DAY 1 : DEPART KUALA LUMPUR (KLIA) - VIENNA



- Arrival in Vienna with transfer to the hotel
- Free time to relax or explore nearby surroundings
- Tour information available at hotel reception boards

Upon arrival in Vienna, We'll **transfer** you to the hotel and you'll have some free time. In the afternoon, you'll find information about the start of your tour on the boards located at the hotel reception.

DAY 2: VIENNA



- Morning panoramic tour of Vienna with views of its grand avenues, imperial palaces and elegant parks
- Discover the historic center and main landmarks of Austria's capital
- Evening transfer to Town Hall Square to admire the illuminated city
- Free time to enjoy the vibrant evening atmosphere

In the morning, we'll enjoy a **panoramic tour** of the city, during which we'll discover its majestic avenues, impressive palaces, elegant parks, and charming historic center.

At nightfall, we'll have a **transfer to the Town Hall Square**, where you can admire the beautiful illumination and enjoy the lively evening atmosphere of the surrounding streets. **Overnight : Vienna**

DAY 3 : VIENNA – MARIBOR – ZAGREB



- Scenic journey from Vienna through alpine landscapes into Slovenia
- Stop in Maribor for a short walk past the cathedral and castle
- Continue to Zagreb, capital of Croatia, arriving by lunchtime
- Guided panoramic tour of Zagreb

We'll leave Vienna for a journey of great scenic beauty, traveling through the mountains to **Slovenia**. Our first stop will be in **Maribor**, where we'll take a short stroll around the cathedral and castle. We'll then continue to Croatia, arriving in **Zagreb** by lunchtime.

In the afternoon, a local guide will take us on a **panoramic tour**, allowing us to admire the city's two hills, the upper town, and the new districts of **Croatia**'s capital. **Dinner will be included.**

DAY 4: ZAGREB – BANJA LUKA – JAJCE – SARAJEVO

🍽️ B/D

- Early departure to Bosnia with scenic drive through Republika Srpska
- Stop in Banja Luka to explore its fortress and Orthodox cathedral
- Visit Jajce, known for its fortress, mosque and impressive waterfall (admission included)
- Arrival in Sarajevo with evening stroll through the historic Bazaar

We'll depart early in the morning to travel to **Bosnia**. Border formalities may take some time. As we drive through certain areas, we'll be reminded of the tragic war of the 1990s. Our journey will take us through the majority-Serb territory of Bosnia, with our first stop in **Banja Luka**. Here, you'll have time to explore the capital of the autonomous entity of Republika Srpska, the second largest city in Bosnia after Sarajevo, known for its fortress and Orthodox cathedral. There will be time for lunch. We'll then continue to **Jajce**, arguably the most beautiful town in Bosnia, celebrated for its cultural diversity, mosque, fortress, and impressive **waterfall** (admission included). After some time to explore, we'll proceed to **Sarajevo**, arriving in the evening. You'll have the opportunity to stroll through the historic center and visit the charming Bazaar, an old Ottoman market renowned for its architecture, oriental ambiance, and traditional shops. **Dinner will be included.**

DAY 5: SARAJEVO – MOSTAR – DUBROVNIK

🍽️ B/D

- Guided morning tour of Sarajevo, the "Jerusalem of Europe," highlighting its mosques, churches and synagogues
- Discover the Ottoman-influenced Old Town with its historic mosque and fountain
- Visit Mostar's charming historic center and iconic stone bridge linking diverse communities
- Continue to Dubrovnik with included dinner upon arrival

In the morning, we include a guided tour of **SARAJEVO**, a fascinating city known as the "Jerusalem of Europe" for its coexistence of different religions. Mosques, churches, and synagogues reflect this rich diversity. We will notice the strong Ottoman influence in its old town, with its more than 500-year-old mosque and beautiful fountain. After the visit, we continue our journey through an area of stunning natural beauty to **MOSTAR**, with its beautiful historic center and its iconic stone bridge that links the Orthodox, Muslim, and Catholic communities. Free time for lunch and to explore the city. We then continue on to **CROATIA**. Border formalities (which may be lengthy). Arrival in **DUBROVNIK** at the end of the day. **Dinner included**

Overnight : Dubrovnik

DAY 6: DUBROVNIK

 B/D

- Guided panoramic tour of Dubrovnik, the walled Adriatic city
- Visit the Franciscan Monastery and Assumption Cathedral
- Scenic viewpoint and boat trip to Lokrum Island (seasonal)

We'll enjoy a **panoramic tour of Dubrovnik** with a local guide in the morning. We will undoubtedly be in one of the most beautiful cities in Europe, perched on a cliff, surrounded by walls and kissed by the Adriatic Sea. Its intact historic center is a jewel of world architectural heritage. We'll have the opportunity to enjoy a stunning view of the city from a scenic viewpoint along the road. The tour includes tickets to the **Franciscan Monastery**, home to the oldest pharmacy in Europe, and the Assumption Cathedral. We'll also take **a boat trip to Lokrum**, a small island just 15 minutes away that is home to the ruins of an eleventh-century Benedictine monastery, a popular setting for the series Game of Thrones. Afterward, you'll have free time to explore at your leisure before returning to the hotel in the late afternoon. **Dinner will be included.**

Overnight : Dubrovnik

Note: On some occasions, accommodation may be in Cavtat, a coastal town near Dubrovnik. From November to March, there is no boat service to Lokrum, so we will not visit the island during these months.

