DAY 1: CHECKIN KLIA - FLIGHT TO AMSTERDAM - ARRIVAL

- Arrival Amsterdam airport, pickup up by our driver and send to hotel

Upon arriving at the airport, we'll transfer you to your hotel. Check the information boards in the hotel reception area for details about the welcome meeting with your guide next day

DAY 2 : AMSTERDAM



- Visit Zaanse Schans, known for windmills, canals, and traditional houses
- Explore Volendam, a charming fishing village, followed by a boat trip to Marken
- Take a panoramic tour of Amsterdam famous for canals, landmarks, and a diamond-cutting demo

Today we'll visit some truly picturesque places; the Holland of our dreams. First, we head to **Zaanse Schans**, with its charming houses, canals, and windmills. Then on to **VOLENDAM**, a very scenic fishing village.

From Volendam, we'll take a short boat ride to Marken, once an island now connected to the mainland by a fixed dike. Its houses were traditionally built on stilts to protect from flooding.

In the afternoon, we'll **enjoy a guided tour of AMSTERDAM**, combining several highlights: the iconic image of the windmill and the Rembrandt statue, the contemporary elegance of the South District, and the centuries-old magic of **diamond cutting** at Museum Square.

Finally, we make our way to the Central Station, where the tour will end. The guide will provide you with information to explore Amsterdam's famous canals, street markets, and cafés (back to hotel on own)

DAY 3 : AMSTERDAM - BRUSSELS - PARIS



- Discover Brussels, the elegant Belgian capital and home to major European institutions.
- Visit the magnificent Grand Place and see the iconic Manneken Pis.
- Continue the journey into France and arrive in Paris by evening.

After breakfast, we set out for **BELGIUM**. Just over 200 km away lies **BRUSSELS**, the Belgian capital and home to the main European institutions, a city that blends elegance with multiculturalism. Before arriving at the city center, we'll make a **brief stop at The Atomium, Brussels most iconic landmark**. We will admire its impressive Grand Place, a jewel of Flemish Baroque, and stroll past the symbolic Manneken Pis. This city fuses history, chocolate, and modernity.





DAY 4 : PARIS

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- Visit the Palace of Versailles
- Explore Montmartre a charming bohemian neighborhood
- Enjoy a panoramic city tour of Paris with a local guide

We'll immerse ourselves in the rich history of **France** at the magnificent **Palace of Versailles** (admission not included), renowned for its stunning gardens.

On our return to **Paris**, we'll visit **Montmartre**, a charming bohemian neighborhood, famous for its artists, painters, and cabarets.

To fully appreciate the grandeur of **Paris**, we'll embark on a **panoramic city tour** with a local guide, showcasing the city's impressive avenues and iconic monuments.

Afterward, we'll return to the hotel. For those interested, there is an **optional variety show** in the evening.

DAY 5 : PARIS

 B

- Visit the iconic Eiffel Tower 2nd floor tickets included
- Enjoy a 75-minute boat cruise along the Seine River
- Free afternoon to explore Paris at your leisure

We'll start our day in central **Paris**, beginning with a visit to the iconic **Eiffel Tower**.

You'll have the chance to go up to the **second floor** of this famous iron landmark (tickets included).

Afterwards, we'll enjoy a relaxing **boat cruise along the Seine**, which will last approximately one hour and fifteen minutes.

You'll have a free afternoon to explore the city at your own pace (**back to hotel on own expenses**)

Note: If wait times at the Eiffel Tower are too long, we might reschedule the visit to a different time (or on Sunday) for your convenience.

DAY 6 : PARIS - BURGUNDY - BEAUNE - LYON

 B

- Travel through Bourgogne, stopping in Beaune to visit its wine museum
- Proceed to Lyon, take a cable car to Notre-Dame de Fourvière for city views, and explore at your leisure
- Free time to explore Lyon at your leisure

Today, we will travel to the heart of **France**, passing through the **Bourgogne region**, famous for its beautiful vineyards and exceptional wines.

