse-drawn jaunting car ride along the National Park lakeshore for pictures of Ross Castle. Then to Adare, renowned as one of Ireland's prettiest towns. Its main street is punctuated with beautiful stone buildings and thatched cottages, medieval monasteries, ruins, and a picturesque village park. Go medieval with an original Irish castle medieval banquet optional. Enjoy a 4-course feast with wine, then relax as your medieval hosts dazzle you with unforgettable music and storytelling. Today's Distance: 58 mi/ 92 km

## DAY 6 : ADAREM - CLIFFS OF MOHER - GALWAY - SLIGO



- Cliffs of Moher - Admire stunning 668-foot cliffs with Atlantic views.
- Cross The Burren - Explore the unique limestone landscape.
- Stop in Galway - Enjoy the lively seaside city with shops and cafés.
- Arrive in Sligo - Rest in this charming town for the night.

Breathtaking scenery awaits you today. Start with a visit to the spectacular 668-foot Cliffs of Moher and fantastic views over the Atlantic and Clare coast. Then, cross the limestone plateau of The Burren and stop in Galway, a popular seaside destination and a buzzing cosmopolitan district with vibrant shops, and a busy café and bar culture. Your destination for tonight is Sligo.

Today's Distance: 194 mi/ 309 km

## DAY 7 : SLIGO - DERRY, NORTHERN IRELAND - GIANT'S CAUSEWAY - BELFAST



- Donegal Bay Drive - Scenic route with fishing ports and hidden beaches.
- Visit Derry - Explore the historic walled city on the Foyle River.
- Giant's Causeway - Discover the stunning UNESCO-listed basalt columns.
- Arrive in Belfast - Stay in the city where the Titanic was built.

- Drive along Donegal Bay with its small fishing ports and hidden beaches to Derry, the walled city on the banks of the Foyle River. Continue on to awe-inspiring Giant's Causeway, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Hear how millions of years ago, the more than 40,000 interlocking basalt columns were formed. Overnight in the vibrant city of Belfast, where the Titanic was built.
- Today's Distance: 197 mi/ 317 km

## DAY 8 : BELFAST - ALLOWAY, SCOTLAND - GLASGOW

 B

- Morning in Belfast - Enjoy free time in Northern Ireland's capital.
- Ferry to Scotland - Cross the Irish Sea to Cairnryan.
- Stop in Alloway - Visit the birthplace of poet Robert Burns.
- Arrive in Glasgow - End the day in Scotland's vibrant city.

Enjoy a leisurely morning in the capital city of Northern Ireland before boarding the ferry for the Irish Sea crossing to Cairnryan. On your way to Glasgow, stop in Alloway, the birthplace of Scottish poet Robert Burns.

## DAY 9 : GLASGOW - FORT WILLIAM - FORT AGUSTUS - CULLODEN MOOR - HIGHLANDS

- Loch Lomond - Scenic drive along the "Bonnie Banks."
- Rannoch Moor & Glen Coe - Pass through dramatic Highland landscapes.
- Fort William & Ben Nevis - See Britain's highest mountain.
- Loch Ness - Watch for the legendary monster.
- Culloden Moor - Visit the historic battlefield of the Jacobite Rising.

Follow the "Bonnie Banks" of Loch Lomond, and proceed via wild Rannoch Moor, Glen Coe, Fort William, beneath Ben Nevis and Fort Augustus. In the afternoon, look out for signs of the mysterious Loch Ness monster, on the way to Culloden Moor where the Jacobite Rising, with Bonnie Prince Charlie at its helm, came to a tragic end at the hands of the Hanoverians. Today's Distance: 202 mi/ 325 km

## DAY 10 : HIGHLANDS - PITLOCHRY - ST. ANDREWS - EDINBURGH

- spectacular Cairngorms National Park to Pitlochry, the Victorian mountain resort set amid beautiful scenery
- head to St. Andrews, whose Royal and Ancient Golf Club has given us the rules of golfing, optional in Evening an authentic Scottish evening filled with traditional food, drinks, singers, dancers, bagpipes, and, of course, the unforgettable Ceremony of the Haggis!

Travel through the spectacular Cairngorms National Park to Pitlochry, the Victorian mountain resort set amid beautiful scenery. 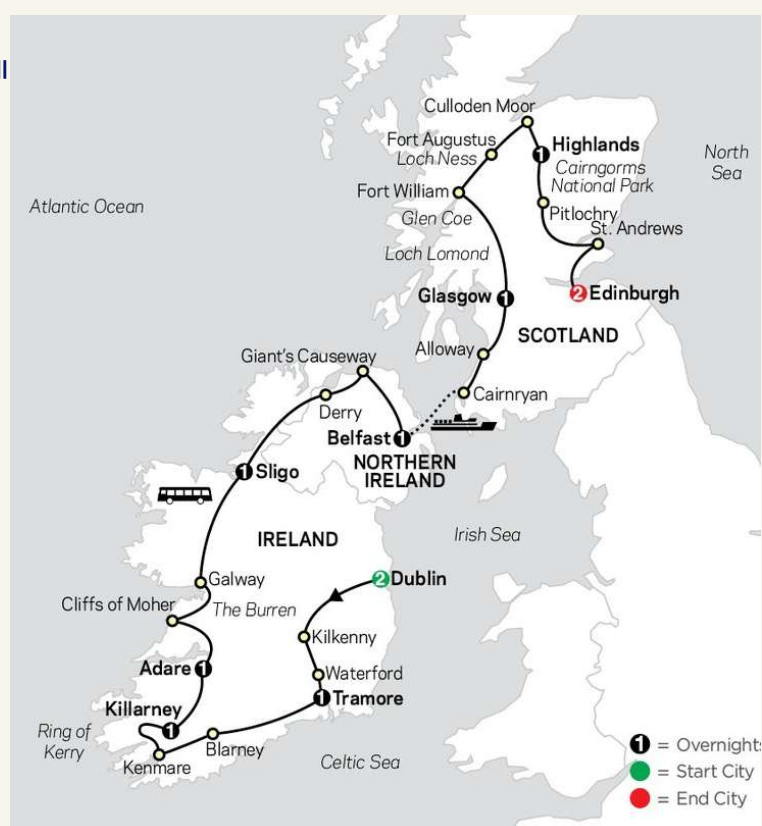