DAY 7 : DUBROVNIK – STON – SPLIT

 B/D

- Scenic drive along the Croatian coastline
- Stop in Ston to see its famous medieval walls
- Cross the impressive Pelješac Bridge
- Guided tour of Split including Diocletian's Palace (admission included) and dinner

We'll set off in the morning, traveling along the stunning Croatian coastline, which features breathtaking seascapes and islands. Our first stop will be in **Ston**, a picturesque town boasting one of the longest walls in the world. As we continue through beautiful landscapes, we'll cross the impressive Pelješac Bridge over the sea. We'll arrive in **Split** at midday and enjoy **a tour with a local guide**, including **admission to Diocletian's Palace**. We'll explore this vast Roman palace, with its labyrinthine streets and stunning sea views. **Dinner will be included.**

Overnight : Split

DAY 8 : SPLIT – BRAC ISLAND – BOL ISLAND

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- Ferry from Split to Brač Island, known for its rugged coastline and blue seascapes
- Visit Jakšić Gallery in Donji Humac (entrance included)
- Traditional Croatian brunch at a local konoba
- Stop at Vidova Gora for panoramic views over Zlatni Rat Beach; free time in Bol

From **SPLIT**, we **board a ferry** to the **ISLAND OF BRAČ**, one of the most beautiful islands in the Adriatic, surrounded by deep blue seascapes and rugged coastlines. We travel through the island's interior, passing olive groves and stone walls, to Donji Humac, where we **visit the Jakšić Gallery (entrance included)**, a reflection of the local sculptural tradition. We enjoy a **traditional Croatian brunch (included)** at a typical konoba, then continue **up to Vidova Gora**, the highest point of the Adriatic islands, offering unforgettable views of the Dalmatian Coast and the famous Zlatni Rat beach. The day ends in Bol, a charming seaside town, with free time to stroll along the waterfront or relax on its crystal-clear beaches.





DAY 09: BOL ISLAND – HVAR ISLAND – JELSA

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- Free time in Bol to relax at the famous Zlatni Rat Beach
- Catamaran transfer across the Adriatic to Hvar Island
- Scenic sailing past turquoise waters and small islands
- Arrival in Jelsa with transfer to hotel

The day begins in **BOL**, with free time to enjoy the Adriatic Sea and relax on the famous Zlatni Rat beach, known for its crystal-clear waters. A unique natural setting to enjoy the island’s charm at a leisurely pace. In the afternoon, **we board a catamaran to HVAR ISLAND**, sailing through turquoise waters and past small islands. Arrival in **JELSA**, a quiet harbor with a Mediterranean feel. **Transfer to the hotel.**

DAY 10: JELSA – KORCULA ISLAND – KORCULA ISLAND

 B

- Free morning to explore Hvar’s Venetian architecture and Mediterranean charm
- Ferry crossing to Korčula Island through scenic Adriatic waters
- Arrival in Korčula, the walled medieval town and birthplace of Marco Polo
- Free time to explore the historic center and seaside views

Free morning in **HVAR** to stroll through one of the Adriatic’s most exclusive destinations, renowned for its elegant Venetian architecture, white stone alleyways, and lively Mediterranean atmosphere. In the afternoon, **we take a ferry to KORCULA ISLAND**, sailing through a seascape dotted with small islands and deep blue waters. Arrival in Korčula, a walled town with a strong medieval character, famous as the birthplace of Marco Polo. **Transfer to the hotel** and free time to explore and be captivated by its vibrant atmosphere and stunning views over the Adriatic.

DAY 11: KORCULA ISLAND – PELJESAC PENINSULA – DUBROVNIK

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- Guided tour of Korčula’s medieval walled Old Town
- Cross to Pelješac Peninsula, known for its vineyards
- Wine tasting included in a scenic rural setting
- Continue to Dubrovnik with free time upon arrival

In the morning, we discover **KORCULA** on a complete **guided tour**, exploring its walled old town, full of history and medieval charm. We then cross over to the **PELJESAC** Peninsula, a land of vineyards with a long winemaking tradition, where we **enjoy a wine tasting (included)** in an exceptional rural scenery. We continue on to **DUBROVNIK**, the Pearl of the Adriatic. Arrival at around 3:00 PM, followed by free time to begin enjoying its unique atmosphere, stroll along its city walls, or wander through the streets of its impressive historic old town.

Overnight : Dubrovnik

DAY 12: DUBROVNIK TO KUALA LUMPUR (KLIA)

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After breakfast, our journey will come to an end, leaving you with wonderful lasting memories as we transfer to the airport for your return flight to Kuala Lumpur.