Our first stop will be **Beaune**, a delightful town in the center of **Burgundy**, known for its flower-lined streets, hospice, and wine museum.

After enjoying some free time for lunch and a stroll, we'll proceed to **Lyon**, the former capital of Roman Gaul, situated along the **Rhône River**. Lyon's historic center is a UNESCO World Heritage site. We'll take a **cable car up to Notre-Dame de Fourvière**, where you can soak in breathtaking views of the city. You'll have some free time to explore at your own pace.

Note: In some cases, part of the group will stay in **Chambéry**, a city near Lyon. In these instances, we'll travel to Chambéry in the evening for an overnight stay. In the morning, you'll have time to visit this medieval-style city, the **capital de la Saboya**, known for its beautiful historic center and impressive castle.

DAY 7 : LYON - GENEVA - ZURICH

 B

- Explore Geneva’s key landmarks, including the Palace of Nations, English Garden, and Jet d’Eau.
- Travel scenic routes along Lake Geneva and the Three Lakes region, surrounded by vineyards and mountain views.
- Stop in Neuchâtel to enjoy its lakeside promenade and historic town center.
- Arrive in Zurich in the late afternoon.

Today, we’ll travel to **Switzerland**. Upon arrival in **Geneva**, we’ll pass by the **Palace of Nations** (the European headquarters of the United Nations) and explore the pretty **English Garden** with its flower clock and admire the **Jet d’Eau**, the tallest fountain in Europe.

After lunch, we’ll continue our journey through Switzerland, traveling along the scenic routes by **Lake Geneva** and **Lake Neuchâtel**. We’ll drive along the **Three Lakes region**, enjoying views of magnificent vineyards set against the mountain backdrop. We’ll stop in **Neuchâtel**, where you can enjoy a walk by the lake, explore the historic town center, or visit the beautiful 10th-century castle. Our journey will conclude in **Zurich**, where we’ll arrive in the late afternoon.

Note: Depending on the number of passengers traveling from Geneva to Zurich, this part of the trip may be done by train, in which case there will be no stop in Neuchâtel.

DAY 8 : ZURICH

 B

- Explore Zurich
- Enjoy a scenic cruise on Lake Zurich
- Disembark in Rapperswil , a picturesque village renowned for its medieval castle

With our guide, we’ll explore **Zurich**, the most populous city in **Switzerland**, and its financial and cultural heart. Known for its banks, Zurich has been twice recognized as the city with the best quality of life in the world. Afterwards, we’ll embark on a **scenic cruise** of nearly two hours on **Lake Zurich**, with brief stops to enjoy the charming villages along the route. We’ll disembark in **Rapperswil**, a picturesque village renowned for its medieval castle. We’ll return to Zurich by **local train**, providing an opportunity to experience the efficiency and punctuality of the Swiss railway system.

Note: Depending on the number of travelers, transfers to and from the city center may be via local transport.

DAY 9: ZURICH - LUCERNE - ZURICH

 B/L

- Visit Grindelwald First Cliff and Cable Car Ride
- Includes lunch on the mountain before returning
- Explores charming cityscape of Lucerne

Today’s journey features stunning landscapes with tall mountains and pristine lakes. We’ll enjoy breathtaking scenery in the **Interlaken region**.

Our first stop will be **Grindelwald**, where we’ll have time for a coffee before taking the cable car up the mountain. Once there, we’ll walk along a winding path leading to a suspended bridge.

For those who are adventurous, crossing the bridge offers spectacular views of the surrounding glaciers.

We’ll have **lunch on the mountain** (included) before heading back down. Our next destination is **Lucerne**, one of Switzerland’s most beautiful cities, where you’ll have time to explore and enjoy the charming cityscape. We’ll then return to **Zurich**.





DAY 10 : ZURICH - KUALA LUMPUR

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After breakfast, check-out as per hotel standard policy then free at own leisure till transfer to airport for flight back to Malaysia

DAY 11 : ARRIVAL KUALA LUMPUR
